WOMEN'S BASKETBALL WELCOMES MIAMI

The Western Michigan women's basketball team welcomes the MAC leaders Miami Redhawks to Kalamazoo on Tuesday night for a midweek matchup. Tip-off for Tuesday's game is set for 7:00 p.m. from University Arena.

LAST TIME OUT

The Broncos had a big second half performance to earn a 73-67 win over the South Alabama Jaguars on Saturday. WMU went 1-1 in the MAC-SBC Challenge this season with their six-point win over South Alabama this weekend. The Brown and Gold's defense took advantage of the Jaguars ball handling, forcing 15 turnovers along with winning the game under the glass 33-31.

Sophomore guard Kailey Starks had a career performance for Western Michigan on the floor, scoring 33 points with seven rebounds, three steals, a block, and an assist. Also helping the Broncos to its first 70+ point game in over a month on the floor was sophomore guard Alli Harness with 12 points and a rebound.

SCOUTING THE REDHAWKS

Miami currently sits atop the MAC standings as the only team without a conference loss midway through conference play. The Redhawks have 10 MAC wins while having an overall record of 19-4. Miami's four losses have all come on the road, with its last loss happening on Dec. 14 at Colorado. The Redhawks had their largest loss of the season to the Buffaloes in a 20-point margin of defeat.

But during Miami's current 12 game win streak the team has been led by four players averaging double figures. Junior forward Amber Tretter is the Redhawks leader in both offense and defense, averaging 14.8 points and 8.1 rebounds a game. She is also fourth in the MAC in rebounds with 187 boards on the season so far. Miami's other double figure players include senior guard Amber Scalia (14.1), sophomore forward Ilse de Vries (12.5), and sophomore guard Tamar Singer (10.3).

SERIES HISTORY

Tuesday night is the 76th meeting between WMU and Miami dating back to the 1980s. The Redhawks hold a slight edge in the series going into Tuesday's game at 41-34. Part of that edge is the five game win streak Miami currently has in the series, going back to the 2021-22 season. The Brown and Gold last beat the Redhawks on Jan. 22, 2022 in Oxford by a score of 63-54.




