## **OPENING DRIVE ...**

- \* Saturday will be the only meeting between the Cougars and Western Oregon this season. The Wolves are trying to snap a three-game losing streak against Azusa Pacific.
- \* Western Oregon and Azusa Pacific have met eight times in the series history with both teams winning four times.
- \* Since Azusa Pacific joined the GNAC in 2011, Western Oregon is 1-3 against the Cougars.
- \* Prior to 2011, Western Oregon had won three-of-four games against Azusa Pacific.
- \* Western Oregon leads the GNAC in passing offense with an average of 315.1 yards per game.
- \* Paul Revis is third in the country averaging 205.1 all-purpose yards per game. The redshirt freshman leads the Great Northwest Athletic Conference with that stat.
- \* Revis is also the conference leader in receiving yards per game, averaging 112.8, while also catching a league-high nine touchdowns so far this season.
- \* Ryan Bergman leads the GNAC averaging 330 passing yards per game and has also thrown a GNAC-leading 19 touchdowns so far this season.
- \* Jesse Correa's nine made field goals this season is currently tied for the lead in the GNAC.

# FIRST 10

I Dixie State became the first team in six years to return a fumble for a touchdown against WOU. The last team to do it was Dixie State in 2008.

**2** Ryan Bergman is nine touchdown passes shy of tying the all-time record at WOU. His 51 TDs is currently second behind Mark Thorson (2004-07).

**3** WOU is 17-4 in its last 20 games at home, including a perfect 3-0 this season at McArthur Field.

**4** Tyrell Williams is 452 recieving yards from sole possession of the all-time record at WOU. His career total is currently 2,555.

**5** Jesse Correa made a 50-yard field goal as time expired in the first half at North Alabama. The senior became only the sixth player in WOU history to make a 50-yard field goal.

**6** Alexander Bradt reached 6,500 punting yards in his WOU career during the game at CWU two weeks ago.

**7** Against Humboldt State, Paul Revis became only the fourth player in GNAC history to gain 300 all-purpose yards in a single game. It was the highest total for WOU in the past 15 years.

**8** Revis is third in NCAA Div. II in all-purpose yards per game. He also leads the Great Northwest Athletic Conference.

**9** Bergman moved into third alltime in WOU history in most yards gained passing (5,818) in the game versus Simon Fraser last week.

**10** Bergman's 412 yards through the air at CWU was the fifth 400-yard game of his career. It was five yards short of his personal best.

#### NO PETS ALLOWED

#### CAPITOL AUTO REDZONE TAILGATER

Wolves fans and visitors can enjoy this unique college football experience at WOU. Members of the Wolves Club at or above the \$300 level and have purchased season tickets will have reserved parking with their names painted in two stalls and do not have to pay. Parking will be available in the Redzone on game days for \$10 a spot, first come first serve in any stall that is not painted or marked. Alcoholic beverages are allowed but must stay within the Redzone fence. Fans are welcome to grill but no open flames. Gates will open at 9:45 a.m. on game day and overnight camping is not allowed. At the conclusion of the game all trash and belongings must be picked up.

#### WOLF WALK

At 12:30 the football team will be making its way from the field into the locker room under the stadium on the outside of the stadium near the Capitol Auto Redzone just before they head out onto the field. Western Oregon invites you to line the walk way and cheer on the team as they head into the locker room.

## TICKET BOOTH / WILL CALL / ENTRY AND RE-ENTRY

Tickets will be available for purchase on the day of the game starting at 11am. Will Call will also open at 11am. A ticket is required to enter the venue. Upon leaving the venue in order to gain access back into the stadium a hand stamp from the ticket taker is required.

#### **OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE / CONCESSIONS**

No outside food or beverage will be allowed inside the stadium. Concessions are available at McArthur Field. Cash is the only form of payment accepted currently. A percentage of sales will go toward the athletic program working that day.

#### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

Fans are encouraged to provide a positive cheering atmosphere at all times. Any chants or cheers that contain profanity, derogatory, or political statements are not permitted.

#### BANNERS AND SIGNS

Hand-held banners and signs are permitted at WOU athletic events, provided that they are in good taste, contain no profanity, derogatory or political statements, present no safety hazard and do not block the view of the other guests.

#### FIELD POLICY

Field access is limited to participating student-athletes, coaches, officials, support personnel and other credentialed individuals. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted on the field. Any individual on the field must have a credential shown at all times. Media members must stay within designated areas and display appropriate credentials/vests at all times.

# HEAD COACH ARNE FERGUSON

WESTERN OREGON '91 10TH SEASON 62-43 AT WESTERN OREGON SECOND MOST WINS AT WOU

Western Oregon head coach Arne Ferguson enters his 10th season as the leader of the WOU football program in 2014.

In his nine seasons with the program, Ferguson has led the Wolves to a .500 or better record in each of the last eight years. The string is the longest streak for the program since Bill McArthur led the Wolves to nine straight .500 or better seasons from 1965-1973.

Ferguson began his run as head coach of the Wolves in 2005, and promptly turned a 1-9 team (2004) into a 5-6 club that fall. WOU then went 6-4 in 2006, losing all four games by a total of just 21 points. He then guided Western Oregon to one of the best records in program history with a 9-2 mark and a victory in the Rotary Bowl. In 2008, the Wolves went 7-4 with a 5-2 record on the road. He then followed it up with a 5-5 campaign in 2009 and a 7-4 mark in 2010. Ferguson enters his 10th season with an impressive career record of 58-39 (.598 winning percentage).

In his time as head coach, Ferguson has led a number of student-athletes to All-American honors. Since his arrival, nine student-athletes have been named All-American.

Western Oregon has also had two NFL draft picks during Ferguson's tenure. Kevin Boss was drafted by the New York Giants in the fifth round of the 2007 draft and helped the Giants win the Super Bowl as the starting tight end. In 2011, Jason Slowey went to the San Francisco 49ers in the sixth round.

Ferguson's heart and soul is all Wolves red as he has been involved as a player, assistant coach, and now head coach of the Western Oregon football program.



Ferguson played his college football in Monmouth from 1985-88. He began his coaching career at Western Oregon in 1989 and has been on the sidelines at McArthur Field ever since, minus a one-year stint in the high school coaching ranks (Silverton, 1992).

He coached the defensive backs and linebackers at WOU before becoming the defensive coordinator in 1997. His defensive squad that season was one of the most feared in the conference and was a major component in the Wolves' CFA title drive that year.

A 1991 graduate of Western Oregon, Ferguson was a three-time All-CFA choice, earning first-team honors in 1986 and 1987 and was a second-team pick as a senior. He led Western Oregon with 65 tackles, seven pass deflections and three interceptions in 1987. He played on the last Wolves teams to post back-to-back winning seasons (1986 and 1987), a distinction that he would like to see erased with an above-.500 campaign this fall.

Ferguson graduated from Vale High School in 1984, where he was a standout in football, basketball and baseball.

He and his wife April make their home in Monmouth, where they are parents to sons Logan and Brooks.

# Western Oregon 27, Simon Fraser 16 Oct. 25, 2014

## Monmouth, Ore. - McArthur Field

MONMOUTH, Ore. - Western Oregon University scored 13 unanswered points in the fourth quarter to overcome a two-point deficit, as the Wolves defeated the Clan of Simon Fraser University, 27-16, in Great Northwest Athletic Conference (GNAC) play Saturday at McArthur Field.

Western Oregon (4-4, 2-1 GNAC) trailed Simon Fraser (2-6, 2-2 GNAC) by two points, 16-14, early in the fourth quarter before Ryan Bergman connected with Paul Revis on back-to-back touchdowns of 29 and 54 yards within a five-minute span to complete the come-from-behind victory.

Bergman concluded the afternoon completing 18-of-42 passes for 332 yards and four touchdowns, while Tyrell Williams and Revis combined for 286 yards on 13 catches with three TDs.

On a rain-filled and windy day, WOU started the scoring with a 35-yard touchdown from Bergman to Williams to go up 7-0 late in the first quarter. On the drive, Bergman was 2-for-3 for 50 yards that included the 35-yard strike to Williams for the game's opening touchdown.

Simon Fraser opened the second quarter with an eight-play, 71-yard drive that resulted in a 26-yard field goal by Tiernan Docherty that brought the Clan within four points (7-3).

After back-to-back drives that resulted in each team punting, Simon Fraser intercepted Bergman at the 49 yard line and then saw Ryan Stanford connect with Lemar Durant on a 51-yard touchdown that handed the Clan a 10-7 lead midway through the second quarter.

Neither team would score for the remainder of the first half, as Docherty missed back-to-back field goals of 48 and 42 yards, respectively, within the final six minutes of the second quarter.

The second half would begin with Simon Fraser going three-and-out before Western Oregon put together a 55-yard scoring drive that concluded on a one-yard touchdown pass from Bergman to James DePew that put the host Wolves ahead by four points (14-10) early in the third quarter.

On its very next drive, Simon Fraser would march 52 yards down the field before getting a 39-yard field goal from Docherty that pulled the Clan within a single point (14-13).

Simon Fraser would grab its final lead of the afternoon on the first play of the fourth quarter, as Docherty connected on his third field goal of the game via a 25yard kick through the uprights resulting in a 16-14 lead for the visiting Clan.

After back-to-back three-and-out series for Western Oregon, the Wolves' offense began clicking as WOU marched 94 yards in seven play concluding with a 29-yard touchdown from Bergman to Revis that gave Western Oregon the lead for good, 21-16, midway through the final period.

WOU's final scoring drive covered 65 yards on six plays in two minutes and 28 seconds, as Bergman once again found Revis wide open for a 54-yard touchdown that capped the game's scoring (27-16).

Williams concluded the day with 157 yards on nine catches with one touchdown, while Revis tallied 129 yards on four catches with a pair of TDs. For Williams, it is his fourth game this season with over 100 yards receiving to go along with five 100-plus yard performances by Revis.

For Simon Fraser, Stanford finished the day connecting on 23-of-52 passes for 299 yards and one touchdown. Steve Spagnuolo gained 132 yards on 24 carries for the Clan, while Durant tallied 184 yards on 10 catches with one touchdown.

As a team, Western Oregon had 407 yards of total offense versus Simon Fraser's 462 yards. The difference in the game was third-down conversions, as WOU held Simon Fraser to 3-of-17 that also included an 0-for-1 on fourth-down conversions.

Western Oregon returns to action on Saturday, Nov. 1, against No. 25-ranked Azusa Pacific beginning at 6:00 PM at Citrus Stadium in Glendora, California.



# Azusa Pacific 38, Western Oregon 28 Nov. 2, 2013

# Glendora, Calif. - Citrus Stadium

GLENDORA, Calif. - The Western Oregon University football team had its three-game win streak snapped at Azusa Pacific University Saturday, 38-28. The Cougars remain atop the Great Northwest Athletic Conference with the win.

Azusa Pacific (7-2, 7-1 GNAC), which is receiving votes in the national poll, held Western Oregon to 79 yards on the ground in the win. APU held off the Wolves behind 197 rushing yards. The Cougars finished with 393 yards of offense to WOU's 323.

Western Oregon entered the game with a chance to tie Azusa Pacific for first place in the conference, but with the win the Cougars now own a game lead over Central Washington and a two-game cushion over WOU in the GNAC standings.

Azusa Pacific's Terrel Watson came into the contest as the leading rusher in the conference and proved why Saturday. He ran for 173 yards on 30 carries with three touchdowns. Watson finished with 206 all-purpose yards. He ran for 102 yards in the first meeting with WOU this season.

Dasmen Stewart completed 18 of his 31 pass attempts for 196 yards. He threw a touchdown and an interception. Stewart also ran for 22 yards and a touchdown. Tarik Myles caught eight passes for 98 yards.

The Cougars built a 10-0 lead after the first quarter with a five-yard Kyle Dravis touchdown catch on their first possession and a 31-yard field goal at the 1:34 mark.

Lucas Gonsalves reeled in a 22-yard reception with 10:21 left in the second quarter to cut the lead to 10-7. Stewart completed a six-play 63-yard drive midway through the quarter with a two-yard run.

Azusa Pacific opened the second half with Watson's first touchdown, a 36-yard run, increasing the lead to 24-7. On the Wolves' next possession, Gonsalves made another touchdown catch from just a yard away. Watson completed the scoring in the quarter with a 15-yard run.

Devin Wells opened the fourth quarter with a 63-yard interception return to the Azusa Pacific 12-yard line. On the next play, Devauntae Hoffman ran in a 12-yard score, cutting the lead to 31-21. Watson and the Cougars answered with a 19-yard touchdown run. Robert Savoy completed the scoring with a 22-yard catch with 6:50 remaining in regulation.

The Wolves' (5-4, 5-3) Ryan Bergman finished 24-of-39 with three touchdown passes and an interception. Gonsalves caught six passes for 101 yards. Hoffman finished with 98 rushing yards on 14 carries.

Shane Kuenzi led all players with 14 tackles. He also had a fumble recovery and a pass breakup. Kraig Akins had eight tackles with a fumble recovery. Tyler Thornton led APU with 12 tackles and a fumble recovery. The Cougars had five sacks as a team.

Western Oregon welcomes Central Washington (6-3, 6-2) Nov. 9 for a 1 p.m. kickoff. The Wildcats won the first meeting in Ellensburg, Wash., 20-7, on Sept. 14. It will be Senior Day for WOU. Fans are encouraged to wear black for a Blackout at McArthur Field.

APU DEPTH CHART


