## BUILDING ON A FOUNDATION OF EXPERIENCE

The combination of a wide open offense, an attack-oriented defense and 21 returning starters provides Coach **Larry Arico** with a sense of optimism for his second season at William Paterson University.

Arico looks at the 2001 season as a continuation of his rebuilding process and he looks to his returning starters to assume leadership roles while influencing the development of the younger players. He is confident that his team, which finished 2-8 last season, is moving in the right direction.

"I'm looking for better point production this season and a better ability to control the ball," Arico said. "Our players understand our offense and defense and feel they can be more aggressive than last year. We're much deeper this season and we believe we can win."

**Rob Warchol** (Wallington), a senior, returns for his second season at quarterback and will direct a spread offense that usually features one running back and four receivers. Arico plans for the Pioneers to evenly mix the pass and run. Warchol (6-3, 205) is a strong passer and his knowledge of the game and, in particular, the William Paterson offense, has grown. Last season, he completed 55 percent of his passes for 1,597 yards and seven touchdowns. Freshmen **Cristobal Rodriguez** (Fort Lee) and **Patrick Obuchowski** (Cinnaminson) will provide depth at QB.

Warchol will look most often to his top receiver from 2000, sophomore **Keyth Hardy** (Middlesex), a captain, who frequently makes tough catches over

the middle. Hardy, a member of the William Paterson University basketball team that lost in the NCAA Division III championship game, caught 50 passes for 490 yards in 2000. Sophomore **Bryant Richardson** (6-0, 180), who caught 26 passes for 342 yards last season, is Warchol's breakaway threat with great hands and great speed. The Pioneers' receiving corps will be bolstered by the addition of **Justin O'Connor** (Hackensack), a junior transfer student. Junior **Mark Janis** (Greenpond), a former backup quarterback who moved to wide receiver this season, **Jim Conway** (Bloomfield), **Ted Morrison** (Sussex) and **Kile Caldwell-Stevens** (Williamstown), who caught 15 passes last season, will also see action at wide receiver.

Senior **Tom Del Mauro** (Pine Brook), a powerful and quick running back, returns for his senior year after missing last season with a torn quad muscle. Juniors **Joe Lenza** (Lyndhurst) and **Evan Quinn** (Glen Rock) will also see action in the backfield.

Arico will rely on a strong and flexible offensive line to control the line of scrimmage for the balanced attack. Key linemen include junior captain **Joe Panzica** (Allentown, 6-2, 275) and sophomore **Jason Lachawiec** (Belford, 6-3, 295) at tackle, senior **Dave Pinto** (Wallington, 6-1, 285) and junior **Rich Renda** (West New York, 6-0, 265) at guard and junior **Vin Rizzo** (Waldwick, 6-2, 315) at center. Other linemen expected to contribute include **Vin DiStefano** (Bergenfield, 5-10, 245) at guard, **Bob Birney** (Rockaway, 6-2, 240) at center and **Dwight Bartholomew** (Jersey City, 6-0, 265) at guard and tackle.

On defense, Arico features a 3-4 alignment that relies on speed. He looks for his unit to cut down on last year's tendency to permit big plays and believes the added maturity and experience will help get the job done. Senior captain and cornerback **Kenyatta Jefferson** (Newark) sets the tone. A quick all-around athlete who also returns kicks, Jefferson (6-1, 180) led the Pioneers last season with six interceptions and was among the team leaders with 24 tackles. Junior **Lamar Askew** (North Burlington, 5-11, 187), slowed last season by a knee injury, expects a big year at strong safety, where he was second on the team in 2000 with 41 tackles. Sophomore **Rafael S. Santiago** (Elizabeth, 5-9, 209), senior **Tray Barnard** (Newark, 5-8, 170) and sophomore **Brandon Thomas** (Rahway, 6-3, 215) will see plenty of action at the cornerback positions.

Arico will rely on a veteran crew of outside linebackers, including senior **Eric Mele** (Bridgewater, 5-8, 190), sophomore **Jeff Hennie** (Englewood, 6-1, 215), and senior **David Eugene** (Neptune, 6-1, 195), who returned a fumble 56 yards for a TD in 2000. At inside linebacker, Arico will depend upon senior **Frank Lamanna** (West Orange, 5-11, 243), who made great progress over the course of last season, senior **Joe Frappolli** (Florence, 5-10, 217), and junior **Terrance Fabor** (Clifton, 6-2, 232), who shifts over from outside linebacker. **Eric Schmelz** (Jefferson, 6-1, 215) and **Frank Ciccarone** (West Orange, 5-10, 210) are coming back from season-ending injuries in 2000.

Captain **Paul Zambuto** (Valley Stream, NY, 6-2, 245) will anchor the defensive line at strongside tackle. He'll play next to senior **Chris Benedetto** (Holbrook, NY, 6-0, 250) at nose guard and tackles **Manley Beaubrun** (Irvington, 6-2, 234), a junior, and **Joel Sabino** (West New York, 6-2, 270), a sophomore with great potential.

On special teams, the Pioneers return junior **Mickey Hulse** (Kearny), one of the best punters in the conference. He was named second team all-NJAC, punting for a 38.8-yard average, including a long of 65 yards. Hulse also nailed all 13 of his point-after-touchdowns and kicked six field goals.

With a veteran-filled lineup, the Pioneers begin the season knowing they can build upon the progress achieved last year.

"We made great strides last season," Arico said, "And we're ready to keep improving week to week."





**LARRY ARICO**  
Head Coach

Larry Arico is entering his second season as the Head Coach of the Pioneer football program after spending the previous eight years with the Devils of FDU-Madison. Arico served as FDU-Madison's head coach from 1997-99, and prior to that was the offensive coordinator from 1993-97.

Arico is the 10th coach in the 30-year history of varsity football at William Paterson.

In 1999, Arico guided FDU-Madison to a 5-5 record and a berth in the East Region Eastern College Athletic Conference Championship game just two seasons after finishing 0-10. Arico has a four year coaching record of 9-32.

A 1992 graduate of Lehigh University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history, Arico was an All-Patriot League tailback who set the school record for consecutive 100-yard rushing games (six) and rushing touchdowns in a single game (four). He finished his collegiate career with 1,500 yards rushing.

Arico is a native of Mount Arlington and starred for the Pope John XXIII High School football team. He, his wife, Kim, the head women's basketball coach at Adelphi University, and new baby boy, Trevor, live in Teaneck.



**PHIL LONGO**  
Associate Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator

Phil Longo is entering his second season with the Pioneers and will assume the position of Associate Head Coach, in addition to his duties as Offensive Coordinator.

Longo came to WPU after serving four years as the head coach at Parsippany Hills High School, where he led the Vikings to their first playoff appearances and finished with the highest winning percentage in school history. Prior experience includes serving as the head coach at Orange (1995), offensive coordinator at Williamson (1994), quarterbacks and wide receivers coach at New Jersey City University ('93) and as an intern with the Philadelphia Eagles ('92).

A 1992 graduate of Rowan University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Physical Education, Longo is currently completing his Masters Degree at Rowan in Administration and Supervision. Longo played running back at Rowan for three years (1988-89, 1991) after transferring from East Stroudsburg. He was a member of the first Division III playoff team in school history.

A native of Bayville, Longo starred as a quarterback for Central Regional High School. He and his wife, Diane, a principal in Mantua Township, reside in Glassboro.

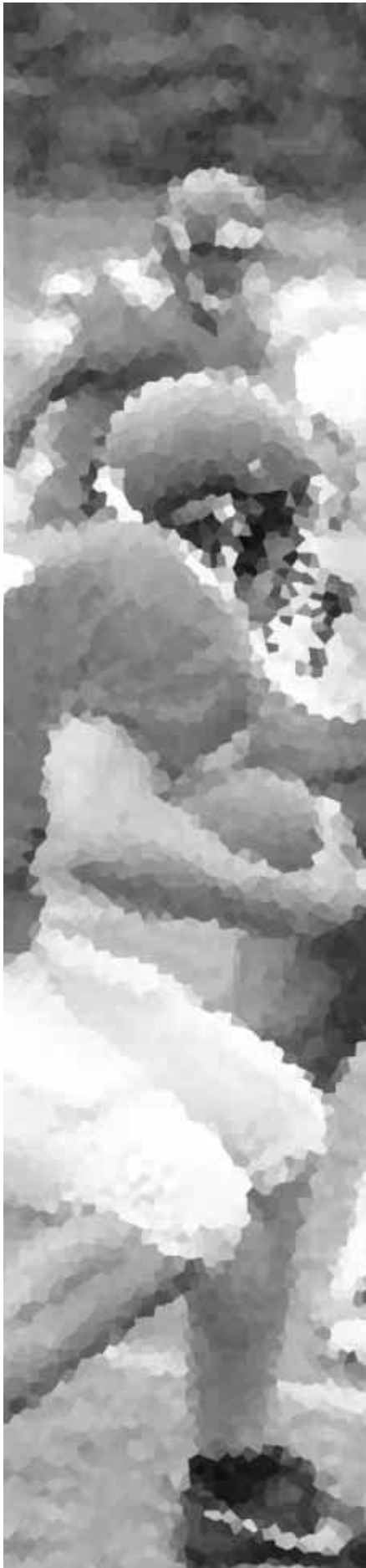
