OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

Wright State staged a second half comeback attempt, but it came up just short on Monday afternoon as the Raiders fell to George Washington 74-63 in the first of three games at the Naples Invitational. Tanner Holden finished with a game-high 24 points, including 17 in the second half, on 10-of-21 shooting while filling his stat line with eight rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block in 37 minutes of action. Grant Basile turned in the only double-double of the afternoon with 13 rebounds and 11 points, but saw nine of his 11 points come from the free throw stripe. Tim Finke was the third and final Raider in double figures, chipping in 12 points and nine rebounds.

DUKE IT OUT

Wright State and James Madison will square off for the first time in program history on Tuesday afternoon in the Raiders' third-straight "first" meeting following matchups against George Washington and Purdue.

Tuesday's meeting continues a trend for the Raiders, as this will be the fourth "first" meeting in five games for Wright State to date. The Raiders also have a first-time meeting with North Carolina State down the road on December 21. Depending on how the bracket shakes out Tuesday, the Raiders could still have a first meeting with either Long Beach State or Missouri State coming.

ABOUT THE HOST

The Community School of Naples is serving as the host of the first Naples Invitational this week. The private K-12 school was founded in 1982. In 1986 the School graduated its very first student, Evan Berlin, in a graduating class of one, and today enrolls more than 800 students each year on its 77-acre campus with 24 total buildings.

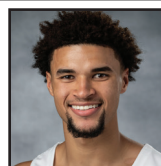

WRIGHT STATE 2021-22 MEDIA PROTOCOLS

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, please contact Nick Phillips, Assistant Athletics Director for Communications (nick.phillips@wright.edu). All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Face coverings will be required at all times for everyone. Requests for credentials will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Athletic Communications office has the final authority on whether any individuals from any organization will be issued media credentials.

MEDIA ENTRANCE: Working media will gain access to the Nutter Center via the loading dock (as in previous years). The Media Room for working media will again be available pre-, post- and in-game, along with a pregame meal and beverages.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: COVID-19 guidelines require appropriate distancing around the playing floor - still and video photographers must remain at least 6 feet back from the playing court (denoted by a black marked line on each baseline) and also be aware of ticketed fans around them. Contact Nick Phillips with any questions.

RADIO COVERAGE: Radio broadcast permission must be obtained in advance from Nick Phillips. Official radio partners of visiting teams should work with their SID to communicate with Wright State in advance of the game(s). Wright State provides a courtesy ethernet line for the official radio partners of visiting teams. ISDN lines will not be readily available at the Nutter Center this season due to temporary relocation of radio areas due to COVID-19, but may be made available upon request. Inquiries about any accommodations should be made well in advance with Nick Phillips.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: All postgame press conferences with head coach Scott Nagy and select players, will be conducted as a hybrid, both in person and electronically on Zoom this season. The link to join the press conference will be sent out at the conclusion of each game, along with any other relevant info. Wright State Athletic Communications representatives will be available to assist in postgame interviews. Interviews with the visiting team can be coordinated with the visiting SID and/or Nick Phillips.

WEEKLY MEDIA AVAILABILITY: Men's Basketball head coach Scott Nagy will hold his weekly media availability with the media in person this season when the team schedule allows, usually on a weekly basis. Select players may also be available at the weekly media availability. Contact Nick Phillips for any inquiries about the weekly media availability schedule.

JAMES MADISON HEIGHTS

-James Madison dropped its first game of the season on Monday afternoon in Naples, falling 74-69 to Kent State despite erasing multiple double-digit deficits in the second half. Julien Wooden tallied 13 points and seven boards while Justin Amadi and Vado Morse each had 12 points.

-JMU had opened the season with home wins over Old Dominion and George Mason by a combined eight points and also had a one-point road win at Eastern Kentucky.

-The Dukes were 4-0 (3-0 against Division I competition) for the first time since the 1999-2000 season after being picked to finish fourth in the Colonial Athletic Association prior to the start of the year.

PRESIDENTIAL PARDONS

Wright State is facing off against former presidents for the first time in program history after going up against George Washington, the first president of the United States and "The Father of His Country" on Monday and facing James Madison, the fourth U.S. president and "Father of the Constitution" on Tuesday afternoon.

The site of Tuesday's matchup, Florida, did not become a state until March 3, 1845, however, in 1812, then-President James Madison commissioned General George Mathews to approach the Spanish governor of East Florida in an attempt to acquire the territory. This became known in history as the Patriot War of East Florida. Eventually, negotiations led to the withdrawal of U.S. troops in 1813.

WELCOME TO COLLEGE

Freshman AJ Braun saw his first collegiate action off the bench on Nov. 22 against George Washington, turning in 8 points on 4-of-5 shooting with a pair of rebounds in 14 minutes.

THE LAST TIME WE WERE IN THE SUNSHINE STATE

Wright State makes its second visit to Florida for tournament play in the last three seasons after playing in the Gulf Coast Showcase in November 2019. Among current Raiders, Grant Basile averaged 8.7 points, 7.7 rebounds and shot 39 percent while averaging over 20 minutes; Tanner Holden turned in 6.7 points and added 6.0 rebounds while shooting 50 percent in 29.3 minutes per contest and Trey Calvin chipped in 4.3 points in 21.3 minutes/game off the bench.

CAREER-HIGH CALVIN

Trey Calvin had a career night in Wright State's loss at Purdue on Nov. 16, finishing with a game-high 21 points, surpassing his former career-best 19 points from December 2020. Calvin finished the night 9-of-17 shooting, including hitting three of his nine three-point attempts, as his nine made baskets was also a career-best.

BIG TIME BASILE

Grant Basile has reset his career-high scoring total in Wright State's loss at Marshall on Nov. 12. Basile ended last season with a then-best 35 points in the Raiders' Horizon League tournament loss against Milwaukee last March, going 11-of-18 from the floor with a 12-of-15 mark from the free throw stripe. Basile turned in 37 points on the road against Marshall, including 22 points in the second half, as he went 12-of-21 from the floor while hitting 12-of-14 from the stripe.

HOLDEN ON HENSON WATCH LIST

Tanner Holden was named to the Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List on November 4. The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player. Holden's selection follows the Henson recognition from former Raider Loudon Love, named to Lou Henson All-America Team the last three consecutive seasons.

MOVING UP

Raider head coach Scott Nagy tallied his 110th victory at Wright State with the season-opening win over Lake Erie, moving into second-place all-time for career victories at Wright State behind only the legendary Ralph Underhill, who finished his career with 356 Raider wins over 18 seasons.

WELCOME TO THE NUTT HOUSE

Ever since its inaugural game – an 88-86 win over Tennessee State on December 1, 1990 – the Nutter Center has been a welcoming home for the Raiders over the years. In 2019-20, Wright State turned in a 14-2 mark at home in front of the Raider faithful, and since the Nutter Center's opening for the 1990-91 campaign, the Raiders have won over 300 games at home – a winning percentage above 70 percent.

MID-MAJOR POLL

Wright State is ranked No. 20 in the first CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, released Nov. 1. Horizon League foes Cleveland State, Milwaukee and Detroit Mercy also received votes in the first poll.

The Raiders climbed as high as No. 7 in the poll last February, their highest ranking in the poll in the last two seasons. Wright State climbed as high as 10th overall in the poll on three occasions during the 2019-20 campaign.

STARTING STRONG

Wright State has always opened seasons strong at home. The Raiders have won 14 season openers over the last 21 years, dating back to 2000-01. This season was the 10th time the Raiders have opened the season inside the Nutter Center in the last 21 years, with eight wins in those games. Wright State is a combined 44-8 all-time in season openers in its two home venues. The Raiders were an astounding 19-1 in home openers inside the Physical Education Building from 1970-71 through 1989-90 (one loss was 1976-77) and have been just as impressive since opening the Nutter Center on December 1, 1990, where Wright State is 25-7 in home openers, including winning the first home contest of the season nine of the last 11 years.

PRESEASON HONORS

A pair of Raiders earned Horizon League preseason honors ahead of the season, with redshirt junior Grant Basile named a first team preseason selection and junior Tanner Holden earning second team preseason honors. Basile scored at a 15.0 points per game clip with 19 double digit scoring games, including a career-high 35 points in the Horizon League tournament last March against Milwaukee. Holden averaged a team-high 34 minutes per game last season and tallied 15.8 points per game, second-most on the roster. He recorded 21 double digit scoring games, including 18 games with 15 or more points. Basile and Holden both began their Raider careers as all-freshman honorees in 2019-20.

LIFE ON THE ROAD (TRIP)

With 2021-22 returning to a 'normal schedule' compared to last season, Wright State will face a pair of long road trips after seeing its longest road stretch be only three games in 2020-21.

After opening the season at home on Nov. 9, the Raiders will not return to the Nutter Center until Dec. 15, playing seven games on the road in four states during that stretch. Wright State travels to Marshall (Nov. 12) and Purdue (Nov. 16) before three games in three days at the Naples Invitational from Nov. 22-24. The Raiders cap the stretch with their first two Horizon League contests of the year, at Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 2) and Cleveland State (Dec. 4).

Wright State also faces a five-game road trip during Horizon League play in January, traveling to Northern Kentucky (Jan. 10), Robert Morris (Jan. 13), Youngstown State (Jan. 15), IUPUI (Jan. 20) and UIC (Jan. 22).

IN CASE YOU'VE FORGOTTEN ABOUT US...

Wright State returns 10 players from last season's squad that finished 18-6 overall and recorded a 16-4 conference mark on the way to the third straight season of claiming at least a share of the Horizon League regular season title. Three returning Raiders earned Horizon League postseason honors, with Tanner Holden on the first team, Grant Basile on the second team and Tim Finke garnering All-Defensive honors, while former Raider Loudon Love earned his second straight HL Player of the Year honor along with being a first team performer. In October, Wright State received 463 total votes and nine first-place votes as the Raiders were selected second in the Horizon League preseason poll ahead of the 2021-22 season. Basile was named a first team preseason selection and Holden earned second team preseason honors.

THE NAGY ERA - AN ERA OF SUCCESS

Since being hired in April 2016 as the ninth head coach in program history, Scott Nagy has led the Wright State program to unprecedented success. A three-time Horizon League Coach of the Year (when there had been previously been only three in program history prior to his arrival), Nagy and the Raiders have qualified for a postseason tournament in three of his five seasons (2018 NCAA Tournament, 2019 and 2020 NITs).

Entering the 2021-22 season, Nagy has won 109 of his 158 games at Wright State in five seasons, having won 69 percent of his games. That clip is just behind the winning percentage of the top coach in Wright State program history, Ralph Underhill, who won 120 games in his first five seasons from 1978-79 to 1982-83 when the Raiders competed at the NCAA Division II level.

Nagy's 69 Horizon League victories over the last five seasons are 26 more than Wright State won in the five years immediately preceding his hiring (2011-2016), while the Raiders' 28 All-Conference accolades (6 first team, 4 second team, 1 third team, 4 Newcomer team, 5 All-Defensive, 3 All-Tournament, 3 Coach of the Year) are more than nine times the amount of honors from 2013-2016 (1 second team, 1 Newcomer team, 1 All-Defensive).

Additionally, Nagy's Raider teams have produced in the classroom as well, with six student-athletes earning Horizon League All-Academic Team recognition, including two Raider student-athletes earning spots on the five-member team in two different seasons, while Nagy's teams have each had a cumulative GPA of over 3.0 since taking over in April 2016. In the three years immediately preceding his hiring, the program did not reach a 3.0 GPA in any season.

Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark when he did so Feb. 22, 2020 against Cleveland State. He went on to win his 100th career game at Wright State on January 16, 2021 against Cleveland State, becoming the third head coach in program history to record 100 career wins with the Raiders.

Along with leading Wright State to the postseason three times in his five seasons, the Raider head man has made 16 total postseason appearances in his 26-year head coaching career.

Away from the court, Scott Nagy and the Raider program have been heavily involved with Samaritan's Feet, an international humanitarian organization whose mission is to put new shoes and socks on the feet of those in need.

Since beginning his tenure at Wright State, Nagy and the Raiders have served at three shoe distributions in the Dayton area, providing nearly 600 pairs of shoes to children and adults. The Raiders also served on an international level in 2018 in the Dominican Republic. THE BIG 5-0(0)

Wright State head coach Scott Nagy reached another milestone of his coaching career on Feb. 22, 2020 with an 81-74 overtime victory over Cleveland State for his 500th collegiate victory. With the victory, Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark. His career-high for victories in a season is 27, which he did twice at South Dakota State (2003-04: 27-7 and 2011-12: 27-8). He has won 25 games in a season twice in four years at Wright State (2017-18: 25-10 and 2019-20: 25-7).

KEEPING IT 100

Head coach Scott Nagy won his 100th career game at Wright State on Jan. 16, 2021 against Cleveland State, becoming the third head coach in program history to record 100 career wins with the Raiders, joining the legendary Ralph Underhill (356 Wright State wins in 18 years) and Billy Donlon (109 career Wright State wins in six years). Ironically, Nagy won his 500th career game overall in February 2020 at Cleveland State. Nagy became just the second current Horizon League head coach to reach 100 wins at the League school, joining Oakland's Greg Kampe. Kampe is the only other current Horizon League head coach with 500-plus career wins overall.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Wright State basketball and the Nagy's are one of 20 father-son/coach-player combos in Division I this season, with Scott and T.J. one of four combos within the Horizon League.

NATIONAL NAGY

In his 27 year career, head coach Scott Nagy has accumulated his share of wins, beginning the 2021-22 season ranked No. 24 nationally amongst active coaches in terms of career victories and is No. 42 nationally amongst winningest active coaches with a .542 winning percentage. Nagy began the 2021-22 campaign ranked No. 94 in the winningest coaches of all-time broken down by total victories, a mark that ranks 26th among active coaches.

WHO'S THE NEW GUY?

The Wright State coaching staff has a new look this season after three new faces joined the Raider bench. Dan Beré, Travis Trice and Tae Gibbs are new to the staff, replacing former associate head coach Brian Cooley (Colorado State), assistant coach Sharif Chambliss (Wisconsin) and administrative assistant Nick Nagy.

WHERE'S THE LOVE?

Former Wright State standout Loudon Love announced during the summer that he was forgoing the additional season of eligibility he would have gained because of the COVID-19 pandemic, opting instead to begin his professional career. Love was selected 11th overall in the 2021 NBA G League Draft on Oct. 23 by the Texas Legends, affiliates of the Dallas Mavericks.

Love, the all-time leading rebounder in Wright State basketball history, played in 120 career games in a Raider uniform and departed Wright State as the winningest player in the Division I era, having been a part of 89 wins over his five seasons. He finished his career with 1,123 career rebounds, the most in Wright State basketball history (men and women). Love exited Wright State as the No. 3-leading scorer all-time in program history with 1,792 career points.

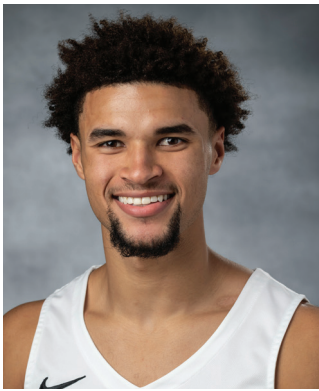

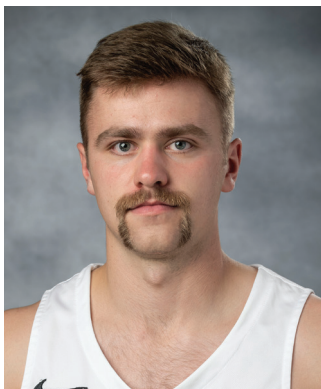

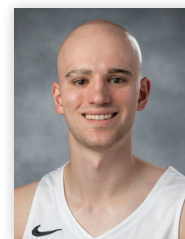
