OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

On Monday, Wright State opened its 2023-24 season with a 67-63 loss at Southern Indiana. The Raiders trailed 51-36 at the 3:40 minute mark of the third quarter but rallied back to a 63-all tie with 1:15 left in the fourth quarter. However, Wright State was scoreless for the remainder of the game, going 0-for-4 on free throws in the span.

WSU had three players scored in double figures, led by **Alexis Hutchison**, who scored a game-high 19 points. The Raider defense recorded 15 steals and six blocks, forcing USI to 25 turnovers and edging the host team 20-11 in points off turnovers. **Rachel Loobie** led the defensive effort with a career-high five steals to go along with six rebounds and two blocks.

TOGETHER AGAIN

Graduate forward **Jada Tate's** younger sister Jocelyn is a junior guard on a Michigan State women's basketball team. The two helped Pickerington Central High School win the 2018 state championship before earning a state runner-up finish in 2019.

VETERAN PRESENCE

Wright State's four upperclassmen transfers bring a wealth of experience to the Raiders with a combined 384 games of collegiate basketball, including 299 starts.

- **Jada Tate** - 112 games (92 starts) over four seasons at D2 Tiffin
- **Alexis Hutchison** - 108 games (103 starts) over four seasons at D2 Malone
- **Julia Hoeftling** - 84 games (41 starts) over four seasons at Loyola Chicago

THE KARI HOFFMAN FILE



Kari Hoffman was named the women's basketball head coach at Wright State University in May 2021, becoming just the eighth head coach in women's program history.

In her second year at Wright State, Hoffman guided the Raiders to a four-win improvement, a Horizon League Championship quarterfinals appearance, and a 6-5 record over the program's last 11 games.

The native of Wisconsin has transformed Wright State into one of the nation's most prolific long-distance shooting teams, as the Raiders ranked second nationally in 3-point makes per game (10.1) and 22nd in 3-point percentage (.364) during the 2022-23 season. Wright State netted a school record 323 threes in the campaign while also shattering a single-game school record with 18 3-pointers versus Cleveland State (1/20).

Hoffman joined the Raiders after serving as the head coach at nearby Cedarville University for the previous five seasons, where she won 106 games, led the Yellow Jackets to three regular season conference titles, and was named the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2018 and 2021. Hoffman also earned NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors in 2019 and 2020.

Hoffman averaged 21.2 wins per season at Cedarville and has won 66 percent of her

games in her career. She led Cedarville to the NCAA Division II Regional as an at-large selection in 2021 after the Yellow Jackets were an NCCAA National Tournament qualifier following the 2019-20 campaign.

Under Hoffman, Cedarville had five NCCAA All-Americans, including one NCCAA Midwest Region Player of the Year, and nine All-NCCAA Midwest Region players. Hoffman coached 13 All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference players, including a pair of All-Conference Defensive players and one Great Midwest Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year. Academically, Hoffman mentored 20 NCCAA Scholar-Athletes and 31 All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference Academic Team players.

Prior to taking over the reins at Cedarville, Hoffman was an assistant coach with the Yellow Jackets from 2010-16 and was a part of Great Midwest Athletic Conference titles in 2015 and 2016. She began her collegiate coaching career at Cedarville during the 2007-2008 season.

Hoffman spent two seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at Horizon League foe Green Bay from 2008-2010 as the Phoenix won back-to-back Horizon League Championships and represented the League in the NCAA Tournament, which included a first-round win in 2009.

A student-athlete at Cedarville from 2001-05, Hoffman remains the program's No. 2 all-time leading scorer (2,275 points) and is the all-time leader in three-point field goals made (338), three-point field goal percentage (.458) and career games played (142). She led Cedarville to three American Midwest Conference championships and a

pair of NAIA Division II National Runner-Up finishes (2004, 2005) and was a two-time American Midwest Conference Player of the Year, along with being named the 2005 NCCAA National Player of the Year.

Hoffman was a two-time NAIA Division II All-America First Team honoree and also was a NAIA Division II All-America Second Team selection, along with a pair of NCCAA All-America First Team recognitions and two NCCAA Midwest Region Player of the Year awards. Hoffman also played volleyball at Cedarville her senior year, when she was a part of Cedarville's 2005 NCCAA Championship.

Hoffman earned her degree in multi-age physical education from Cedarville University in 2005 and a master's degree in athletic administration and coaching from Concordia University (Calif.) in 2011. Kari and her husband, Jimmy, reside in Springfield with their three children: Finley, Breslyn and Tripp.

HISTORY VS. MSU

Wright State is 0-2 all-time versus Michigan State. The Raiders lost 67-61 in 1987 and 84-68 in 2018. MSU has hosted all three meetings.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Graduate transfer guard **Alexis Hutchison** scored a game-leading 19 points on 7-of-17 shooting against Southern Indiana (11/6). Her point total was the most in a Raider debut since Angel Baker's 21 points against CSU Bakersfield (11/6/18) at the start of the 2018-19 season.

Redshirt senior guard **Layne Ferrell** also made an impression in her first game at WSU, as she stuffed the stat sheet with 16 points, three rebounds, three assists, four steals, and two blocks.

CAREER NIGHT

Senior forward Rachel Loobie finished with career-high marks in steals (5), assists (3), blocks (2), and minutes played (24) in Wright State's season opener at Southern Indiana. She added seven points on 3-of-4 shooting and six rebounds off the bench.

PRESEASON POLL

The Raiders finished seventh in the 2023 Horizon League preseason poll with 54 points, which the league's 11 head coaches voted on. Green Bay (121 points) was selected to win the conference after receiving all 11 first-place votes.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

Wright State has bolstered its depth with seven newcomers on the squad, including upperclassmen transfers **Jada Tate** (Tiffin), **Alexis Hutchison** (Malone), **Layne Ferrell** (Akron), and **Julia Hoefling** (Loyola Chicago). The Raiders also added sophomore transfer **Claire Henson** (Long Island) and freshmen guards **Rylee Sagester** and **Ellie Magestro-Kennedy**.

MILESTONE WATCH

Alexis Hutchison is nearing 1,500 career points (currently at 1,406 points) and 200 career steals (currently at 185 steals) in her collegiate career. The guard spent her first four seasons at Malone University, where she was a two-time NCCAA Division I All-Midwest Region selection and a Third Team NCCAA All-American in 2023. **Jada Tate** is up to 991 points over 113 collegiate games, while **Julia Hoefling** has compiled 88 career blocks.

EARLY TESTS

Wright State's non-conference schedule features seven teams with a winning record last season, two Power Five programs, and a multi-team exempt event (MTE). The Raiders face road meetings at Michigan State (November 12) and West Virginia (December 18). WSU will close its non-conference slate with games against Presbyterian (December 21) and Wyoming (December 22) at the Las Vegas Hoops Classic.

FAMILY HOOPS TREE

Graduate forward **Jada Tate** has three siblings with Division I college basketball experience, including her older brother Jae'Sean, who played at Ohio State from 2014-2018 and is in his fourth year as an NBA forward for the Houston Rockets. Her brother Jalen was a four-year starter at Northern Kentucky (2016-2020) before spending the 2020-21 season at Arkansas. Her sister Jocelyn is currently a junior guard at Michigan State. Tate's father, Jermaine, played college basketball for Ohio State and Cincinnati before embarking on a 13-year professional career.

HL SLATE

Each Horizon League team will play a 20-game double round-robin schedule. Wright State's conference schedule gets underway at the Nutter Center on November 30 versus IUPUI and concludes on March 2 at Detroit Mercy.

BASKETBALL RUNS IN THE FAMILY

Sophomore guard **Lauren Scott** is the granddaughter of Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame coach Gary Williams, who led the Maryland men's basketball program to its first-ever NCAA Tournament Championship in 2002. He also served as head coach for American (1978-82), Boston College (1982-86), and Ohio State (1986-89). Currently, he is Maryland's Senior Managing Director for Alumni Relations and Athletic Development.

BUILT IN OHIO

Six of WSU's seven total newcomers played high school basketball in Ohio, including four from the Greater Dayton area. In total, 11 individuals on Wright State's 15-player roster are from Ohio.

STRONG FINISH

Wright State started the 2022-23 season 2-19 overall but went 6-5 over its last 11 games. The Raiders defeated conference opponents Robert Morris, Northern Kentucky, Milwaukee, Detroit Mercy, and Oakland (twice) in the span. WSU scored 80-plus points six times, highlighted by an 86-point performance in its win over UDM (2/25/23).

TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK

The Raiders committed just 12.8 turnovers per game last season, the 23rd-lowest mark in the nation. WSU had eight games with single-digit turnovers, including a season-low five versus IUPUI (2/4/23).

BACK FOR YEAR THREE

Junior guard **Kacee Baumhower** is one of only two players who has been with the Raiders since the 2021-22 season. She joined the program as a mid-year transfer from Saint Bonaventure in January 2022.

ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

Makiya Miller was named to the 2023 Horizon League All-Freshman Team after averaging 5.9 points, 1.5 assists, 1.3 rebounds, and 0.6 steals per contest last season. The 5-foot-7 guard scored in double figures in her opening three games as a Raider, becoming the first freshman player in the last 17 seasons to do so.

ALL-AMERICAN NEWCOMER

Graduate transfer **Alexis Hutchison** averaged 18.1 points, 6.7 rebounds, 4.6 assists and 2.0 steals over 31 games (all starts) at Division II Malone last season en route to Third Team NCCAA All-American honors. She also landed on the NCCAA Division I All-Midwest Region Team and the Great Midwest All-Defensive Team.

PRESENCE DOWN LOW

Graduate transfer **Julia Hoefling** totaled 87 blocks (1.0 bpg) during her four-year career at Loyola Chicago. The Cincinnati native finished her junior season with 54 blocks (1.8 bpg), which ranked 44th nationally and third in single-season history.

TOP PROSPECT

Freshman guard **Rylee Sagester** was runner-up for the 2023 Ohio Miss Basketball award after averaging 21.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists, and 2.6 steals per game as a senior and leading Tri-Village High School to its first-ever state title and a perfect 30-0 record. She finished her high school career with 2,001 points, and a state-record 401 career 3-point makes.

UP NEXT

Wright State will stay on the road for a matchup at Michigan State on Sunday, November 12. The non-conference matchup will tip-off at 2 p.m. and stream on Big Ten Plus.

HYPING UP HOFFMAN

Third year Raider head coach **Kari Hoffman** is no stranger to success, as she averaged 21.2 wins per season at Cedarville University and has won 63 percent of her games in career.

Hoffman won 106 games at Cedarville as head coach from 2016-2021, leading the Yellow Jackets to three regular season conference titles. She was named the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2018 and 2021, and also earned NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors in 2019 and 2020.

Under Hoffman, Cedarville had five NCCAA All-Americans, including one NCCAA Midwest Region Player of the Year, and nine All-NCCAA Midwest Region players. Hoffman coached 13 All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference players, including a pair of All-Conference Defensive players and one Great Midwest Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year. Academically, Hoffman has mentored 20 NCCAA Scholar-Athletes and 31 All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference Academic Team players.

COACH HAS GAME

COACH HAS GAME (PART 2)

Leuzinger was selected by the San Antonio Silver Stars with the 14th pick in the 2009 WNBA Draft. She played two seasons in the WNBA and seven more overseas in Europe. She was inducted into the Liberty Athletics Hall of Fame in September 2021.

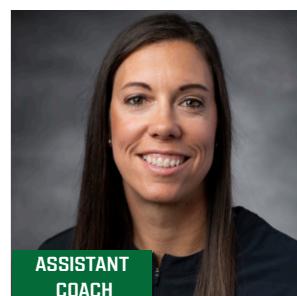
