FIRST PITCH

FIVE-PEAT

The Raiders swept Milwaukee from May 12-14 to clinch their fifth consecutive Horizon League regular season title (excluding the Covid-shortened 2020 season). WSU has won 20-plus games against HL teams each year in the stretch.

CHAMPIONSHIP REWIND

Wright State clinched its 10th NCAA Division I appearance with a 24-0 victory over No. 2 seed Oakland in the 2022 Horizon League Championship at Nischwitz Stadium. The Raiders set single-game tournament records in runs scored, largest shutout margin (24), doubles (8), and RBI (23) in the blowout victory. WSU took down Northern Kentucky 18-4 in the tournament's quarterfinals and proceeded to defeat Oakland 14-3 in the semifinals.

The Raiders outscored opponents 56-7 in their three HL Championship wins, including a tournament-record 11 home runs.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR

Sebastian Gongora was named the 2023 Horizon League Pitcher of the Year as the conference office announced its yearly awards on Tuesday, May 23. The 6-foot-5 lefty compiled a 9-1 record in the regular season with a 2.87 ERA and 77 strikeouts in 78.1 innings. The Dayton, Ohio native has gone a perfect 8-0 with a 2.89 ERA and 64 strikeouts over ten starts (62.1 IP) against conference opponents. He leads the Horizon League in wins, ERA, opposing batting average (.221), and hits allowed per nine innings (7.35) while also possessing top-five HL marks in innings pitched (3rd), strikeouts (3rd), and WHIP (4th, 1.23). Gongora took home Horizon League Pitcher of the Week after striking out seven batters in eight shutout innings versus Oakland (3/26). He enters the postseason with four or fewer earned runs allowed in five-plus innings in 12 starts.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Head coach **Alex Sogard** won Horizon League Coach of the Year honors after leading the Raiders to a 35-20 overall record and their fifth consecutive HL Regular Season title in 2023. He also earned the award in the 2019 and 2021 campaigns en route to becoming the first-ever Raider head coach to win three HL Coach of the Year honors. The previous record of two was held by former WSU skippers Rob Cooper (2010, 2011) and Greg Lovelady (2014, 2016). Dating back to the 2010 season, Wright State coaches have won eight of the 14 Coach of the Year honors (Sogard, Cooper, Lovelady and Jeff Mercer (2018)). Legendary Raider head coach Ron Nischwitz was the 2004 HL Coach of the Year.

ALL-LEAGUE HONORS

The Raiders placed six players on the All-League First Team, with **Gehrig Anglin**, **Jay Luikart**, **Andrew Patrick**, **Sammy Sass**, and **Jake Shirk** joining HL Pitcher of the Year **Sebastian Gongora**. **Patrick Fultz** and **Joey Valentine** collected All-Freshman Team honors.

HOME RUN KING

Andrew Patrick belted two long balls in WSU's weekend sweep of Milwaukee to become the program's single-season school record holder in home runs with 17. He bested the previous record of 16 shared by Nick Shields (2001), Bryan Vickers (2004), and Gehrig Anglin (2022).

STRIKE-THROWER

Starting pitcher **Jake Shirk** has proven to be one of the top strike-throwers in the country, as he ranks 15th nationally in walks allowed per nine innings (1.49) and 24th nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.31). The junior has not walked a batter in his last 32.1 innings pitched.

PITCHING EXCELLENCE

Wright State's pitching staff leads the Horizon League in ERA (5.04), strikeouts (478), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.38), strikeouts per nine innings (9.0), WHIP (1.46), saves (16), opponent batting average (.264), fewest hits allowed per nine innings (9.32), and fewest walks allowed per nine innings (3.79).

MONSTER NUMBERS

Andrew Patrick put together the top offensive numbers in the Horizon League after slashing .327/.427/.692 with 17 doubles, four triples, 17 homers, 50 RBI, 62 runs, and 26 stolen bases in 54 games during the regular season. Wright State's primary leadoff hitter led the conference in stolen bases, total bases (144), three-plus hit games (11), and multi-homer games (T-1st, 4) while ranking second in doubles, triples, homers, hits (68), runs, hits, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.119). The Hilliard, Ohio native has tallied 13 multi-hit games and 14 multi-RBI games in addition to Horizon League Batter of the Week honors twice.

LOTS OF POP

Wright State leads the Horizon League with 70 home runs. Six players have gone yard six-plus times, paced by **Andrew Patrick** with a team-leading 17 in the category. **Jay Luikart** and **Gehrig Anglin** have homered nine times.

SPEED KILLS

The Raiders rank 28th nationally and first in the Horizon League with 101 stolen bases. **Andrew Patrick** has swiped a team-high 26 bases on 28 attempts, while **Gehrig Anglin** has stolen 13 bases. **Dane Thomas** is 12-for-13 on stolen base attempts and **Avery Fisher** is a perfect 10-for-10 in the category. **Sammy Sass** has added a career-high 11 stolen bases on 14 attempts this season.

TEAM GUYS

Wright State ranks sixth in the country with 37 sacrifice flies. **Jay Luikart** and **Sammy Sass** are tied for first in the Horizon League with six sac flies.

VETERAN GROUP

WSU returns 16 letterwinners and 11 starters from last year's team, including eight All-Horizon League recipients. **Gehrig Anglin** and **Julian Greenwell** collected All-League First Team honors, while **Jay Luikart**, **Jake Shirk**, and **Alex Theis** were named to the Second Team. **Sebastian Gongora**, **Andrew Patrick**, and **Justin Riemer** earned spots on the All-Freshman Team.

ALL-AMERICA RECOGNITION

Jay Luikart earned preseason All-America nods from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper after starring as WSU's starting outfielder and closer in 2022. The Ashland, Ohio native slugged .299/.409/.544 with 14 doubles, three triples, 10 homers, 31 RBI, and 49 runs scored over 54 starts. Luikart pitched to a 4-2 record with a team-low 2.53 ERA and seven saves in 21.1 innings.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

The Raiders were picked atop the 2023 Horizon League preseason poll. Wright State was also selected as the preseason conference favorite by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game USA. **Sammy Sass** was listed as preseason Player of the Year by D1Baseball, while **Gehrig Anglin** earned preseason Player of the Year honors from Perfect Game. Both sites named **Sebastian Gongora** the preseason Pitcher of the Year and the conference's top prospect for the 2023 MLB Draft.

DRAFT TALENT

Wright State's Alec Sayre was selected in 17th round of the 2022 MLB Draft, becoming the 17th draftee since 2015 and the 41st in program history. The Raiders saw three total players selected in the top 10 rounds of the MLB's 2021 first-year player draft, along with another two signing free agent contracts.

PRO RAIDERS

Sean Murphy, drafted by the Oakland Athletics in 2016, and Jesse Scholtens, drafted by the San Diego Padres in 2016, are the Raiders' two current Major League players. Murphy debuted with the Athletics in September 2019 and earned the Gold Glove award following the 2021 season. He signed a 6-year, \$73 million contract extension with the Atlanta Braves in December 2022, which includes a \$15 million club option for the 2029 season. Scholtens made his long-awaited MLB debut for the Chicago White Sox in April 2023. Peyton Burdick, drafted by the Miami Marlins in 2019, made his MLB debut for the organization in August 2022. He has since joined the Marlins for multiple stints. Joe Smith spent 15 years (2007-2022) in the big leagues as a reliever with eight different clubs and currently sits Top 40 all-time with 866 career pitching appearances.

COACHING SUCCESS

Alex Sogard, the seventh-youngest active head coach in Division I baseball, is 148-86 at the helm of the Raiders. Among fifth-year D1 coaches entering the 2023 season, he possessed the third-most wins and fourth-best winning percentage (.631). Sogard had guided the Raiders to back-to-back NCAA Regional appearances and collected

ABCA/ATEC East Coach of the Year honors in 2021. The Phoenix, Arizona, native led WSU to a 42-17 record in 2019, the most wins by a first-year head coach in program history. Wright State beat three ranked teams in 2019 and took down top-ranked Louisville in the COVID-shortened 2020 campaign before going 35-13 in 2021 on the way to the Horizon League regular season and tournament titles. In June 2021, Sogard was named to the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team coaching staff.

MORE TOP TALENT

D1Baseball listed several other Raiders as top MLB prospects in the Horizon League in addition to Gongora. **Jake Shirk** was named the number two prospect for the 2023 MLB Draft, followed by **Justin Riemer** in the third spot and **Luke Arnold** in the tenth spot. Patrick, **Boston Smith**, and **Josh Laisure** earned the first, fourth, and fifth spots for the 2024 MLB Draft, while **Joey Valentine** was the second-ranked prospect for the 2025 MLB Draft.

LOOKING BACK AT 2022

The Raiders are coming off a 30-27 campaign in 2022, winning the Horizon League regular season and tournament championships en route to their fifth trip to the NCAA Regionals in the last seven seasons. Wright State broke single-season school records in home runs (81) and strikeouts (461) while also possessing top-50 national marks in shutouts (10th, 6), walks (19th, 318), scoring (27th, 8.0), runs (41st, 455), triples (41st, 17), slugging percentage (42nd, .484), and on-base percentage (48th, .396).

SMITH REACHING MILESTONES

Former Wright State pitcher Joe Smith made 866 career appearances over 15 seasons as a reliever in the MLB. He ranks 36th in MLB history in games pitched and finished his career with 3.14 earned runs average, tallying 660 strikeouts, 55 wins, and 30 saves over 762.1 innings pitched. Smith is a member of the Wright State Hall of Fame, was the 2006 Horizon League Pitcher of the Year and is one of four Raider numbers retired on the Nischwitz Stadium left field wall.

MLB DRAFT HISTORY

Wright State's Alec Sayre was selected in 17th round of the 2022 MLB Draft, becoming the 17th draftee since 2015 and the 41st in program history.

WSU had three players picked in the 2021 MLB Draft. The Milwaukee Brewers selected Tyler Black with the 33rd overall pick in the competitive balance round A of the draft. Black's Sunday selection at No. 33 overall was bettered only by Wright State Hall of Famer Brian Anderson as the highest drafted player in Raider history. Anderson, a left-handed pitcher, was selected third overall by the California Angels in 1993.

Outfielder and 2021 Horizon League Player of the Year Quincy Hamilton was selected in the fifth round by the Houston Astros with the 148th overall pick. In the ninth round, the Miami Marlins selected right-handed pitcher Jake Schrand with the 269th overall pick. After the draft, Damon Dues (San Francisco Giants) and Konner Pionto (Texas Rangers) signed free agent contracts.

Wright State has had three or more draftees in five of the last seven drafts, dating back to 2016, including a program-high five selections in the 2016 Draft. The Raiders saw four players taken in 2019 and three in both 2018 2021, and one last year.

Prior to the 2015 draft, Wright State had only had 24 total players drafted, dating back to the 1976 Draft, when Bob Grote was the first selection in program history. The Raiders had only had multiple players selected in the same draft five times in program history (two players four times, three players once) before the five selections in 2016 shattered that mark.

Alex Sogard was named the head baseball coach at Wright State on July 6, 2018 after two years as an assistant with the Raiders.

In 2022, Sogard led the Raiders a 30-27 overall record and a 20-9 mark against conference opponents. Wright State earned its third consecutive regular season championship, a second consecutive Horizon League Championship title, and a trip to the NCAA Blacksburg Regional. The regional berth was the fifth in the past seven seasons (excluding 2020 covid canceled season) for the Raiders.

WSU continued its yearly trend of reaching new heights under Sogard, as the team broke single-season records in strikeouts (490) and home runs (81). Gehrig Anglin also tied a single-season home run record with 16 on the season.

The 2022 campaign featured ten All-Horizon League honors for the Raiders, including three First Team selections (Alec Sayre, Gehrig Anglin, Julian Greenwell), four Second Team selections (Zane Harris, Jay Luikart, Jake Shirk, Alex Theis), and three All-Freshman Team selections (Sebastian Gongora, Justin Riemer, Andrew Patrick). Sayre and Zane Harris also earned a spot on the East-ABCA/Rawlings All-Region Team.

The 2021 Raiders won 35 regular season games on the way to the Horizon League regular season and tournament championships and appearance in the NCAA Knoxville Regional. Sogard earned his second Horizon League Coach of the Year honor, while Quincy Hamilton was named HL Player of the Year. In addition to the major awards, the Raiders placed five players on the All-League First Team, with Tyler Black, Austin Cline, Sammy Sass and Alec Sayre joining Hamilton. Three Raiders – Bradley Brehmer, Damon Dues and Zane Harris – earned Second Team honors, while Jake Shirk earned All-Freshman Team honors.

Sogard and the Raiders made the most of the COVID-shortened 2020 season, with a midweek win at then-No. 1 Louisville and a road series win at then-No. 11 Tennessee. The

two wins over Tennessee turned out to be the Volunteers' lone losses in the shortened season.

In his first season as head coach in 2019, the Raiders finished 42-17, 22-8. The 42 wins were the most wins by a first-year head coach in program history and earned him the Horizon League Coach of the Year. The Raiders had a year for the record books. The offense broke the single season record for walks (368), stolen bases (169), runs (501), and home runs (67). They were also ranked second in the Nation in Walks & Stolen Bases, third in the Nation in Runs, fifth in the Nation in On Base Percentage, ninth in the Nation in Fielding Percentage, 10th in the Nation in Batting Average and 27th in the Nation in Home Runs.

The Raiders had a number of big wins again in 2019, including #9 East Carolina, #10 Ole Miss, #18 Oklahoma State and Indiana.

Outfielder Peyton Burdick was selected by the Miami Marlins in the third round and 82nd overall of the 2019 MLB Draft, becoming the third-highest to ever be drafted for Wright State baseball behind Brian Anderson, who went third overall in the first round in 1993 to the California Angels and Keith Gordon, who went 47th overall in the second-round of 1990 draft by the Cincinnati Reds.

In all, the 2019 Raiders had nine All-Horizon League Honors, including six First Team (Peyton Burdick, JD Orr, Zach Weatherford, Seth Gray, Tyler Black, and Bear Bellomy), two Second Team (Chase Slone, Bradley Brehmer), and two All-Freshman Team (Damon Dues and Bradley Brehmer). The six First Team selections tied the most all-time at Wright State.

Sogard, a left-hander, was drafted by the Houston Astros in 2010 in the 26th round of the MLB Draft and played seven seasons of professional baseball. In his first full season with the Astros organization, he led the Single A Lexington Legends in strikeouts. He advanced as high as AAA and was selected to play in the Arizona Fall League in 2012 (Mesa Solar Sox) and 2013 (Peoria Javelinas) with stints in the Arizona Diamondbacks and Baltimore Orioles organizations as recently as 2016. Sogard worked as the pitching instructor for several elite camps, including the Pro 5 Academy in Raleigh, NC.

Sogard started his collegiate playing career at Oregon State, where he won back-to-back National Championships in 2006 and 2007, before moving to North Carolina State for his final three collegiate seasons. In 2008, Sogard closed the regional championship game against South Carolina to win the Raleigh Regional. Sogard was drafted by the Diamondbacks in 2008 in the 26th round of the MLB Draft but chose to stay in school, ultimately being drafted by the Astros in 2010. His career also includes playing in the World Baseball Classic for Team Czech Republic in 2012 in Germany and 2016 in Mexico. His brother, Eric, was a 2nd round pick by the San Diego Padres in the MLB Draft out of Arizona State and spent 11 years as an infielder

in the big leagues, playing with the Oakland Athletics, Milwaukee Brewers, Toronto Blue Jays, Tampa Bay Rays and Chicago Cubs.

Sogard is a 2010 graduate of North Carolina State with a B.S. degree in Science Technology with a specialty in Nutrition and Exercise Science.
