OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

Wright State saw four players finish with double figure scoring nights, led by a career-high 23 points from freshman Michael Cooper, as the Raiders cruised to an 86-58 Sunday victory over Green Bay in Horizon League action inside the Nutter Center.

Michael Cooper scored 15 of his new best 23 points in the second half as he finished the night 7-of-13 overall with a trio of three-pointers, filling his stat line with four rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block in just 25 minutes of action. Michael Imariagbe notched another double-digit scoring night of his own, shooting a perfect 7-of-7 from the floor on the way to 14 points, while Logan Woods had 13 points and Dominic Pangonis added 10 points and a game-high seven rebounds.

HOME SWEET HOME

Wright State has opened the season with seven of its first 11 games away from the Nutter Center, but that changes the rest of December, as the Raiders kick off a four-game homestand with the Miami (OH) matchup Tuesday night.

The Raiders will play seven of their next 11 games at home through the end of January.

WE MEET AGAIN

Wright State is set to square off with Miami (OH) for the 41st time in program history on Tuesday, with the Raiders having won the last six meetings, including an 81-68 road win last November and a 92-82 victory inside the Nutter Center December 2024. The regional foes have squared off in 25 of the last 26 seasons, with the only outlier coming in the 2021 campaign, in a series that dates all the way back to December 1972.

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, please contact Nick Phillips, Assistant Athletics Director for Communications (nick.phillips@wright.edu). All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Requests for credentials will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Athletic Communications office has the final authority on whether any individuals from any organization will be issued media credentials.

MEDIA ENTRANCE: Working media will gain access to the Nutter Center via the loading dock. The Media Room for working media will again be available pre-, post- and in-game, along with a pregame meal and beverages.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: Still and video photographers must remain at least 6 feet back from the playing court (denoted by a black marked line on each baseline) and also be aware of ticketed fans around them. Contact Nick Phillips with any questions.

RADIO COVERAGE: Radio broadcast permission must be obtained in advance from Nick Phillips. Official radio partners of visiting teams should work with their SID to communicate with Wright State in advance of the game(s). Wright State provides a courtesy ethernet line for the official radio partners of visiting teams. ISDN lines will not be readily available at the Nutter Center this season, but may be made available upon request. Inquiries about any accommodations should be made well in advance with Nick Phillips.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: All postgame press conferences with head coach Scott Nagy and select players, will be conducted in person will occur following a 10-minute cooling off period. Playing areas, team locker rooms and other team spaces are private areas and not open to media access. Wright State Athletic Communications representatives will be available to assist in postgame interviews. Interviews with the visiting team can be coordinated with the visiting SID and/or Nick Phillips.

WEEKLY MEDIA AVAILABILITY: Men's Basketball head coach Clint Sargent will hold his weekly media availability with the media in person this season when the team schedule allows, usually on a weekly basis. Select players may also be available at the weekly media availability. Contact Nick Phillips for any inquiries about the weekly media availability schedule.

MIAMI MINUTE

- **Miami (OH)** enters Tuesday undefeated at 10-0, including tallying six wins at home. The start includes wins over Division I opponents Old Dominion, Air Force, Mercyhurst, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, UNC Greensboro, Maine and UNC Asheville.

- **Miami (OH)** finished 2024-25 with a 15-1 record at home, with the lone blemish a 81-68 set-back handed to them by Wright State on November 9.

HITTING FROM DEEP

The Raiders have already connected on double-digit three-pointers three times this season (14, Stetson / 13, Radford / 12, Marshall) after tallying 10-plus triples 10 times in 33 games a year ago.

Wright State's 14 three-pointers in the Nov. 25 win at Stetson was just two triples shy of the program record 16 set last December at Oakland. The Raiders also hit 14 three-pointers last March against IU Indy in the Horizon League tournament first round.

TJ TURNS TO STEALING

TJ Burch's 30 steals are the 9th-most nationally through games on December 14, with his 3.00 steals/game average No. 7 nationally. Burch has multiple steals in eight of 10 games to date. Despite missing the Ohio Wesleyan game on Nov. 20, he has three games with five steals (against Radford and Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, Dec. 7 against Green Bay).

DOUBLE DIGIT KELLEN

Kellen Pickett scored in double figures for the second time in his young career on Dec. 13 at Marshall, finishing with 10 points, two off his career-best 12 from against Ohio Wesleyan. Pickett has scored in seven of his first 11 games, adding at least one rebound in 10 games.

COOP'S COURT

Michael Cooper has opened his collegiate career with double-digits scoring in nine of his first 11 games, leading Wright State with his 15.3 points per game mark. Cooper tallied a career-best 23 points on Dec. 7 against Green Bay and added a 22-point game at Marshall on Dec. 13 while also having a pair of 19-point performances against Kent State and Stetson. His five three-pointers on Nov. 25 at Stetson were a new high in his young career.

HOLDEN IT DOWN

Andrea Holden has tallied double-digit scoring efforts in four of his last seven games, including 11 points on Dec. 3 at Youngstown State in his first start of the year. The stretch also includes a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double against Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-off on Nov. 16 and a career-high 16 points at home over Ohio Wesleyan on Nov. 20, as well as a 10-point, six-rebound effort on Nov. 25 at Stetson.

Holden turned in a career effort at Youngstown State, with his five blocks, two assists and 27 minutes of action all personal bests for him, while he tallied four steals for the second time in his career, joining a four steal game against Youngstown State from Jan. 2025.

BIG MIKE

Michael Imariagbe has double-digit scoring performances in seven of 11 games, tallying his first double-double of the year with a 13-point, 10-rebound effort against Ohio Wesleyan (Nov. 20) and notching a season-best 17 points against Toledo. He grabbed 13 rebounds at Butler (Nov. 28) and added another 10-rebound game on Nov. 15 versus Radford and is currently averaging 5.9 boards per contest.

COOP EARNS ANOTHER HL FRESHMAN HONOR

Michael Cooper was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week for the second time this season on Dec. 8. Cooper tallied a career-high 23 points in the Dec. 7 game against Green Bay and added eight points at Youngstown State on Dec. 3, finishing the opening two Horizon League contests of his career averaging 15.5 points per game for the week.

SAM SHOTS

Sam Alamutu turned in his best game as a Raider on Dec. 3 at Youngstown State, finishing with 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting with seven rebounds in 26 minutes of action, all season high efforts.

BURCH BUCKETS

TJ Burch tied a career-high with 14 points in the loss at Youngstown State on Dec. 3, one game after tallying 13 points at Butler on Nov. 28. In the last two games, Burch is 15-of-28 shooting on the way to the 27 points, adding eight assists and five steals as he played 28- and 29-plus minutes in the two contests.

COOL CALLAGHAN

After a slow start to the season, Solomon Callaghan turned in a pair of double-digit scoring games at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, scoring a game-high 20 points against Radford on Nov. 15 before 10 points against Kent State on Nov. 16 and 17 points at Butler on Nov. 28.

THAT'S DIFFERENT

Wright State's three three-pointers at Youngstown State on Dec. 3 were its fewest made three-pointers since connecting on four in a loss at Purdue Fort Wayne in Feb. 2025. The last time the Raiders made less than three triples was back on Dec. 19, 2023 when they hit two three-pointers in a 93-83 home win over Miami (OH).

BALLIN' BRUSKY

Alex Bruskotter turned in a career-high 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting against Ohio Wesleyan on Nov. 20, connecting on a trio of three-pointers in 21 minutes. It was the second double figure scoring game of his career following 11 points against Franklin on Nov. 3.

SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?

Wright State dropped its first overtime contest of the season on Nov. 16 against Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, something that the Raiders hope isn't a sign of what's to come. Last season, the Raiders played in 11 total games that were either one possession or OT contests, losing nine of them. Both marks were among the top five in the country.

OVERTIME HEARTBREAK

With the overtime loss to Kent State on Nov. 16, Wright State has now lost five of its last six overtime games, dating back to the 2023-24 campaign. The Raiders' last OT win was Jan. 25, 2024 at Cleveland State.

COOP NAMED HL FROSH OF WEEK

Michael Cooper was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week on Nov. 10. Cooper had a pair of double-digit scoring performances, including a team-high 17 points at Cal after 10 points and six rebounds against Franklin.

NOVEMBER TOURNAMENT ACTION

Wright State has been up-and-down its recent MTE past. The Raiders have played in November MTE action in five of the last six seasons, dating back to the 2019-20 season, playing three times in Florida in that span with visits to Myrtle Beach, Las Vegas and West Virginia as well. The Raiders are 8-9 over those five MTEs.

STARTING STRONG

Wright State has always opened seasons strong at home, any way you slice its schedule. The Raiders have won 19 season openers over the last 26 years, dating back to 2000-01.

Wright State is a combined 45-8 all-time in season openers in its two home venues. The Raiders were an astounding 19-1 in home openers inside the Physical Education Building from 1970-71 through 1989-90 (lone loss was 1976-77 home opener) and have been just as impressive inside the Nutter Center.

Since opening the Nutter Center on December 1, 1990, Wright State is 26-9 in home openers, including winning the first home contest of the season 11 of the last 15 seasons.

Clint Sargent enters his second season in the top seat for the Raiders, but has been with Wright State and the Horizon League since 2016-17 season, giving him the fourth-longest overall tenure in the HL among current head coaches.

TENTH - BUT FOURTH

Clint Sargent was named the 10th head coach in Wright State history on March 28, 2024 and enters the 2025-26 season at 37 years old. However, he's the fourth-youngest Raider head man in program history when hired, behind Ed Schilling (31 years old), Billy Donlon (33) and Marcus Jackson (34). After Sargent, Ralph Underhill (37) and Brad Brownell (38) were also in their 30s when Wright State came calling, giving the Raiders six of their 10 head coaches beginning their Wright State careers under the 40-year age mark.

The average age of Division I men's basketball head coaches in 2023-24 was 50, while among first-time head coaches hired since 2014 the average age was 42.6 years of age. According to data from ahead of the 2023-24 season, 17.9 percent of all Division I men's basketball head-coaching hires since 2014 have been internal promotions, and of those, 89.7 percent of the hires have been first-time head coaches.

GOOD FINISH

Michael Imariagbe ended 2024-25 with three straight contests of 10-plus points, a streak that saw him tally double digits scoring in five of the last seven games overall last season.

OPENING ACTS

Wright State saw seven different players get their first action as Raiders against Franklin on Nov. 3.

- Redshirt freshman Alex Bruskotter had 11 points off the bench thanks in part to a trio of three pointers as he added three rebounds and two steals.
- True freshman Michael Cooper tallied 10 points, adding six boards and two assists, while fellow frosh Kellen Pickett added seven points, five rebounds and three steals.
- Transfer Sam Alamutu turned in nine points, five rebounds, five steals and two assists, while newcomer Byan Etumnu had seven points, seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. Transfer Dominic Pangonis added seven points and five rebounds while newcomer TJ Burch dished out a game-high nine assists.

ALLOW US TO (RE)INTRODUCE OURSELVES...

Wright State returns six players from a season ago. Logan Woods started 25 games in 2024-25 while shooting 48 percent overall, while Michael Imariagbe (18 starts, 64 percent shooting) and Solomon Callaghan (11 starts, 41 percent shooting) also had double-digit starts and shot over 40 percent from the floor and Andrea Holden connected at a 65 percent shooting clip with five starts.

EXHIBITION ACTION

Wright State squared off in an exhibition matchup for the second-straight season, grabbing the 63-57 victory over Ohio after a 108-59 win over Wilmington last October inside the Nutter Center. Prior to last season, the Wright State had not played a preseason tune-up since prepping for the 2018-19 campaign with now-defunct Notre Dame College (Ohio).

WELCOME TO THE NUTT HOUSE

Ever since its inaugural game - an 88-86 win over Tennessee State on December 1, 1990 - the Nutter Center has been a welcoming home for the Raiders over the years. In 2019-20, Wright State turned in a 14-2 mark at home in front of the Raider faithful, and since the Nutter Center's opening for the 1990-91 campaign, the Raiders have won over 300 games at home - a winning percentage above 70 percent.

SHOOTING IT WELL

Wright State is in the 77th percentile among all qualifying Division I teams with its 36.0 percent three-point average, while the Raiders' 53.7 percent effective field goal percentage is in the 74th percentile.

Wright State's 17.3 points/game off turnovers is in the 85th percentile, while its 4.4 blocks/game is in the 82nd percentile and the 8.8 steals/game is in the 88th percentile.

THIS AND THAT

-Wright State has tallied an assist on 77.6 percent of its three-point baskets opposed to assisting just 33.5 percent of its two-point baskets.

-The Raiders have 59 total assists on three-pointers, accounting for 50.0 percent of their 118 total assists.

-Wright State has evenly distributed its shooting - recording 37.2 percent of total shots at the rim, 39.1 percent coming from three-point range, 10.2 percent on mid-range two-point shots and 13.5 percent coming on shots in the paint.

PLAYING THE PERCENTAGES

Wright State is shooting 57.7 percent (116-of-201) in around the rim baskets, below of the current Division I average of 62.5 percent. The Raiders are connecting on shots in the paint at 53.4 percent (39-of-73), 11.3 percent higher than the current average of 42.1 percent. The mid-range shooting game is also ahead of the national average, with Wright State connecting at 38.2 percent (21-of-55), ahead of the Division I average of 35.8 percent.

The Raiders are connecting better than the national average from deep as well, shooting 35.9 percent (61-of-170) from above the break threes (national average 32.9), with Wright State hitting 36.6 percent (15-of-41) of its corner threes (national average 35.1).

COACHES CORNER

SARGE IN CHARGE

Clint Sargent was named the 10th head coach in Wright State program history on March 28, 2024, but he had already been the Raiders' head man on the sidelines after filling in as acting head coach for two games during the 2021-22 season.

With then-head coach Scott Nagy and several Raider players away from the team due to COVID protocols in place that season, Sargent led Wright State to a pair of home victories over Milwaukee (80-75, Dec. 30, 2021) and Green Bay (72-69, Jan. 1, 2022) during what turned out to be an NCAA season for the Raiders.

SECOND (YOUNG) SARGENT

Wright State head coach Clint Sargent has made two trips to the NCAA Tournament with the Raiders, but that's still only the second-most NCAA appearances under his own roof. Sargent's wife, the former Jill Young, was a standout with the South Dakota State women's basketball team that made four consecutive NCAA appearances with the Jackrabbits from 2009-2012, including an opening round win over TCU in the 2009 tournament, with Jill scoring 17 points during that win.

A standout player in his own right, Sargent played for Scott Nagy at South Dakota State, where he remains inside the top 10 in total points scored, three-pointers made, total starts and minutes played.

TOURNAMENT TRICE

Associate head coach Travis Trice made his second NCAA Tournament appearance with the Raiders in 2022 but his first in over 30 years, after the then-freshman guard was part of Purdue's 1991 appearance. Purdue fell to Temple in the opening round, but Trice finished with five points, three assists and a rebound in 14 minutes off the bench.

Trice has a pair of sons who have also played in the Big Dance: Travis Jr. made four appearances with Michigan State and D'Mitrik had a pair of appearances with Wisconsin. Trice's daughter, Olivia, is a current player at Florida International and was part of Bowling Green's WNIT run in 2021.

BERÉ ON THE BENCH

Associate head coach Dan Beré made it to college basketball's highest game as a student manager at Indiana, as the Hoosiers danced to the 2002 national championship game, falling to Maryland in the title tilt. Beré spent four years as a manager for the Hoosiers under Mike Davis.

SIMMONS COMES HOME

Jaaron Simmons was named an assistant coach at Wright State ahead of the 2024-25 campaign, with the Dayton-area native returning home to take the next step in his coaching career. Simmons prepped at Archbishop Alter High School and is the school's all-time leading scorer and is second in career assists. He was just the sixth player in Alter school history to score 1,000 points or more during his career.

Simmons played at Ohio for two seasons (2015-17) after starting his collegiate career at Houston. An All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) first team (2017) and second team (2016) player at Ohio, Simmons ranks fourth all-time at Ohio with 475 career assists. He played one season at Michigan (2017-18) as the team won the Big Ten Tournament title, recorded a program-best 33 wins and advanced to the Final Four and national title game.

RETURNING RAIDERS - WRIGHT STATE 25-26 RETURNERS

PLAYERS AT WRIGHT STATE LAST SEASON

COOL CALLAGHAN

Solomon Callaghan turned in five-straight double digit scoring performances from Feb. 8-27, including a career-high 21 points at Green Bay (Feb. 16). He finished 2024-25 with eight double digit scoring games overall (six in Horizon League action). In that five-game February stretch, Callaghan shot 61.7 percent overall (up from 40.6 percent final season average) and was at 54.8 percent from deep (37.2 percent season).

HORIZON LEAGUE SOLOMON

Solomon Callaghan was named to the Horizon League's all-freshman team in March after played in 32 games with 11 starts, averaging just shy of 23 minutes per game while tallying 6.7 points per contest. He shot 40.6 percent overall with a 37.2 percent three-point shooting mark. His scoring average increased to 7.5 points per game in Horizon League contests, with his overall shooting mark up to 43.0 percent and a 41.8 percent from three-point range.

MAGIC MIKE

Michael Imariagbe came on in the month of February and has carried that into March, turning in 12 points and eight rebounds in the HL tourney opener against IU Indy on March 4 and following that up with 15 points against Rober Morris in the HL quarterfinals. He ended the regular season by scoring six or more points in seven of eight games in the month of February with a pair of double digit scoring efforts - 13 points against Northern Kentucky (Feb. 21) and 10 points at Milwaukee (Feb. 14) - before notching his first double-double of the season on March 1 at IU Indy with 18 points and 11 rebounds.

MILESTONE MIKE

Michael Imariagbe recorded his 1,000th collegiate point on Jan. 30 at Youngstown State with a first half bucket. Imariagbe logged 557 points at McMurry College (2020-22) and then had 330 points last season at Houston Christian.

LOGAN WOODS HITTING THE MARK

Logan Woods finished 2024-25 shooting 48.0 percent overall and 46.1 percent from deep while shooting 40 percent or better in 22 of 32 games. He entered last season with career averages of 36.4 and 28.6 percent, respectively. Woods has recorded five-plus points in 23 of 32 games and had six games with 10-plus points, including a career-best 18 points on Nov. 21 against Princeton.

WELCOME TO THE PARTY

Andrea Holden burst onto the scene in January, tallying 11 points in his first two games against Green Bay (Jan. 2) and Oakland (Jan. 9) while adding 11 rebounds in his second contest for his first collegiate double-double. In 17 games last season, Holden finished with a 4.1 points per game average with a 3.5 rebounds per game mark while shooting 65.2 percent overall.

HORIZON LEAGUE HOLDEN

Andrea Holden was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week on Jan. 6 after turning in 11 points with seven rebounds, three steals and a pair of blocks to his scoring output in his collegiate debut on Jan. 2 against Green Bay.

QUICK GLIMPSE

Ayden Davis appeared in six games early last season as a true freshman before a season-ending injury. He averaged 6.5 minutes per game, including logging 13 minutes at Kentucky and playing 12 minutes against Ohio Christian. He checked off his first collegiate basket, rebound and block before shutting it down last season.

READY TO SEE BRUSKY

Alex Bruskotter redshirted in 2024-25 after averaging 23.8 points, 9.1 rebounds and 5.9 assists per game as a senior at Shelby High School. He earned Division II Northwest District Player of the Year, Division II District 6 Player of the Year and Mid-Ohio Athletic Conference Player of the Year honors as a senior and was a finalist for 2024 Ohio Mr. Basketball Award while being named the 2024 Ohio Division II Player of the Year.

DATA DUMP

SOLOMON CALLAGHAN

-Evenly distributed his shooting, with 37.2 percent of his shots on above the break three-pointers, 22.2 percent shot attempts at the rim, 18.9 percent in the midrange game, 15.0 percent on corner threes and 6.7 percent on shots in the paint.

-Took 86 total shots inside the arc and 94 total shots from three-point range. Greatest amount of shots came on above the break threes (67 attempts) or at the rim (40 attempts) as the two areas combined to produce 74.4 percent of his shots.

-Connected at 55.0 percent on shots at the rim (22-of-40) and hit 37.2 percent of his three-point attempts (24-of-67 above the break, 11-of-27 corner threes).

-Finished with an 80.5 percent made free throw percentage and had a 54.0 percent overall true shooting percentage - a mark that takes into account field goals, three-point field goals and free throws.

MICHAEL IMARIAGBE

-Finished the season with an effective field goal percentage of 64.8 percent, which was in the 93rd percentile nationally.

-Saw 134 of his 135 shots come on two-point attempts - all from either in the paint or at the rim. Finished the year with 76.3 percent of his shots coming at the rim and connected at 67.0 percent from that spot (69-of-103). Shot 58.6 percent (17-of-29) from inside the paint.

-The 2024-25 NCAA Division I player average for shot attempts at the rim was 31.0 percent, with Imariagbe finishing the year attempting 45.3 percent more close range shots at the rim than the average.

-Imariagbe grabbed an offensive rebound 18.8 percent of the time he was on the floor in 2024-25.

LOGAN WOODS

-Attempted 38.0 percent of his total field goals on above the break threes while his 89 total three-point attempts accounted for 52.1 percent of his total shot attempts.

-Connected at 58.3 percent (14-of-24) on corner three-pointers and 41.5 percent (27-of-65) on above the break threes.

-Two-point shots not at the rim only accounted for 18.7 percent of his total attempts, but he shot 53.4 percent (23-of-43) from that range.

-Finished with an 78.9 percent made free throw percentage and had a 61.3 percent overall true shooting percentage - a mark that takes into account field goals, three-point field goals and free throws.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES - WRIGHT STATE 25-26 NEWCOMERS

COLLEGIATE TRANSFERS

SAM ALAMUTU

Sam Alamutu joined the program as a transfer in late April. Alamutu, a 6-5 guard from Ajax, Ontario, joins the Raiders after spending his first four seasons at Vermont, going to three NCAA Tournaments in that time - 2022 (redshirt), 2023 and 2024. Alamutu was a part of three America East regular season championships and three tournament title teams overall at Vermont.

Alamutu played in all 33 of Vermont's games in 2024-25, starting 19 contests, as he averaged 17.3 minutes per game with a 5.6 points per game mark. He shot 46.9 percent last season overall while he was active on the glass as well, averaging 6.5 boards per contest. Alamutu notched a season-best 16 points in March against Albany, one of six games last season that saw him tally 10-plus points. He collected five or more points in 14 games, while he finished his final six games of the year strong with three of his double-digit scoring efforts and eight-plus points in all six contests. Alamutu played in 35 games in 2023-24, shooting 58.2 percent for the season with a career-best 23 points at New Hampshire in March, one of his 11 games with five-plus points scored. He saw action in 24 games in 2022-23 as a redshirt freshman, notching a season-high 12 points against Northern Vermont-Lyndon.

TJ BURCH

TJ Burch joined the program as a transfer in mid-May. Burch, a 6-1 guard from Dallas, Texas, joins the Raiders after spending his freshman season at Ball State and he comes to Wright State after playing in 21 contests in his first collegiate campaign.

Burch played in 21 games in 2024-25 for Ball State, averaging 9.5 minutes per contest as a freshman. He averaged 4.8 points per game while shooting 50.0 percent overall and 56.3 percent from three-point range and a trio of double-digit scoring games. He connected on a career-best 14 points against Indiana State in November and also had 13 points against Franklin in his first collegiate contest before ending the year with a 12-point effort at Miami (OH) in March. Burch recorded five or more points in 11 of his 21 games, shooting over 50 percent in 10 contests.

BRYAN ETUMNU

Bryan Etumnu joined the program as a transfer in mid-April. Etumnu, a 6-7 forward from Sugar Land, Texas, joins the Raiders after spending his first three seasons at Merrimack and he comes to Wright State fresh off a season that earned him MAAC Defensive Player of the Year honors.

Etumnu led the MAAC with 73 blocks in 2024-25, with his 2.28 blocks per game average also tops in the conference, finishing with the 16th-most total blocks nationally and the No. 14-ranked blocks per game average. Etumnu notched three games with six blocks last season and averaged 6.1 rebounds per game last season with five games of 10-plus boards, collecting five or more rebounds in 22 of 32 games.

Etumnu started 55 games over the last two seasons at Merrimack, averaging 8.4 points per game and over 30 minutes per night in 2024-25 to go along with his defensive efforts. He shot 51.8 percent from the floor overall last season and is a 53 percent shooter for his career while connecting at over 70 percent at the free throw line.

DOMINIC PANGONIS

Dominic Pangonis joined the program as a transfer in mid-April. Pangonis, a 6-7 guard from Toronto, Canada, joins the Raiders after spending his freshman season at Stephen F. Austin and he comes to Wright State after previously being ranked the third-best overall recruit in Ontario as a prep player at Polaris Prep.

Pangonis played in 31 games in 2024-25 for Stephen F. Austin, averaging 21.4 minutes per contest as a freshman. He averaged 6.2 points per game while shooting 45.0 percent overall and 27.0 percent from three-point range, tallying six double-digit scoring games with a season-high 17 points against Houston Christian in early January. Pangonis recorded five or more points in 22 of his 31 games, while he shot 50 percent or higher in 19 contests. He grabbed multiple rebounds in 16 contests while averaging just under two boards per game.

Pangonis was tabbed as the 46th-best guard in his class and was listed as the third-best overall recruit in Ontario when he was coming out of Polaris Prep in 2023-24.

COLLEGIATE TRANSFERS

MICHAEL COOPER

Michael Cooper signed his national letter-of-intent last November, joining the Raiders from Jeffersonville (IN) High School. He helped lead Jeffersonville to the Indiana Class 4A State Championship in March 2025.

Cooper played in 29 games as high school senior, averaging 18.7 points per game with a 2.4 assists per contest mark and 3.8 rebounds per game average while shooting 54 percent overall and 41 percent from three-point range. As a junior, he averaged 16.4 points per game, 4.4 rebounds per game and 2.4 assists per game while shooting 54 percent overall with a 41 percent rate from three-point range.

PJ DOUGLAS

PJ Douglas signed his national letter-of-intent last November, joining the Raiders from Jeffersonville (IN) High School. He helped lead Jeffersonville to the Indiana Class 4A State Championship in March 2025.

Douglas played in 27 games as high school senior, averaging 12.5 points per game with a 2.4 assists per contest mark and 5.1 rebounds per game average while shooting 49 percent overall and 47 percent from three-point range. As a junior, he averaged 20.5 points per game, 11.9 rebounds per game, 4.5 assists per game and 3.8 blocks per game, shooting 54 percent overall.

KELLEN PICKETT

Kellen Pickett signed his national letter-of-intent last November, joining the Raiders from Blackhawk Christian School (Fort Wayne, Indiana). He helped lead Blackhawk Christian to the Indiana Class 3A regional final in March 2025, while Pickett and Blackhawk Christian won the 2023 Indiana 2A State Championship.

Pickett played in 27 games as high school senior, averaging 19.3 points per game with an 11.5 rebounds per contest mark and 3.5 assists per game average while shooting 54 percent overall and 27 percent from three-point range. As a junior, he averaged 20.5 points per game, 11.9 rebounds per game, 4.5 assists per game and 3.8 blocks per game, shooting 54 percent overall.

ISAIAH WILLIAMS

Isaiah Williams joins the Raiders from Beavercreek (OH) High School. He was a first team all-GWOC player as a senior and was a special mention on the Division I All-Ohio team.

Williams played in 25 games as high school senior, averaging 22.1 points per game with a 7.0 rebounds per contest mark and 3.9 assists per game average while shooting 55 percent overall and 23 percent from three-point range. As a junior, he averaged 19.3 points per game, 5.7 rebounds per game, 4.3 assists per game, shooting 53 percent overall.


