OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

Kellen Pickett blocked a potential game-tying layup in the closing moments as Wright State erased a 12-point second-half deficit, defeating the Detroit Mercy 66-63 to capture the 2026 Barbasol Horizon League Championship on March 10 inside Corteva Coliseum and punch their ticket back to the NCAA Tournament.

BACK IN THE DANCE

Wright State is making its fifth Division I NCAA tournament appearance, and first since 2022 when the Raiders defeated Bryant in the First Four for their first D-I tournament win before falling to No. 1 Arizona in the first round in a game that had a seven-point margin in the second half.

The 1983 NCAA Division II national champions, the Raiders also made the NCAA Division I tournament in 1993, 2007 and 2018 tournaments in addition to the 2022 Dance.

SEEDING HISTORY

Wright State has now earned a No. 14 seed three in its five NCAA appearances, also receiving the seed in both the 2007 and 2018 tournaments. The 2007 squad won 25 games and the 2018 team had 23 victories.

RAIDER FIRST

The 2025-26 Raiders are the first Wright State team in program history to win the Horizon League outright regular season and tournament titles in the same season.

KEPT THE TREND GOING

Wright State is the third straight Horizon League team to complete the regular season and tournament title sweep, joining Oakland (2024) and Robert Morris (2025).

GIVE ME 20

Wright State reached the 20-win mark this season for the 15th time in its Division I history, reaching the mark for the first time since the 2021-22 season. The Raiders won 20-plus games in seven of eight seasons from 2012-2020.

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, please contact Nick Phillips, Assistant Athletics Director for Communications (nick.phillips@wright.edu). All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Requests for credentials will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Athletic Communications office has the final authority on whether any individuals from any organization will be issued media credentials.

MEDIA ENTRANCE: Working media will gain access to the Nutter Center via the loading dock. The Media Room for working media will again be available pre-, post- and in-game, along with a pregame meal and beverages.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: Still and video photographers must remain at least 6 feet back from the playing court (denoted by a black marked line on each baseline) and also be aware of ticketed fans around them. Contact Nick Phillips with any questions.

RADIO COVERAGE: Radio broadcast permission must be obtained in advance from Nick Phillips. Official radio partners of visiting teams should work with their SID to communicate with Wright State in advance of the game(s). Wright State provides a courtesy ethernet line for the official radio partners of visiting teams. ISDN lines will not be readily available at the Nutter Center this season, but may be made available upon request. Inquiries about any accommodations should be made well in advance with Nick Phillips.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: All postgame press conferences with head coach Scott Nagy and select players, will be conducted in person will occur following a 10-minute cooling off period. Playing areas, team locker rooms and other team spaces are private areas and not open to media access. Wright State Athletic Communications representatives will be available to assist in postgame interviews. Interviews with the visiting team can be coordinated with the visiting SID and/or Nick Phillips.

WEEKLY MEDIA AVAILABILITY: Men's Basketball head coach Clint Sargent will hold his weekly media availability with the media in person this season when the team schedule allows, usually on a weekly basis. Select players may also be available at the weekly media availability. Contact Nick Phillips for any inquiries about the weekly media availability schedule.

(NO) HISTORY WITH VIRGINIA

Wright State and Virginia will meet on the hardwood for the first time on Friday, marking the 280th different opponent in Raider history. It is also the fourth first-time matchup this season for Wright State.

COMMONALITIES WITH THE COMMONWEALTH

Wright State has three common opponents with Virginia on the schedule this season, with both squads facing Marshall, Butler and Cal. The Raiders lost all three games, including a two-point loss at Marshall and a 10-point defeat at Butler, while Virginia grabbed wins over Marshall and Cal, losing to Butler at the Greenbrier Tip-Off.

BALLIN' IN THE CITY OF BROTHERLY LOVE

Wright State is set to play in Philadelphia on Friday for just the second time in program history. The Raiders only other trip to the city came on February 11, 1995 against LaSalle - in a Midwestern Collegiate Conference (now Horizon League) game, no less.

PHILLY FLAVOR

Wright State Hall of Famer Bill Edwards, the all-time leading scorer (2,303 points) in program history and No. 2 all-time rebounder (907) in Raider history, played with the Philadelphia 76ers during the 1993-94 season. He later went on to have a 12-year overseas career. Edwards was a member of the bronze medal-winning senior men's Team USA at the 1998 FIBA World Championship.

PHILLY FLAVOR

Wright State Hall of Famer Vitaly Potapenko played in the NBA from 1996-2007. Potapenko has been an assistant coach since 2009, including becoming an NBA Champion as part of the Cavaliers staff in 2016.

Potapenko's career-high 18 rebounds came nearly 26 years ago on March 24, 2000 as a Boston Celtic against Philadelphia - in the same building the Raiders will play in Friday. Potapenko is perhaps best known for being selected No. 12 overall in the 1996 NBA Draft - one spot above Philly native and Lower Merion High School legend Kobe 'Bean' Bryant.

MAGIC NUMBER

Wright State has tallied 65 wins and counting when scoring 80 or more points the last five-plus seasons (65-14), dating back to the start of the 2021-22 campaign. The Raiders are 15-36 when scoring less than 80 points over the same time span, however own seven of those wins this season (at Stetson, vs. Eastern Michigan, vs. Milwaukee, at Milwaukee, vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, at Purdue Fort Wayne, vs. Detroit Mercy - HL Championship).

BLOCK PARTY

Wright State has recorded 15 games with five or more blocks this season, with a season-high nine blocks Jan. 4 at IU Indy. The Raiders finished the 2024-25 season with six such games. Kellen Pickett leads the Raiders with 46 blocks - currently the second-most in the Horizon League - followed by Andrea Holden with 40 (sixth in the HL) and Michael Imariagbe with 26.

DEFENSIVE DÉJÀ VU

Wright State has allowed 75 points or less in 17 of 34 games to date after holding opponents to 75 points or less 16 times last season in 33 contests.

SHARING THE SCORING

Wright State has had seven different players lead the team in individual game scoring this season (Imariagbe, Cooper, Callaghan, Holden, Burch, Pickett, Bruskotter) while three more players (Pangonis, Etumnu, Woods) have finished a game as the second-leading scorer.

ROAD REVERSAL

Wright State tallied an 8-2 road record in Horizon League games this season (9-5 on the road overall) after the Raiders were 2-8 in HL road games a season ago (3-12 on the road overall). The Raiders didn't win a road last season after January 18 - this year, they were 5-1 on the road after January 18.

WIN YOUR HOME GAMES

Wright State was 22-9 at home the last two seasons under Clint Sargent (11-4 last season and 11-5 this year) after going a combined 18-13 the previous two years (2022-23 / 2023-24).

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

2022

WRIGHT STATE BEATS BRYANT FOR FIRST NCAA WIN

Playing in front of a Wright State-heavy crowd in the First Four, the Raiders beat Bryant 93-82 to record their first NCAA tournament win in team history. Guard Tanner Holden scored 37 points, one shy of a career high, to outplay the nation's leading scoring, Peter Kiss, in a matchup of No. 16 seeds. Trey Calvin added 21 points for Wright State, while Grant Basile scored 14.

RAIDERS FALL TO NO. 1 ARIZONA

Wright State's historic season ended when the Raiders fell to No. 1 Arizona 87-70 in the First Round of the NCAA Division I tournament at Viejas Arena. Grant Basile led Wright State with a game-high 21 points, while Trey Calvin had 16 points and four assists. Tim Finke added 15 points and Tanner Holden also reached double figures with 12 points.

Top-seeded Arizona led by 16 points late in the first period and was up 42-31 at halftime before the Raiders stormed back within 49-42 at the 16:38 minute mark of the second half on a 3-pointer and three-point play from Basile. In response, the Wildcats pulled away with a 15-2 run and led by double digits for the remainder of the postseason contest.

2018

SPECIAL SEASON COMES TO AN END IN DALLAS

Picked to finish fifth in the Horizon League preseason poll, Wright State proved many outsiders wrong by advancing to the first round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament at the American Airlines Center in Dallas, falling 73-47 to Tennessee. Wright State shot 32% (19-60) from the field and a staggering 19% (4-21) from beyond the arc. The 47 points scored marked the lowest output in head coach Scott Nagy's first two seasons at the helm.

2007

RAIDERS FALL TO PITTSBURGH IN NCAA FIRST ROUND

The magical season for Wright State came to an end as No. 3 seed Pittsburgh Panthers broke away in the late stages of the first half and went on to a 79-58 decision over the No. 14 seed Raiders in the first round of the NCAA West Regional at the HSBC Arena in Buffalo. Four Raiders scored in double figures, led by DaShaun Wood, who tallied 13 in his final game as a Raider and added seven assists and six rebounds. Vaughn Duggins chipped in 12, Scottie Wilson 11 and Todd Brown 10 points.

TENTH - BUT FOURTH

Clint Sargent was named the 10th head coach in Wright State history on March 28, 2024 and entered the 2025-26 season at 37 years old. However, he's the fourth-youngest Raider head man in program history when hired, behind Ed Schilling (31 years old), Billy Donlon (33) and Marcus Jackson (34). After Sargent, Ralph Underhill (37) and Brad Brownell (38) were also in their 30s when Wright State came calling, giving the Raiders six of their 10 head coaches beginning their Wright State careers under the 40-year age mark.

The average age of Division I men's basketball head coaches in 2023-24 was 50, while among first-time head coaches hired since 2014 the average age was 42.6 years of age. According to data from ahead of the 2023-24 season, 17.9 percent of all Division I men's basketball head-coaching hires since 2014 have been internal promotions, and of those, 89.7 percent of the hires have been first-time head coaches.

1993

WRIGHT STATE RUNS INTO INDIANA IN FIRST APPEARANCE

Wright State's first Division I NCAA appearance was met by more than 36,000 Indiana faithful inside the Hoosier Dome in Indianapolis, with No. 1-ranked and No. 1-seeded Indiana taking care of the Raiders 97-54. Indiana shot 56.9 percent from the floor to WSU's 31.9 percent as the Raiders fell behind 45-29 at halftime and couldn't keep pace in the second half.

1983 NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

RAIDERS DEFEAT UNIVERSITY OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Wright State finished the 1983 regular season 23-4 overall, earning the No. 1 seed in the Great Lakes Region and downing Lewis and Kentucky Wesleyan to advance out of the regional.

After a 20-point quarterfinal round win against Bloomsburg State in Pennsylvania, the Raiders took down national semi-final opponent Cal-State Bakersfield 57-50 to set up the title tilt.

Wright State led by seven at the half and played a near-flawless second half, hitting 29 of 32 free throws in the second half on the way to a 92-73 national championship win.

The Raiders shot 63% from the field, and shot a whopping 41 free throws, making 32. Gary Monroe, a Washington D.C. native, scored 23 points and set an NCAA tournament record by connecting on all 11 of his free throw attempts. He was named the Most Outstanding Player of the tournament.

WRIGHT STATE DEEP DIVES

MORE THAN A TREND...

Wright State has 23 wins and counting this season - in 20 of those wins, the Raiders have led at the half, have led with 10 minutes to play and have led with five minutes to play. The lone outlier wins when trailing at the half came when the Raiders came from behind in the Horizon League Championship against Detroit Mercy on March 10, at Northern Kentucky on Feb. 28 and at home against Youngstown State on Jan. 15.

HOT SHOTS

Four rotation players are shooting over 50.0 percent from the floor, led by Michael Imariagbe (58.9), followed by Andrea Holden (57.0), Kellen Pickett (56.4) and Sam Alamutu (50.0). Four more regulars - Dominic Pangonis (47.5), TJ Burch (46.0), Logan Woods (45.0), Michael Cooper (44.9) - are just off the shooting pace.

TRACKING FROM THREE

Wright State is hitting three-pointers at a 36.1 percent rate (241-of-667). The current mark is just off the pace for the Raiders' best percentage since hitting 40.5 percent in 2001-02. The school-record is 41.0 percent, set in the program's first year in Division I in 1987-88.

BETTER AT THE STRIPE

Wright State has shot 20-plus free throws in 17 of the last 25 games after only shooting 20-plus free throws four times in the first nine games.

TJ TURNS IT ON

After recording just three double figure scoring efforts in the first 11 games, TJ Burch has now scored 10-plus points in 21 of the last 22 contests, including a quartet of 20-plus point games against Youngstown State (24 points, Jan. 15), Cleveland State (23 points, Feb. 15), IU Indy (23 points, Feb. 19) and NKU (22 points, March 9).

BURCH STEALS THE SHOW

TJ Burch currently has 83 steals on the year, which is the most in a season since former Wright State standout DaShaun Wood had 64 steals in 2006-07. Burch's 83 swipes are the second-most in a single season in Raider history, with former Wright State standout Mark Woods holding the top spot with 109 steals in the 1992-93 season.

TJ TURNS TO STEALING

TJ Burch leads the nation in steal rate (5.8) according to KenPom, while his 83 steals are the 5th-most nationally entering the NCAA tournament, with his 2.52 steals/game average No. 9 nationally. Burch has multiple steals in 22 of 33 games. He has four games with five steals (against Radford and Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, Dec. 7 Green Bay, Feb. 1 Green Bay) and a career-high six steals on Dec. 29 at Oakland.

COOP'S COURT

Michael Cooper has double-digits scoring in 21 of his 30 games played, leading Wright State with his 13.4 points per game mark. Cooper tallied a career-best 25 points against Northern Kentucky in the Horizon League semifinals, one of four games with 20-plus points this season. His five three-pointers on Nov. 25 at Stetson are a season-high.

KP SAYS NO

Kellen Pickett's 46 blocks are the second-most in the Horizon League and is also the second-most in a single season in Raider history. Pickett still has a ways to catch Grant Basile's 59 blocks in the 2021-22 season.

PICKETT AND CHOOSING

Kellen Pickett has scored in 27 of 34 games in his freshman campaign, with 13 games in double digits scoring. Since being inserted into the starting lineup on Dec. 22, Pickett has scored in double digits in 12 games - including his career-best 21 points at Green Bay on Feb. 1.

DOUBLE THE MIKE

Michael Imariagbe has six double-doubles this season, with four in the month of February. The stretch began with back-to-back double-doubles on Feb. 4 and Feb. 7, turning in 16 points and 13 rebounds against RMU before 19 points and 16 rebounds against Purdue Fort Wayne. Imariagbe added to the recent run with 12 points and 10 rebounds at Cleveland State on Feb. 15 and has 15 points and 16 rebounds at NKU on Feb. 28.

BIG MIKE

Michael Imariagbe has double-digit scoring performances in 22 of 33 games, including a season- and Wright State-best 24 points against Northern Kentucky on Jan. 24, along with 19 points at IU Indy on Jan. 4 and a pair

of 17-point performances (Milwaukee Jan. 1, Toledo Nov. 11). He has six double-doubles on the year.

SILENT SCORER

Dominic Pangonis has quietly scored double figures in 16 of 33 games in his first year as a Raider, including 12 games with 10-plus points against Horizon League opponents, shooting nearly 48 percent overall and 38 percent from deep.

HOLDEN IT DOWN

Andrea Holden has tallied seven double-digit scoring efforts to date, including a career-best 17 points at Detroit Mercy on Jan. 9 and 15 points against Detroit Mercy on Feb. 12. His season also includes a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double against Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-off on Nov. 16 and 16 points at home over Ohio Wesleyan on Nov. 20, as well as a 10-point, six-rebound effort at Stetson.

Holden turned in a career effort at Youngstown State, with his five blocks, two assists and 27 minutes of action all personal bests for him, while he tallied four steals for the second time in his career, joining a four steal game against Youngstown State from Jan. 2025.

LET'S LINEUP

Wright State has had 12 different starting lineup combinations to date this season, while the Raiders currently have seven different players averaging over 15 minutes per contest (9 players averaging over 12 minutes).

AT THE TOP

The Raiders are Horizon League regular season champions for the first time since the 2020-21 season, and own the outright title for the first time since the 2019-20 campaign. Wright State is the No. 1 seed in the HL Championship for the fourth time, also sitting as the top seed in the 2020, 2019 and 2007 HL tournaments.

AWARDS SEASON

Wright State received nine Horizon League honors, headlined by TJ Burch earning both Defensive Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year honors, while Kellen Pickett was named the HL's Freshman of the Year and Clint Sargent selected as the League's Coach of the Year.

Burch was also recognized on the HL first team, with Michael Imariagbe on the second team as Michael Cooper joined Pickett on the All-Freshman team. Solomon Callaghan was also a finalist for the HL Sportsmanship Award for the second-straight season.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

Wright State's 20-point comeback victory in the regular season finale Feb. 28 against Northern Kentucky was the largest comeback Raider win in the Division I era, surpassing the previous record of 16 points. The Raiders trailed by 20 late in the first half and 18 at the half before winning on Michael Imariagbe's putback tip-in with less than a second remaining.

The Raiders had previously come back to win when trailing by 16 points four times, most recently on Feb. 27, 2025 when they scored 51 second half points to win 82-76 at home against Cleveland State.

KELLEN FROM DEEP

Kellen Pickett connected on four three-pointers Feb. 7 against Purdue Fort Wayne after entering the contest 5-of-25 from deep on the season.

HORIZON LEAGUE FRESHMAN BATTLE

Kellen Pickett and Michael Cooper each had three Horizon League Freshman of the Week nods during the regular season, with the pair combining for six of the 17 weekly HL freshman awards.

STRANGE BUT TRUE

Wright State's win at Purdue Fort Wayne on Feb. 25 was the Raiders' first Wednesday win of the season (1-3 record) and the first Wright State win of the campaign when losing the defensive glass (1-10). It was also the Raiders second win when losing the rebound battle overall (2-8) and second time winning when shooting less than 20 free throws (2-8).

BOUNCED BACK

The Raiders have had strong bounce back shooting percentages recently following losses. After shooting 40.6 percent on Feb. 12 in the loss to Detroit Mercy, the Raiders connected at 72.7 percent in the first half at Cleveland State before finishing the win shooting 61.8 percent overall. The bounce back shooting followed a similar path from other recent hot shooting games are a loss.

500 FOR ALAMUTU

Wright State graduate transfer Sam Alamutu grabbed four rebounds on Feb. 7 to reach the 500 career rebound mark. Alamutu played three seasons at Vermont and amassed 428 rebounds in 92 games before joining the Raiders this season.

CENTURY MARK

Wright State's 102 points on Feb. 15 at Cleveland State were its most in the regular season and the second time reaching the century mark after scoring 100 in the Nov. 20 win over Ohio Wesleyan. The 102 points against Cleveland State were the most since the Raiders tallied 113 points in a 120-113 double overtime home loss to Purdue Fort Wayne last January. Prior to Feb. 15, the last time Wright State eclipsed 100 points in regulation against a Division I opponent was in a 101-71 home win over Robert Morris back on February 17, 2024.

TURNED A TOUGH DOUBLE PLAY

Wright State captured wins at Milwaukee and Green Bay over the weekend on the same trip for just the third time in program history. The Raiders most recently completed the sweep in January 2023, also doing so in February 2013.

JAMMIN' JANUARY

Wright State won seven of eight contests in the month of January, its most victories in a single month since going 7-3 in January 2022 ahead of its Horizon League Tournament title and NCAA appearance.

FREE THROW FRENZY

Wright State shot 36 free throws in the Jan. 24 win over Northern Kentucky, the most the Raiders have had since going to the line 38 times in an overtime win at Cleveland State in January 2024. They ended the win 29-of-36 at the free throw line, including going to the stripe 28 times over the final 20 minutes.

WIN STREAKERS

Wright State won seven straight games from December 22-January 15, its longest streak since winning seven straight games from December 18-January 12 in the 2021-22 season. The Raiders' longest winning streak as a Division I program was 11 straight victories during the 2007-08 season.

PICKETT EARNS THIRD-STRAIGHT HL NOD

Kellen Pickett was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week for the third consecutive week, the League office announced on Jan. 19. Pickett turned in his second-straight 18-point performance on Jan. 15 in Wright State's home win over Youngstown State. The 18 points, which tied his career-best set Jan. 11 at Oakland, came with nine rebounds as he just missed his third-straight double-double.

NATIONAL AUDIENCE WIN

Wright State's 94-84 win at Oakland on January 11 was flexed to ESPN2, giving the Raiders their first linear tv game of the season.

THAT'S DIFFERENT

Wright State's three three-pointers against Miami (OH) on Dec. 16 and at Youngstown State on Dec. 3 were its fewest made three-pointers since connecting on four in a loss at Purdue Fort Wayne in Feb. 2025. The last time the Raiders made less than three triples was in Dec. 2023 when they hit two triples in a home win over Miami (OH).

SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?

Wright State dropped its first overtime contest of the season on Nov. 16 against Kent State at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, something that the Raiders hope isn't a sign of what's to come. Last season, the Raiders played in 11 total games that were either one possession or OT contests, losing nine of them. Both marks were among the top five in the country.

OVERTIME HEARTBREAK

With the overtime loss to Kent State on Nov. 16, Wright State has now lost five of its last six overtime games, dating back to the 2023-24 campaign. The Raiders' last OT win was Jan. 25, 2024 at Cleveland State.

RAIDERS SWEEP WEEKLY AWARDS

Solomon Callaghan and Kellen Pickett swept the Horizon League weekly awards, earning HL Player and Freshman of the Week honors, the League office announced on Jan. 12. Callaghan averaged 21 points for the week after a pair of double-digit scoring efforts, including a new career-high 27 points at Oakland. Callaghan finished the weekend shooting 65 percent overall and 60 percent from deep on the way to his 21.0 points per game average, adding five assists and four rebounds to his weekly stat line. Pickett averaged a double-double for the weekend, beginning with a new career-high 12-rebound effort at Detroit Mercy before an 18-point performance against Oakland. For the weekend, Pickett shot 53 percent overall on the way to his 11.5 point, 11.5 rebound double-double average.

PICKETT EARNS HL WEEKLY FRESHMAN HONORS

Kellen Pickett was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week on Jan. 5. Pickett tallied his first collegiate double-double against Milwaukee and averaged eight points as he helped Wright State to a 3-0 week in HL play. He finished the week shooting 71.4 percent from the floor with the 8.0 points per game average and 8.0 rebounds per game mark, adding seven blocks to his stat line.

STARTING THE NEW YEAR RIGHT

With the January 1 win over Milwaukee, Wright State has won its first game of the new calendar year in each of the last seven seasons. The Raiders are 21-6 in their first games each January dating back to January 3, 2000.

COOP EARNS ANOTHER HL FRESHMAN HONOR

Michael Cooper was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week for the second time this season on Dec. 8. Cooper tallied a career-high 23 points in the Dec. 7 game against Green Bay and added eight points at Youngstown State on Dec. 3, finishing the opening two Horizon League contests of his career averaging 15.5 points points for the week.

SAM SHOTS

Sam Alamutu turned in his best game as a Raider on Dec. 3 at Youngstown State, finishing with 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting with seven rebounds in 26 minutes of action, all season high efforts.

BURCH BUCKETS

TJ Burch tied a then-career-high with 14 points in the loss at Youngstown State on Dec. 3, one game after tallying 13 points at Butler on Nov. 28. In the last two games, Burch is 15-of-28 shooting on the way to the 27 points, adding eight assists and five steals as he played 28- and 29-plus minutes in the two contests.

COOL CALLAGHAN

After a slow start to the season, Solomon Callaghan turned in a pair of double-digit scoring games at the Greenbrier Tip-Off, scoring a game-high 20 points against Radford on Nov. 15 before 10 points against Kent State on Nov. 16 and 17 points at Butler on Nov. 28.

BALLIN' BRUSKY

Alex Bruskotter turned in a career-high 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting against Ohio Wesleyan on Nov. 20, connecting on a trio of three-pointers in 21 minutes. It was the second double figure scoring game of his career following 11 points against Franklin on Nov. 3.

COOP NAMED HL FROSH OF WEEK

Michael Cooper was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Week on Nov. 10. Cooper had a pair of double-digit scoring performances, including a team-high 17 points at Cal after 10 points and six rebounds against Franklin.

NOVEMBER TOURNAMENT ACTION

Wright State has been up-and-down its recent MTE past. The Raiders have played in November MTE action in five of the last six seasons, dating back to the 2019-20 season, playing three times in Florida in that span with visits to Myrtle Beach, Las Vegas and West Virginia as well. The Raiders are 8-9 over those five MTEs.

STARTING STRONG

Wright State has always opened seasons strong at home, any way you slice its schedule. The Raiders have won 19 season openers over the last 26 years, dating back to 2000-01.

Wright State is a combined 45-8 all-time in season openers in its two home venues. The Raiders were an astounding 19-1 in home openers inside the Physical Education Building from 1970-71 through 1989-90 (one loss was 1976-77 home opener) and have been just as impressive inside the Nutter Center.

Since opening the Nutter Center on December 1, 1990, Wright State is 26-9 in home openers, including winning the first home contest of the season 11 of the last 15 seasons.

OPENING ACTS

Wright State saw seven different players get their first action as Raiders against Franklin on Nov. 3.

- Redshirt freshman Alex Bruskotter had 11 points off the bench thanks in part to a trio of three pointers as he added three rebounds and two steals.
- True freshman Michael Cooper tallied 10 points, adding six boards and two assists, while fellow frosh Kellen Pickett added seven points, five rebounds and three steals.
- Transfer Sam Alamutu turned in nine points, five rebounds, five steals and two assists, while newcomer Byan Etumnu had seven points, seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. Transfer Dominic Pangonis added seven points and five rebounds while newcomer TJ Burch dished out a game-high nine assists.

ALLOW US TO (RE)INTRODUCE OURSELVES...

Wright State returns six players from a season ago. Logan Woods started 25 games in 2024-25 while shooting 48 percent overall, while Michael Imaniagbe (18 starts, 64 percent shooting) and Solomon Callaghan (11 starts, 41 percent shooting) also had double-digit starts and shot over 40 percent from the floor and Andrea Holden connected at a 65 percent shooting clip with five starts.

EXHIBITION ACTION

Wright State squared off in an exhibition matchup for the second-straight season, grabbing the 63-57 victory over Ohio after a 108-59 win over Wilmington last October inside the Nutter Center. Prior to last season, the Wright State had not played a preseason tune-up since prepping for the 2018-19 campaign with now-defunct Notre Dame College (Ohio).

WELCOME TO THE NUTT HOUSE

Ever since its inaugural game - an 88-86 win over Tennessee State on December 1, 1990 - the Nutter Center has been a welcoming home for the Raiders over the years. In 2019-20, Wright State turned in a 14-2 mark at home in front of the Raider faithful, and since the Nutter Center's opening for the 1990-91 campaign, the Raiders have won over 300 games at home - a winning percentage above 70 percent.

DEEPER DIVE INTO THE DATA (STATS AGAINST DIVISION I OPPS. ONLY)

LOOKING AT THE NUMBERS

Wright State is in the 92nd percentile among all qualifying Division I teams with its 48.3 percent field goal average, while the Raiders' 54.4 percent effective field goal percentage is in the 84th percentile.

Wright State's 14.4 points/game off turnovers is in the 73rd percentile, while its 4.4 blocks/game is in the 88th percentile and the 7.1 steals/game is in the 67th percentile.

THIS AND THAT

-Wright State has tallied an assist on 78.4 percent of its three-point baskets and assisted on 36.4 percent of its two-point baskets.

-The Raiders have 178 total assists on three-pointers, accounting for 42.0 percent of their 424 total assists.

-Wright State has evenly distributed its shooting - recording 43.1 percent of total shots at the rim, 33.7 percent coming from three-point range, 6.8 percent on mid-range two-point shots and 16.4 percent coming on shots in the paint.

PLAYING THE PERCENTAGES

Wright State is shooting 60.6 percent (488-of-805) in around the rim baskets, below of the current Division I average of 62.4 percent. The Raiders are connecting on shots in the paint at 47.4 percent (145-of-306), 5.2 percent higher than the current average of 42.2 percent. The mid-range shooting game is right at the national average, with Wright State connecting at 33.1 percent (42-of-127), just off the current Division I average (36.5 percent).

The Raiders are connecting right at the national average from deep as well, shooting 36.3 percent (185-of-509) from above the break threes (national average 33.4), with Wright State hitting 35.3 percent (42-of-119) of its corner threes (national average 35.8).

NATIONAL QUICK HITTERS FROM 2024-25

-Wright State finished 2024-25 No. 6 nationally in FG percentage (first in HL) at 49.4%

-The Raiders' Effective Field Goal percentage was No. 11 nationally (first in HL) at 56.6%

-Wright State was No. 12 nationally in three-point percentage (first in HL) at 38.4%

-The Raiders passed out 15.2 assists per game last year, No. 69 nationally (second in HL)

COACHES CORNER

SARGE IN CHARGE

Clint Sargent was named the 10th head coach in Wright State program history on March 28, 2024, but he had already been the Raiders' head man on the sidelines after filling in as acting head coach for two games during the 2021-22 season.

With then-head coach Scott Nagy and several Raider players away from the team due to COVID protocols in place that season, Sargent led Wright State to a pair of home victories over Milwaukee (80-75, Dec. 30, 2021) and Green Bay (72-69, Jan. 1, 2022) during what turned out to be an NCAA season for the Raiders.

SECOND (YOUNG) SARGENT

Wright State head coach Clint Sargent has now made three trips to the NCAA Tournament with the Raiders and added one on the staff at South Dakota State. He's now tied for the most NCAA appearances under his own roof. Sargent's wife, the former Jill Young, was a standout with the South Dakota State women's basketball team that made four consecutive NCAA appearances with the Jackrabbits from 2009-2012, including an opening round win over TCU in the 2009 tournament, with Jill scoring 17 points during that win.

A standout player in his own right, Sargent played for Scott Nagy at South Dakota State, where he remains inside the top 10 in total points scored, three-pointers made, total starts and minutes played.

TOURNAMENT TRICE

Associate head coach Travis Trice made his second NCAA Tournament appearance with the Raiders in 2022 but his first in over 30 years, after the then-freshman guard was part of Purdue's 1991 appearance. Purdue fell to Temple in the opening round, but Trice finished with five points, three assists and a rebound in 14 minutes off the bench.

Trice has a pair of sons who have also played in the Big Dance: Travis Jr. made four appearances with Michigan State and D'Mitrik had a pair of appearances with Wisconsin. Trice's daughter, Olivia, is a current player at Florida International and was part of Bowling Green's WNIT run in 2021.

BERÉ ON THE BENCH

Associate head coach Dan Beré made it to college basketball's highest game as a student manager at Indiana, as the Hoosiers danced to the 2002 national championship game, falling to Maryland in the title tilt. Beré spent four years as a manager for the Hoosiers under Mike Davis.

SIMMONS COMES HOME

Jaaron Simmons was named an assistant coach at Wright State ahead of the 2024-25 campaign, with the Dayton-area native returning home to take the next step in his coaching career. Simmons prepped at Archbishop Alter High School and is the school's all-time leading scorer and is second in career assists. He was just the sixth player in Alter school history to score 1,000 points or more during his career.

Simmons played at Ohio for two seasons (2015-17) after starting his collegiate career at Houston. An All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) first team (2017) and second team (2016) player at Ohio, Simmons ranks fourth all-time at Ohio with 475 career assists. He played one season at Michigan (2017-18) as the team won the Big Ten Tournament title, recorded a program-best 33 wins and advanced to the Final Four and national title game.


