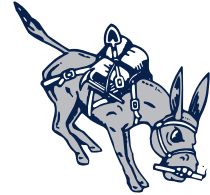

GAME NOTES

SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's game will be the 93rd meeting between Western and the Colorado School of Mines. The Mountaineers hold a commanding 52-37-2 lead on the series. The matchup between Colorado Mines and Western is the longest continual rivalry in the state of Colorado.

Western has won the last two matchups, including the last game in Golden, 45-42 on Nov. 7, 2015. Both wins came against the Orediggers while they were ranked in the top-25 in Division II.

In Golden, Western has a 22-21-2 record at CSM. The Mountaineers' win in 2015 broke an eight-game win streak by the Orediggers over Western, and a six game win streak in Golden against the Mountaineers.

CSM is 1-0 in home games this season, defeating New Mexico Highlands University 70-0 on Sept. 9.

LAST WEEK

WESTERN - The Mountaineers lost to Chadron State College 49-7 in Western's home opening game of the 2017 season. True freshman Dylan Jacob led the Mountaineers in passing with 101 yards. Justice Macneal-Young led the team in rushing with 32 yards. The Mountaineer defense forced two fumbles and blocked a punt.

CSM - The Orediggers lost to Colorado Mesa University 38-36. The Mavericks kicked a game-winning field goal as time expired. CSM's Cameron Mayberry ran for 151 yards on a program-record 39 carries. Quarter back Ben Bottlinger threw for a career-high 370 yards and four touchdowns.

4TH QUARTER FIREWORKS

The Mountaineers have been winning the fourth quarter, this season and last. In two games (Colorado Mesa and Adams State) this year, Western has shutout their opponents, outscoring them 20-0 in the final quarter.

This year, Western is outscoring their opponents 20-7 in the final 15 minutes of play.

Since last season, Western has outscored opponents 95-40 in the fourth.

Last season, Western outscored opponents 75-33 in the fourth quarter. The Mountaineers held six teams scoreless in the final 15 minutes last season (Colorado Mines, Fort Lewis, Black Hills State, New Mexico Highlands, CSU-Pueblo, and S.D. Mines).

THE BAINS REIGN

Western Head Coach Jas Bains is one win away from tying Paul Wright (1935-47) for the sixth most wins by a Mountaineer football coach at 20.

Bains is also three more games away from tying Wright for the fourth most games coached in Western program history at 72. By the end of the season, Bains should have the third most games coached with 77, moving past Wright at 72 and Pete Pederson (1953-60) at 74.

GAME NOTES

HOME OPENERS

Western is 44-46-2 in home openers. The last time Western won their home opening game of the season came on Sept. 19, 1998. The Mountaineers defeated Mesa State College, now Colorado Mesa University, 42-6.

The Mountaineers lost to Chadron State College 49-7 during this season's home opener. Western has hosted Chadron three other times in their home opening game of the season. The series is now 1-2-1.

COLORADO CLASSIC

The rivalry between Adams State University and Western State Colorado University is the second longest continual rivalry in the state of Colorado.

These two programs have been playing each other every year since 1950. The winner of the Colorado Classic earns the right to possess the Colorado Classic Trophy, which travels to the winning institution. The trophy currently now resides at Adams State after they took this year's matchup 51-14.

The longest continual rivalry in Colorado is between Western State and Colorado School of Mines. The two schools have played 92 games, dating back to 1925.

SEASON OPENERS

Western is 32-60 in season openers. Since 1995, the Mountaineers are 1-22 in season openers. This season, Western lost to CMU 49-23 in the season opener. The last opening day win came in 2014 against Wayland Baptist, 38-21, on the road.

Of their 32 season opening wins, Western has finished those seasons with a winning record 19 times (59.4%) and won the conference title 12 times (37.5%).

RMAC OPENERS

The Mountaineers have struggled winning the conference opener recently. Over the past 13 seasons, Western has a 1-12 record in their Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference openers. The lone victory came against New Mexico Highlands University in 2006 on the road, with the Mountaineers winning 14-9.

Western lost the 2017 RMAC opener to Colorado Mesa 49-23.

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

After defeating then ranked No. 23 Colorado School of Mines 45-31 in week four last season, and losing to No. 23 Colorado Mesa 49-23 this season, Western has won the past 2-of-3 games against ranked opponents. The Mountaineers defeated No. 21 Mines in week 10 of 2015.

NEW FACES WITH THE BALL

After four seasons with the same starting quarterback and running back, the Mountaineer offense will begin a new era. Quarterback Brett Arrivey and running back Austin Ekeler were a staple of the Western offense, each planting their names in the record book over the past four seasons. This season, there are eight quarterbacks on the roster vying for the starting spot and nine running backs.

In his seventh season at the helm of Western State Colorado University, Jas Bains looks to lead the Mountaineers to victory in 2017.

2016 was a breakout year for the Mountaineers. Western recorded seven wins, the most wins for the program since 1998, and finished the season fourth in the conference standings, just one win behind three teams tied for first place. Bains' defense ranked top-10 in Division II for scoring defense and red zone defense. Offensively, Bains helped coach the first Harlon Hill Trophy finalist in Western history in running back Austin Ekeler. Ekeler signed a free-agent contract with the Los Angeles Chargers of the NFL.

Bains' first few seasons at Western have been known for his overpowering defense. However, in 2015, the Mountaineer offense was a juggernaut finishing in the top 15 of all Division II teams in total offense. Western's four wins in conference were the most RMAC victories in 12 seasons.

In 2012, the Mountaineer defense led the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) in rush defense and ranked 16th in all of NCAA Division II, allowing only 1,139 yards. The Mountaineer defense followed that with another impressive defensive showing in 2013, again leading the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) in rush defense allowing 1,358 yards on the ground.

In 2014, Bains led the Mountaineers to their highest win total since 2003 and the first Colorado Classic win over Adams State University in 12 seasons. Bains' squad also produced 44 academic awards including the RMAC Academic Player of the Year, a CoSIDA Capital One Academic All-America selection for the first time since 1988, and the Brechler Award for the RMAC team with the highest GPA.

After a season as defensive and special teams coordinator for the Mountaineer football program in 2010, Bains began his first season as Head Coach during the 2011 season.

While Head Coach, Bains has spearheaded community engagement projects with the Gunnison County Partners Organization, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Gunnison County youth. The Mountaineers also hosted a free kids clinic in the spring of 2011 and will established Mountaineer Buddies, a mentoring program with the Gunnison Community Schools.

Bains coached the top kick-blocking team in the RMAC in 2010 and one of the top kick-blocking teams in Division II. His defense was also ranked among the top half of the conference in interception return average and opponent fourth-down conversion.

Bains spent five seasons as a member of the coaching staff at Chadron State, with the final three as special teams coordinator and defensive secondary coach. He was part of a defensive staff that led the RMAC in total defense, passing defense and opponent first downs. He coached a punter and kicker to All-America honors as the special teams coordinator and tallied 30 blocked kicks in his five seasons. His punt and kickoff returners were consistently ranked among the top five in the nation.

Bains graduated from Fresno State in 2004 where he helped lead the Bulldogs to three bowl victories as a defensive back and special teams player against Georgia Tech, UCLA and Virginia. He transferred to Fresno State from Willamette University, where he started at safety as a true freshman.

A native of Fresno, Calif., Bains was the Clovis High School Athlete of the Year in 1999-2000. He was a two-time all-conference safety, a member of state tournament wrestling teams and was a member of the baseball team.

Bains is often a featured speaker at conventions, workshops and clinics on the role of defense and special teams. He is also a talented and respected recruiter in the state of California, as evidenced by the significant increase of West Coast athletes on the Chadron State rosters.

Bains was a member of the Chadron State staff as a graduate assistant before becoming a member of the full-time staff in early 2007. He earned his master's degree from Chadron State in December 2006.
