WAYNE STATE WOMEN FACE TOP TWO TEAMS IN NSIC NORTH THIS WEEKEND WITH VISITS TO MSU MOORHEAD, NORTHERN STATE

February 4, 2016

THE MATCHUP: Wayne State College concludes a four-game NSIC road trip this weekend with games at #25 Sioux Falls and Southwest Minnesota State with the 'Cats battling the Cougars Friday night at 6 p.m. followed by a 5 p.m. Saturday contest in Marshall against the Mustangs.

The Wildcats, 14-9 overall and fourth place in the NSIC South with an 11-7 league record, beat Sioux Falls in the first meeting this season in Wayne (January 3) 83-73. USF is ranked #25 in this week's USA Today Sports/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll and has a record of 20-4 and 14-4 in league play. SMSU starts play this weekend with records of 5-19 and 3-15 in the NSIC. WSC beat the Mustangs 88-59 in Wayne on January 2nd in the first meeting this season between the two clubs.

Wayne State College women's basketball can be heard on the Wildcat Sports Network and flagship radio stations KTCH FM 104.0/KCTY 1590 AM-98.9 FM in Wayne. Fans outside the KTCH listening areas can listen to the broadcast by logging onto the internet broadcast link at www.waynedailynews.com. WILDCATS FALL AT MSU MOORHEAD, WIN AT NORTHERN STATE: Wayne State faced the top two teams in the NSIC North last weekend on the road and came away with a split, falling 67-59 at MSU Moorhead while winning 66-51 at Northern State.

The Wildcats trailed most of last Friday's game at MSU Moorhead, then rallied to take a 59-58 lead with 2:10 to play before the Dragons held WSC scoreless down the stretch for a 67-59 win. Junior forward Anna Martensen led Wayne State in scoring with a career-high 18 points followed by senior guard Sadie Murren with 13. WSC leading scorer Paige Ballinger suffered a broken ankle in the contest in the third quarter and will miss the remainder of the season.

WSC shot 36.2 percent from the field (21 of 58), but had 20 turnovers and were out-rebounded 47-39.

The following night Wayne State held Northern State without a basket for the final 3:42 as the Wildcats pulled away for a 66-51 victory over the Wolves. Sophomore forward Maggie Schulte scored 22 of her career-high 28 points in the second half to lead the Wildcats while Murren also reached double figures with 12. WSC shot 41.7 percent from the field (20 of 48), but won the game at the free throw line going 21 of 24 (87.5%) compared to just 3 of 6 at the stripe for Northern State.

ABOUT WAYNE STATE: The Wildcats are 14-9 on the season and 11-7 in the NSIC South heading into the final conference road trip of the season this weekend. WSC is 11-1 at home and 3-8 in road games this year.

Wayne State ranks sixth in the NSIC in scoring (71.3) and fifth in scoring defense (63.4). The Wildcats shoot 42.5 percent from the field (4th-NSIC), 33.2 percent behind the 3-point line (6th-NSIC) and 71.9 percent at the free throw stripe (9th-NSIC). WSC is tied for ninth in the league in 3-point field goals per game (6.0) and ranks seventh in rebounding margin at +2.3 per game.

Sophomore center Paige Ballinger leads WSC in scoring (15.0) and is tied for second in rebounding (6.3), but suffered a broken ankle last Friday at MSU Moorhead and is out for the remainder of the season.

Sophomore forward Maggie Schulte produces 14.4 points and 6.3 rebounds a game, ranking 10th in the league in scoring. She is third in the NSIC in free throw percentage (.908) making 59 of 65 at the charity stripe and ranks seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.394) making a team-high 37 treys.

Senior guard Sadie Murren accounts for 9.0 points a game and leads the NSIC in assists per game (5.1). She is second in the league in steals per game (2.3) and seventh in assist/turnover ratio at 1.9. Junior forward Anna Martensen averages 7.6 points and leads the team in rebounding at 6.6 per game. She also has a team-high four double-doubles on the year.

Junior guard Haley Moore scores 7.1 points a game and is shooting 35 percent from 3-point range.

DID YOU KNOW??:

***Wayne State is 97-8 at home over the last seven seasons at Rice Auditorium.

***Home teams posted an 9-7 record last weekend in NSIC play, bringing the season record to 87-57 (.604). Sioux Falls and Winona State each registered home sweeps last weekend.

***St. Cloud State, Sioux Falls, Winona State and Wayne State each sport 8-1 records at home in NSIC play this season. Winona State also has the top road record in the league at 8-1 followed by MSU Moorhead, Northern State and Sioux Falls each at 6-3 in road league games.

HEAD COACH CHRIS KIELSMEIER: Chris Kielsmeier is in his eighth season as head women's basketball coach at Wayne State College. Kielsmeier has guided the team to a 186-55 record, including a 130-38 mark in the Northern Sun Conference, along with four NSIC regular season titles, two NSIC Sanford Health Tournament titles and five trips to the NCAA Division II National Tournament. In his 16th season as a head coach, Kielsmeier owns a career record of 365-99 and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. His .789 win percentage to start this season ranked second among Division II active head coaches.



Kielsmeier coached the Wildcats to a 28-6 record in the 2014-15 season, including an 18-4 mark in the NSIC that resulted in another regular season league championship for the Wildcats. It was the second straight and fourth NSIC regular season title in the last five seasons for Wayne State. The 28 wins tied for the second most in school history for a single season and the program notched a 10th consecutive winning season, which is a school record.

WSC also advanced to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the fifth time in the last six seasons under Kielsmeier as the Wildcats outscored Harding (Ark.) 87-80 in the first round before falling to Fort Hays State 70-54 in the semi-finals of the NCAA Central Regional in Hays, Kansas. Wayne State finished the season ranked 18th in the final USA Today Sports/WBCA Top 25 Coaches Poll.

Under Kielsmeier in 2013-14, the Wildcats captured the Northern Sun Conference regular season title (19-3) while recording a 28-5 overall record. WSC advanced to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, topping Pittsburg State of Kansas 83-77 before falling to Emporia State 76-69 in the Central Regional semi-finals. Kielsmeier achieved his 300th career win on November 25, 2013 with a 70-65 win over Augustana. WSC ended the 2013-14 season ranked 16th in the final USA Today/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll.

In 2012-13, Wayne State finished with a 17-10 record while tying for fourth in the NSIC South Division at 13-9 in league play. It was the ninth straight winning season for Wildcat women's basketball, the longest streak in school history. The Wildcats extended a school record home court win streak to 52 games (a span covering over 3 1/2 seasons) until a January 4th home loss to Concordia-St. Paul snapped the amazing home court win streak.

The Wildcats recorded the team's most successful season in school history under Kielsmeier in 2011-12, recording a 32-3 overall record while winning a second straight Northern Sun Conference regular season title with a 20-2 league mark. WSC was unbeaten at home for a third straight season, going 19-0 at Rice Auditorium to extend the team's school record win streak to 46 straight games without a loss at home. The Wildcats also vaulted to a number one national ranking for the first time in school history.

Kielsmeier coached the Wildcats to a 26-4 overall record in the 2010-11 season and finished first in the NSIC with a 21-1 conference record. The 21 wins in NSIC play were the most-ever by a Northern Sun Conference women's basketball team. It was the second NSIC regular season title in program history while the Wildcats advanced to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the fourth time in the last six seasons. WSC finished the season ranked 14th in the final USA Today/ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, the highest-ever ranking to end the season.

In 2009-10, Kielsmeier led Wayne State to a 26-5 overall record, finishing tied for second in the NSIC with a 16-4 league mark that led to him receiving the 2010 NSIC Coach of the Year Award. The Wildcats captured the 2010 NSIC Sanford Health Women's Basketball Tournament Title, clinching a berth in the NCAA Division II National Tournament. WSC also posted a perfect 15-0 record at home in Rice Auditorium under Kielsmeier, marking just the second time in school history that a Wildcat women's basketball team went unbeaten at home.

In Kielsmeier's first season at Wayne State in 2008-09, the Wildcats posted a 15-13 overall record, going 12-8 in the Northern Sun Conference.

Kielsmeier was hired as the 10th coach in the program's history on May 8, 2008. He comes to Wayne State College after serving eight years as head coach at Howard Payne University in Brownwood, Texas, an NCAA Division III school. He compiled an impressive 179-44 record as head coach and led the Lady Jackets to a 33-0 record and the NCAA Division III National championship in 2007-08. Kielsmeier was named the WBCA South Region and National Coach of the Year in 2007-08 and was selected the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches Small College Coach of the Year. He was the winningest women's basketball coach in Howard Payne University history, coaching the school to four straight appearances (2005-08) in the NCAA Division III National Tournament.

Kielsmeier is a native of Iowa, graduating from Hubbard-Radcliffe High School, and he is a 1999 graduate of Iowa State University. He served as the intern for the women's basketball program at Iowa State under head coach Bill Fennelly and then became the assistant women's basketball coach at Howard Payne University in the 1999-2000 season before taking over as the head coach in 2000.

SCOUTING SIOUX FALLS: The Cougars are 20-4 overall and second place in the NSIC South at 14-4 heading into Friday's contest against WSC. USF is ranked #25 in this week's USA Today Sports/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll, the first-ever national ranking for the Cougars in NCAA Division II. Sioux Falls is 12-1 at home and 8-3 in road games this year.

Sioux Falls averages 75.1 points per game (2nd-NSIC) and allows 60.8 (3rd-NSIC). The Cougars rank third in the NSIC in field goal percentage (.426), fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.351) and 10th in free throw percentage (.715). USF is third in the league in 3-point field goals per game (8.5) and second in rebounding margin (+6.0).

Senior guard Taylor Varsho leads USF in scoring at 18.6 points a game, ranking second in the NSIC. She tops the NSIC in 3-point field goals per game (3.5) and ranks fourth in assist/turnover ratio (2.1) and eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (.392).

Junior forward Sam Knecht accounts for 10.5 points and 6.8 rebounds a game with Alison Klostergaard at 9.9 points and 7.1 rebounds per contest.

WAYNE STATE VS. SIOUX FALLS SERIES HISTORY: The Wildcats are 10-2 all-time against Sioux Falls and 6-2 vs. the Cougars since USF joined the NSIC. WSC won earlier this season against Sioux Falls, 83-73 in Wayne, after the Wildcats trailed 36-18 in the second quarter. Last season, WSC won both meetings against the Cougars - 76-74 in overtime in Wayne and 73-51 at Sioux Falls. USF beat WSC 75-69 in OT in the 2014 NSIC Tournament at the Pentagon and beat the Wildcats 81-63 in Sioux Falls in the 2012-13 season.

ABOUT SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA STATE: The Mustangs are 5-19 overall and 3-15 in the NSIC South heading into play this weekend. SMSU is 3-10 at home, 2-8 in road games and 0-1 on a neutral floor this season. Southwest Minnesota State has won two of its last three games, posting an 87-75 road win at Minnesota Duluth January 30th followed by a 73-52 home win over Bemidji State last Friday in Marshall.

Southwest Minnesota State scores 61.8 points a game (14th-NSIC) while giving up 75.2 (15th-NSIC). The Mustangs rank 13th in field goal percentage (.380), 16th in 3-point field goal percentage (.279) and 14th in free throw percentage (.698). SMSU ranks 15th in the league in rebounding margin (-2.5) and is 15th in 3-point field goals per game (4.4).

Senior forward Hope Bonlander leads SMSU in scoring at 14.4 points a game (11th-NSIC) while ranking second in rebounding at 6.3 boards a game. Sophomore forward Lauren Hedlund adds 12.1 points a game and leads the Mustangs in rebounding at 6.8 boards a contest.

Senior guard Annessa Rosch also averages double figures at 11.2 points a game and leads the Mustangs in assists with 70 (2.9 per game).

WAYNE STATE VS. SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA STATE SERIES HISTORY: The Wildcats have won 13 consecutive meetings against the Mustangs in women's basketball and lead the all-time series against SMSU 31-18. Earlier this season, WSC beat the Mustangs in Wayne (January 2nd) 88-59). Last season, WSC posted wins of 75-61 in Marshall and 100-52 in Wayne.

The last win for SMSU over Wayne State happened in Wayne during the 2008-09 season by the score of 67-62. Wayne State has won 11 straight times in Marshall against the Mustangs. The last time Southwest Minnesota State beat WSC in Marshall was in the 2004-05 season 67-58.
