POSTGAME NOTES

- Junior Josh Hawkinson had his second double-double in as many games this season and his 22nd career double-double...it's his fourth-straight double-double going back to the 2014-15 season.
- Hawkinson is tied for sixth in WSU's career record books for double-doubles.
- Hawkinson finished with 19 points and added 14 rebounds, his most rebounds since grabbing 14 at UCLA, March 1, 2015.
- Hawkinson had 11 of his rebounds on the defensive end and maintained his 11.0 defensive rebounds per game average, which currently leads the nation in the young season.
- Junior Valentine Izundu had a career-high 6 blocked shots...he had 4 in the first game and is averaging 5.0 blocks per game.
- Izundu added 10 points on 4-for-4 shooting from the field, as well as 7 rebounds and an assist.
- Junior Ike Iroegbu had a career high with 21 points...he had career highs with 10 free throws made and 12 attempted and had a game-high 7 assists.
- For the second-straight game, newcomer, junior Renard Suggs reached double-figures, putting up 10 points while grabbing 6 rebounds.
- Freshman Viont'e Daniels and junior Charles Callison got their first WSU career starts.
- The Cougars outrebounded the Bengals, 49-35.
- WSU improves to 8-1 all-time against Idaho State.
- WSU remains home to host Cal State Los Angeles, Tuesday, Nov. 24 at 8 p.m. at Beasley Coliseum.
