MULTI-TOOL PLAYER

Brittney Martin may be the most well-rounded player in the Big 12 and she has the numbers to prove it.

- A year ago, she ranked in the top 10 among league players in scoring (8th), rebounding (2nd), double-doubles (7th), steals (2nd), offensive rebounds (7th) and defensive rebounds (2nd).
- Additionally, she ranked 11th in blocked shots and 14th in field-goal percentage.
- Martin was the league leader in steals as both a freshman and sophomore and was the league's second-leading rebounder as a sophomore.

NATIONALLY SPEAKING

Brittney Martin enters her senior campaign ranked nationally among the active career leaders in several categories.

- Martin's 2.61 steals per game are the fifth-best average and her 256 steals are the fourth-best total among returning players.
- Additionally, she ranks 53rd with her 1,154 points through her first three years.

MARCH MADNESS

The Cowgirls are in the midst of a program-record nine consecutive postseason appearances.

- That string is comprised of six NCAA Tournament berths (2007, 2008, 2010, 2013, 2014, 2015) and three WNIT appearances (2009, 2011, 2012).
- In 2012, the Cowgirls won their first WNIT title. This season marks three consecutive NCAA trips for the first time for OSU since a four-year run from 1993-96.
- If OSU can secure an NCAA berth this season, it would mark just the second time in program history the Cowgirls have made four NCAA appearances in a row.
- OSU made the NCAA field four consecutive years from 1993-1996.

TOUGH SLEDDING

By the time conference play rolls around, the Cowgirls will be battled tested with a formidable non-conference schedule. Eight of the squads on OSU's non-conference slate made the postseason a year ago with three earning NCAA berths (North Carolina, South Florida, Savannah State), three playing in the WNIT (Texas Southern, Missouri State, Washington State) and two making the WBI (Oral Roberts, Texas-Rio Grande Valley).

MIGHTY MITE

If her performance down the stretch last season is any indication, Roddricka Patton could fill the role of standout point guard that has become the norm for the OSU program since the arrival of Andrea Riley in 2005.

- Patton saw her first significant action in OSU's road win at Kansas, logging six assists.
- She made the first of 10 consecutive starts in OSU's next contest, a victory against Texas, finishing with 10 assists.
- She played 40 minutes and dished out 14 assists in a win at West Virginia.
- She finished with seven steals and six assists in OSU's Big 12 Championship win against Iowa State
- After scoring 34 points in the squad's first 31 games, Patton scored 23 against FGCU in the first round of the NCAA Championship. She hit five 3-pointers in the contest after entering the game 0-16 on the year.

ACROSS THE POND

Liz Donohoe, a member of OSU's senior class a year ago, has continued her career overseas. Donohoe is currently playing for Jamtland in Sweden.

- She joins Tiffany Bias in the professional ranks. Bias just completed her second season as a member of the WNBA's Phoenix Mercury.
- Brisa Silva and Toni Young are also active with Silva most recently appearing on the roster of Libertad in Paraguay, while Young competed for the Good Angels in Slovakia.
- Tegan Cunningham currently appears on the Dandenong Rangers roster in her native Australia.

FRESH FACES

The OSU staff added a pair of new coaches during the offseason with the addition of Ashley Davis and Rebecca Kates-Taylor. Davis joins the Cowgirl staff after working at North Texas the past two seasons, while Kates-Taylor's last coaching stop came at Mississippi during the 2012-13 campaign.

I WAS BORN IN A SMALL TOWN

Of the 12 players on the OSU roster, only one, Mandy Coleman, hails from a town with a population exceeding 100,000. Coleman's hometown of Stockton, Calif., boasts a population of 300,899. Four Cowgirls; Jentry Holt, Kaylee Jensen, Rylie Swanson and Sydney Walton all come from towns with populations under 10,000.

COWGIRLS PICKED EIGHTH

OSU was picked eighth in the Big 12 Women's Basketball Preseason Poll in a vote of the league's head coaches.

- Baylor received eight first-place votes and 80 total points to lead the way. Texas received one first-place vote and had 70 points, while Oklahoma received a first-place vote and 69 points.
- The Cowgirls received 27 points and came in behind Kansas State (36 points) and ahead of Texas Tech (18 points).

THE CENTURY MARK

Entering his fifth season as OSU's head coach, Jim Littell is 12 wins shy of No. 100 at the school. If and when he reaches the mark, Littell would become the third Cowgirl head coach to do so, joining Dick Halterman (333 wins) and Kurt Budke (112 wins).

GROW UP FAST

Despite having eight returners among the 12 players on its roster, OSU will enter the 2015-16 team as an inexperienced squad.

- OSU returners combined for 45 starts a year ago with Brittney Martin accounting for 31 of those.
- Kaylee Jensen made one start, Rodricka Patton had 10 and Katelyn Loecker was in the starting five on three occasions.
- Those four players have combined for 113 career starts with Martin being responsible for 98 of them.

COWGIRLS SIGN FOUR

OSU signed four during the fall signing period.

- Alexis Bryant · 6-3 · F · Cibolo, Texas (Steele)**
 · Bryant earned a first-team TGCA All-State pick after averaging 17 points and 12 rebounds during her junior season at Steele High School.
- Areanna Combs · 5-10 · G · Oklahoma City, Okla. (Putnam City West)**
 · She received honorable mention all-state honors from The Oklahoman as a junior after averaging 17.5 points per game.
- Rodrea Echols · 5-10 · G · Memphis, Tenn. (Overton)**
 · Echols checks in at No. 83 on the ESPN Hoop-Gurlz Top 100 rankings.
 · Echols averaged 13.6 points, 10 assists and seven rebounds per contest during her junior campaign.
- Jaden Hobbs · 5-8 · G · Alva, Okla. (Alva)**
 · Hobbs averaged 18.7 points and 6.9 assists per game as a junior.
 · In nine state tournament games, Hobbs has scored 241 points, which ranks second all-time in state history.

HEAD COACH JIM LITTELL

• OSU tallied its school-record fourth 20-win season in a row and secured its third consecutive NCAA berth in 2015-16.

• Brittney Martin earned All-America status and was a unanimous All-Big 12 selection.

• The 2013-14 season produced a 25-win campaign as well as the program's third NCAA Sweet 16 appearance. OSU reeled off a school-record 12 consecutive wins to start the year.

• Coached Tiffany Bias to honorable mention All-America status. Bias went on to be drafted by the WNBA's Phoenix Mercury

• In 2012-13, Littell guided OSU to its first NCAA Tournament berth since 2010. The Cowgirls got out of the gate quickly, starting the year with 11 consecutive victories to log what was the best start in school history at the time.

• Coupled with its six wins to close out 2012, Littell's squad held the nation's longest winning streak for six weeks.

• Littell coached Tiffany Bias and Toni Young to honorable mention All-America status, while Brittney Martin was named a freshman All-American.

• Young capped her career as a first-round draft pick by the WNBA's New York Liberty, while Martin finished her freshman campaign with an invite to USA Basketball's U19 Team Trials.

• In 2011-12, he directed the Cowgirls to the 11th 20-win season in program history and saw his squad extend its school-record string of postseason appearances to six in a row and capped the season with the school's first-ever WNIT title.

• Littell served as OSU's associate head coach from 2005-2011.

• OSU's WNIT semifinal victory over San Diego resulted in Littell's 20th victory as head coach, making him the first coach in program history to achieve the feat during their first season.

• As associate head coach, he was instrumental in the Cowgirls producing the nation's largest turnaround and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in more than a decade in 2007. He also helped OSU to NCAA berths in 2008 and 2010 as well as WNIT appearances in 2009 and 2011.

• Prior to his move to the Division I level, Littell constructed a hall of fame career during his 14-year tenure at Seward County (Kan.) Community College.

• A 2009 inductee into the National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame, Littell compiled an eye-popping set of numbers at his former post as the Lady Saints won 87 percent of their games, tallying a 418-61 ledger and producing nine Jayhawk West Conference titles.

• A nine-time conference coach of the year, Littell was named the WBCA National Coach of the Year in 2001.

• His 2002 squad produced three All-Americans, a perfect 38-0 mark and the school's first-ever national championship in any sport. He was named the NJCAA National Tournament Coach of the Year that same season.

• Under his watch, the Lady Saints recorded seven 30-win seasons. After finishing with a 14-16 record during his first season, Littell's squads never produced less than 25 wins in a season and averaged nearly 32 wins per year against less than four losses over the course of his final 13 seasons.

• From 1995-2004, the Lady Saints did not lose a home game, posting a 135-game winning streak inside the SCCC Activities Center to set the NJCAA national record. During the course of his final 13 seasons, Littell's squads won 99 percent of their home contests, producing an astounding record of 189-2.

• All told, his squad's produced 11 All-Americans and five Region VI Most Valuable Players. Nine times, one of Littell's players was tabbed as the Jayhawk West Conference Most Valuable Player, while four players from Seward County earned the league's freshman of the year honor under his direction.

• Littell spent the 1990-91 season at Garden Plains High School, posting a 21-3 mark.

• As head coach at Friends University from 1983-88, he produced a 95-39 record and a pair of conference championships. He also served as the assistant men's coach at Cameron (Okla.) University from 1988-89.

• Littell began his coaching career at Oxford High School in 1978 where he produced a 94-14 mark and a Kansas Class 2A state championship in 1981.
