RIVALRY CONTINUES TUESDAY IN PULLMAN

- After hosting eight of its first nine games, Gonzaga plays its first true road game of the season at Washington State.
- The Zags begin a stretch of five straight road contests over a 16-day span. GU's next home game is Dec. 31.
- Gonzaga will travel 7,725 miles during the upcoming five-game road stretch.
- The Bulldogs will be playing their third game over a six-day span against WSU.

GONZAGA STORYLINES

- The Bulldogs are fifth in the country with 51 total blocks. Their 5.7 blocks per game average tops the West Coast Conference and are 28th in the country.
- Shelby Cheslek needs six blocks to break Kayla Standish's program record of 176 in a career.
- The senior is 10th in the nation with 23 blocks already this season, and her 2.56 per game ranks 29th in the country.
- The Zags sit atop the Collegelnsiders.com Mid-Major Top-25 for the second consecutive week.
- Gonzaga is holding opponents to 54.8 points per game, which leads the West Coast Conference and is 39th in the nation.
- Under Head Coach Lisa Fortier, Gonzaga is 26-0 when it scores at least 70 points and 6-11 when it does not.
- The Bulldogs' 134 made free-throws ranks 13th in the nation, while their 187 attempts are 18th.

ABOUT THE COUGARS

- Washington State enters the game winners of seven of its first eight games of the season.
- The Cougars' lone loss of the season was a 70-60 road setback at Oklahoma State.
- WSU handed fellow West Coast Conference member, San Diego, its first loss of the season Sunday, 78-72.
- Washington State has been paced by its defense so far. It's forcing 20.25 turnovers per game, which is third in the Pac-12 and is 52nd in the nation. WSU is also 17th in the country with 92 steals already this season (11.5 spg).
- WSU is 11th in the nation holding opponents to 21.8 percent from behind-the-arc.
- The Cougars are also averaging 5.9 blocks per contest, which is 19th in the country.
- Individually, Dawnielle Awa (5-9, SR) is 28th in the nation averaging 3.13 steals per game, which tops the Pac-12.
- Borislava Hristova (6-0, FR) ranks 24th nationally with a team-high 20.6 points per game.

SERIES HISTORY

- Tuesday is the 25th all-time meeting between the programs separated by only 76 miles.
- The Zags have five of the last seven meetings after winning only two of the first 17 matchups.
- Gonzaga lost in its first nine trips to Pullman, but have won the last two meetings in the Beasley Coliseum.
- The last four meetings have all been decided by single digits and a total of 17 points.
- WSU won last season's game, despite leading for only two minutes and 50 seconds. Elle Tinkle scored 13 points for GU.

PREPPING FOR CONFERENCE ACTION

- The Bulldogs loaded up their non-conference schedule with tough competition to prepare for WCC play again.
- Gonzaga opened last season with four losses in its first 10 games.
- It then won 16 straight games, the fifth-longest win streak in program history.
- The Zags also won their 11th straight West Coast Conference regular season title with a 16-2 league record.
- GU ended its season with a run to the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament and was ranked No. 19 in the AP poll.

CHESLEK TABBED M-O-P

- Shelby Cheslek was named the Most Outstanding Player in the Zags' matchup with North Carolina.
- The senior scored a team-high 16 points and pulled down a game-high 11 rebounds.
- She finished the game in the Mohegan Sun Arena shooting 7-for-10 from the field with two assists.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- Shelby Cheslek recorded her 11th career double-double against North Carolina in Connecticut (16 pts, 11 rbs).
- The senior has two double-doubles this season after having four in 2014-15.
- Her first career double-double was an 11-point and 11-rebound performance at LMU on Feb. 9, 2013.
- Teammate Kiara Kudron also has two double-doubles this season.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Gonzaga currently leads the West Coast Conference with a 54.8 scoring defense (39th in the nation), and blocks per game at 5.7 (28th in the nation).
- The Bulldogs are first in the WCC in three-point field goal percentage defense at 25.9 (51st in the country), and third in steals per game with 9.3 (98th in the country).

IT'S A BLOCK PARTY

- Last season's GU team broke the program record with 184 blocks in a season.
- This season's team has 51 through the first nine games. They are on pace for 170 through the regular season, which would be second on the program's all-time single season list.
- This season's team made 11 blocks in the win over West Virginia, which is fourth on the program's all-time single game list, and were the most since the record was broken with 16 against Saint Mary's in 2010.
- Shelby Cheslek is on pace to contend with the single season program record of 77 set by Stephanie Hawk in 2006-07. Cheslek needs six blocks to break Kayla Standish's GU career record of 176.

CHASING MILESTONES

- Shelby Cheslek
 - Cheslek is second in program history with 171 blocks, five away from tying the record.
 - She is also sixth in GU history with 730 rebounds.

FREQUENT FLYER MILES

- After the 2,705-mile trip to New England, the Bulldogs travel to Dayton, Ohio, and Hamilton, N.Y., next week.
- Dayton is 2,055 miles away from Gonzaga, and Dayton to Colgate is then a 581-mile trip.
- The Zags will then make the 2,509-mile trip back to Spokane.
- Gonzaga's longest conference road trip is 1,301 miles to San Diego.

PACKING THE MAC

- Gonzaga is third in the nation in accumulative attendance with 44,123 fans in the first eight home games.
- The Zags' 5,515 average fans per game is 13th in the country.
- The Bulldogs are also second in the NCAA filling the 6,000-seat McCarthy Athletic Center to 91.92 percent.

ZAGS NEW RADIO HOME

- Fans will enjoy a broader listening radius for Gonzaga women's basketball games in 2015-16.
- The Zags will now have all of their games on Fox Sports 790 KJRB on the AM dial.
- Steve Myklebust returns as the voice of GU women's basketball this season.

THE LISA FORTIER SHOW

- The radio show returns for its second year live from Thai Bamboo on North Division in Spokane.
- Fans can listen live on Fox Sports 790 KJRB on the AM dial.
- Steve Myklebust will once again be the host of the show that welcomes GU coaches and players.

FORTIER INKS DUO ON SIGNING DAY

- Lisa Fortier announced the signing of Grace Collett and Jessie Loera for the 2016-17 season.
- Collett, a 6-4 post, has been on several training squads for Australia's junior national teams.
- Collett was selected as a Development Player for the WNBL's Melbourne Boomers.
- Loera was named the Columbia Basin Big Nine Player of the Year and co-Defensive Player of the Year following her junior season at Moses Lake High School in Moses Lake, Wash.
- Over her three-year career at Moses Lake, the 5-6 guard has amassed 872 points, an average of 12.3 per game.

ZAGS NAMED PRESEASON CONFERENCE FAVORITE

- For the third straight season, Gonzaga was picked as the West Coast Conference preseason favorite.
- The Zags, which have won the last 11 regular season WCC titles, received six of the nine possible first-place votes for 78 points in the poll. Coaches are not allowed to vote for their own team.
- BYU was picked second and received four first-place votes and 76 points.
- It marked the third time GU and the Cougars were the top two teams in the poll since BYU joined the conference four years ago.
- The two-point separation is also the second closest margin between first and second over the last 10 years.
- Saint Mary's (61), San Diego (58) and San Francisco (51) rounded out the top half of this year's preseason poll.
- The Zags have now been picked the WCC preseason favorite in eight of the last 11 years.

CHESLEK AND TINKLE TABBED ALL-WCC

- Shelby Cheslek and Elle Tinkle were both named to the preseason All-WCC team for the first time.
- Tinkle was named to the All-WCC First Team last season after averaging 14.9 points per game during conference play, which was ninth in the WCC. In conference action, the senior was second in the league shooting 50.6 percent from the field, and 43.8 percent from behind-the-arc, which was fourth in the WCC.
- Also in conference play, she was fifth in steals (2.1), seventh in blocks (1.0), ninth in three-pointers made per game (1.9), and 16th in rebounds (5.9).
- Cheslek averaged 1.6 blocks per game, which was third in the West Coast Conference.
- The senior was also fourth in the WCC averaging 8.2 rebounds per outing.
- She recorded four double-doubles in 2014-15, while grabbing at least eight rebounds in 14 games.

FOURTH LONGEST CONFERENCE TITLE STREAK

- Gonzaga captured its unprecedented 11th-straight WCC regular-season title.
 - In the 11-year reign, GU piled up an astonishing 152-13 record against WCC foes.
 - That includes three undefeated seasons in 2004-05, 2009-10, and 2010-11.

- Only Gonzaga and Green Bay have active streaks.

NOT A BAD DEBUT

- Lisa Fortier's first season was the best opening year for a head coach in program history.
- Bill Evans' 1983-84 Zag team went 21-9 and qualified for NAIA Districts.
- In 1985-86, Mike Peterson led GU to the NAIA Districts and a 21-10 record.
- Fortier was only the third head coach in the history of the program to post a winning record in their first season.

NOT A BAD DEBUT ... PART TWO

- Lisa Fortier was named the Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year.
- She was also selected the West Coast Conference co-Coach of the Year.
- Fortier became the first first-year coach to receive the award in conference history.

HOME SWEET HOME IN WCC PLAY

- GU has won 31 of the last 32 home games versus WCC opponents.
- Since 2010, the Bulldogs are 46-2 against conference opponents at home.
- At home against conference opponents, the Zags are 91-6 (.938) since 2003.
- The six losses were to Pepperdine ('03, '07), San Francisco ('04), Portland ('09), St. Mary's ('12), and Pacific ('15). Four of the six losses were by six points or less.

IN THE MCCARTHEY ATHLETIC CENTER

- Since the McCarthey Athletic Center opened in 2004, GU has gone 152-20 (.883).
- The Bulldogs went undefeated at 14-0 in the McCarthey Athletic Center during the 2004-05 campaign, the first season it was open; went 15-0 during the 2009-10 season and finished last season with a perfect 16-0 record.
- Seven of the 20 losses have been to Pacific-12 Conference members - Stanford (three times), USC (twice), Arizona State, and Washington State (twice) - and three to West Coast Conference schools.
- Against West Coast Conference opponents, the Zags are 85-5 (.944) in the MAC.
- Gonzaga averaged 5,366 fans per game last season at home, which was 13th in the nation. The Bulldogs averaged 89.4 percent filled to capacity, which was third in the country.

SPOKANE, Wash. -- The Gonzaga women's basketball team used a 10-3 run over the final three minutes and 45 seconds to pull away from Montana State, 65-52, in the Kennel Sunday.

The Zags (6-3) made a season-high eight three-pointers on their 16 attempts from behind-the-arc. They finished 37.5 percent from the field and 15-of-19 from the free-throw line.

Elle Tinkle led Gonzaga with 11 points on 5-of-9 shooting from the field. She added six rebounds and a pair of steals. Shelby Cheslek was a rebound shy of a double-double with 10 points and nine boards. Jill Barta also scored 10 points and pulled down six rebounds. Kiara Kudron contributed seven rebounds, while Georgia Stirton dished out four assists.

In a game that featured five ties and six lead changes, it was Gonzaga that closed the game convincingly. The Bulldogs made five of their last six shots from the field over the final 6:11.

Montana State led 12-9 after the first quarter and had its largest lead of the game, 14-9, just into the second quarter. GU then went on a 13-3 run over the next six minutes and did not trail again. The Zags took a 25-22 lead into the halftime break, and stretched the gap to 44-35 at the end of the third quarter. Gonzaga's largest lead was 65-51 with 32 seconds left in regulation.

The Bobcats (5-3) were led by Peyton Ferris' 14 points. Riley Nordgaard and Jasmine Hommes both added 11 points respectively. Nordgaard grabbed a team-high nine rebounds. Hannah Caudill and Lindsay Stockton had seven and five steals.

HEAD COACH LISA FORTIER

SECOND YEAR - CAL STATE-MONTEREY BAY, 2004

After spending much of the last decade as a member of the Gonzaga University women's basketball staff, including seven as an assistant, Lisa Fortier was named the program's head coach on April 14, 2014.

In her first season as a head coach in 2014-15, Fortier oversaw one of the nation's more efficient offenses. The Bulldogs outscored opponents by 10.0 points per game. As a team, the Zags broke seven team records, including a program-best 77.4 percent from the free-throw line this season, which was also fourth-best in the country. GU made 534 free-throws and 211 three-pointers this season, both new program records.

Fortier was the 2015 recipient of the WBCA Division I Rookie Coach of the Year Award. Fortier had the best first season any head coach in Gonzaga women's basketball history has ever had. Her 26 wins and 76.5 winning percentage were both top of the list among first year finishes for any GU women's basketball coach.

Fortier led Gonzaga to a 26-8 finish and its seventh-straight NCAA Tournament appearance. GU made its fourth appearance in the Sweet 16, after a pair of upsets in the first and second rounds as an 11-seed.

Fortier was named the West Coast Conference co-Coach of the Year after guiding the Zags to their 11th straight conference regular season title. During the season, Gonzaga won 16 straight games, the fifth-longest win streak in program history. GU enjoyed its seventh-straight 25-win season.

Fortier first came to Gonzaga in 2004, spending two years as the coordinator of basketball operations. She then spent one season as an assistant coach at the University of Northern Colorado before returning to GU in 2007.

In her seven years as a Gonzaga assistant, the Bulldogs have produced an overall record of 196-43. The Zags have dominated the West Coast Conference during that span, compiling a 98-8 mark to go with seven consecutive WCC regular-season championships and five WCC Tournament titles.

After a second-round appearance in the WNIT in Fortier's first season as an assistant, the Zags have qualified for the NCAA Tournament each of the last seven years, which included a stretch of three straight Sweet Sixteens from 2010-12. The highlight was an Elite Eight run in 2011, in which the Bulldogs upset three higher-seeded teams.

In addition to serving as Gonzaga's recruiting coordinator, Fortier has been responsible for coordinating GU's defense. She also spent time coaching Gonzaga's guards. She has mentored two WNBA draftees in Courtney Vandersloot and Katelan Redmon as well as Haiden Palmer, a 2014 draft hopeful. She also coached Taelor Karr, the 2012-13 WCC Player of the Year.

A native of Grass Valley, Calif., Fortier played collegiate basketball at Butte (Calif.) Community College before transferring to Cal State Monterey Bay. At CSUMB, she earned honorable mention All Cal-Pac Conference honors as a junior and was an NAIA Academic All-American in 2003. She also earned the 2004 CSUMB Female Scholar Athlete of the Year.
