SEASON NOTES

WSU DURING THE 2015-16 SEASON

Washington State finished ninth in the Pac-12 Conference with a 5-13 record and a 14-16 overall record. The Cougars found early-season success, jumping out to a 5-0 start. Led by freshman phenom Borislava Hristova, WSU clinched the 2015 Bank of Hawaii Rainbow Wahine Classic title. In her ninth season at the helm of the women's program, June Daugherty led a youthful team to the Cougars' best start since 1989-90. WSU completed its nonconference season with a 9-2 record before entering the country's toughest RPI conference. Washington State swept Colorado and Arizona and picked up a Pac-12 win over No. 25 USC.

HRISTOVA AND HAILEY EARN ALL-PAC-12 HONORS

Freshman Borislava Hristova and sophomore Caila Hailey received All-Pac-12 honors. Hristova was selected to the All-Pac-12 Team by media members and was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team. Sophomore Caila Hailey received an honorable mention to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team.

FOUR COUGS EARN PAC-12 ALL-ACADEMIC AWARDS

Senior Mariah Cooks headlined a quartet of Cougar players that earned Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention. Cooks earned the honor for the third-consecutive season, while sophomores Bianca Blararu, Louise Brown, and Pinelopi Pavlopoulou garnered honorable mention in their first year of eligibility.

WSU SENIORS LEAVE THEIR MARK

WSU's four seniors, Dawnyelle Awa, Mariah Cooks, Taylor Edmondson, and Alexas Williamson, finished their careers having played a combined 8,047 minutes in Cougar uniform. The four seniors have their names sprinkled throughout the WSU record book with seven spots among the program's all-time top-10 lists. The senior class led WSU to back-to-back postseason berths for the first time in school history and the best conference finish since 1997-98.

BLOCK PARTY

The Cougars broke the WSU single-season record with 120 total blocks during the 2015-16 season. WSU averaged 4.0 blocks per game led by redshirt-freshman Nike McClure and true freshman Maria Kostourkova. The freshman duo headlined the Cougar frontline with 25 and 23 blocks, respectively, fourth- and fifth-most in WSU freshman history.

AWA FINDS HER FLOW

Senior Dawnyelle Awa proved herself to be a competent leader on the Cougar hardwood over the past four seasons. With 127 games under her belt (t-third in school history) and 109 career starts (third in school history), the Hawaiian native found her name sprinkled throughout the WSU record book. Awa led the team in assists (89) and steals (53) this season and finished her collegiate career sixth in school history with 353 career assists.

BORISLAVA 'BOBI BUCKETS' HRISTOVA

True freshman and Pac-12 All-Freshman Team honoree Borislava Hristova turned heads in her first season with the Cougars. The Varna, Bulgaria native led the team with 16.3 points per game, second-best in the conference by a freshman and sixth-best overall. The three-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week selection set the WSU freshman scoring record with 490 total points. During her first season in Pullman, Hristova set the WSU freshman records in total points, field goals made (200), points per game (16.3), and free throw percentage (.881). She reached double-digit scoring figures 26 times this season and already holds the all-time record at WSU for best career free throw percentage at .881 (min. 50 made FTs). Nine times this season Hristova scored at least 20 points, breaking a freshman record that had stood for over 26 years.

TWO MINUTE DRILL

Thirteen times this season Washington State played a game that was within two possessions (six points) in the final two minutes. In six of those games the Cougars were leading, and in seven games they were trailing. WSU owns a 5-8 record in such games. The Cougars finished 4-2 when leading in the final 120 seconds and 1-6 when trailing down the stretch, having pulled off a last-second comeback at Arizona, Feb. 21. In addition, WSU was within two possessions of pulling off upsets of No. 16 Stanford and No. 9 Oregon State with less than four minutes remaining. The Cougars went 2-6 in games decided by five points or fewer.

RECORD BREAKERS

Senior Dawnyelle Awa finished her collegiate career in sixth place in school history with 353 career assists. Awa, along with senior Mariah Cooks, each played in 127 games during their time on the Palouse. The mark places the duo in a tie for third place in career games played at WSU. Awa made 109 career starts in a Cougar uniform, tied for third-most all-time at Washington State. Senior Taylor Edmondson made 77.6 percent (83-of-107) of her free throws during her WSU career. The mark is fifth-best in school history, after the New Mexico native began the season tied for seventh with a .769 clip.

COUGAR FRESHMEN CONTRIBUTE EARLY

Washington State welcomed one of its most talented recruiting classes in June Daugherty's tenure with the signing of its three 2015-16 freshmen. Borislava Hristova led the team with 16.3 points per game. The Varna, Bulgaria native dropped 30 points on San Jose State, becoming just the second freshman in WSU history to reach the 30-point plateau. Maria Kostourkova proved herself an inside threat, averaging 4.3 rebounds per game and 5.5 points per game. Kostourkova led the team with a career-high 17 points against Colorado, Jan. 4. Alexys Swedlund dropped four 3-pointers against California to aid the Cougars, finishing with a career-high 16 points, and finished the season averaging 4.7 points per game.

COUGARS' DEPTH SHINES

Nine Cougar players appeared in all 30 games during the season, and nine players averaged over 10 minutes per game. WSU's bench players outscored the opponent's bench 24 times this season and the Cougar reserves outscored opponent reserves by an average of 12.1 points per game.

DAUGHERTY REACHES 100 WSU WINS

Head coach June Daugherty earned her 100th-career win at Washington State with the Cougars' 74-66 victory at Colorado, Jan. 4. Daugherty has guided the WSU program to a 104-177 record over nine seasons in Pullman, becoming the third coach in Cougar history to reach 100 WSU wins. Sue Durant boasted a 134-99 record in nine seasons (1974-82) and Harold Rhodes guided the Cougars to 194 wins over 17 years at WSU (1983-99). Daugherty is no stranger to success, having reached 400-career wins last season, and currently owns a 417-391 record over her 27-year coaching career.

DAUGHERTY DOMINATES FOR DECADES

Head coach June Daugherty has proven to be successful across the Pac-12 Conference and beyond. When she earned her 100th win Jan. 4, she became the first coach in conference history to win 100+ games at multiple Pac-12 schools (Washington). Daugherty also became one of three active coaches at a Power-5 conference school to have guided three different Division-I programs to 100+ wins. Daugherty boasted a 191-139 record while at Washington and registered 122 wins in her time at Boise State.

THE "UNITED NATIONS OF BASKETBALL"

The 2015-16 Cougar basketball team was represented by student-athletes from seven different countries and five different states. Head coach June Daugherty regarded the team as the "United Nations of Basketball." The Cougars had five student-athletes from Europe compared to six for the rest of the Pac-12 Conference combined. Of the conference's six Australian student-athletes, two of them don WSU uniforms. The student-athletes on the WSU roster speak a combined 17 languages.

AWA PARTICIPATES IN WBCA PROGRAM

Senior guard Dawnyelle Awa was selected in March to participate in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want To Be A Coach Program" program. The highly-competitive program is a collaborative effort between the WBCA and the NCAA to provide female student-athletes with an experience that becomes the foundation of a successful coaching career. The program assists female collegiate basketball players who are interested in pursuing a career in coaching women's basketball with professional development and career advancement through education, skills enhancement, networking, and exposure opportunities, while increasing awareness regarding the availability of talented female basketball players who want to coach.

LATE PRESIDENT FLOYD HONORED

Washington State University's late president Elson S. Floyd, who passed away in June after complications from colon cancer, was honored this season by WSU student-athletes with a black 'ESF' patch on team uniforms. The Cougars' basketball uniforms donned the patch on the right side of the chest.

RACKING UP THE AIRLINE MILES

Washington State did its fair share of traveling during the nonconference season. The Cougars traveled a total of 15,728 miles during the 9-2 nonconference season, averaging 1,430 miles per game. WSU traveled to Honolulu, Hawaii for the Bank of Hawaii Rainbow Wahine Classic, Nov. 20-22, flying 5,860 miles. After returning home for Thanksgiving and a single home game, the team turned around and began a nine-day trip to Oklahoma State, Boise State and San Diego, accruing 4,722 miles. WSU continued its travels with a trip to Moraga, Calif., to face Saint Mary's, adding an additional 1,758 miles. The Cougars closed the nonconference season accruing 3,308 miles with a trip to Lawrence, Kan., and a victory over the Jayhawks.

STARTING OFF STRONG

After beginning the season 5-0 for the first time since 1998, the Cougars recorded their first loss of the season at Oklahoma State. WSU responded with three-straight victories, improving to 8-1 for the first time since 1989-90, before falling at Saint Mary's, Dec. 12. The honor for the best start in school history goes to the Cougars' 1978-79 squad that started the season 10-0 before falling to Oregon.

YOUNG WSU TEAM LED BY FOUR SENIORS

With nine underclassmen, WSU was young this season. The Cougars entered the season with eight student-athletes that had played less than 300 minutes in their careers, but were led by a senior class that played more than 8,000 minutes in Cougar uniform.

DAUGHERTY INKS FOUR FOR 2016-17

Chanelle Molina, Cameron Fernandez, Katie Campbell, and Kayla Washington have each signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball at Washington State University beginning next fall. Molina (Kailua Kona, Hawaii) is listed as a five-star recruit by ESPN.com, and is the third WSU recruit from Konawaena High School (Dawnynelle Awa and Lia Galdeira). Fernandez (Makawao, Hawaii) led Lahainaluna High School to a 20-2 last season and the state championship game, while averaging 17 points, six assists, four steals, and five rebounds per game. Campbell (Oxnard, Calif.) is a three-time captain at Oaks Christian High School, she is a 3-point threat for the Lions, and made 77 shots from beyond the arc during her junior season. Washington (San Bernardino, Calif.) is a four-year captain at Cajon High School, Washington has led the Cowgirls to three-straight Citrus Belt League Championships.

SIGNEES NOMINATED AS ALL-AMERICANS

Katie Campbell, Kayla Washington, and Chanelle Molina, incoming freshmen on the 2016-17 Washington State women's basketball team, were nominated as McDonald's All-Americans, the organization announced this month. The trio are a part of the Cougar class that is expected to be one of Coach Daugherty's most talented in her tenure at Washington State.

USC TAKES RUBBER GAME WITH COUGS

The Cougars and Trojans met in the opening round of the 2016 Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament in Seattle. The No. 9-seeded Cougars held a slim, 3-point halftime lead that No. 8 USC erased before securing victory in the final 90 seconds of the game after 19 lead changes and 13 ties. Borislava Hristova led the Cougars in scoring with a game-high 24 points and notched a career-high four assists and four steals.

UTES CRASH SENIOR DAY AT WSU

Washington State was unable to hold on to a halftime lead against Utah, falling on Senior Day, 75-69. The Cougars held a double-digit halftime lead, but the Utes outscored WSU by 13 in the third quarter to erase the deficit. In a game that featured seven ties and 14 lead changes, the Cougars were led by freshman Borislava Hristova with 14 points and sophomore Caila Hailey who matched her career-high with 11 points.

COUGS RUN BUFFS OFF PALOUSE

The Cougars cruised to an 83-70 victory over Colorado, holding a double-digit lead for all but the first two minutes of the second half. Five WSU players scored in double figures, led by freshman Borislava Hristova with 17 points. The Cougars shot .527 (29-of-55) from the floor and .556 (10-of-18) from beyond the arc, including six 3-pointers in the second quarter.

COOKS PROVIDES GAME-WINNER AT U OF A

Mariah Cooks buried a free throw with 3.4 seconds left at Arizona, Feb. 21, giving the Cougars a 62-61 victory over the Wildcats. Trailing by two with five seconds left in regulation, Cooks slid to her right and rebounded a missed free throw from teammate Nike McClure, slammed the ball once onto the hardwood, and laid in a left-handed hook shot with four Arizona players around her. As the game-tying field goal fell to the bottom of the net, a whistle sounded as Cooks was fouled by Wildcat player LaBrittney Jones. Cooks stepped to the line and sunk the game-winning free throw to give WSU its first victory since Jan. 15.

COUGAR OFFENSE STUMBLES AT NO. 9 ASU

The Cougars struggled to find an offensive rhythm against No. 9 Arizona State, falling in Tempe, 61-39. Freshman Alexys Swedlund led 11 WSU scorers with nine points. The Cougars forced the top-ranked Sun Devils into 20 turnovers, but failed to capitalize, scoring just eight points off the errors.

ANOTHER HEARTBREAKER FOR WSU

Washington State's Valentine's Day would prove a heartbreaker as the Cougars dropped another close loss, falling to USC, 64-62, at the Galen Center. WSU was led in scoring and rebounding by senior Dawnyelle Awa with 16 points and six rebounds. The Cougars also shot over .500 from the field for the second time this season, but were unable to put the Trojans away.

WSU CAN'T HOLD ON IN FOURTH VS. UCLA

The Cougars were unable to keep pace with No. 14/16 UCLA. After taking a two-point lead midway through the third quarter, the Bruins went on to outscore WSU 17-10 in the final quarter and secure a 73-61 victory. Three Cougars scored in double figures, led by freshman Borislava Hristova with 16 points.

UPSET FALLS SHORT AGAINST NO. 9 OSU

Washington State was unable to complete the upset of No. 9/8 Oregon State, falling to the Beavers, 54-45. With the Cougars leading by six at the end of the third quarter, top-ranked OSU outscored WSU 26-11 in the final 10 minutes to secure the victory. WSU freshman Borislava Hristova led all scorers with 22 points.

COUGAR OFFENSE STALLS AGAINST OREGON

Washington State suffered from cold shooting, while Oregon shot an impressive .595 from the floor, as the Cougars fell to the Ducks, 48-73. The Cougars went without a 3-pointer or a free throw in the opening 20 minutes and were unable to overcome a 14-39 halftime deficit. Freshman Borislava Hristova led the Cougars with 19 points.

WSU FALLS AT NO. 16 STANFORD

The Cougars were unable to keep their first-half momentum going at No. 16 Stanford, falling to the Cardinal, 52-69. After leading by two at halftime and holding SU to one field goal in the opening quarter, WSU went cold from the field in the fourth quarter. Stanford's Lili Thompson dropped a career-high 30 points to guide the Cardinal to victory. WSU senior Mariah Cooks led the Cougars with 15 points and seven rebounds.

BEARS BEAT COUGS IN FINAL MINUTE

For the third game in a row, the Cougars found themselves trailing early and fought to overcome the deficit. The Cougars dropped a 71-74 decision at California, Jan. 29, after the Bears made a late three to take a one-point lead and seal victory. WSU forced a season-high 27 turnovers and were led in scoring by Alexys Swedlund with 16 points, one of four double-digit scorers.

COUGS CAN'T KEEP PACE WITH HUSKIES

The Cougars rallied from a 13-point halftime deficit, to lead the Washington Huskies entering the fourth quarter, but were unable to hold on to defeat their rivals in Seattle, falling 69-63. WSU outscored UW 24-9 in the third quarter, but put itself in a deficit early in the game. Borislava Hristova led the Cougars with 13 points and Taylor Edmondson added 12 points for WSU.

WSU'S UCLA UPSET FALLS SHORT AT BUZZER

Washington State dropped a heartbreaker to then-No. 17 UCLA, falling at home, 73-75. The Cougars had a chance to send the game to overtime, but a last-second shot went halfway down before coming back out as the buzzer sounded. Borislava Hristova led WSU with 19 points, as the Cougars outscored UCLA 37-34 in the paint, 22-19 off of turnovers, 13-6 in fast break points, and 31-6 off the bench.

COUG CLINCH VICTORY OVER NO. 25 USC

The Cougars handed No. 25 USC a 73-61 defeat at Beasley Coliseum, Jan. 15. The victory was the first over a ranked opponent for WSU this season. Borislava Hristova scored 21 points to lead the Cougars. She was complemented by Louise Brown with her first-career double-double (10 points, 13 rebounds), Caila Hailey with nine points and a career-high seven rebounds, and 10 points and eight rebounds from Maria Kostourkova.

COUGS CAN'T KEEP PACE WITH ASU

Washington State was unable to keep pace with No. 14 Arizona State, falling to the Sun Devils, 45-63 at Beasley Coliseum. The Cougars entered the break tied with ASU, but a 25-9 quarter by the Devils led to WSU's downfall. Borislava Hristova led Washington State with 10 points, while Caila Hailey recorded a career-high six steals.

TEAM EFFORT LEADS COUGS TO WIN

The Cougars won their second-consecutive Pac-12 game, handing the Arizona Wildcats a 67-46 defeat in Pullman. WSU defeated a conference opponent by 21 points for the first time since 2011 behind senior Mariah Cooks (15 points, 9 rebounds) and freshman Borislava Hristova (14 points). All 14 Cougars appeared in the game, and 12 WSU players scored in the contest.

WSU PICKS UP FIRST PAC-12 WIN AT CU

The Cougars earned their first Pac-12 victory of the season, defeating Colorado 74-66 in Boulder, Jan. 4. WSU was led by freshman Maria Kostourkova with a career-high 17 points. Seniors Mariah Cooks and Taylor Edmondson complemented Kostourkova. Cooks recorded her first double-double of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds. Edmondson scored 12 points, including six points in the fourth quarter.

COUGARS UNABLE TO COMPLETE COMEBACK

Washington State erased a 13-point halftime deficit at the University of Utah to take a lead with 88 seconds to play in the game, but was unable to complete the comeback, falling to the Utes, 71-73. Senior Taylor Edmondson tied a career-high with 17 points, while freshman Borislava Hristova scored 23 points to lead all scorers. While the Cougars were unable to secure a victory, they forced Utah into 25 turnovers, including a season-high 16 steals.

WSU FALLS TO UW IN PAC-12 OPENER

The Cougars fell to Washington in the opening game of Pac-12 Conference play, 79-64 at Beasley Coliseum. Senior Mariah Cooks scored a career-high 20 points to lead Washington State, but the Cougars were unable to find an answer for the country's leading scorer in Husky junior Kelsey Plum, who finished with 33 points.

AWA AND COUGARS GROUND JAYHAWKS

The Cougars closed their nonconference season with a win at Kansas. WSU defeated the Jayhawks at historic Allen Fieldhouse, 66-52, Dec. 20, led by a career-high performance from senior Dawnyelle Awa. The Hawaiian native scored 19 points to lead all scorers. The Cougars shot 9-of-16 (.563) from beyond the arc, including a perfect 3-for-3 from Awa.

COUGS COMEBACK FALLS SHORT AT SMC

Washington State's come-from-behind victory at Saint Mary's, Sunday, fell short, as the Cougars lost to the Gaels, 75-71. After trailing by as many as 18 points in the opening half, WSU rallied in the third quarter, using a 23-5 run to erase the deficit. However, the Cougars were unable to hold off the Gaels in the final quarter, as SMC went 12-of-13 from the free throw line down the stretch to seal the victory and WSU's second loss of the season.

BROWN GUIDES COUGS TO VICTORY OVER GU

Sophomore Louise Brown scored a career-high 14 points to go along with 17 points from freshman Borislava Hristova, as the Cougars knocked off visiting Gonzaga, 55-48. In a highly defensive battle, the Cougars held the Bulldogs to 18-of-64 (.281) shooting and just one field goal in the second quarter. WSU improved to 8-1 for the first time since the 1989-90 season.

WSU CLOSES ROAD TRIP WITH VICTORY AT USD

Washington State concluded a nine-day road trip with a 78-72 win at San Diego. True freshman led Borislava Hristova led WSU with 21 points and five rebounds, and was assisted by sophomore Caila Hailey with a career-high 11 points. The Cougars shot an impressive .542 (32-of-59) from the floor and committed only 12 turnovers.

COUGS WRANGLE BRONCOS FOR ROAD WIN

The Cougars pulled out a road win at Boise State, behind a career-high 12 points from sophomore Pinelopi Pavlopoulou and 18 points from freshman Borislava Hristova. Sophomore Bianca Blanaru pulled in a career-high 10 rebounds, alongside 10 boards from senior Mariah Cooks. It was a defensive game in which WSU had a school-record 11 blocked shots, including four from redshirt-freshman Nike McClure.

WSU FALLS FOR FIRST TIME THIS SEASON

Freshman Borislava Hristova continued her high-scoring season with 22 points at Oklahoma State Monday night, but it was not enough to lead the Cougars to victory, as they fell in Stillwater, 70-60, for their first loss of the season. Redshirt-freshman Nike McClure played a career-high 10 minutes, while pulling in a career-best five rebounds along with senior Mariah Cooks to lead WSU on the glass.

WSU OFF TO BEST START SINCE 1998-99

WSU's three true freshmen poured on a combined 56 points as the Cougars defeated San Jose State, 95-80. Borislava Hristova led the way with a career-high 30 points, becoming just the second freshman in school history to score 30 points in one game. Alexys Swedlund added 16, making four shots from beyond the arc. Senior Mariah Cooks pulled in a season-best 12 rebounds, as WSU outrebounded the Spartans 63-39.

COUGARS DOWN HAWAII FOR TOURNAMENT TITLE

Senior Dawnyelle Awa scored a career-high 16 points in her return to Hawaii, leading WSU to a 62-52 win over Hawaii in the 2015 Bank of Hawaii Rainbow Wahine Classic. In addition to Awa, freshman Borislava Hristova (16 points) and senior Taylor Edmondson (10) scored in double digits to carry the Cougars to the tournament title. Hristova was named the tournament's MVP, averaging 19.5 points across two games, while Awa picked up all-tournament team honors.

WSU OPENS WAHINE CLASSIC WITH VICTORY

Freshman Borislava Hristova continued her hot start, leading all scorers with 23 points, as the Cougars defeated Nevada, 70-57, in the opening round of the Rainbow Wahine Classic. Washington State forced the Wolf Pack into 26 turnovers, including 18 in the first half, leading to 21 points for WSU. Senior Dawnyelle Awa scored a season-high nine points, while sophomores Caila Hailey and Bianca Blanaru set career bests in rebounds (4) and points (7).

COUGARS FEND OFF HAMPTON

The Cougars improved to 2-0 with a 68-61 win over visiting Hampton Monday, Nov. 16. Freshman Borislava Hristova led WSU with 20 points, becoming the first freshman to break the 20-point plateau since Lia Galdeira did so against Arizona in 2013. The Cougars shot 11-of-22 from beyond the arc, as Hristova, senior Taylor Edmondson, and freshman Alexys Swedlund each made three 3-pointers.

WSU OPENS SEASON WITH WIN OVER UCSB

Washington State opened the 2015-16 season with a 61-44 victory over UC Santa Barbara Nov. 13 at Beasley Coliseum. True freshman Borislava Hristova led all scorers with 15 points, the most by a true freshman in their debut since Lia Galdeira scored 33 in 2012. The Cougars used a stifling defense to hold the Gauchos to 11-of-43 (.256) from the floor, while forcing UCSB into 23 turnovers, including 15 steals.

HEAD COACH JUNE DAUGHERTY

Cougar Head Coach June Daugherty finished her ninth season at the helm of the Washington State women's basketball program. Daugherty guided the Cougars to back-to-back postseason berths for the first time in school history after reaching the opening round of the WNIT in 2014 and 2015. The Cougars are 104-177 in Daugherty's time in Pullman.

HEAD COACH JUNE DAUGHERTY



Washington State University Head Coach June Daugherty begins her ninth season with the Cougars and has led the charge toward a new era in WSU women's basketball. Just as she had done at each of her two previous stops, Daugherty, who has coached more than 700 career games, has begun turning around the WSU women's program, leading the Cougars to two consecutive WNIT appearances in 2014 and 2015, bringing in top-ranked recruiting classes, improving attendance numbers and overseeing student-athletes who place premiums on academics and community service.

This past season, Daugherty hit a personal milestone, earning her 400th career win as the Cougars defeated Utah Feb. 15. Daugherty continued to build on the success of the previous season, as WSU earned a second-consecutive postseason berth for the first time in school history. The WSU women's basketball program earned national recognition,

recording one of the biggest wins in program history with a 70-64 victory over No. 10/8 Maryland, an eventual No. 1 seed and Final Four participant, in Puerto Rico, November 29.

Under Daugherty, Washington State has reached the Pac-12 Conference Tournament semifinals in two of the last four seasons, 23 student-athletes earned all-academic honors in the last seven years, and five players signed professional contracts to play overseas in the last four summers.

Off the court, the Cougars continued to shine in the classroom as the Cougars earned national recognition as part of the NCAA's Public Recognition Awards for the 2013-14 academic year. WSU earned the honor for the second-straight season with a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score among the top 10 percent of all squads in the country. WSU posted a perfect four-year average score of 1,000, and was one of 43 women's basketball teams honored for its accomplishments. WSU, along with Stanford, were the only two Pac-12 Conference schools recognized.

During the 2013-14 season, Daugherty led the Cougars to one of the best campaigns in program history, earning a trip to the WNIT, the program's first postseason appearance since 1991, and posted 17 wins, the most since 1995-96. WSU also notched four wins over ranked teams, including one on the road against No. 10 Nebraska and went on to post nine conference wins for the first time since 1994-95. Guards Lia Galdeira and Tia Presley both earned spots on the All-Pac-12 Team, becoming the first pair of Cougar teammates to earn all-conference honors in the same season in program history. The Cougars received some national recognition late in the year, receiving votes in the Top-25 USA Today Coaches' Poll following their Pac-12 Tournament run, becoming the first WSU team to be mentioned in a poll since the 1990-91 season.

In 2012-13, Daugherty led a team that featured six freshmen and three sophomores to the Pac-12 Conference Tournament quarterfinals for the second straight season, beating Arizona State in the opening round before falling to top-seeded Stanford. The Cougars improved three spots in the conference standings from a season ago, finishing eighth. WSU produced some notable wins while playing one of the toughest schedules in the country, beating No. 20 Ohio State, posting a road victory over regional rival Gonzaga and sweeping the season series with Arizona State. The Cougars finished the year with a program record for blocks in a season with 114.

Also under Daugherty's guidance in 2012-13, the Cougars backcourt received recognition from the conference as Lia Galdeira, the second-leading freshman scorer in the country and three-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week winner, earned a number of All-Pac-12 accolades as a freshman after pacing the Cougars in scoring, rebounding, steals and minutes. Sophomore point guard Tia Presley also earned all-conference honors despite being limited to seven conference games due to injury. Daugherty also saw center Carly Noyes cap off her impressive career by becoming the school's all-time leader in blocked shots, games played and career starts.

The 2011-12 campaign saw Daugherty lead the Cougars to one of the most successful seasons in program history while playing one of the toughest schedules in the country (No. 27). WSU posted the most wins since 1995-96, recording 13 overall victories and the second double-digit win season under Daugherty while improving their final RPI by 50 spots from the season prior. The Cougars saved its best for last, beating UCLA the final weekend of the regular season before posting the program's inaugural wins at the conference tournament. WSU knocked off Oregon State and USC in the first two rounds to advance to the nationally-televised semifinal against California held at the Staples Center in Los Angeles. Additionally, Daugherty led the Cougs to the program's inaugural win over a Big Ten Conference opponent (Wisconsin) and the first win over a Big East Conference opponent (Marquette) in over 20 years. Daugherty's team followed nonconference play by winning its first three games of Pac-12 play for the first time since 1977-78. The 2011-12 Cougars made their mark on the record book as well, posting the most rebounds, the sixth-most points, fourth-most threes, fifth-most assists and second-most assists in WSU single-season history.

2011-12 also saw Daugherty's first WSU recruiting class cap their impressive careers as a pair of 1,000-point scorers exited along with a three-time academic all-conference selection in addition to the three players who received invites to the WNBA combine. Headlining the group was guard Jazmine Perkins who finished her career as a three-time all-conference selection and WSU's all-time leader in games played and the first player in school-history, male or female, with 1,200+ points, 700+ rebounds and 250+ steals.

2010-11 saw the Cougars take another step forward under Daugherty's guidance while playing the No. 27 toughest schedule in the country. WSU posted the most conference wins, the highest scoring average and highest shooting percentage since 2000-01. The Cougars posted their highest finish since the 1997-98, tying for seventh after posting season sweeps over California and Oregon State and beating Oregon and Oregon State on the same weekend to record their first weekend sweep in conference play since 2001.

WSU finished the year with a school-record 208 made three-point field goals and the second-most assists in program single-season history. The past two Cougar teams have produced two of the top block totals in program history, recording 98 in 2009-10 and 100 last year, the second-best mark in the Cougar single-season record book.

In 2009-10, the Cougars started to make their move. Despite having the sixth-youngest team in the country, WSU started earning wins and accolades that hadn't been seen in Pullman for years. The Cougars defeated Arizona State in Tempe, Ariz., in front of a national television audience, their first road win over the Sun Devils in more than 13 years. WSU also defeated USC at Galen Center, the team's first road win over the Trojans in more than 11 years.

Individually, following a 33-point scoring barrage against ASU, guard April Cook garnered WSU's first Pac-10 Player of the Week honor in four years, and just the second by a Cougar in the last 13 years. Then-freshman Carly Noyes broke WSU's single-season blocks record, a mark that had stood for 25 years, and became the first player in school history to lead the Pac-10 in the statistical category. Daugherty also signed her third-straight nationally-ranked recruiting class, and if recent history is any

indication, greatness should be expected from the get-go. Multiple players from each of her first three signing classes garnered postseason recognition by Pac-10 coaches and media members following their debut seasons.

Following 2008-09, the Cougars ranked among the nation's top 30 teams in both increasing their win total and increasing their RPI ranking. During the regular season the Cougars won six more games than the previous season, ranking 26th nationally and second in the Pac-10 amongst teams making the greatest turnarounds. WSU also moved up 83 spots in the RPI from the previous season, the second-highest increase amongst Pac-10 teams, and tied for the 28th-highest jump nationally.

In year one, Daugherty instilled excitement around Cougar women's basketball, signing the nation's 16th-ranked recruiting class (Blue Star Basketball). The class also received a top-25 nod from HoopGurlz (No. 24), ranked second in the Pacific-10 Conference and was unquestionably the greatest signing class in school history. Fans' excitement translated into a packed Beasley Coliseum, as WSU more than tripled its attendance from the previous season. In year two, Daugherty guided the Cougars to an eighth-place finish in the Pac-10, WSU's highest ranking in the conference since also finishing eighth in 1998-99, and the team posted double-digit wins for the first time since the 2000-01 season. Daugherty also followed the most heralded recruiting class in school history with another highly-ranked class in 2008-09.

Daugherty's players have received quite a bit of postseason attention since her arrival on the Palouse. In her first season guard Katie Appleton garnered her first-career all-conference honor after being named All-Pac-10 honorable mention. Guard Kezia Kelly was named Freshman All-Pac-10 honorable mention. April Cook and Jazmine Perkins took home a slew of honors following the 2008-09 season, earning mention on the All-Pac-10 Team and the Pac-10 All-Freshman Team. Perkins was also named to the Pac-10 All-Defensive Team. In 2009-10, Cook garnered her second-straight honorable mention all-conference honor, and freshmen Carly Noyes and Kiki Moore combined for a number of accolades. Daugherty continued to produce all-conference selections last season as Perkins and Sage Romberg garnered All-Pac-10 honorable mention honors while Romberg was placed on the Pac-10 All-Freshmen team and Ireti Amojor received All-Pac-10 All-Freshmen honorable mention. It marked the third consecutive season that Daugherty had at least one freshman garner all-conference recognition.

Dating back to her years at Washington, Daugherty has placed at least one individual on the All-Pac-10/12 team each year since 1997. A pair of Cougs received All-Pac-12 accolades in 2011-12 as Perkins received all-Pac-12 honorable mention while both Perkins and Carly Noyes earned all-defensive team honorable mention. In 2012-13, Galdeira and Presley received all-conference honorable mention with Galdeira also earning a spot on the all-defensive and all-freshmen teams. This past season, Galdeira and Presley both earned spots on the All-Pac-12 Team, becoming the first pair of Cougar teammates to earn all-conference honors in the same season in program history.

Daugherty, whose career record stands at 387-360 (.518), has more than 20 years of experience working with WNBA-caliber talent. She began her head coaching career at Boise State, where she coached for seven years (1989-96) and compiled a record of 123-74 (73-31 Big Sky Conference). Under her watch, the Broncos not only made the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history, but achieved their first national ranking and won their first regular season conference title.

In 1992, the Broncos won the Big Sky regular season championship, and in 1994 they shared the conference crown with Montana and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA tournament. At the conclusion of the 1993-94 season, Daugherty was named Big Sky Co-Coach of the Year.

After turning things around at Boise State, Daugherty continued her success at Washington, where she coached for 11 seasons. After finishing ninth in the Pac-10 in 2000, Daugherty led the Huskies to their first conference title since 1990, the greatest turnaround in conference history. She led Washington to nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons - six NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT appearances - and led the Huskies all the way to the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship Elite Eight in 2001.

Daugherty helped a number of players earn individual honors at Washington, with Giuliana Mendiola becoming the school's first Pac-10 Player of the Year, and four players earning District VIII All-America honors. 16 players have combined for 49 selections to the Pac-10 All-Academic Team at Washington, and 30 student-athletes on the Big Sky Conference All-Academic Team at Boise State. In her seven seasons at WSU, 11 players have combined for 23 All-Academic selections.

A major advocate for healthy heart awareness, Daugherty was named the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Association's National Coach of the Year in 2008. Since becoming a survivor of sudden cardiac arrest Daugherty has become one of the nation's most visible spokesmen, filming a nationally-aired commercial, speaking at fund-raisers for the Hope Heart Institute and the American Red Cross and helping WSU sponsor the inaugural "Cougs Have Heart" basketball game to raise awareness for heart disease.

Daugherty is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association and is a former member of its Board of Directors. She is also a member of both the State Farm Coaches' All-America Team and the Russell Athletic/WBCA Coach of the Year selection committees and is currently serving on the WBCA Ethics Board, the WBCA All-America selection committee for Region 8 and is the captain of the Pac-12 coaches committee. Daugherty often serves as a clinician for the NCAA YES Clinic at the Final Four, and she has been active in USA Basketball and was an assistant coach for the West Team at the 1995 Olympic Sports Festival.

Daugherty served as an assistant coach at Stanford under head coach Tara Vanderveer prior to taking over the Boise State program. Daugherty also had a two-year stint on the Kent State staff as an assistant coach from 1983-85.

Daugherty played collegiate basketball at Ohio State from 1974-78, where she led the Buckeyes to the Big Ten Championship in 1977 and 1978. She is still ranked amongst the school's top 25 in career scoring with 1,137 points. She also ranks fifth in career rebounds (829), is tied for 17th in career field goals made (500) and shares the single-game school record for blocked shots (12 against Michigan State in 1976). At the conclusion of her senior season, she earned first-team All-America honors and was a Wade Trophy finalist the first year the award was presented.

Just prior to the start of the 2001 season, The Ohio State University honored Daugherty with an induction into the OSU Athletic Hall of Fame. Daugherty was inducted into the Westerville High School in December, 2011.

Following graduation in 1978, Daugherty contributed as both a player and coach on several international teams, including a period as a player and coach for the Union Sportive Vierzon Club based in France.

Daugherty, a native of Columbus, Ohio, is the daughter of Naomi and Jim Brewer and has two brothers, Mark and Neil Brewer, and one sister, Ruth Williams. She and her husband Mike are the parents of twins Doc and Breanne.
