#### **LASTTIME OUT**

Washington State Volleyball fell in the second match-up against the Ducks of Oregon inside Bohler Gym, by a final score of 3-2. Set scores from the match were: 19-25, 25-20, 19-25, 25-22, and 8-15 in favor of Oregon (1-1, 1-1 Pac-12). Julianna Dalton posted 14 kills in the match, a career-high for the freshman. Dalton also tied a career-high in total blocks with five, and added a kill percentage of .326 in the contest. Pia Timmer also posted her second double-double of the year with 12 kills, and a career-high 17 digs.

#### **WEEK PREVIEW**

The Cougars head into week two of the 2021 spring season with a 1-1 overall record after spliting the series with Oregon at home. The WSU offense was led by sophomore Pia Timmer who posted 28 total kills, 3.11 kills per set, and two aces. Timmer recorded two straight double-doubles as well, with 29 overall digs on the weekend. Freshman Julianna Dalton had an impressive debut for the Cougars with 27 total kills in two matches, 3.00 kills per set, and an attack percentage of .222. Dalton also leads Washington State in total blocks through two matches with 10.0 total. Sophomore Hannah Pukis anchored the Cougars with 78 total assists, and 32 digs, posting back-to-back double-doubles.

#### **2019 QUICK NOTES**

- > Swept the Ducks of Oregon in the regular season for the first time since 2003. This was the first time since 2002 the Cougars swept both the Oregon schools also.
- > Head Coach Jen Greeny was part of five of the six seasons with equal or more wins than 2019 during the Pac-10/12 era: as a player in 1996 (27 wins) and 1997 (26 wins), and as an assistant coach in 2002 (24 wins), and as a head coach in 2018 (23), and 2019 (23). \*Only season she was not a part of was 1992 (27 wins)
- > WSU's 23 wins ties the victory total from last season (2019), and is tied for 4thmost in WSU history in a single season.
- > Washington State is one of only 28 programs (18 from Power 5 Schools) in the nation, out of 334 total schools, to qualify for the NCAA Championship Tournament in 4 consecutive seasons (2016-19).
- \*Others included are: Alabama State, Baylor, BYU, Colorado State, Creighton, Denver, Florida, Florida State, Hawaii, Howard, Kentucky, Marquette, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Iowa, Penn State, Pittsburgh, Purdue, San Diego, Stanford, Texas, USC, Utah, Washington, and Wisconsin
- > WSU's 12 conference wins (12-8 -- 5th in Pac-12) is tied for 2nd-best conference win total in WSU history. First time since 1996-97 with 12 or more conference wins in back-to-back seasons.
- > WSU ranks 17th overall in total wins among Power 5 programs since 2016 through 2019 with 86 total wins.

#### **HEAD COACH** JEN GREENY

10th Year | Washington St. '99

Jen Greeny completed her ninth season as the head coach at WSU, highlighted by leading the Cougars to a fourth consecutive NCAA Championship tournament appearance, where Washington State made the trip to the University of Hawaii for the opening round.

2019 saw a combined effort of seniors and freshmen help the Cougars secure a 23-10 overall record, along with a 12-8 record in the Pac-12 for a fifth place overall finish in the conference. WSU earned the season sweep over rival Washington, where the Huskies were ranked in the top ten during each match. Washington State saw a breakout season by freshman Magda Jehlárová, who was named the AVCA National Freshman of the Year by the season's end, along with earning Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

In 2018 Greeny led Washington State to their third consecutive NCAA Championship Tournament appearance, where the Cougars advanced to the Sweet Sixteen for the first time since 2002. WSU earned the No. 16 overall seed in the tournament as well, which saw the Cougars host the opening two rounds of play inside Bohler Gym. Washington State defeated defending Big Sky Champions Northern Arizona, and the University of Tennessee, each in four sets to continue on into the regional round. The Cougars ultimately fell to No. 1 overall seed and the 2018 NCAA National Champions, Stanford Cardinal inside Maples Pavilion in the Sweet Sixteen.

The 2018 season saw Washington State Volleyball receive numerous awards upon the conclusion of the regular season, as three student-athletes, Taylor Mims, McKenna Woodford, and Jocelyn Urias were all selected as AVCA All-Americans. Associate Head Coach Burdette Greeny was named the Division I AVCA Assistant Coach of the Year to continue the recognition of WSU. Finally the Cougars earned four All-Pac-12 selections, three AVCA All-Region picks, six Pac-12 All-Academic selections, along with Woodford being named to the 2018 Google Cloud Academic All-District® 8 team.

Jennifer Stinson was a stellar multi-sport athlete at Davenport (Wash.) High. At WSU she became the seventh player in WSU history with 1,000 career kills. A three-time All-Pacific-10 Conference selection, Greeny's statistics are prominent in WSU's all-time career lists ranking fourth in block assists (360), fourth in total blocks (419), and sixth in solo blocks (59). She trained with the 1997 U.S. National volleyball team.

Greeny has coached or played in nine of WSU's 13 NCAA Championship tournament appearances.

Junior Taylor Mims embraced the position move from middle blocker to outside hitter and had the sixth-best offensive output (4.17 kills per set and 4.75 points per set) in the Pac-12, and her 599 points was 12th-best in the NCAA. Mims was accorded All-Pac-12 First Team honors as well as named to the All-America honorable mention teams for PrepVolleyball.com and VolleyballMag.com.

Great blocking was another key to the Cougars' success in 2017 as WSU was sixth-best nationally with 364.5 total blocks and 11th in team blocks per set at 2.89. Redshirt sophomore Jocelyn Urias and juniors Ella Lajos and Claire Martin provided the most stops at the net while sophomore libero Alexis Dirige became the 11th player in school history to reach 1,000 digs and did it in the fewest number of sets.

The Fall of 2016 was the most successful season for the WSU volleyball program since 2002. The Cougars tallied a 22-12 overall record and an 11-9 record for fifth place in the highly-competitive Pac-12 Conference after a preseason coaches' poll predicted a ninth-place finish. Seeing her success

throughout the season, Greeny's fellow conference coaches voted her the 2016 Pac-12 Coach of the Year. WSU made history in 2016 with a trio of consecutive wins over AVCA Top 10 nationally-ranked teams in 10 days: at No. 4 Washington Sept. 21, at No. 9 UCLA Sept. 23 and versus No. 9 Stanford Sept. 30.



The Cougars earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Championship

tournament for the first time in seven years and won a First Round match for the first time in 14 seasons. This season's 22 wins is tied for fifth-most in WSU volleyball program history and under Greeny's leadership, WSU has produced the best three season win-totals in the last 14 years with 18 wins in 2013, 16 wins in 2015 and 22 wins in 2016. Greeny's WSU teams have posted a 62-11 non-conference record during her six years as head coach. The Cougars compete in the country's strongest volleyball conference, the Pac-12, where for the last 17 consecutive seasons the conference has had six or more teams advance to the NCAA Championship tournament including the record of 10 teams in 2014.

The Cougars led the country in total blocks in 2016 and was third-best nationally for blocks per set (3.23 bps) with sophomore middle blockers Taylor Mims and Claire Martin producing outstanding statistics. Mims was third-best nationally in total blocks (191) and eighth-best in blocks per set (1.49 bps) while Martin was 24th-best in total blocks (156) and 16th-best in blocks per set (1.41bps). Mims and WSU junior outside hitter Casey Schoenlein were named to the 2016 All-Pac-12 honorable mention team.

Greeny and her staff have tirelessly worked to return the Cougars volleyball program back to the national prominence it received when Greeny was a player and an assistant coach. To that end, the Cougars ranked No. 17 in recruiting class rankings from 2013-15 according to PrepVolleyball.com, which includes two classes ranked among the Top 21: No. 14 in 2013, and No. 21 in 2015, with the 2014 class garnering honorable mention accolades. Among the WSU recruits are six PrepVolleyball.com Top 100 players and two Gatorade State Players of the Year. Greeny credits her husband and lead recruiter, assistant coach Burdette Greeny, with achieving these fine recruiting classes.

Greeny has also changed the academic culture of the program with 12 semesters of a team grade point average of 3.0 or better.
