COUGARS HEAD TO SALT LAKE CITY OF MATCHUP AT UTAH

Washington State hits the road for the first time in 2021 with a matchup at Utah in Salt Lake City Saturday afternoon. Kickoff is set for 11:30 a.m. (PT) on the Pac-12 Network.

SERIES HISTORY

Washington State's all-time series record with Utah is tied at 9-9 after the Utes claimed the last two meetings, both played in Rice-Eccles Stadium where the series is also tied, 5-5. The Cougars last win in Salt Lake City came in 2017, 33-25. Including Saturday, five of the last six meetings between the two schools will have been played in Salt Lake City with the only meeting in Pullman coming in 2018 (WSU, 28-24).

WSU, GESA CREDIT UNION ANNOUNCE GESA FIELD

Washington State and Gesa Credit Union announced a partnership to provide Gesa the naming rights to the playing surface at Martin Stadium, now named Gesa Field, pronounced gee-sah. The 10-year agreement is valued at a minimum \$11 million, that will escalate as additional Gesa consumer-based incentives are reached. The agreement with WSU Athletics will formalize the first major sponsorship announced under the new Gesa Credit Union which recently merged with Inspirus Credit Union making it the second-largest credit union in the state.

COUGAR FOOTBALL HOME GAME PROTOCOLS

Washington State University Athletics, in alignment with our football partners in the State of Washington, the Seattle Seahawks and the Washington Huskies, will require proof of vaccination for COVID-19 for fans 12 years of age and older, beginning with home contests at Gesa Field in the month of October. Those who are not vaccinated will need to show proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of the event. Additional details will be communicated at a later date. In the interim, effective immediately, WSU Athletics will mandate masks for all fans in attendance at Gesa Field, regardless of vaccination status. This will include both indoor and outdoor seating at all times, unless actively eating or drinking.

COLLEGE GAMEDAY RECORD

Dating back to the middle of the 2003 season, ESPN's College GameDay has had the WSU flag appear throughout the show. The streak reached 261 after appearing last Saturday in State College for Auburn-Penn State. The first appearance came in Austin, Texas (10/4/03) and the streak began two weeks later in Madison, Wisc. (10/18/03). Two flags - Ol' Crimson and Gray - have been flown in the background of the GameDay set by dozens of friends and alumni. The Gray flag was added in 2014 after Whitey was retired in honor of Steve Gleason's "No White Flags." Appearance No. 217 was its first in Pullman (10/20/18), a 34-20 win over Oregon.

The 20-station football network reaches from British Columbia to Oregon and can be heard worldwide via the internet and XM Satellite radio. Cougar football broadcasts begin an hour before kickoff, carry through the game and conclude with post-game interviews with players and coaches.

The Washington State Sports Network also features radio coverage of WSU men's basketball, baseball, women's basketball and women's volleyball, and the Cougar Coaches Show in the fall and winter seasons.

Learfield manages corporate marketing opportunities and on-site promotions at WSU football and basketball games as well as oversees sales for all signage at Gesa Field, Friel Court at Beasley Coliseum and all Cougar competition sites.

HARRIS NAMED PAC-12 SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK AFTER PORTLAND STATE WIN

Kick returner/punt returner Travell Harris was named the Pac-12 Conference Special Teams Player of the Week following the week two win over Portland State. Harris earns his second career conference weekly accolade after recording 188 all-purpose yards including a 50-yard kickoff return and a career-long 22-yard punt return, both set up touchdown drives for the Cougars in the 44-24 win over Portland State. The redshirt-senior also caught six passes for 80 yards including two for touchdowns (19, 13). Harris' 50-yard kickoff return was his seventh career kick return of 40-plus yards. The Tampa, Fla. native earned his first Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week award back in 2018 after his 100-yard kickoff return against Eastern Washington. Harris enters the week with school records in kick returns (71) and kick return yards (1,782) and owns the 8th-most career all-purpose yards (3,308) in WSU history.

ALL-PURPOSE, ALL THE TIME

Cougar running backs served all-purpose roles for the Air Raid and increased their production in the run-n-shoot offense under Nick Rolovich • last season, Deon McIntosh rushed for a career-high 147 yards in the win at Oregon State, the most by a Coug since Dwight Tardy's 214 yards against UCLA in 2007 • McIntosh added another 92 yards and a score on the ground against Oregon before Max Borghi and McIntosh combined for 109 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns at Utah • McIntosh finished the season seventh in the Pac-12 averaging 80.8 yards/g • Borghi opened the 2021 season with 86 rushing yards including a 64-yard rushing touchdown against Utah State • Borghi, McIntosh and Jayden de Laura each rushed for a touchdown against Portland State

COUGAR DEFENSE CONTINUES TO IMPROVE

• Since 2015, the Cougars are 30-9 when forcing multiple turnovers • Jahad Woods enters the week with 342 career tackles, seventh in WSU history and the most by any active Pac-12 player, 4th-most among all FBS players • WSU opened 2021 by forcing a pair of turnovers against Utah State, recorded two more against Portland State and added 3 more takeaways along with 9 TFL against USC • WSU enters the week 2nd in the Pac-12 and No. 13 in the country with 7 takeaways in 2021

LET'S ROLL, NICK ROLOVICH IN YEAR 2 LEADING COUGS

Nick Rolovich took the reigns as the Cougars' Head Coach in 2020 after spending a total of eight seasons at the University of Hawai'i, the last four as head coach. Rolovich, 41, was named the 33rd head football coach in Washington State history, Director of Athletics Pat Chun announced Jan. 14. He also served as Nevada's offensive coordinator for four seasons and spent two years coaching quarterbacks at City College of San Francisco. Rolovich completed his fourth season at Hawai'i with a 28-27 record and three bowl games in his time. Last season he guided UH to its first 10-win season since 2010 as the Rainbow Warriors went 10-5, capped by a 38-34 win over BYU in the Hawaii Bowl.

- In 2016, took over the program as the fifth-youngest head coach in NCAA Division I FBS at the age of 37

ROLO AND THE COMMUNITY

Washington State football was not able to see fans at Gesa Field in 2020 but head coach Nick Rolovich was still able to connect with Cougar fans.

- Throughout the spring of 2020, Rolovich would order a number of meals at a local Pullman restaurant, tweet out a "password" and the first 20 people to show up at the restaurant and use the password, would receive the meal
- Rolovich also provided dinner to the staff at Pullman Regional Hospital who were working a late night shift

NICK ROLOVICH HEAD COACH / SECOND YEAR

Nick Rolovich was named the 33rd head football coach in Washington State history, Director of Athletics Pat Chun announced Jan. 14, 2020.

The 2020 season for Washington State was unlike any in Cougar history, as WSU went 1-3, playing just four of seven scheduled conference-only games due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Having the 2020 spring practice schedule canceled, and delays to the start of fall camp, Rolovich was able to guide WSU to a 38-28 win at Oregon State in the season opener. He is the first Cougar head football coach to win his debut since 2003 and first to win his debut on the road since 1977. He mentored 11 student-athletes who received All-Pac-12 honors and WSU claimed the Pac-12's first two Freshman of the Week awards in 2020. Rolovich's Run and Shoot offense produced two of the Pac-12's top three leaders in receiving yards during the season while the defense led the league with eight forced fumbles. In the spring and summer of 2020, Rolovich did his part during the pandemic, donating meals to front-line workers and assisting businesses in the Pullman area

Rolovich, 40, spent a total of eight seasons at the University of Hawai'i, the last four as head coach. He also served as Nevada's offensive coordinator for four seasons and spent two years coaching quarterbacks at City College of San Francisco. He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at San Marin High School in Northern California.

In his four seasons in Honolulu, Rolovich led the program to a 28-27 record and three bowl games including a 2019 campaign where he guided UH to its first 10-win season since 2010 as the Rainbow Warriors went 10-5, capped by a 38-34 win over BYU in the Hawaii Bowl. It marked just the seventh time in program history Hawaii reached double-digit wins and its first back-to-back winning seasons since 2006-07 after going 8-6 in 2018.

During his time as a head coach at Hawai'i, Rolovich coached 31 All-Mountain West Conference selections and 39 different student-athletes to a total of 59 All-Academic honors.

The 2019 Mountain West Coach of the Year, Rolovich's offense threw of 338.0 ypg this past season, fifth nationally, while the Rainbow Warriors were 13th nationally in total offense at 471.0 ypg. He opened the season with back-to-back wins over Pac-12 foes Arizona and Oregon State, won five of their final six games while reaching the Mountain West Championship game.

The 2018 season saw a true resurgence of the famed Run-and-Shoot offense. Under Rolovich's guidance, the UH offense racked up more than 5,800 yards of offense, along with 43 touchdown passes. The aerial assault accounted for 30.8 points per game, 310.3 passing yards per game, ninth nationally, and 419 total yards of offense per contest. The production led to the Rainbow Warriors returning to the Hawaii Bowl for a second time under Rolovich, finishing with an 8-6 record.

In 2016, when he took over the program as the fifthyoungest head coach in NCAA Division I FBS at the age of 37 after a four-year stint as Nevada's offensive coordinator, Rolovich promised a refined offense and he came through in the form of a 1,000-yard rusher and a 1,000-yard receiver for just the second time in program history. He also guided Hawai'i to its first bowl game since the 2010 season, a 52-35 win over Middle Tennessee State giving the Rainbow Warriors a 7-7 record.

During his time in Reno (2012-15), Rolovich coached quarterbacks and served as the Wolf Pack's offensive coordinator, helping lead the team to three bowl appearances: the 2012 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, the 2014 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl and the 2015 NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl.

Rolovich's first coaching stint at UH was wildly productive from 2008-11, directing one of the top passing offenses in the nation. He was the quarterbacks coach all four seasons and spent the final two years as the Warriors' offensive coordinator.

For the latter three years of his time with the Warriors, he had play-calling duties, while UH threw for 13,915 yards—an average of 347.9 yards per game—and 96 touchdowns. That includes the 2010 season in which Hawai'i led the nation in passing offense (394.3 ypg) and finished sixth in total offense (500.6 ypg).

Rolovich was a two-year letterwinner at quarterback for Hawai'i from 2000-01, starting the bulk of the 2001 season and leading the team to an 8-1 record as a starter. He passed for 4,176 career yards and 40 touchdowns and still holds six school passing records. The highlight of his career was perhaps one of the best performances in college football history. Rolovich led the Rainbow Warriors to an upset over previously unbeaten and No. 9 BYU in the 2001 season finale, 72-45, with 543 yards and eight touchdowns. As a senior, he ranked 10th nationally in passing efficiency with a 150.5 rating and broke 19 school passing and eight total offensive records. He ended his college career with three consecutive 500-yard passing games, engineering at least 52 points each outing.

Following his collegiate playing career, Rolovich participated in the Dallas Cowboys minicamp before signing with the Denver Broncos. He was later allocated to the Rhein Fire of NFL Europe, where he threw for 907 yards and led the Fire to World Bowl XI.

Rolovich got his coaching start in 2002 as an assistant coach for San Marin (Calif.) High School, later reuniting with his college coach, June Jones, in coaching the Run-and-Shoot offense as a student assistant at Hawai'i during the 2003-04 seasons

He returned to Denver in 2003, then started a five-year career in the Arena Football League, beginning with the San Jose SaberCats, where he was a member of their Arena Bowl Championship team. He then spent time with the Chicago Rush, Arizona Rattlers and Las Vegas Gladiators. While with the Gladiators, he threw for 1,248 yards and 23 touchdowns and had a passer rating of 104.8 in 2007 before retiring and accepting a full-time role at his alma mater on Greg McMackin's coaching staff
