MATCH PREVIEW

The 25th-ranked Washington State volleyball team (18-8, 10-5 Pac-12) hopes to grab its first 2-0 Pac-12 road trip of the season on Sunday in Tucson, Ariz., as it takes on Arizona (14-12, 4-11 Pac-12) at the McKale Center where it has won four of the last five matchups. Sunday's match will be streamed live on the Arizona Live Stream.

Washington State tallied seven service aces as a team in a Friday night sweep at Arizona State (11-16, 5-10 Pac-12) and Pia Timmer finished with a match-high 13 kills. Timmer started slow but had nine kills in the third set with zero errors to lead a Cougars offense that hit .282 in the final set to close out their 12th sweep of the season. The Wildcats came from behind twice on Friday, dropping the first and third sets to 20th-ranked Washington before prevailing, 15-10, in a fifth set to begin their weekend with a home upset win over the Huskies.

COUGAR QUICK NOTES

- >> WSU cracked the AVCA Top-25 for the first time in 2022 on Monday, reaching the No. 25 spot after last week's 25th-ranked team, Iowa State, dropped out of this week's coaches' poll.
- >> The Cougars finished the 2021 season at No. 23 in the AVCA Top-25 and were receiving votes in eight of the first 11 top-25 polls of the season before finally reach their first national ranking of the season in the Week 11 poll on Monday.
- >> Washington State has split each of the last two weekends with its two losses both coming in top-25 matchups (vs. No. 9 Stanford, at No. 12 Oregon). Washington State is 17-1 this season against teams outside the top-25 and has won 23 of 24 against unranked teams dating back to last season.
- >> Five of the Cougars' six road wins have been sweeps after Friday's three-set win at Arizona State.
- >> In search of its first 2-0 weekend on the road, WSU has split each of its first four Pac-12 road trips with wins at USC (9/24), at Cal (9/30) at Utah (10/16), at Oregon State (11/4), and at Arizona State (11/11).
- >> **If the season ended today**, the Cougars' .273 hitting percentage would rank as the third-highest in WSU volleyball history and their 1.70 aces/set would rank as the fifth-most.
- >> **Pia Timmer** averaged 4.29 kills/set last week in Oregon while hitting .226 (30-11-84) for the weekend. She also picked up her second double-double of the season (19 kills, 12 digs) Sunday at Oregon and had a match-high 13 kills in Friday's win at ASU.
- >> **Magda Jehlarova** began the weekend first in the Pac-12 and 12th in the nation at 1.40 blocks/set for the season. **Jehlarova's** 126 total blocks are the most in the Pac-12 and 17th-most in the NCAA.
- >> Setter **Argentina Ung** tallied five aces at the service line last week on the road at the Oregon schools and had a career-high six blocks in Friday's win at ASU.
- >> Libero **Karly Basham** reached a new season career high with her 34th ace of the season on Sunday at Oregon and was one of six Cougars to drop in an ace in Friday's win at ASU.
- >> **Laura Jansen** tallied her fourth double-double of the season in last Sunday's match at Oregon. **Jansen** has also posted four 20-kill matches on the season highlighted by a season-high 27 kills in a five-set win over Arizona on Oct. 21.

ARIZONA NOTES

>> Washington State is 9-3 against Arizona since 2016, winning three of the last four matchups capped by a five-set thriller in Bohler Gym last month.
 >> Head Coach Jen Greeny captured her 200th-career win in the Cougs' win over Arizona last month.
 >> Laura Jansen finished the first matchup with a season-high 27 kills and the Cougs hit .308 as a team in the fifth set in which they just edged out the Wildcats, 16-14, to win in five.
 >> The Cougars have won four of the last five matchups in Tucson with a sweep over the Wildcats last October.
 >> WSU has won both matchups over the Wildcats last season without dropping a single set.
 >> Arizona tallied 16 blocks as a team in a five-set win over Washington to start the weekend Friday at McKale Center.
 >> The Wildcats dropped the first set against Washington before winning the second, 25-18. Arizona forced a fifth set by rebounding from a sluggish third with a 25-19 fourth-set win followed by a 15-10 fifth set to upset the Huskies.
 >> Arizona had dropped five of its previous six matches before Friday's upset over Washington.
