### MATCH PREVIEW

Washington State volleyball (21-8, 13-5 Pac-12), the 25th-ranked team in the AVCA Division I women's volleyball coaches' poll for a third week in a row, gets set to host its penultimate match on the 2022 regular season against UCLA (15-12, 9-9 Pac-12) Tuesday in Bohler Gym. Tuesday's match will be televised live on Pac-12 Network with A.J. Kanell on the play-by-play and a first serve slated for 6:04 p.m.

The Cougs are coming off of an impressive 2-0 weekend that saw them sweep Utah on Friday night before a convincing four-set win over Colorado to split the season series with the Buffaloes. Pia Timmer averaged a team-high 4.43 kills/set last weekend and Magda Jehlarova had a season-high 16 kills on only 21 swings (16-1-21, .714) in Sunday's win over Colorado. WSU improved to 10-1 on the season at home going into this week's final two matches in Bohler Gym.

### COUGAR QUICK NOTES

- >> The Cougs have won six of their last seven matches overall and are 20-1 this year against teams outside the top-25.
- >> Washington State remained at No. 25 for a third-consecutive week in the AVCA Division I Women's Volleyball Coaches' Poll, having cracked the top-25 for the first time back on Nov. 7.
- >> The Cougars rank No. 16 in the NCAA with a .281 hitting percentage as a team. .281 (547-169-1241) would rank as the second-highest for a team in WSU history behind the 1996 NCAA Eight Eight team.
- >> Washington State is 10-1 this season at home and has won 15 of 16 matches dating back to last season.
- >> The Cougs are averaging a .305 hitting percentage as a team at home in Bohler while opponents are averaging just .178.
- >> **Magda Jehlarová** (574 career blocks) is only four blocks shy of moving into second all-time at WSU in career blocks.
- >> **Jehlarová** is 10th in the NCAA and first in the Pac-12 with 1.44 blocks/set this season.
- >> **Pia Timmer** finished last weekend with 4.43 kills/set and a .406 hitting percentage (31-5-64). She is 11th in the Pac-12 heading into Tuesday's match with 3.37 kills/set on three season.
- >> **Laura Jansen**, a fifth-year transfer from Arkansas - Little Rock with over 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs, has a team-leading 3.60 kills/set at home this season.
- >> **If the season ended today**, the Cougars' .281 hitting percentage would rank as the second-highest in WSU volleyball history and their 1.71 aces/set would rank as the fifth-most.
- >> Washington State is 17-1 this season after winning the first set, are a perfect 14-0 after winning the first two and have 13 sweeps on the season.
- >> The Cougars have hit .300 or better in their last three matches and six of their last seven. WSU is 16-1 on the year when hitting over .300 as a team.
- >> The Cougs' 13 blocks against Colorado on Sunday was its highest team total in Pac-12 play this season. WSU is 11-1 in its 12 matches with 10 or more blocks as a team and are 19-1 when finishing with more blocks than its opponents.
- >> Washington State leads the Pac-12 with 1.71 aces/set as a team and are 17-2 in matches in which they finish with more aces than its opponent.

## UCLA NOTES

>> Three of the last four Washington State wins in the all-time series against UCLA have come at home in Bohler Gym.  
 >> UCLA leads the series, 59-12, and is 28-8 all-time in Pullman but the Cougs are 5-6 since 2016.  
 >> Tuesday's will be only the third time since 2014 that the Bruins have not been ranked inside the top-25 at the time of the matchup with the Cougs.  
 >> UCLA won the last matchup in Bohler by winning a marathon fifth set, 20-18, last season.  
 >> The Bruins have won five of their last seven matches heading into Tuesday's contest and pushed 12th-ranked Oregon to a fifth set last Friday in Eugene.  
 >> Freshman Mokihana Tufono tied a UCLA record with eight service aces in the loss to Oregon. Elan McCall is averaging a team-high 3.11 kills/set on the season while Anna Dodson is averaging 2.57 kills/set and is ninth in the Pac-12 with a .342 hitting percentage (.239-71-491).
