THE STARTING FIVE

>> The Cougars will be coming into Friday's matchup against Montana looking for their third-straight win. Washington State defeated the defending WNIT champions, South Dakota State 61-41 this past Monday, Nov. 28, in Beasley Coliseum to move to 5-1 on the year.

>> Washington State stands at 5-1 through the first six games of the 2022-23 season. It marks the third-straight season that WSU has won five of its first six contests. It is just the fifth time since the turn of the century that the Cougars have started a campaign at 5-1. It also marks the 18th time in program history that Wazzu has opened a season winning five of its first six games.

>> Friday's matchup against Washington State and Montana will be the 40th meeting between the two schools. Montana leads the all-time series 22-17 and has won the last nine games against the Cougars.

>> Washington State and Montana are quite familiar with each other historically, as they've played 39 times prior to Friday's contest. Montana is Washington State's second-longest non-conference rivalry, trailing only WSU's 41 games played against Idaho and Boise State. The last meeting came on March 19, 2014, in the WNIT, with the Griz taking a 90-78 victory in Missoula. Washington State's last win in the series came back on Dec. 21, 1988, with a 62-60 victory in Pullman.

>> Washington State will be seeking its 11th-straight non-conference win at home this Friday. The current 10-game winning streak dates back to the 2019-20 season. WSU is 17-4 against non-conference foes inside Beasley Coliseum under Head Coach Kamie Ethridge.

JUNIOR CHARLISSIE LEGER-WALKER WAS NAMED THE 2022 NORTH SHORE SHOWCASE'S MOST VALUABLE PLAYER. THE COUGARS WILL BE WELCOMING CIA EKLÖF (HELSINKI, FINLAND), KYRA GARDNER (RAYMOND, WASHINGTON), LAUREN GLAZIER (NORTH BEND, WASHINGTON), AND ASTERA TUHINA (PRISTINA, KOSOVO) TO THE PALOUSE. EKLÖF WILL BE REDSHIRTING THIS SEASON, WHILE THE OTHER THREE ARE EXPECTED TO MAKE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT THIS SEASON FOR THE COUGARS.

TAKING CARE OF THE HOME COURT

BEASLEY COLISEUM HAS BECOME A TOUGH VENUE FOR OPPONENTS TO COME INTO AND WALK OUT WITH A VICTORY. LAST SEASON, WASHINGTON STATE WON 11 GAMES AT HOME WHICH SET A PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST WINS AT BEASLEY IN A SEASON.

THE COUGARS ARE 18-7 AT HOME OVER THE LAST TWO SEASONS, WHILE WASHINGTON STATE HAS WON SEVEN-STRAIGHT NON-CONFERENCE GAMES INSIDE BEASLEY COLISEUM DATING BACK TO THE 2019-20 CAMPAIGN. WSU IS 14-4 AGAINST NON-CONFERENCE FOES AT BEASLEY DURING THE ETHRIDGE ERA.

LOOKING TO MAKE IT THREE IN A ROW

WASHINGTON STATE COMES INTO THE 2022-23 SEASON HAVING COME TO THE LAST TWO NCAA TOURNAMENTS. IT IS THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY THAT THE COUGARS HAVE EARNED A BID INTO BACK-TO-BACK NCAA TOURNAMENTS.

THE COUGARS WILL BE LOOKING TO MAKE THEIR THIRD-STRAIGHT APPEARANCE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT THIS SEASON. WASHINGTON STATE IS ONLY ONE OF FOUR PAC-12 PROGRAMS TO HAVE GONE TO EACH OF THE LAST TWO NCAA TOURNAMENTS, JOINED BY STANFORD, ARIZONA, AND OREGON.

COACH E IS COLLECTING THE WINS

WASHINGTON STATE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HEAD COACH KAMIE ETHRIDGE HAS WON 51 GAMES DURING HER FIRST FOUR SEASONS IN PULLMAN. THE 51 VICTORIES ARE THE MOST COLLECTED BY A WSU HEAD COACH DURING THEIR FIRST FOUR YEARS AT THE HELM.

THE COUGARS HAVE SEEN THEIR WIN TOTAL IMPROVE EACH SEASON UNDER ETHRIDGE, AS WASHINGTON STATE COLLECTED 19 VICTORIES LAST SEASON TO SET A PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST SINGLE-SEASON WINS IN THE NCAA ERA.

COUGS WORLDWIDE

ONCE AGAIN, WASHINGTON STATE'S ROSTER WILL HAVE SEVERAL INTERNATIONAL PLAYERS ON ITS ROSTER. WSU HAS A TOTAL OF NINE PLAYERS FROM SEVEN DIFFERENT COUNTRIES ON ITS 2022-23 ROSTER. WASHINGTON STATE HAS THE MOST INTERNATIONAL PLAYERS ON ITS ROSTER IN THE PAC-12 THIS SEASON WITH NINE.

BELLA BLOCKS

SENIOR BELLA MUREKATETE ENTERS HER SENIOR SEASON LOOKING TO CEMENT HERSELF AS ONE OF THE PREMIER RIM PROTECTORS IN PROGRAM HISTORY. COMING INTO THE 2022-23 SEASON, THE 6-3 CENTER FROM RWANDA RANKS THIRD IN PROGRAM HISTORY IN BLOCKS PER GAME AT 1.3, WHILE HER 106 CAREER SWATS IS THE SIXTH-MOST IN WASHINGTON STATE HISTORY.

PRESEASON PAC-12 POLL

WASHINGTON STATE WAS SELECTED AS SEVENTH IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL BY BOTH THE COACHES AND MEDIA. IT IS THE SECOND-HIGHEST PLACEMENT FOR THE COUGARS IN EITHER CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL, AFTER BEING PICKED A PROGRAM-BEST SIXTH LAST SEASON.

WASHINGTON STATE IS NO STRANGER TO PROVING THE PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATORS

WRONG, AS WSU HAS FINISHED AHEAD OF ITS PLACEMENT IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL EVERY SEASON UNDER HEAD COACH KAMIE ETHRIDGE. LAST SEASON, THE COUGARS WERE SELECTED TO FINISH SIXTH IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL, ONLY TO FINISH IN A TIE FOR SECOND PLACE IN THE PAC-12 STANDING AT THE END OF THE SEASON.

KAMIE ETHRIDGE

HEAD COACH FIFTH SEASON AT WSU TEXAS - '86

Kamie Ethridge was named the head coach of WSU women's basketball on April 15, 2018.

Coach Ethridge has continued to raise the bar every season she has been on the Palouse. The hall of famer has brought her winning ways to the Palouse and has quickly elevated the WSU women's basketball program into the upper echelon of the college women's basketball landscape.

Washington State has seen its win total increase each season under Ethridge. Since coming to Pullman, Coach Ethridge has guided the Cougs to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first in program history (2021, 2022), set program records for most wins in a regular season (19 in 2021-22), most Pac-12 Conference wins in a season (11 in 2021-22), earned WSU's highest finish in the Pac-12 standings (T-2nd in 2021-22) and earned the program's first AP Top-25 ranking.

Ethridge's 51 overall wins are the most by a fourth-year coach in WSU women's basketball history. The Cougars' 20 Pac-12 wins collected over the last two seasons (2020-21, 2021-22) are the most conference wins in a two-year stretch in program history. Ethridge has dominated the Boeing Apple Cup Series during her tenure on the Palouse, as she is 7-1 against Washington. The seven wins over the Huskies are the most by a WSU head coach in program history.

Washington State continued to shatter the



glass ceiling in her fourth season in 2021-22, as the Cougars set numerous program records and made a return trip to the NCAA Tournament. WSU ended the 2021-22 season with a 19-11 record, which set the program record for most wins in a season in the NCAA Era (post-1981-82). Washington State finished tied for second in the Pac-12 in 2021-22 with an 11-6 conference record. The 11 victories are a program record for most Pac-12 wins in a season, while the second-place finish marked the Cougars' highest finish in the Pac-12 standings in program history.

Ethridge lifted Washington State to new heights in her third season at the helm in 2020-21, as she guided the Cougars to their first NCAA Tournament berth in 30 seasons. Washington State earned a No. 9 seed in the 2021 NCAA Tournament, where they took on No. 8 -seed South Florida in Austin, Texas. Ethridge also led Washington State to its first-ever ranking in the Associated Press top-25 poll, coming in at No. 25 in the Jan. 11, 2021 poll. Washington State also won a program-best 11 games at Beasley Coliseum in 2021-22.

Washington State ended its third season under Ethridge at 12-12, marking the first time the program has posted a .500-or-better overall record since the 2014-15 campaign. The Cougars knocked off three top-25 teams in 2020-21, which included a 67-63 win over No. 5/4 UCLA on Feb. 5, 2021 in Pullman. The win over the Bruins marked the program's first victory over a top-five opponent. WSU also defeated the eventual national runner-up Arizona in Beasley Coliseum, as the Cougs knocked off the Wildcats, 71-69 in overtime, on Jan. 10, 2021 in Beasley Coliseum. Washington State won nine Pac-12 games during the 2020-21 season, which is tied for the second-most Pac-12 wins in a single season in program history. Academically, the Cougars posted their highest cumulative grade point average in program history in 2020-21 with a team GPA 3.629. Washington State was selected to the 2020-21 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll for the first time in program history, posting the 20th-best team GPA in all of NCAA Division I women's basketball that season.

Ethridge has recruited elite talent from all over the globe during her tenure at Washington State, which includes New Zealand native Charlisse Leger-Walker, who was a 2020-21 USBWA All-American Honorable Mention selection and the 2020-21 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year. Players such as Ula Motuga (Australia), Johanna Teder (Estonia), Bella Murekatete (Rwanda), Krystal Leger-Walker (New Zealand) Jessica Clarke (Canada) and Tara Wallack (Canada) have went on to play for their national team programs.

The 2019-20 campaign featured a challenge like no other Washington State women's basketball team had seen before. Coming into her second season in Pullman, Ethridge scheduled a school-record 15 games against teams ranked inside the top-25, with 11 of those contests coming in Pac-12 Conference play. The tough sledding proved to be fruitful for the Cougars, as they posted a two-win improvement from year one under Ethridge's guidance, finishing at 11-20 in 2019-20.

Ethridge helped guide Borislava Hristova and Chanelle Molina to their second All-Pac-12 selection under her direction. Hristova earned All-Pac-12 honors four a program record fourth time, as the forward ended her career as WSU's all-time leading scorer with 2,269 career points.

Ethridge won her 100th career game as a head coach on Jan. 5, 2020 with a 96-75 victory at Cal. The win at Cal also featured Borislava Hristova becoming Washington State's all-time leading scorer, breaking Jeane Eggart's 38-year-old school record. The Cougars outscored the Bears 31-6 in the first quarter en route to the 21-point victory. The 31 points were the most ever points scored in an opening frame in WSU history.

The 20 victories collected by Ethridge during her first two seasons on the Palouse is the second-most by head coach through two seasons at Washington State.

Ethridge won her first game at WSU Nov. 16, 2018 in with an 87-84, (2OT) victory over Nebraska at home at Beasley Coliseum. She would nab her first Pac-12 win against rival Washington, 79-76, Dec. 30, 2018 in her first-career Apple Cup contest. The win over Washington would be her first of two on the year as she led the Cougs to a sweep of the Huskies for just the second time since 1970. In addition, Ethridge guided her team to its most lopsided win over Washington in the NCAA era as the Cougs defeated the Huskies by 33, 94-61, Feb. 15, 2019, to complete the series sweep.

With Ethridge at the helm, the Cougs put a two on the All-Pac-12 postseason team with Borislava Hristova earning first team honors while Chanelle Molina was named an honorable mention as well as to the all-defensive team.

Ethridge came to Pullman following four seasons

as the head coach at the University of Northern Colorado, where she posted a combined 83 victories and led the Bears to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in her final season.

In four seasons at Northern Colorado (2014-18), Etheridge posted three 20-plus win seasons during that time, including a school-record 26 wins en route to being named the Big Sky Coach of the Year in 2018. She led UNC to a then-school record 22 wins in her first season before topping that mark in 2018. In addition, she guided the Bears to two postseason appearances in her four years.



Prior to UNC, Ethridge established herself as one of the premier teachers in the game. Her reputation was not just as a coach, but also as a player, earning a gold medal with the United States at the 1988 Olympics, winning a NCAA National Championship as a player at the University of Texas, and being inducted to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 2002.

Ethridge spent 18 seasons (1996-2014) as an assistant coach at Kansas State, where she was part of a staff that took teams to nine NCAA postseason

tournaments, four WNIT postseason tournaments (including winning the 2006 WNIT Championship), and two Big 12 Championships. The Wildcats advanced to six Sweet Sixteen while totaling a record of 350-226 over that span.

In addition to her service with the Wildcats, Ethridge served a four-year term on the USA Basketball Women's Player Selection Committee, which is responsible for the selection of numerous teams, including the World University Games, Pan American Games and Jones Cup teams. In the summer of 1999, she was invited to lead a point guard camp in Colorado Springs, Colo., for current, past and prospective USA Basketball talent.

Prior to Kansas State, Ethridge spent five seasons with Vanderbilt as an assistant coach from 1991-96. The Commodores won the SEC postseason tournament twice en route to advancing to the Sweet Sixteen all five seasons, including one Final Four trip

in 1992-93. Ethridge played a major role in recruiting five high school Kodak All-Americans and 13 Gatorade State Players of the Year.

In her first year of coaching, Ethridge joined the Northern Illinois program that advanced to the WNIT Postseason Tournament.

Ethridge had a prestigious playing career at the University of Texas, including leading the Longhorns to the 1986 national championship, where she was named the Most Valuable Player. She served as a team captain for the Longhorns while putting together the



first perfect season in NCAA Division I history, finishing the campaign 34-0. Ethridge and Texas advanced to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen every season while moving on to the Elite Eight twice.

A two-time Kodak All-American, Ethridge was honored with the Wade Trophy and the Honda Broderick Cup, awarded to the top female student-athlete in the country, in 1986. The final jewel in her awards crown was the Frances Pomeroy Naismith Player of the Year Award, presented annually to the nation's top senior collegian under 5-foot-6 in height, that same season.

Ethridge continued her playing career after Texas while competing on the international level. She was a member of the U.S gold medal-winning Olympic team at the 1988 Summer Olympics in Seoul, Korea. Ethridge also won gold medals for Team USA at the 1986 Goodwill Games, 1986 World Championships and the 1987 Pan American Games.

Ethridge had her #33 jersey retired at Texas in September of 2019 as she became the first female athlete in Longhorns Athletics history to earn the honor.

In their lone exhibition game of the 2022-23 season, the Cougars got a standout performance from senior Bella Murekatete, who collected a double-double with 26 points and 10 rebounds.

Washington State led for all but 20 seconds of Sunday's exhibition. WSU shot 45 percent from the field (27-of-60), while also collecting 20 assists as a team.

Sophomore Tara Wallack also recorded double-digit points in the exhibition win, as the 6-2 guard collected 11 points and dished out four assists.

PULLMAN, Wash. –The Washington State women's basketball team put on an offensive clinic in its 2022-23 season opener, as the Cougars scored the fourth-most points in a game under Head Coach Kamie Ethridge in a 93-41 victory over Loyola Marymount at Beasley Coliseum Monday, November 7.

All 12 WSU players that were active scored in the victory, with four recording double-digit points. The Cougars shot 58.6% from the field, which is the ninth-highest team field goal percentage in a game in program history.

Washington State got out of the gates fast against Loyola Marymount and never slowed down. The Cougar led for 39:32 of game time and used a 20-0 run midway through the fourth quarter to collect the 52-point win over the Lions.

Senior Bella Murekatete led a quartet of double-digit scorers for Washington State, as the 6-3 post tallied a game-high 18 points, while shooting 61.5% from the field.

Washington State debuted three of its four freshmen in the game against LMU, with Asteria Tuhina, Kyra Gardner, and Lauren Glazier played in their first official game as Cougs.

SAN FRANCISCO –The Washington State Women's basketball team (RV) completed one of the biggest comebacks in program history on Friday, Nov. 11, as the Cougars rallied from a 15-point deficit at San Francisco to score a 69-63 victory over the Dons to move to 2-0 on the year.

Washington State trailed San Francisco by 15 points heading into halftime, as the Dons held a 38-23 advantage. The Cougars were able to lock down USF defensively over the final two frames of play, as WSU held San Francisco to just a 27.3 percent shooting percentage in the third and fourth quarters.

Junior Charlissee Leger-Walker hit a reverse layup with 6:44 remaining to give WSU a 51-50 lead the Cougars would never relinquish. The 15-point comeback is tied fourth-largest comeback victory in program history.

With the win, Washington State improves to 2-0. It is the fourth-straight season that the Cougars have opened a campaign winning back-to-back games.

Leger-Walker scored a career-high 35 points in the victory, as she is now just 14 points shy from joining the 1,000-point club.

Senior Bella Murekatete battled through foul trouble throughout the afternoon against the Dons, but she came up big in the comeback effort, scoring 14 of her 16 points in the second half.

PULLMAN, Wash. – Junior Charlisse Leger-Walker scored her 1,000th career point in historic fashion against Prairie View A&M on Sunday, Nov. 13, as the Washington State women's basketball team collected an 89-61 win over the Panthers in Beasley Coliseum as part of the Pac-12/SWAC Legacy Series.

Leger-Walker tied the Washington State women's basketball record for the quickest to 1,000 career points was WSU, as she accomplishes the feat in 57 career games, tying her with Jeanne Eggart. Leger-Walker scored a game-best 24 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor and tied for the team lead with six assists, a mark that was matched by senior Johanna Teder. Her 24-point effort marked the 25th time that Leger-Walker has scored 20-or-more points in a game in her career.

Washington State enjoyed an efficient shooting performance to put away the Panthers and move to 3-0 on the year. The Cougars shot 53.8 percent from the floor in the 28-point victory. The Cougars have now shot over 50 percent from the floor in two of their first three games. The Cougars led Prairie View A&M for all but three minutes of game time on Sunday.

The Cougars put the game out of reach in the third quarter, as WSU scored 39 points in the frame to set a program record for the most points scored in any quarter. Washington State went on a 22-0 run midway through the third quarter, which saw WSU's lead expand from a 12-point advantage to a 34-point lead.

LAIE, HAWAII – The Washington State women's basketball team was handed its first loss of the 2022-23 season Friday, Nov. 18, as the Cougars fell to BYU, 65-56, in their first game at the 2022 North Shore Showcase.

Washington State fell victim to a hot-shooting BYU squad that shot a blistering 75 percent over the first two quarters of play. Despite that, WSU was still able to keep the game manageable, as the Cougars trailed BYU by 12 points, 36-24, going into the break.

After falling down by a game-high 20 points early in the fourth quarter, Washington State attempted a comeback over the final 9:30 of game time. The Cougars battled throughout the fourth and cut their deficit to just nine points after a 3-point basket from senior Johanna Teder with 2:16 remaining in the game. That would be as close as the Cougars would get, as BYU was able to thwart WSU's comeback and collect a 65-56 victory.

Junior Charlisse Leger-Walker led the way for Washington State, as the guard from Waikato, New Zealand scored a game-high 21 points. It is Leger-Walker's third-straight 20-plus point performance, she has now collected 26 career games with 20-or-more points during her WSU career.

Teder joined Leger-Walker in the double-digit scoring column, as the guard from Tartu, Estonia chipped in 12 points. It is Teder's first double-digit scoring performance of the season, while it is the 15th time in her WSU career scoring 10-or-more points in a game.

GAME 6 - SOUTH DAKOTA STATE - W, 61-41

PULLMAN, Wash. –The Washington State women's basketball team put on a defensive clinic against South Dakota State Monday, Nov. 28, as the Cougars locked up the Jackrabbits to pick up a 61-41 win inside Beasley Coliseum.

The Cougars didn't allow SDSU to make a single field goal in the second quarter, as Washington State limited the Jackrabbits to just three points, all free throws, in the stanza. The three points are the fewest points that Washington State has allowed in a quarter in program history, matching the three points scored against them versus LMU in the fourth quarter on Nov. 11, 2016.

Senior Johanna Teder paced the Cougars against the defending WNIT Champions, as the guard from Estonia scored a season-high 17 points. It is the third-straight game that Teder has scored 10 or more points, as she hit a game-high three 3-pointers and shot a blistering 60% (6-of-10) from the field.

Fellow senior Bella Murekatete recorded her second-consecutive double-double, and her third in the last four games, with a 15-point, 11-rebound effort. It is Murekatete's eighth career double-double.

Junior Charliisse Leger-Walker and sophomore Tara Wallack rounded out the double-digit scoring for Washington State, as Leger-Walker scored 13 points in the win, while Wallack registered 10 points.
