COUGARS KICK OFF 2023 AT COLORADO STATE

Washington State opens the 2023 season with a trip to Fort Collins, Colo. for a Saturday matchup at Colorado State. Kickoff is set for 4 p.m. (PT) on CBS Sports Network.

SERIES HISTORY

Washington State evened the all-time series against Colorado State with a 38-7 win over the Rams in Pullman last season while CSU won the initial meeting, 48-45 in the 2013 New Mexico Bowl. WSU has won four of its last five season openers after beating Idaho 24-17 last season. The last time the Cougars opened the season on the road at a Mountain West Conference opponent, Gardner Minshew II led WSU to 41-19 win at Wyoming in 2018 and went on to a school-record 11-2 mark.

ABOUT WASHINGTON STATE

Washington State opened last season with three-straight wins, including a victory at No. 19 Wisconsin, and captured three of its final four games to reach a bowl game, the Jimmy Kimmel L.A. Bowl, for the seventh-straight season, the second-longest current bowl streak in the Pac-12 Conference. The Cougars, who went 7-6 including a 4-5 mark in Pac-12 play last season, again were strong defensively, finishing in the top four of numerous Pac-12 categories, including second in Red Zone defense and tackles-for-loss, third in scoring defense and turnovers gained, and fourth in sacks. WSU also led the Pac-12 in Red Zone offense. In 2022, WSU had 10 All-Pac-12 players, including honorable mention quarterback Cameron Ward and second-team selection EDGE Ron Stone Jr. while safety Jaden Hicks garnered third-Team Freshman All-America honors. Head coach Jake Dickert has guided WSU to back-to-back bowl games and begins his second full season leading the Cougars.

WSU ATHLETICS AND SOCIAL ISSUES

Over the past two years, Washington State Athletics has been proactive in providing opportunities for its student-athletes to lend their voices to social matters. Cougar football games are broadcast live on the radio throughout the Pacific Northwest via the Washington State Sports Network from Learfield. The 20-station football network reaches from Alaska to British Columbia to Oregon and across the state of Washington and can be heard worldwide via the internet on the Varsity Network App and Sirius XM Satellite radio. Cougar football broadcasts begin two hours before kickoff, carry through the game and conclude with post-game coach and player interviews and the Cougar Talk call-in show.

The Washington State Sports Network also features radio coverage of WSU men's basketball, baseball, women's basketball and women's volleyball, and the Cougar Coaches Show in the fall, winter and spring seasons.

Learfield manages corporate marketing opportunities and on-site promotions at WSU football and basketball games as well as oversees sales for all signage at Gesa Field, Friel Court at Beasley Coliseum and all Cougar competition sites.

SEVEN NAMED PRESEASON ALL-PAC-12

Seven Cougars were named to Preseason All-Pac-12 Conference Teams, the conference office announced Tuesday. Four players were named to the second team in EDGES Ron Stone Jr and Brennan Jackson, defensive back Chau Smith-Wade and punter Nick Haberer. Defensive back Jaden Hicks, kicker Dean Janikowski and running back Nakia Watson were each named honorable mention.

COLLEGE GAMEDAY RECORD

Dating back to the middle of the 2003 season, ESPN College GameDay has had the WSU flag appear throughout the show. The streak reached 287 after appearing at the 2022 Big 12 Championship Game. The first appearance came in Austin, Texas (10/4/03) and the streak began two weeks later in Madison, Wisc. (10/18/03). Two flags – Ol' Crimson and Gray – have been flown in the background of the GameDay set by dozens of friends and alumni. The Gray flag was added in 2014 after Whitey was retired in honor of Steve Gleason's "No White Flags." Appearance No. 217 was its first in Pullman (10/20/18), a 34-20 win over Oregon.

HICKS RETURNS AFTER FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICAN CAMPAIGN

Redshirt-freshman safety Jaden Hicks was named to the Freshman All-America Third Team by College Football News last season. Hicks was WSU's second Freshman All-American in as many seasons after punter Nick Haberer earned the honor in 2021 and is the first Cougar defensive player to earn Freshman All-America accolades since safety Jalen Thompson in 2016. Hicks enters the LA Bowl second on the team with 76 tackles, the most among Pac-12 freshmen defenders, along with two tackles-for-loss, one sack, six pass breakups, one interception and one fumble recovery he returned for a touchdown. The Las Vegas native recorded 10 tackles along with an interception in his first career start in the win over Colorado State and was named Pac-12 Conference Freshman of the Week after making six tackles and returning a fumble 17 yards for a touchdown in the win at Stanford.

DAIYAN HENLEY DRAFTED BY CHARGERS

Linebacker Daiyan Henley was selected in the third round by the Los Angeles Chargers in the 2023 NFL Draft. Henley, taken as the No. 22nd pick in the round and No. 85 overall, was the second Cougar defensive player drafted in as many years after cornerback Jaylen Watson was taken by the Kansas City Chiefs in the seventh round last season. Henley was the first Cougar linebacker drafted since Raonall Smith went to Minnesota Vikings in the second round of the 2002 draft. Henley transferred to Washington State prior to the 2022 season after four seasons at Nevada and in his only season with the Cougars earned All-American second-team honors from College Football News and was WSU's first Butkus Award Finalist in program history. Henley was also named to the All-Pac-12 Conference First Team as a linebacker and to the All-Pac-12 second team as an all-purpose/special teams player, WSU's first all-conference first-team linebacker since Will Derting in 2003. Henley was second in the Pac-12 with a team-high 106 tackles, fifth in the league with 12 tackles-for-loss and paced the team with six special teams tackles.

COUGAR DEFENSE LED THE WAY

- Jaden Hicks leads Pac-12 freshmen in tackles (76), named to Freshman All-America Third Team
- WSU made seven sacks in the win over Colorado State, tied for the seventh-most in WSU single-game history and most since 2017 (8, at Utah)
- WSU held USC quarterback Caleb Williams to 15-of-29 passing and 188 yds, season lows

CAMERON WARD PACES THE COUG RAID

In his first season with the Cougars, Ward was named All-Pac-12 Conference Honorable Mention after starting all 13 games last year, leading WSU to its seventh straight bowl game and throwing for 3,231 yards and 23 touchdowns. The junior from West Columbia, Texas recorded four 300-yard games, rushed for five touchdowns, had five games with one passing touchdown and one rushing touchdown and was named a semifinalist for the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award, given to the top offensive player from Texas. Last season, Ward completed 320 passes, the eighth-most in WSU single-season history while his 64.4 completion percentage was ninth-best in WSU single-season history.

NEW COACHES

OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR / QUARTERBACKS

Ben Arbuckle arrives in Pullman having spent the past two seasons at Western Kentucky, serving as the co-offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach during the 2022 season. In his first season in that role, Arbuckle took the Hilltoppers to great heights as the team finished sixth in total offense (497.3 ypg) and 15th in scoring (36.4 ppg), while quarterback Austin Reed led the nation in passing yards (4,746) and was third in passing touchdowns (40).

DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR / LINEBACKERS

Jeff Schmedding returns to the Pacific Northwest having spent the past two seasons at Auburn, most recently serving as defensive coordinator. In 2022, Schmedding oversaw the development of All-SEC First Team edge rusher Derick Hall, who totaled 60 tackles, 12 TFL's and seven sacks. In his first season at Auburn (2021), the Tigers ranked 29th in rushing defense and 17th in tackles-for-loss. Schmedding spent the previous two seasons at Boise State as the defensive coordinator where in his first season leading the defense saw the Broncos claim the Mountain West Championship and finish in the top 25 nationally in team sacks (37) and scoring defense (20.6 ppg).

WIDE RECEIVERS

Nick Edwards arrives in Pullman having spent the 2022 season as an offensive assistant with the Atlanta Falcons, working alongside the offensive coordinator with gameplan duties. Edwards joined Atlanta's staff after spending two seasons (2020-21) as the offensive coordinator and wide receivers coach at Cal Poly. Prior to his time at Cal Poly, Edwards spent three seasons (2017-19) as the wide receivers and running backs coach at Cal and three seasons (2014-16) at his alma mater, Eastern Washington, as the wide receivers coach where he coached future NFL wide receivers Cooper Kupp and Kendrick Bourne.

EDGES

Frank Maile (MY-lay) joins Dickert's staff having spent the past two seasons at Boise State where he served as the Broncos' assistant head coach and defensive line coach. During the 2022 season, the Bronco defense led the way to a 10-4 overall record, including a victory over North Texas in the Frisco Bowl. The Broncos finished ninth nationally in total defense and 16th in scoring defense.

STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING

Ben Iannacchione is no stranger to Dickert as the two worked together when both were on Craig Bohl's staff at Wyoming during the 2018-19 seasons. Iannacchione comes to Pullman having spent the 2022 season as the head strength and conditioning coach at Akron. A former standout offensive lineman who played collegiately at Boise State, Iannacchione arrived at Akron after spending the 2021 campaign at Pitt after prior stops on the football staffs at Kansas (2020), Wyoming (2018-19), LSU (2011-15, 2016-17) and Youngstown State (2015).

WASHINGTON STATE def. Colorado State, 38-7

PULLMAN, Wash. (AP) – Cameron Ward threw for 292 yards and four touchdowns Saturday as Washington State pounded Colorado State 38-7. Washington State (3-0) scored on its first four possessions to put this game away early. “We started fast,” Washington State coach Jake Dickert said. “That’s exactly what we needed to do in this football game.” Dickert said his team has bought into the concept of not looking ahead each week. “It’s important to take these one game at a time,” he said “They’ve bought into the mentality of not looking into the big picture.” Ward completed 26 of 36 passes and was intercepted once. Donovan Ollie and De’Zhaun Stribling each caught two touchdown passes. Freshman quarterback Clay Millen completed 24 of 34 passes for 211 yards for Colorado State (0-3), which has lost eight consecutive games dating to last season. Washington State sacked Millen seven times and limited Colorado State to 37 rushing yards on 30 carries. “He stays in there, takes hits and keeps going,” Dickert said of Millen. Washington State linebacker Daiyan Henley finished with 13 tackles, three sacks and three tackles for loss. “He’s out there making plays. He plays hard,” Dickert said. The Cougars marched 46 yards in four plays on their first possession, with Ward throwing a 17-yard touchdown pass to Ollie for a 7-0 lead. The Cougars took over at midfield again on their second series and Ward fired a 13-yard touchdown pass to Stribling for a 14-0 lead just five minutes into the game. Cayden Camper missed a 44-yard field-goal attempt for Colorado State and WSU marched 73 yards, with Ward hitting Stribling for a 19-yard touchdown and a 21-0 lead with more than 3 minutes left in the first quarter. Ward found Ollie for a 2-yard touchdown pass to cap an 82-yard drive that gave WSU to a 28-0 lead at half-time. Washington State went into the locker room with a 255-82 advantage in yards gained, along with four sacks and eight tackles for loss. Colorado State rushed 18 times in the first half, for just 4 net yards. The Rams did not score until the fourth quarter, on a 14-yard pass from Millen to Justus Ross-Simmons. The Cougars scored only one touchdown in the second half. “I’d like in the second half to keep firing and do some things,” Dickert said. Colorado State coach Jay Norvell said he was disappointed in his team’s play. “There’s just not enough continuity right now. Lots of young players on this team who just aren’t doing enough yet, but we’ll get there. We’re not discouraged,” Norvell said. The Rams have given up 23 sacks in three games this year, tops in the nation. “I hate seeing the quarterback get hit, we’re trying everything we can to keep him up,” Norvell added. “We haven’t found out how to do that to this point. We need to take better care of him.” FAST START Dickert became the first Washington State head coach to start his first full season with three consecutive victories since Mike Price in 1989. Dickert was named interim coach midway through last season when Nick Rolovich was fired for refusing the COVID-19 vaccine. BIG PICTURE Washington State: The Cougars were coming off an impressive 17-14 nonconference win at Wisconsin that knocked the Badgers out of the Top 25. This victory could lift the Cougars into the Top 25 for the first time since 2019. Colorado State: The Rams, a 16-point underdog, remain winless under new coach Jay Norvell, who was hired from Nevada. The Rams’ offense is struggling to score.

2013 NEW MEXICO BOWL
Dec. 21, 2013

Colorado State def. Washington State, 48-45

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. (AP) – With less than two minutes to play and Colorado State down by eight points, Shaquil Barrett knew the Rams needed the ball back quickly to finish an improbable comeback against Washington State. Once down by 22 points in the New Mexico Bowl, the Rams got their chance when Cougars running back Jeremiah Laufasa came barreling toward Barrett. “I was kind of thinking in my mind, yeah, ‘That was our shot to get back in the game right there,’” said Barrett, who stripped the ball. “I really didn’t think I was going to get the opportunity.” That fumble, at the Cougars 33, set up Kapri Bibbs’ 1-yard run score and Donnell Alexander’s two-point conversion run that tied it at 45 with 33 seconds left. Then, Washington State’s Teondray Caldwell fumbled a kick-off return at the 24, setting up Jared Roberts’ 41-yard field goal with 3 seconds left that gave Colorado State a 48-45 victory Saturday. It was a quarterback shootout that saw close to 800 passing yards combined and a game largely dominated by Washington State until the last 2 minutes. And Colorado State did not have a led the entire game until that winning field goal. “That win right there...it’s pretty amazing how it worked but at the end of the day, it’s about being resilient,” Rams coach Jim McElwain. “It’s about understanding (that) every play has a history and life of its own.” Garrett Grayson threw for 369 yards and Bibbs ran for 169 yards and three touchdowns for Colorado State (8-6). The Rams overcame three early turnovers. “I’m still kind of at a loss for words about how that whole thing ended up,” Rams center Weston Richburg said. “It must have been destiny. That’s the most unbelievable game I’ve ever been a part of.” Meanwhile, Washington State’s Connor Halliday threw touchdown passes to six receivers and finished with 410 yards for Washington State (6-7). Those six touchdown passes tied West Virginia’s Geno Smith and Iowa’s Chuck Long for an NCAA bowl record. After the first touchdown pass, Halliday got into a shouting match with a Colorado State coach when Halliday ran into the Rams’ sideline. That exchange created a social media buzz and McElwain vowed look into it. “Coach grabbed me and said some profane things to me and that’s all I’ll say about it,” Halliday said. Washington State scored 35 points in the first half, but had only 10 in the second. With the game winding down, a lack of a running game forced the Cougars to stay with their spread offense and prevented them for running down the clock when ahead by 15 points in the fourth quarter. “Colorado State finished the game. We didn’t,” Washington State coach Mike Leach said. “They finished the game better than we did. The lesson to be learned from that is it doesn’t matter where you’re at. You need to go out and finish the game.” Washington State rushed for minus-10 yards total. The match-up brought together two second-year coaches working to turn around their teams’ fortunes with high-octane offenses. Colorado State had not played in a postseason game since 2008. Washington State had not been in a bowl game since 2003. McElwain predicted the bowl victory would help the Rams with recruiting and said it was evidence how far the program had come. “Unbelievable,” McElwain said. “You don’t write scripts like this.”

JAKE DICKERT
HEAD COACH / SECOND YEAR

Washington State University Director of Athletics Pat Chun announced Nov. 27, 2021 that Jake Dickert had been named the Cougars' Head Football Coach. Dickert agreed in principle to a five-year contract in becoming the 34th head football coach in program history.

Dickert began the 2022 season, his first full year leading WSU, with three-straight wins, including a victory at No. 19 Wisconsin. The win was WSU's first in three meetings against the Badgers and WSU's first regular-season nonconference road win over a ranked team since 2003. The Cougars captured three of its final four games and reached a bowl game, the Jimmy Kimmel L.A. Bowl, for the seventh-straight season, the second-longest current streak in the Pac-12. Under Dickert's leadership, WSU again was strong defensively, finishing in the top four of numerous Pac-12 categories, including second in Red Zone defense and tackles-for-loss, third in scoring defense and turnovers gained, and fourth in sacks. WSU also led the Pac-12 in Red Zone offense. In 2022, WSU had 10 All-Pac-12 players, including first-team linebacker and third-team All-American Daiyan Henley, while safety Jaden Hicks garnered third-Team Freshman All-America honors. Henley was selected in the third round of the NFL Draft by his hometown Los Angeles Chargers.

Dickert spent the final five games of the 2021 regular season serving as the Cougar's acting head coach, leading WSU to a 3-2 record with wins over Arizona State, Arizona and a dominating 40-13 Apple Cup victory in Seattle before WSU earned a trip to the Tony The Tiger Sun Bowl. The Apple Cup win snapped a seven-game skid to Washington and was WSU's largest margin of victory in series history.

Under Dickert's leadership, the Cougar defense was a huge spark in 2021, leading the Pac-12 with 29 takeaways, fifth-most nationally, while also leading the Pac-12 and tied for ninth nationally in turnover margin. Last season, 14 players earned All-Pac-12 honors including first-team selections in right tackle Abraham Lucas, kicker Dean Janikowski and EDGE Ron Stone Jr. while punter Nick Haberer was named a Freshman All-American. In the 2022 NFL Draft, offensive lineman Abraham Lucas was selected in the second round by the Seattle Seahawks and cornerback Jaylen Watson went in the seventh round to the Kansas City Chiefs.

Entering the 2021 season, Dickert was in his second year as WSU's defensive coordinator and linebackers coach. In his first season in

Pullman, the Washington State defense produced four All-Pac-12 Conference selections including linebacker Jahad Woods, who was second on the team with 31 tackles and led the team with 4.5 tackles-for loss. The Cougars led the league with eight forced fumbles and was fourth in rush defense (154.8), a 30-yard improvement from the previous season.

Dickert arrived at WSU after working three seasons at the University of Wyoming (2017-19) including the 2019 campaign as the defensive coordinator while working with the linebackers and safeties.

In 2019, the Cowboys were sixth in the country in red zone defense, No. 11 in the country in rush defense (107.1) and scoring defense (17.8), No. 40 tackles-for-loss (83) and No. 43 in total defense. Dickert saw four Cowboys earned All-Mountain West Conference honors led by second-team All-American linebacker and Butkus Award Finalist Logan Wilson while redshirt-freshman defensive end Solomon Byrd was named a Freshman All-American by the Football Writers Association of America.

Dickert originally joined the Wyoming football staff in February, 2017 and coached the safeties for the 2017 and 2018 seasons before he was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2019 where he started the season coaching the linebackers and later coached the safeties. In his three seasons at Wyoming, Dickert coached a pair of future NFL safeties including three-time first-team All-Mountain West Conference pick Andrew Wingard and saw four players earn All-MWC honors in 2019 while another earned 2019 Freshman All-America accolades on the defensive line.

In 2018, Wyoming's defense was among the best in the nation, finishing the season No. 19 in total defense (326.2), No. 25 in rushing defense (129.5), No. 28 in scoring defense (22.0) and No. 32 in pass defense (196.7). Dickert coached senior safeties Andrew Wingard and Marcus Epps as Wingard ended his career tied for the Mountain West Conference career tackle record with 454. Wingard earned First Team All-Mountain West honors for the third consecutive season after being named to the preseason watch lists for the Chuck Bednarik, Bronko Nagurski and Jim Thorpe Awards in both 2017 and 2018. Epps concluded his career as the only three-time team captain in the modern era of Cowboy

Football, recorded 325 career tackles and was a finalist for the 2018 Burlsworth Trophy, which is awarded to the nation's most outstanding player who began his career as a walk-on. Epps was selected in the sixth round of the 2019 NFL Draft by the Minnesota Vikings where he played in seven games before playing in eight more with the Philadelphia Eagles. Wingard played in the 2019 East-West Shrine Game, was invited to the 2019 NFL Draft Combine and signed a free-agent contract with the Jacksonville Jaguars where he played all 16 games and made two starts as a rookie.

In his first season at Wyoming, Dickert help the 2017 Cowboy defense become one of the best groups in the country as they led the countr in takeaways (38), ranked ninth in scoring defense (17.5), were first in fumbles recovered (18), second in interceptions (20), eighth in defensive touchdowns scored (4 TD), No. 13 in pass defense (174.9) and No. 23 in total defense (335.2). Dickert coached first-team All-Mountain West strong safety Wingard while the safety tandem of Wingard and Epps led the Pokes in interceptions in 2017, with five and four interceptions, respectively.

Before arriving at Wyoming, Dickert spent the 2016 season as the safeties coach and co-special teams coordinator at South Dakota State. Earlier in his career, Dickert was a part of Bohl's coaching staff at North Dakota State from 2008-10.

In his one season on the South Dakota State coaching staff, Dickert helped guide the Jackrabbits to the 2016 Missouri Valley Football Conference Championship and a No. 8 seed in the 2016 NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Playoffs, where they advanced to the FCS National Quarterfinals.

As defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Minnesota State, Mankato for the 2014 and 2015 seasons Dickert was part of a coaching staff that led the Mavericks to back-to-back Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) championships and consecutive NCAA Division II Playoff berths, earning their way to the 2014 National Championship Game. Minnesota State posted a combined record of 24-3 over that two-year span. Dickert's 2014 defense ranked second in the nation in scoring defense (12.9), fourth in turnovers gained, No. 12 in pass defense efficiency and No. 15 in total defense. In 2015, the Mavericks ranked fifth in the nation in scoring defense (16.1), third in rushing defense, seventh in pass defense efficiency and sixth in total defense. He coached 16 All-Conference players, three First Team All-Americans and

a two-time Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Defensive Player of the Year.

In his first season as a college defensive coordinator in 2013 at Augustana, Dickert's defense ranked No. 20 in the nation at the NCAA Division II level in scoring defense, giving up only 19.5 ppg. Augustana ranked second in the NSIC in pass defense, third in rushing defense and third in total defense. He coached five All-Conference players at Augustana.

In 2012, he served as the defensive backs coach at Southeast Missouri State. The Redhawks ranked No. 18 in the nation in turnovers gained (25) and No. 23 in interceptions (13). Southeast Missouri State ranked No. 2 in the Ohio Valley Conference in pass defense. Dickert also coached a First Team All-Conference strong safety at Southeast Missouri.

Dickert spent the 2011 season as the special teams coordinator and defensive backs coach at South Dakota, where the Coyotes ranked second in the Great West Conference in fewest passing yards allowed and interceptions. He coached three all-conference performers while at South Dakota and his special teams units ranked in the Top 10 in the nation in punting average and net punting and had an individual rank in the Top 10 in punt return yards.

He joined the North Dakota State coaching



staff in 2008 as a defensive graduate assistant on Bohl's staff. In 2009 and 2010, he was elevated to serve as safeties coach for the Bison. The 2010 NDSU team advanced to the FCS National Quarterfinals. Dickert began his college coaching career in 2007 as a defensive graduate assistant at his alma mater, Wisconsin-Stevens Point.

He played football at Wisconsin-Stevens Point from 2002-06 where he earned All-Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) honors as a wide receiver his senior season of 2006 and was named his team's Wide Receiver of the Year both his junior and senior seasons. Dickert earned his bachelor's degree in secondary math education from Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 2007, and completed his master's degree in general education, also from UW-Stevens Point in 2009.

He and his wife, Candice, have three children, daughter Rylee and sons Jett and Jace.
