No. 5 and top seeded West Texas A&M will face No. 8 seed Daemen in the 2021 NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Elite Eight on Wednesday, March 24, at the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind.

WINNING IS FUN, ESPECIALLY IN LUBBOCK

WT faced No. 10 Lubbock Christian for the third time on March 16 in the NCAA DII South Central Final at the Rip Griffin Center in Lubbock. The Buffs led by 10 at halftime and never looked back as they defeated the Chaps 101-92 to punch their ticket to this week's NCAA DII Elite Eight.

Qua Grant scored a career-high 40 points in the victory as the Buffs shot 55.7 percent from the floor, 43.8 percent from beyond the arc and 83.6 percent from 3-point range.

BACK TO MAKE THINGS RIGHT

The Buffs return to Evansville, Ind. looking for revenge after suffering a 94-84 defeat to hometown Southern Indiana in 2018. Grant and Joel Murray are the players left on the roster that faced the Eagles that day in front of NCAA DII tournament record 7,330 fans.

BIG GAME QUA

Grant has turned it up a notch (if that is possible) during the Buffs run to their third straight Elite Eight appearance. He was named the South Central Region Most Valuable Player after averaging 30 points and six rebounds per game. He scored a career-high 40 points against LCU in the final connecting on a career-best seven 3-pointers.

In six NCAA Tournament games, Grant is averaging 24.3 points per game shooting 54.3 percent from the floor, 43.2 percent from three and 84.8 percent from the free throw line. He scored 27 points against USI in their last trip to Evansville and the Ford Center.

NABC ALL-DISTRICT HONORS

Grant and Murray were both named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District First Team on Tuesday. It marks the second straight season that the dynamic duo has earned first team all-district honors.

Murray is having one of the best offensive seasons in program history as the junior guard is scoring a Lone Star Conference-best 23.5 points per game shooting 48.9 percent from the floor, 31.0 percent from 3-point range and 80.8 percent from the free throw line.

Grant picks up NABC All-District honors for a third straight year after averaging a career-best in points, rebounds and assists. The junior guard is scoring 22.5 points, 8.3 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game having recorded eight double-doubles and the program's first triple-double under seventh year head coach Tom Brown.

SURVIVE AND ADVANCE

Survive and advance. A phrase that is nearly used as much in March as the newest hit single from Lady Gaga. But the truth is that the Buffs have done a great job of winning games in March during Tom Brown's seven years as head coach.

WT is 11-3 in the NCAA Tournament under Brown including eight straight wins in the regional portion of the tournament. Wednesday's game will be their second game against the East Region Champion after defeating LeMoyne 87-73 at the 2018 NCAA DII Championships behind a 25-point, 10 rebound double-double from All-American Ryan Quaid.

A win over Daemen would make WT the second team in LSC history to make two Final Four appearances as Tarleton State accomplished the feat in 2005 and 2016.

A LOOK AT THE NCAA RANKINGS

Entering Wednesday's game, WT ranks in the Top 10 NCAA DII men's basketball in six different categories. They rank third in turnover margin (+6.70) and fourth in turnovers per game (17.7/game).

They also own of the top scoring offenses in the nation ranking sixth in points per game (91.6) and eighth in scoring margin (+15.2). Their 11.4 3-pointers per game are also the seventh-most per game.

Individually, Murray ranks seventh in field goal attempts (322) and ninth in points per game. The junior also ranks 10th in free throws made and 12th in free throw attempts.

DAEMEN

Daemen located in Amherst, N.Y. enters the Elite Eight with a record of 10-5 after defeating No. 11 St. Thomas Aquinas 71-70 in the East Region Final.

The Wildcats are led by Mike MacDonald, who is in his seventh season at Daemen after stints at Medaille College and Canisius. He has accumulated a record of 396-282 during his 24 seasons as a head coach.

The Wildcats are led by redshirt senior Andrew Sischo, who enters Wednesday's game averaging 26.7 points and 12.8 rebounds per game. He has recorded a double-double in all but two games including a 31-point, 21 rebound performance against D'Youville.

The Guilderland, N.Y. native has appeared in 103 games including 87 starts during his career. He has scored over 2,000 points and is averaging 21.3 points and 10.5 rebounds all while shooting 60.8 percent from the floor and 71.2 percent from the free throw line.

Sean Fasoyiro earned NABC All-District honors along with Sischo as the graduate student is averaging 13.8 points and 7.4 rebounds per game after transferring from Franklin Pierce. The Houston native has scored in double figures in 11 games with a season-best against D'Youville.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Wednesday will be the first all-time meeting between the two programs.

It will also mark the Buffs first game against a member of the East Coast Conference.

Tom Brown was hired as the 17th head coach in West Texas A&M men's basketball history on April 16, 2014. During his six years at WT, Brown is 162-140 (.802) building the Buffs into one of the top NCAA Division II men's basketball programs in the nation.

In 2019-20, Brown was named the LSC Coach of the Year for a third consecutive year after leading the Buffs to the No. 1 seed and host of the NCAA DII South Central Regional for the third straight year before the season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. They won 30 straight games for the third straight season, 32-1, where they finished the season on a program best 23 game win streak. They also own the nation's longest home win streak at 42 games after going 16-0 at the First United Bank Center.

WT defeated No. 9 St. Edward's in the LSC Championship game, 81-65, to become the second school in conference history to win three straight titles and first since 1987. Joel Murray was named the Tournament's Most Valuable Player after going for 21 points and eight rebounds in the final in Frisco. Murray and Qua Grant were named NABC All-Americans while also being named to the Bevo Francis Top 25 Watch List.

Grant was named the D2CCA First Team All-American honors after earning South Central Regional Player of the Year. The sophomore became the second straight Buff to be named to the LSC Player of the Year after leading the team in scoring in rebounding. Murray also earned First Team All-LSC and All-Defensive Team honors with Derrick Geddis (Third Team), Jon'il Fugett (Honorable Mention) and Zach Toussaint (All-Freshman) also earning conference recognition.

Jordan Collins finished his four-year career as the winningest player in program history (124-18) while ranking sixth in 3-point makes and attempts. He went an incredible 65-1 at home since joining the program in 2016. He scored a career-high 20 points on Senior Night at the FUBC going 6-of-13 from beyond the arc. He also went 4-of-5 from downtown against SEU to help WT overcome a double-digit first half deficit.

Eric Mosley appeared in third most games in program history (121) during his career as a Buff. The 6 foot 5 guards started in all 33 games as a senior in 2019-20 where he averaged a career-high 5.9 points and 4.9 rebounds per game. He scored a career-high 15 points against Lubbock Christian on Jan. 6 to give Brown his first win over the Chaps in Lubbock. He also made four 3-pointers in LSC Championship against the nationally ranked Hilltoppers.

In 2018-19, Brown took WT to new heights again

as he led the Buffs to another school record of 34 wins. Breaking the previous record of 32 wins set in 2017-18. This is the second time in WT history that the basketball program has reached the 30-plus win plateau. Coach Brown also led the squad to a Lone Star Conference Regular Season Title as well as the Lone Star Conference Tournament Title. The Buffs went on to host and win the NCAA Division II South Central Region Championship. The Buffs knocked off then #4 ranked St. Edward's in the regional championship game to capture the South Central Title in the First United Bank Center. WT finished the season 34-4 and an appearance in the Elite Eight in Evansville, IN. After winning a program-record 19 straight games and being ranked in the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Top 25 all season the Buffs finished the season ranked #3 in the country. The Buffs have won more games each year (17, 21, 26, 32, 34) and have never had a losing season with Coaches Brown/Gove/Henderson and Kratz on the sidelines.

Brown won his 100th game on the road in a 112-87 victory over Adams State on November 10, 2018 in Gunnison, CO making him the fastest to 100 wins in school history.

Protecting home court has been a point of emphasis for Coach Brown and the Buffs. The Buffs finished the season a perfect 17-0 at home improving Brown's record at the friendly confines of the First United Bank Center to an incredible 74-8 (.902). The fans have shown their support for the Buffs as the Buffs Finished 1st in the LSC and 9th in the nation in total attendance (25,161). Brown was named the LSC Coach of the Year after leading the Buffs to a 17-1 LSC record.

Ryan Quaid was recognized as one of the top players in the nation as the senior earned numerous All-American honors. Ryan throughout his career has amassed an incredible amount of honors. Just to name a few, Ryan was honored as the Academic Player of the Year, LSC Player of the Year and the South Central Region Player of the Year. He finished his four-year career as the program's all-time leader in rebounds while becoming the first player to record 1,700 points, 1,000 rebounds and 100 blocks in a career. He finishes his career at WT with a 113-27 career record (winningest player in WT History). He played in three NCAA Sweet 16's, two NCAA Elite 8's and one NCAA Final 4. Ryan Quaid is from Fort Collins, CO and graduated with a double major in Finance and Accounting.

Gach Gach was a starter for two seasons and played on the two best teams ever to play at WT. He won Back2Back LSC and LSC Tournament Titles. His LSC Tournament record was a perfect 6-0. His NCAA South

Central Regional Record was also a perfect 6-0. In his career he made 152 3-Pointers (6th All-Time), attempted 473 3-Pointers (5th All-Time) and finished with 748 Career points in 2 Seasons. He played in two NCAA Elite 8's and one NCAA Final 4. Gach was honored by the WT Buffalo Club as the Student Athlete of the Month (December 2018). He has an unprecedented record of 66-8 (.891). Gach Gach is from Austin, MN and graduated with a SES Degree.

Brandon Hall started every game on the winningest team in WT school history. He led the Buffs to a LSC and LSC Tournament title. Brandon was named LSC Tournament Most Valuable Player as he had 32 Points and 10 Rebounds in the Lone Star Conference Title Game! He led the team to the South Central Regional Title and a trip to the Elite 8. Brandon finished his career with the best winning percentage in school history. Brandon was 34-4 (.894) in his career here at WT. Brandon Hall is from Arlington, TX and will graduate with a Sport Leadership and Recreation degree from Emporia State.

Qua Grant had an impressive freshman season under Coach Brown as the Waxahachie, Texas native was named the Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year while earning 1st Team All-LSC and 1st Team All South Central Region. Qua was also named the Freshman of the Year at the All-Sports Banquet at WT.

Joel Murray also made an impression on the LSC as he was named to the Lone Star Conference All-Defensive Team as well as 2ndteam All-LSC. The Buffs led the nation in two categories in 2018-19, including three-point field goals attempted (1,128) and free throws attempted (859). They also ranked second in free throws made (600) and fifth in three-point field goals made (381).

In 2017-18, the Buffs accomplished a record-setting year on many fronts. Coach Brown and the Buffs won an incredible 32 games breaking a 76 year old record of 29 wins, set back in 1940-41. Brown also guided WT to its first Lone Star Conference regular season title since 1994 and won the program's first Lone Star Conference Tournament title since 2007. The Buffs went 25-3 during the regular season and hosted the first NCAA South Central Regional since 1997-98. The Buffs went on to win the South Central Regional in a heated game vs UTPB. The Buffs led 50-32 at halftime and withstood some serious blows to end up winning 95-87. The Buffs advanced to the Elite 8 in Sioux Falls, SD where they took down #5 seed Le Moyne College and Coach Patrick Beilein. The Buffs finished their season making the NCAA Final 4 for the first time in school history. WT was ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the season in the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Top 25 as well as being ranked in every poll throughout the season!

Senior David Chavlovich become the most decorated player in program history as he earned multiple All-American selections, while earning first team all-conference honors for the fourth time and was named South Central Region Tournament Most Valuable Player. He owns the LSC record for career scoring with 2,490 points, ranking in the top 30 all-time in NCAA Division II. Chavlovich finished his senior campaign second in field goal attempts with 537. Senior Jordan Evans earned second team all-conference honors. Jordan leaves with 1,455 career points and tallied a school-record 135 triples in 2017-18, ranking second nationally, while leading the nation in 3-point field goal attempts with 327. Junior Ryan Quaid was named LSC Academic Player of the Year, as well as first team all-LSC. Freshman Gaige Prim was named LSC Freshman of the Year. Brown earned LSC Coach of the Year honor and South Central Regional Coach of the Year honor. Brown has guided the Buffs to four-straight winning seasons.

The Buffs led the nation in four categories this season, including 3-point field goals made (421), 3-point field goals attempted (1,333), free throws made (695) and

free throws attempted (894). WT finished third in rebounding (1,464), while ranking seventh in scoring margin (14.6) and ninth in scoring offense at 88.4 points per game.

In 2016-17, Brown guided the team to a 26-9 record with six wins over ranked teams as the Buffs were ranked as high as No. 11 nationally during the season. WT won two NCAA South Central Region Tournament games for the first time since 1997-98, reaching the postseason for the first time since 2011-12 and making the program's 14th overall appearance. Brown guided the Buffs to their second Sweet 16 and first Sweet 16 since 1997-98. The 26 wins by the Buffs were the most since the 1997-98 season. WT won 25 NCAA Division II games in 2016-17, marking the most Division II wins in a season and the 26 overall wins ties for fourth-most in program history. Chavlovich earned first team all-conference honors for the third-straight year, while Evans earned second team honors, senior Eric Golightly, Jr., and Quaid were named to the LSC All-Academic Team. Under Brown's guidance, Chavlovich became the program's all-time leading scorer for the Buffs with 1,762 career points as he surpassed former Buff Martin Lattibeaudiere (1993-97) with 1,566 points.

In 2015-16, Brown and the Buffs continued their upward ascent both regionally and nationally. Brown guided the Buffs to a 21-10 season, marking the team's first 20-plus win season since 2010-11. WT finished second in the Lone Star Conference, marking the highest finish for the program since the LSC moved away from divisions. Chavlovich earned NABC All-America honors, named LSC Player of the Year honors and sophomore Jordan Evans received honorable mention all-league honors in his first playing season.

In 2014-15, Coach Brown's inaugural season at WT he inherited a program coming off a 10-17 campaign in 2013-14. Brown was left with three seniors and a walk on freshman. He quickly turned the program around going 17-12 and 7-7 in Lone Star Conference play after the Buffs won just two league games the season before. Brown guided the team to a fifth-place league finish in his inaugural campaign. Senior Miles Gatewood earned honorable mention all-conference honors, senior Tez Dumars surpassed Maurice Cheeks in career scoring finishing fourth all-time in points scored, while senior Antjuan Ball was honored on the LSC All-Defensive Team. Freshman and Brown's recruit, David Chavlovich, began his storied career leading the team in scoring, earning second team all-conference honors and LSC Freshman of the Year accolades, averaging 16.5 points to go along with 93 assists and 30 steals. Prior to West Texas A&M, Tom Brown was the Associate Head Coach and recruiting coordinator at NCAA Division II Winona State University in Winona, MN (1998-

2014). While at Winona State, Brown and the Warriors won the NCAA Division II National Championship in 2006 and 2008. During that time the team compiled an impressive record of 105-6. Brown and the Warriors went to the NCAA Tournament 10 times and a string of seven-straight from 2005-2011. Brown and the Warriors reached the Elite Eight four times, most recently in 2013. Named Division II Bulletin's 'Program of the Decade' for 2000-2009, WSU set a NCAA Division II record with 57 consecutive wins, a run that began on Jan. 13, 2006, and didn't end until the national title game on Mar. 24, 2007. With Coach Brown on the sidelines the 2007-08 Warrior squad won a NCAA record 38 games. Brown and WSU won over 20 games in each of the past 10 seasons as Brown's record as Associate Head Coach was 368-139 (.726).

Brown attended and played basketball at Winona State from 1988-1992. He finished his Warrior career ranked fifth in program history in scoring, second in assists and first in steals. He earned his bachelor's degree in 1993 in physical education and completed his master's degree in education in 1998.

Prior to Winona State, Brown was the Head Basketball Coach, Golf Coach, Junior High Cross Country Coach and Athletic Director at Gilmanton HS in Gilmanton, WI (1994-98). Coach Brown's basketball team had four winning seasons and won two regional titles as well as two conference titles.

He and his wife, Dr. Trisha Brown, are the proud parents of three children, TJ, Zach and Ella. Dr. Brown currently is an Assistant Professor in the Sports & Exercise Science Department at West Texas A&M University.

Associate Head Coach | Seventh Season at West Texas A&M
Winona State '04 | Business Administration



Gove begins his 7th season as Associate Head Coach at West Texas A & M University leading the Buffs to the No. 1 seed in the NCAA DII South Central Regional for a third consecutive season in 2019-20. The Championships were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic before the Buffs had a chance to defend their regional title at the First United Bank Center.

There is not a more decorated Associate Head Coach in Division II than Coach Gove. In his 22 years he has helped lead teams to 2 National Titles, 1 National Runner-Up, 1 Final Four appearance and 6 Regional Titles. Gove also has lead teams to NCAA Division II records of 38 wins in a single season (2008) and 57 consecutive wins (2006-2007). Throughout his career, Gove's teams have made 14 NCAA tournament appearances with an overall record of 32-11 in NCAA Tournament games played.

Taking over a last place program going into the 2015 season, Gove has been instrumental in transforming the Buffs into a Division II National Power. Currently, Gove has helped lead the Buffs to 3 straight outright LSC Regular Season Championships, along with 3 straight LSC Conference tournament Titles. The Buffs have won over 30 games 3 straight seasons and have a record of 98-9 during this time. Those 98 wins are the most by any program at any level of NCAA basketball during this time-frame. In Gove's 6 years with the Buffs, the Buffs have been to a Sweet 16, Elite 8 and Final 4, not including what may have happened during the 19-20 season. In his 6 seasons, he has coached 4 All-Americans, 3 LSC Players of the Year, 3 LSC Freshman of the Year 2 D2CCA Regional Players of the Year and 1 LSC Academic Player of the Year.

In 2019-20, WT won more than 30 games for third straight season, one shy of the NCAA DII record. They finished 32-1 including a 21-1 record in LSC play while winning the LSC Championship for a third consecutive season. The Buffs ranked second nationally in turnovers forced, turnover margin and 3-point defense.

During the 2018-19 season, Ryan Quaid was named the D2CCA South Central Region Player of the Year after leading the Buffs to a program record 34-4 record and second consecutive trip to the NCAA DII Elite Eight. The Buffs also won the LSC Regular Season Title outright, along

with the LSC Conference Tournament.

During the 2017-2018 season, WT made their first-ever trip to the Final Four led by the program's all-time leading scorer David Chavlovich. They won a then-record 32 games en route to winning the program's first outright conference title since 1994. The Buffs also won the LSC Conference Tournament Title.

Prior to WT, Gove spent 16 years as an Assistant Coach at Winona State University turning that program into a National Power. Gove helped coach Winona State to the NCAA Division II National Championship in 2006 and 2008, while also playing for the title in 2007. Winona State set a NCAA Division II record with 57 consecutive wins. The 2007-08 Warrior squad won 38 games, an all-division NCAA record and WSU posted a 105-6 combined record during the 2005-06 through 2007-08 seasons. Winona's consistent success allowed the Warriors to be named Division II Bulletin's "Program of the Decade" for the first decade of the 21st century.

In 16 years at Winona State University, Gove coached 3 National Players of the Year, 4 NCAA Regional Players of the Year, 12 NABC All-Region Players, 27 First Team All-Conference Players, 7 Defensive Players of the Year, and 5 Conference Players of the Year. During that span he was part of 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, 6 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference regular season titles and 5 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Tournament titles.

While at Winona State University, Gove also spent 3 seasons with the WSU Baseball program. In 1998 Gove helped lead the baseball program to their first Division II regional appearance in school history, this also marked the first regional appearance for any team sport at WSU at the Division II level. During those 3 seasons Gove helped lead the baseball program to two NCAA Division II Regional Appearances, 2 Regular Season Conference Titles along with 2 Conference Tournament Titles.

Gove also spent 6 years (2006-2011) as a high school baseball in Wabasha, Minn. In his six seasons, he led the Wabasha-Kellogg Falcons to four Conference Titles and three State Tournament appearances with one runner-up finish. The Three-Rivers Conference titles were the first for the school in 24 years while the State Tournament Appearances were the first in 26 years. The 2009 State Runner-Up finish was the best season in school history.

Gove played basketball at Winona State for two seasons and baseball for three seasons at WSU. As a baseball player, he started at first base on WSU's 1992 NAIA third-place team and was also an NAIA Honorable Mention All-American during the 1994 season. Gove holds degrees in Business Administration and Physical Education from Winona State and he earned a Master of Science degree from WSU in 2004.

Gove and his wife Katie are the proud parents of two daughters, Sydney and Jordyn.

Henderson begins his 7th season on the Buffalo coach staff and second as associate head coach.

The Buffs won 30-plus games for the third consecutive year in 2019-20 as they won the program's third straight Lone Star Conference Championship. They finished the season 32-1 including a program record 23 game win streak before the season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Quaid was named the D2CCA South Central and LSC Player of the Year after leading the Buffs in scoring, rebounding and steals.

In 2018-19, WT won a program record 34 games en route to their second straight run to the Elite Eight after defeating No. 3 St. Edward's in the regional final in Canyon at the First United Bank Center. Under Henderson's tutelage, Ryan Quaid was named the regional and conference player of the year after averaging 15.9 points and 7.6 rebounds. The Fort Collins, Colo. native also finished his career as the program's all-time leader in rebounds with 1,004.

The 2017-2018 campaign marked the greatest run in WT Basketball history as the Buffs finished the season with a 32-4 overall record, a Lone Star Conference Title an appearance in WT's first ever NCAA DII Final Four.

Henderson came to Canyon following a two year coaching stint at Division III perennial power, Illinois Wesleyan under head coach Ron Rose. While at Illinois Wesleyan, Henderson was an integral part of constructing two of the best seasons in program history. He led the team to a 27-5 overall record in his final season, culminating with a conference title, and an appearance in the NCAA Division III Final Four. The 27 wins were the first time the program had achieved this win total since 1997, and only the third time the Titans amassed 27 or more wins dating back to 1947. During the 2013 season, IWU posted a 23-6 record, won the conference title and advanced to the Sweet 16. Henderson helped develop four First Team and two Second Team All-Conference selections in his two-year tenure with the Titans. IWU went an impressive 50-11 during Henderson's time in Bloomington, Ind.

A 6-5 guard/forward, Henderson attended and played at Division I Creighton for two seasons. In 2003 the Bluejays posted a 29-5 record while winning the Missouri Valley Tournament and advancing to the NCAA Tournament as a #6 seed. In 2004 the Bluejays made another post-season appearance and played host to the first round of the NIT Tournament.

Henderson transferred to Winona State in 2005 where he played under current Buffs head coach Tom Brown. In Henderson's three seasons at Winona State the Warriors dominated the Division II landscape en route to being named the Division II Team of the Decade. As a three-year starter for the Warriors, in his first year he led the program to its first ever National Championship in 2006. He followed that up with another trip to the National Championship game and a runner-up finish in 2007. He concluded his illustrious career with another National Championship in 2008.

Henderson, who averaged 9.0 points and 5.0 rebounds with the Warriors, finished his three-year career with an astounding 105-6 record. Within this historic run he propelled his team to an NCAA DII record 57 game win streak and a single season record of 38 victories. This three-year stint also included three Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference titles and three NSIC Tournament Titles.

Following his collegiate career, Henderson played professionally for the Kilsyth Cobras of the Southeast Australian Basketball League. While there his teams advanced to the SEABL playoffs in three consecutive years and won the division title in 2010. While guiding the Cobras for three seasons he was named league Defensive Player of the Year twice.

Henderson grew up in Madison, Wis., where he attended La Follette High School. He was a First Team All-State basketball and volleyball player for the Lancers. Henderson led LFHS to a Wisconsin (WIAA) Division I basketball State Championship in 2002.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Winona State in 2007 and his master's in Sports Management from Illinois State in 2014.
