FINAL ROAD TRIP: Central Oklahoma makes its final road trip of the 2011 season Saturday, traveling to Topeka, Kan. to take on unbeaten and No. 5-ranked Washburn.

Kickoff at 7,200-seat Yager Stadium at Moore Bowl is 1 p.m.

The Bronchos are 1-5 on the season and looking to end a 10-game road losing streak. The Ichabods are 6-0 and have won 10 straight.

It's the sixth road game in seven outings for UCO, which ends the season with a four-game homestand.

The Bronchos will also be taking on their second top-10 team of the season on the road, having opened the 2011 campaign at then-No. 6 and now-No. 1 North Alabama.

ABOUT THE SERIES: It's the first-ever meeting between the two teams, who will become conference rivals next year when UCO joins the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association.

LAST WEEK: UCO gave Football Championship Subdivision-member Cal Poly all it could handle last week in San Luis Obispo, Calif. before falling 44-25.

The Bronchos overcame an early 10-3 deficit to take a 19-10 half-time lead and were ahead 25-24 early in the fourth quarter before the Mustangs scored 20 points in the final 11 minutes -- getting the final score with just 25 seconds left -- to quell UCO's upset bid.

Quarterback **Ethan Sharp** completed 30-of-50 passes for 290 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Bronchos.

NEXT WEEK: UCO begins a four-game season-ending homestand next week against future MIAA rival Fort Hays State.

TOUGH OPPONENTS: Central Oklahoma has played a rugged schedule this season, with its first six opponents a combined 21-13.

Season-opening foe North Alabama -- now ranked No. 1 in NCAA Division II -- is 6-0, while Southwestern Oklahoma and East Central are 4-2. Angelo State is 3-3, with Southeastern Oklahoma and FCS-member Cal Poly both 2-3.

INDEPENDENCE, THEN MIAA: UCO is competing as an NCAA Division II independent this year after ending a long association with the Lone Star Conference following the 2010-11 academic year.

UCO is still eligible for post-season play in all sports and will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 2012-13.

BRONCHO NICKNAME

Bronchos was the nickname selected for Central Oklahoma in 1922 by Mrs. C.W. Wantland, wife of long-time football coach C.W. Wantland.

The name was chosen from a number of suggestions for the name of UCO's football team and became the nickname for all athletic teams at the school.

UCO FOOTBALL TIDBITS

⇒ The Bronchos have won 31 conference/division championships.

⇒ UCO has won more games than any other Oklahoma college team besides the University of Oklahoma.

⇒ The Bronchos have won seven or more games in a season 38 times.

⇒ UCO has had seven Harlon Hill Trophy candidates: RB Tyrone Jones (1993), RB Joe Aska ('94), RB Reggie Donner ('98), WR Dee Dee Carter ('01), RB Jarrod Manoy ('03), QB Justin Allgood ('04) and RB Joshua Birmingham ('10).

⇒ The Bronchos have had 18 players drafted into the NFL and former star Keith Traylor won three Super Bowl rings during a 17-year career.

Of the 79 players on the numerical roster, 50 are freshmen/sophomores and 29 are juniors/seniors.

Fifteen freshmen -- 10 true and five redshirt -- were among the 47 players who saw action last week against Cal Poly.

RUNNING SUCCESS LEADS TO WINS: UCO rushed for 249 yards in last week's win over East Central, the most since racking up 304 in a win over Southwestern Oklahoma late in the 2009 season.

The Bronchos usually win when rushing for 200-plus yards, owning a 22-6 record in the 2000s when doing that.

BIRMINGHAM CATCHES, THROWS TD: All-American running back **Joshua Birmingham** threw the first touchdown pass of his career and also caught one during UCO's tough 44-25 loss to Cal Poly last Saturday.

The sophomore star scored the first TD of the game for the Bronchos with a seven-yard first-quarter reception and then tossed a two-yard scoring pass to tight end **Bryce Davis** out of the Wildcat formation late in the second period as UCO took a 19-10 halftime lead.

Birmingham was limited to 11 carries for 24 yards, but he topped the Bronchos in catches (six) and yards (57) in addition to the one pass completion.

Through six games, **Birmingham** has rushed 80 times for 581 yards (6.0/carry) and three TDs and caught a team-high 34 passes for 253 yards (7.4/catch) and one TD. He's also 4-of-4 passing for 19 yards and a score.

Birmingham has rushed for 100-plus yards in eight of 17 career games with the Bronchos while having had at least two receptions in every game of his career.

He owns the school record for touchdown runs of 50-plus yards with six.

DAVIS COMES THROUGH: Senior tight end **Bryce Davis** had another solid outing last week at Cal Poly, catching four passes for 56 yards. He had a two-yard touchdown grab late in the first half to give UCO a 19-10 lead and his other three receptions resulted in first downs.

Davis has 19 catches for 225 yards (11.8/catch) and two TDs this year, with 13 of those having resulted in a first down or touchdown. He 22 receptions for 212 yards in his first three years with the Bronchos.

ETHAN IS SHARP: Quarterback **Ethan Sharp** had his fifth 200-yard passing game of the season last week, hitting 30-of-50 attempts for 290 yards and two touchdowns (seven and 21 yards) with one interception.

The junior standout has completed 183-of-306 passes for 1,669 yards through six games and is already on the verge of breaking into the top-10 on UCO's single-season passing list, needing just 21 yards for 10th.

(1.60). He's made seven straight field goals and 19 consecutive PATs dating back to last season.

GREVE PUNTS IT: Sophomore punter **Landon Greve** averaged 34.0 yards on seven punts last week at Cal Poly, with the Mustangs managing 11 yards on the two kicks they could return.

Greve is averaging 37.6 yards on 46 punts, with opponents having returned just 10 for 50 yards. UCO ranks 19th in Division II in net punting with a 36.21 average.

Sharp has moved into sixth place on UCO's career passing chart with 4,115 yards and needs just 73 more to jump into fourth. He also ranks seventh in career total offense with 4,145 yards (4,115 passing, 30 rushing).

MEADOWS MOWS 'EM DOWN: Junior safety **Keno Meadows** continued his impressive 2011 campaign at Cal Poly, recording a team-high 11 tackles (seven solo, four assisted) with a seven-yard loss in the hard-fought defeat.

It's the fifth time in six games that **Meadows** has recorded at least 10 tackles.

He tops the Bronchos in both total (67) and solo (42) tackles, having made 6.0 tackles for loss (minus-25) yards while also breaking up four passes. **Meadows** ranks ninth nationally in tackles per-game with an 11.2 average.

CASON ROLLS ALONG: Senior linebacker **Tucker Cason** had the first blocked kick of his UCO career last week at Cal Poly, knocking down a third-quarter field goal try. He also had seven tackles (four solo, three assisted), including a half-tackle for loss.

Cason is second on the team in tackles with 62 (22 solo, 40 assisted) and leads in tackles for loss (7.5 for minus-33 yards). **Cason** is tied for 11th nationally in tackles with an average of 11.0 a game.

Cason has made 10-plus tackles in 11 games the last three years and has 259 tackles (115 solo, 143 assisted) in his four-year career with the Bronchos, including 24.0 for loss (minus-109 yards).

BIG BALLEW: Sophomore linebacker **Drake Ballew** had the best game of his young career at Cal Poly last week, making a career-high 10 tackles (six solo, four assisted) with 1.0 for loss (two yards).

Ballew is tied for third on the team in tackles with 28 (18 solo, 20 assisted), including 3.0 for loss (minus-eight yards).

PENNON DENIED LONG TD RETURN: Junior cornerback **Creadell Pennon** saw his first action of the season as a kickoff returner against Cal Poly and managed 62 yards in five tries, with a penalty negating a 95-yard touchdown return.

Pennon scored on a 100-yard interception return the week before in UCO's 41-21 win over East Central and he ran back a fumble 37 yards for a score last year against Northeastern State.

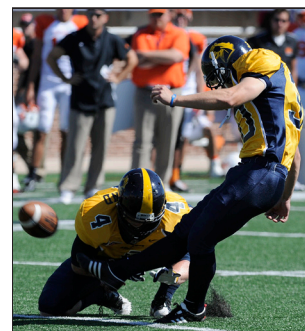
Pennon had three solo tackles and a pass break up last week. He has 19 tackles (12 solo, seven assisted) while sharing the team lead in interceptions (three) and PBU's (four) despite missing the first two games of the season to injury.

ROBBS ON A ROLL: Junior place-kicker **Chris Robbs** is enjoying a splendid season for the Bronchos and it continued last week at Cal Poly when he hit his only field goal try of 35 yards in addition to both extra point attempts.

Robbs has scored a team-high 35 points -- 8-of-9 on field goals and 11-of-11 on PATs -- and is tied for sixth in NCAA Division II for field goals per game

ABOUT WASHBURN: The No. 5-ranked Ichabods improved to 6-0 for the first time since World War II last Saturday with a 42-14 road romp over Truman State as 10th-year head coach head coach **Craig Schurig** became the school's all-time winningest coach (68-41).

Washburn is riding a 10-game winning streak after winning the last four games of 2010, capped by a 45-14 Kanza Bowl rout of Midwestern State.

The Ichabods rolled up 553 total yards against Truman last week and are averaging 491.2 yards a game (315.8 passing, 175.3 rushing).

Dane Simoneau is 121-of-208 passing for 1,799 yards and 19 TDs, with **DeJuan Beard** (26 catches, 376 yards, five TDs) and **Ronnell Garner** (24-471, five TDs) the top receivers. **Justin Cooper** has rushed for 640 yards and eight TDs on 116 carries.

Washburn gives up just 298.5 yards a contest (183.3 passing, 115.2 rushing). **Bryce Atagi** (54 tackles, 6.5 for loss) and **Willie Williams** (41 tackles) lead the defense.



THE SCHEDULE: Here's a game-by-game look at UCO's 2011 schedule:

⇒ **North Alabama 31, UCO 10 (Sept. 1 • Florence, Ala.)** - UCO hung tough most of the way against North Alabama before falling 31-10. The Bronchos led 3-0 in the first quarter, trailed just 14-3 at halftime and were down only 24-10 until UNA put the game away on a touchdown with 4:24 left to play. Quarterback **Ethan Sharp** hit 41-of-71 passes -- both school records -- for 351 yards.

⇒ **Southeastern Oklahoma 30, UCO 23 (Sept. 10 • Durant, Okla.)** - Southeastern Oklahoma scored the last 10 points of the game to rally past UCO 30-23. The Savage Storm outgained the Bronchos 492-341 and held a staggering 43:34-16:26 advantage in time of possession.

⇒ **Angelo State 20, UCO 0 (Sept. 17 • San Angelo, Texas)** - UCO suffered its first shutout since 2007, managing just 253 total yards in a 20-0 loss at unbeaten Angelo State. The Bronchos trailed only 3-0 at halftime, but the Rams pulled away in the final two quarters.

⇒ **Southwestern Oklahoma 27, UCO 20 (Sept. 24)** - Southwestern Oklahoma scored with 56 seconds remaining to pull a 27-20 victory. UCO overcame a 20-6 halftime deficit to tie it at 20-all as cornerback **Brandon Williams** had two end zone interceptions in the second half, returning one a school record-tying 100 yards for a touchdown. **Ethan Sharp** completed 39-of-57 passes for 404 yards.

⇒ **UCO 41, East Central 21 (Oct. 1 • Edmond)** - UCO snapped a 10-game losing streak and earned a big Homecoming victory last week, rolling over East Central 41-21. **Joshua Birmingham** rushed for 233 yards and one touchdown, while **Creadell Pennon** returned one of his three interceptions 100 yards for another score to spark the Bronchos to their sixth straight win over the Tigers.

⇒ **Cal Poly 44, UCO 25 (Oct. 8 • San Luis Obispo, Calif.)** - UCO gave the Football Championship Subdivision-member Mustangs all they could handle before falling 44-25. The Bronchos led 19-10 at halftime lead and went back in front 25-24 early in the fourth quarter before the Mustangs scored 20 unanswered points in the final 11 minutes to quell UCO's upset bid.

⇒ **Washburn • Oct. 15 • Topeka, Kan.** - First-ever meeting. The Bronchos play their final road game of the season against a future conference rival.

⇒ **Fort Hays State • Oct. 22 • Edmond** - UCO leads the series 6-0. It's the first meeting between the two future conference rivals since a 28-0 UCO win in 1995.

⇒ **Black Hills State • Oct. 27 • Edmond** - First-ever meeting. The Bronchos play a rare Thursday night home game.

⇒ **Northeastern State • Nov. 5 • Edmond** - UCO leads the series 44-24-2. The Bronchos lead 7-6 in the President's Cup battle, which started in 1998.

⇒ **Lindenwood • Nov. 12 • Edmond** - First-ever meeting. The Lions are moving to NCAA Division II and will be in the same conference with UCO next year.
