## FOR STARTERS

- The Washburn Ichabods return home for Hall of Fame Saturday when they will face Northeastern State at 1 p.m. on Saturday.
- Washburn (2-3, 2-3 MIAA) is coming off a 38-7 loss to Missouri Western last time out on Sept. 29 in St. Joseph which snapped a three-game Ichabod winning streak over the Griffons.
- The RiverHawks (0-5, 0-5 MIAA) is were topped by Nebraska-Kearney 49-7 last time out and enter the game with a seven-game losing streak dating back to last season.

## WASHBURN/NORTHEASTERN STATE SERIES NOTES

- The Ichabods are 7-1 all-time against the RiverHawks and have won the last six in the series.
- Washburn and Northeastern State opened the 2016 and 2017 seasons against each other and the Ichabods won 38-19 on Sept. 1, 2016 in Topeka and 31-7 last season on Aug. 31, 2017 in Tahlequah.
- The RiverHawks lone win came in the second meeting in the series in a 35-30 win on Sept. 24, 1988 in Tahlequah.
- Washburn is 4-0 in games played in Topeka and 3-1 in games played in Tahlequah.
- The Ichabods have outscored the RiverHawks 200 to 57 in the last five games - an average of 40.0 to 11.4.

## THE COACHES

### Washburn Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig . . .

- was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.
- is 112-77 (.599) in his 17th season as the Ichabod head coach.
- is 93-66 (.603) against the MIAA.
- has led the Ichabods to three NCAA Playoff appearances and four bowl appearances and three bowl championships.
- led the Ichabods to the 2005 MIAA regular season outright championship.
- led the Ichabods to the program's first 10-win season and their first NCAA or NAIA playoff game victory in school history with a win over Abilene Christian during the 2011 season.
- is Washburn's all-time winningest football coach with 112 wins.

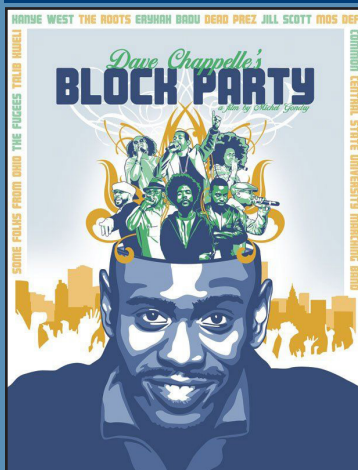

The Washburn Ichabods lead the MIAA and are ranked 10th in the nation in blocked kicks ... this year the Ichabods have three through five games with two coming against UCM two weeks ago ... in 2014 Washburn blocked a RiverHawk punt in the endzone for a touchdown in a 42-7 win.

■ is 6-0 against Northeastern State.

## Northeastern State head coach Rob Robinson ...

- is in his fifth season as the RiverHawks head coach.
- was named the 19th head football coach in school history on Dec. 19, 2013.
- owns a 6-43 all-time record at Northeastern State.
- spent 12 years under Craig Schurig as a member of the Washburn Ichabod coaching staff, serving as the offensive coordinator for the last four seasons in Topeka.
- directed the running backs from 2007-13 and coached the wide receivers from 2002-06
- served as the recruiting coordinator from 2002-10 and was the academic coordinator from 2010-13.
- Robinson is the second former coordinator under Schurig's tutelage to become the head coach of another program in the MIAA, joining Fort Hays State's Chris Brown.
- is 0-4 against Washburn.

## NOTING THE ICHABODS

- Hunter Browning leads the team with 32.2 yards per game as five different Ichabods are averaging a double-digit yards per game average ... Browning made his first start of the season against Missouri Western ... as a team the Ichabods are averaging 102.8 yards per game on the ground while allowing 180.0 per contest ... Washburn is 10th in the MIAA in rushing offense.
- Blake Peterson is averaging 202.7 yards per game passing in three starts with three touchdowns completing 48.9 percent of his passes ... Mitch Schurig is 46 of 78 passing with four touchdowns averaging 210.7 yards per game ... overall the Ichabods are averaging 254.6 yards per game passing.
- James Brania-Hopp has 32 catches for 556 yards with two scores while averaging 111.2 yards per game receiving ... he is also averaging 17.4 yards per catch ... Brania-Hopp leads the MIAA in receiving yards per game (111.2), receptions per game (6.4) and total yards (556) and is ranked 11th in the NCAA in receiving yards and 12th in receiving yards per game.
- Austin Tillman leads the MIAA and the Ichabods with 12.2 tackles per game and Derrick McGreevy is fourth in the league with 10.0 tackles per game ... Tillman also leads the team lead with 3.5 tackles for loss.
- Through five games, the Ichabods have a balanced offensive attack with 178 run plays and 178 pass plays ... on third down and long (anything over seven yards) the Ichabods have ran the ball six times and passed it 47 times this season.
- The Ichabods are ranked ninth in the MIAA in third down conversions moving the chains on 31 of 82 attempts and defensively the Ichabods are ninth in the MIAA in opponent third down conversions limiting foes to 30 of 73 attempts for a 41 percent average ... against the Griffons, Missouri Western converted 12 of 15 tries on third down.
- Washburn is ranked seventh in the MIAA in penalties averaging 7.0 per game for 67.2 yards while opponents are averaging 5.3 penalties per game and 46.0 yards per contest.
- Washburn is eighth in the MIAA in time of possession averaging 28:54 per game.
- Austin Tillman is ranked fifth in the nation in total tackles at 12.2 per game and Derrick McGreevy is ranked 37th in the nation at 10.0 tackles per game.
- Derrick McGreevy's 256 tackles is 13th on the all-time chart at Washburn.
- Austin Tillman's 254 career tackles sit 14th on the all-time chart at Washburn.

## NOTING THE RIVERHAWKS

- The RiverHawks are coached by former Washburn assistant Rob Robinson who is starting his fourth season as Northeastern State's head coach. He has several members of his coaching staff who played and coached at Washburn. Robinson spent 12 seasons at Washburn including four seasons as the offensive coordinator.
- Also on his coaching staff is assistant head coach, wide receiver and recruiting coordinator Rob Messinger who was a graduate assistant at Washburn from 2008-11.
- Former Ichabod All-American quarterback Dane Simoneau is the RiverHawks' offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. Simoneau is the Ichabods' all-time leader in total offense, passing touchdowns, passing yards and 33 other school single-season, single-game and career records finishing in 2011. He spent one season as a graduate assistant at Washburn.
- The RiverHawks are 11th in the MIAA in scoring at 9.4 points per game while allowing 51.2 per game.
- Offensively, the RiverHawks are averaging 211.6 yards per game while allowing 519.6 yards per game.
- Craig Davis leads the team with 25.2 yards per game rushing average.
- Cade Yeager is 41 of 91 passing with two touchdowns and 122 yards per game throwing three interceptions.

## LAST TIME OUT FOR THE ICHABODS

(Sept. 29, 2018) ST. JOSEPH, Mo. -- ST. JOSEPH, Mo. -- The Washburn Ichabods were blanked in the first half by Missouri Western and could not recover as they fell 38-7 to the Griffons dropped to 2-3 on the season. The Griffons (3-2, 3-2 MIAA) led 21-0 at the break after recording 285 yards of offense on 34 plays and would go up 24-0 after scoring on their first drive of the second stanza. The Ichabods jumped on the board with 8:00 to play in the third quarter on a 5-yard touchdown run by James Brania-Hopp but it would not be enough as the Ichabods were shutout in the fourth quarter as the Griffons picked up the win snapping a three-game winning streak by the Ichabods in series. Brania-Hopp, the MIAA-leader in receiving, led the Ichabods with seven catches for 139 yards. Mitch Schurig was 18 of 33 passing for 223 and Kamani Addison led the Ichabods with 11 rushes for 45 yards. Defensively, Austin Tillman led the Ichabods with 14 tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss and Derrick McGreevy had 10 tackles to pace Washburn. Overall, the Griffons outgained the Ichabods 544 to 332 running 69 plays to 66 for Washburn. On the ground, the Griffons had a 295 to 109 advantage holding the ball for 34:45 compared to 25:15 for Washburn. Washburn was 4 of 13 on third down conversions compared to 12 of 15 for the Griffons.

WACO, Texas -- For the 12th time in the last 15 years, the Washburn Ichabod football team received votes in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 Coaches preseason poll released to start the 2018 season. The Ichabods, under head coach Craig Schurig, have been ranked or have received votes in the AFCA poll 66 times and have been ranked in the top 10 a total of 15 times.

### ON THE HORIZON

Washburn returns to Yager Stadium to wrap up its mini two-game homestand with Missouri Southern on Oct. 13 for Washburn's Homecoming. The Ichabods will travel to Edmond, Oklahoma on Oct. 20 before facing Emporia State on Oct. 27 in Topeka.





Entering his 17th season as the Ichabods' head coach, Craig Schurig has built one of the most respected programs in the MIAA with three NCAA playoff appearances as well as the 2005 MIAA title coming on the heel's of a 2007, 2009 and 2011 runner-up finish in the conference race. He has completed an 112-77 record at Washburn. The 112 wins are on top of the all-time wins chart at Washburn. He won his 100th career game in a 45-13 win over Missouri Southern on Oct. 8, 2016 becoming only the fifth MIAA coach to reach the century mark in victories.

Through his first 16 seasons, in addition to three NCAA playoffs and a conference title, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl championship, the 2010 Kanza Bowl championship and the 2017 C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl title; as well as the 2016 Mineral Water Bowl in Washburn's eighth postseason game under Schurig.

In 2011, the Ichabods reached their third NCAA playoffs in school history going 10-3 setting a school-record for the most wins in a season. Washburn also recorded its first playoff victory in school history with a 52-49 win over Abilene Christian.

As quarterbacks coach, he helped Dane Simoneau throw for more than 4,000 yards setting a school record and a national finalist award for the Harlon Hill Trophy as the best player in NCAA Division II, the first national finalist in Washburn history. Simoneau would go on to be a five-time consensus All-American at quarterback as well as the MIAA's Offensive Player of the Year, the first Ichabod to win the award.

The 2010 season saw the Ichabods go 8-4 with the Kanza Bowl appearance in front of a Topeka crowd topping a No. 24-ranked Midwestern State team.

During the 2009 campaign, Schurig led the Ichabods to their sixth straight winning season, something which had not been done in the program's history, finishing with an 8-3 overall record and a second place MIAA finish with a 6-3 mark.

In 2008, the season was the fifth-straight winning campaign for the Ichabods and the first five-year run of winning seasons since the 1903-07 seasons.

In 2007, the Ichabods made their second NCAA playoff appearance with an 8-4 overall record and a 7-2 MIAA mark placing second in the conference.

Following the 2006 season, the Ichabods recorded a 7-4 record securing their third straight winning season for the first time since the 1986 to 1988 campaigns.

Schurig earned the 2005 MIAA's Coach of the Year for his efforts leading the Ichabods that season in which Washburn won its first conference championship since 1983. He was also named the AFCA's Region 3 Coach of the Year. Washburn finished the 2005 season with a school-record nine wins and a 7-1 mark in conference play.

The 2004 season saw the Ichabods record their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the Mineral Water Bowl.

In his 16 seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had 21 different players earn 55 different All-American accolades, two MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players, an MIAA Offensive Player of the Year, four MIAA Freshman of the Year awards and 196 players receive all-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 360 Ichabods named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll, including three Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football program has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium including a new artificial turf and equipment upgrades in the weight room. In the summer of 2009, the Ichabods moved into a renovated football locker room and a state-of-the-art strength and conditioning center in a renovated Whiting Fieldhouse as part of a \$7 million project. Plans are also in the works for a \$19.9 million indoor athletic facility which was approved by the board of regents in the spring of 2018.

Schurig was named the Ichabod head coach on Dec. 28, 2001 after spending nine seasons on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, where he was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II, including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends. Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines before joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a four-year letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team all-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, two sons, Mitchell, a sophomore quarterback at Washburn and Michael, a freshman on the Ichabod baseball team.

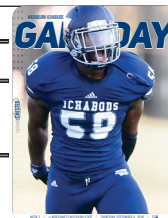
