FOR STARTERS

- The Washburn Ichabod will open 128th season of season on Aug. 30 when they will travel to St. Charles, Mo., to face the Lindenwood Lions.
- The Washburn is 75-46-6 all-time in season openers winning last season's opener over Northeastern State 31-7 in Tahlequah.
- Overall the Ichabods have won their last two season openers.
- The Ichabods are coming off a 7-5 season going 6-5 in the MIAA winning the Heart of Texas Bowl in Copperas Cove, Texas 41-25 over Angelo State in their seventh postseason appearance under 17th-year head coach Craig Schurig and their 13th overall in program history.
- Lindenwood was 4-7 last season and the Ichabods rallied from a 10-point deficit to defeat the Lions on Sept. 16 in St. Charles.
- The Ichabods were picked seventh in both the MIAA Coaches and Media preseason polls.
- The Ichabods have averaged 32.8 points per game under Schurig in season openers going 11-5 in the first games of the season.
- Thursday's game is only the ninth time in program history the Ichabods have opened the season in August going 6-2 overall ... the Ichabods have opened on Aug. 30 only once in a 24-14 win over Nebraska-Kearney starting the 2012 season.

- Three of the four Kansas NCAA Division II postseason schools earned postseason berths this year with Fort Hays State as the No. 1 seed in the Division II for the playoffs, Pittsburg State at the Texarkana Bowl and Washburn in the Heart of Texas Bowl.

THE COACHES

Washburn Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig . . .

- was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.
- is 110-74 (.599) in his 17th season as the Ichabod head coach.
- is 91-63 (.603) against the MIAA.
- has led the Ichabods to three NCAA Playoff appearances and four bowl appearances and three bowl championships.
- led the Ichabods to the 2005 MIAA regular season outright championship.
- led the Ichabods to the program's first 10-win season and their first NCAA or NAIA playoff game victory in school history with a win over Abilene Christian during the 2011 season.
- is Washburn's all-time winningest football coach with 110 wins.
- is 4-2 against Lindenwood.

Lindenwood head coach Jed Stugart . . .

- is in his second season as head coach at Lindenwood.
- is 4-7 in his first season on the Lion sidelines.
- is in his 12th season as a head coach he has a 95-31 record.
- earned a bachelor's degree from Azusa Pacific University in 1995 and a master's degree from Northern Colorado in 2003. He earned three letters as a linebacker from Azusa Pacific.
- was once in the country music business opening for Lone Star, the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band and Tim McGraw playing in front of more than 18,000 fans at the Kansas Festival in Manhattan.
- Washburn defeated a Jed Stugart-coached Sioux Falls team in the 2011 season opener 33-17.
- He is 0-2 against Washburn.

NOTING THE ICHABODS

- The Washburn Ichabods will have a combined 21 starters off of last season's 7-5 team who defeated Angelo State in the C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl to wrap up the 2017 season.
- Offensively, the Ichabods ranked fourth in the MIAA in scoring at 31.8 points per game and ranked fourth in scoring defense allowing only 26.1 points per game.
- From the fifth-best total offensive unit in the MIAA, Washburn has back nine starters off a team who averaged 394.1 yards per game.
- On the defensive side of the ball, the Ichabods tout eight returning starters with the seventh-best total defensive squad in the MIAA.
- The special teams unit is also chalked full of experience with returners at the punter and placekicking spots as well as long snapper and punt return and kickoff returners.

(Dec. 3, 2017) COPPERAS COVE, Texas -- The Washburn Ichabod football team led 21-3 at the break and never looked back as Washburn won the 2017 C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl 41-25 over Angelo State finishing the season at 7-5.

After neither team scored in the first quarter, Ryan Peroo scored on a 4-yard touchdown capping a five-play, 37-yard drive with 11:57 left in the first half. The teams traded punts and then the Rams would get on the board with a 30-yard field goal with 8:42 left in the second quarter cutting the Ichabod lead to 7-3.

After an Ichabod punt returned the ball back to Angelo State (6-5), Peter Pfannenstieler picked off the Jake Faber pass and returned it 38 yards for a touchdown pushing Washburn out to a 14-3 lead.

The Ichabod defense held the Rams to a three and out and Blake Peterson scored on a 10-yard run capping a 65-yard drive before the end of the half as Washburn went up 21-3.

To open the third quarter, Washburn held the Rams on their opening drive, but an Ichabod fumble gave the ball back to the Rams at the Washburn 23. However the Ichabods held the Rams to runs of four yards, four yards and incomplete pass and a run of one yard as the Ichabods regained possession on downs.

After a punt by the Ichabods, the Rams drove to their own 44, but Josh Wright picked off the pass and returned it 48 yards for a touchdown as the Ichabods finished the evening with two pick sixes. After Wright's score, Washburn led 28-10 with 4:10 to play in the third quarter.

On the Rams' next drive, Tyrese Nathan broke free for a 42-yard run up the middle, but he was tracked down by D.J. ICHABODS IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

WACO, Texas -- For the 12th time in the last 15 years, the Washburn Ichabod football team received votes in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 Coaches presason poll released to start the season. The Ichabods are one of eight teams in the MIAA who received votes in the annual preseason poll. The Ichabods, under head coach Craig Schurig, have been ranked or have received votes in the AFCA poll 64 times and have been ranked in the top 10 a total of 15 times.

ON THE HORIZON

The Ichabods will open the home slate for the second-straight season with Northwest Missouri on Sept. 6 in Yager Stadium.



Entering his 17th season as the Ichabods' head coach, Craig Schurig has built one of the most respected programs in the MIAA with three NCAA playoff appearances as well as the 2005 MIAA title coming on the heel's of a 2007, 2009 and 2011 runner-up finish in the conference race. He has completed an 110-74 record at Washburn. The 110 wins are on top of the all-time wins chart at Washburn. He won his 100th career game in a 45-13 win over Missouri Southern on Oct. 8, 2016 becoming only the fifth MIAA coach to reach the century mark in victories.

Through his first 16 seasons, in addition to three NCAA playoffs and a conference title, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl championship, the 2010 Kanza Bowl championship and the 2017 C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl title; as well as the 2016 Mineral Water Bowl in Washburn's eighth postseason game under Schurig.

In 2011, the Ichabods reached their third NCAA playoffs in school history going 10-3 setting a school-record for the most wins in a season. Washburn also recorded its first playoff victory in school history with a 52-49 win over Abilene Christian.

As quarterbacks coach, he helped Dane Simoneau throw for more than 4,000 yards setting a school record and a national finalist award for the Harlon Hill Trophy as the best player in NCAA Division II, the first national finalist in Washburn history. Simoneau would go on to be a five-time consensus All-American at quarterback as well as the MIAA's Offensive Player of the Year, the first Ichabod to win the award.

The 2010 season saw the Ichabods go 8-4 with the Kanza Bowl appearance in front of a Topeka crowd topping a No. 24-ranked Midwestern State team.

During the 2009 campaign, Schurig led the Ichabods to their sixth straight winning season, something which had not been done in the program's history, finishing with an 8-3 overall record and a second place MIAA finish with a 6-3 mark.

In 2008, the season was the fifth-straight winning campaign for the Ichabods and the first five-year run of winning seasons since the 1903-07 seasons.

In 2007, the Ichabods made their second NCAA playoff appearance with an 8-4 overall record and a 7-2 MIAA mark placing second in the conference.

Following the 2006 season, the Ichabods recorded a 7-4 record securing their third straight winning season for the first time since the 1986 to 1988 campaigns.

Schurig earned the 2005 MIAA's Coach of the Year for his efforts leading the Ichabods that season in which Washburn won its first conference championship since 1983. He was also named the AFCA's Region 3 Coach of the Year. Washburn finished the 2005 season with a school-record nine wins and a 7-1 mark in conference play.

The 2004 season saw the Ichabods record their first winning season since 1999 and their first postseason win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the Mineral Water Bowl.

In his 16 seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had 21 different players earn 55 different All-American accolades, two MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players, an MIAA Offensive Player of the Year, four MIAA Freshman of the Year awards and 196 players receive all-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 360 Ichabods named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll, including three Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football program has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium including a new artificial turf and equipment upgrades in the weight room. In the summer of 2009, the Ichabods moved into a renovated football locker room and a state-of-the-art strength and conditioning center in a renovated Whiting Fieldhouse as part of a \$7 million project. Plans are also in the works for a \$19.9 million indoor athletic facility which was approved by the board of regents in the spring of 2018.

Schurig was named the Ichabod head coach on Dec. 28, 2001 after spending nine seasons on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, where he was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II, including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends. Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines before joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a four-year letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team all-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, two sons, Mitchell, a sophomore quarterback at Washburn and Michael, a freshman on the Ichabod baseball team.
