- > The Washburn Ichabods will hit the road for the first time in 2019 as they travel to Maryville, Mo., to take on the No. 7-ranked Northwest Missouri State Bearcats on Saturday at 1:30 p.m. in Bearcat Stadium.
- > The Ichabods are coming off a 49-27 win over Lincoln on Sept. 5 last time out in Topeka after scoring 28 second-half points winning their fourth-straight season opener.
- > The Bearcats will be hosting the Ichabods for their home opener after defeating Missouri Western 45-35 in St. Joseph last time out.
- > The Ichabods have averaged 34.1 points per game under 18th-year head coach Craig Schurig in season openers going 13-5 in the first games of the season.
- > The Washburn Ichabods are 5-5 in school history on Sept. 14 and they have never faced Northwest Missouri on the date.
- > Northwest leads the all-time series 32-6 winning the last 14 meetings.
- > Washburn's last win in the series came in a 31-28 win in Maryville on Oct. 8, 2005 en route to the Ichabods' only MIAA football championship.
- > Since then the Ichabods have dropped the last six games played in Maryville.

Washburn Ichabod head coach Craig Schurig . . .

- was named head coach of the Ichabod football program Dec. 28, 2001.
- is 116-80 (.599) in his 18th season as the Ichabod head coach.
- is 97-68 (.603) against the MIAA.
- has led the Ichabods to three NCAA Playoff appearances and four bowl appearances and three bowl championships.
- led the Ichabods to the 2005 MIAA regular season outright championship.
- led the Ichabods to the program's first 10-win season and their first NCAA or NAIA playoff game victory in school history with a win over Abilene Christian during the 2011 season.
- is Washburn's all-time winningest football coach with 115 wins.
- is 1-16 against Northwest Missouri.

Northwest Missouri head coach Rich Wright . . .

- is in his third season as head coach at Northwest Missouri.
- is 20-6 on the Northwest sidelines as the head coach.
- has been an assistant at NWMSU since 2004 and the defensive coordinator since 2011.
- has gone 183-28 since Wright has been on the Bearcat coaching staff.
- He is 2-0 against Washburn.

- Another true freshman, Percy Mitchell, also rushed for two scores with 58 yards on 10 carries.
- Sophomore James Letcher, Jr. averaged 21.0 yards per catch with one touchdown and finished with 175 all purpose yards, which is fifth in the MIAA leaders after week one.
- Braden Rose is tied for first in the MIAA with sacks after recording 1.5 in the opener against Lincoln.
- The 59 carries by the Ichabods against Lincoln was the third-most in the Craig Schurig era behind 66 against Northeastern State in 2018 and 60 against Missouri Western in 2007.
- The four fumble recoveries against Lincoln tied a school record, as did the seven turnovers the Ichabods had.

BODS AND ENDS

- Entering Saturday's game, Mitch Schurig has averaged 7.58 yards per total offensive play which is second on only Dane Simoneau (7.97 ypp) in program history.
- Josh Wright has three career blocked kicks in his senior season, the school record is six by Zuri Stokes set between 1993 and 1996.

NOTING THE BEARCATS

- The Bearcats are seventh in the AFCA Top 25 Coaches Poll and ranked No. 6 in the D2football.com media poll.
- The Bearcats defeated Missouri Western in their opener 45-35.
- Sam Phillips was named the MIAA's Defensive Player of the Week scoring twice on a fumble and an interception against Missouri Western.
- After Missouri Western took a 38-35 lead, the Griffons ran eight total plays for minus-15 yards. Included in those eight plays were two sacks and an interception by the Bearcat defense.

LAST MEETING WITH NORTHWEST MISSOURI

(Sept. 6, 2018) TOPEKA, Kan. – The Washburn Ichabods fell to No. 6-ranked Northwest Missouri 38-17 on a muggy night in Yager Stadium on Thursday. Washburn returns to the road next Saturday for another top-10 battle when they will face Fort Hays State.

The Bearcats took an opening 7-0 lead, but back to back touchdowns by the Ichabods pushed Washburn (1-1, 1-1 MIAA) out in front 14-7. In the first score, James Letcher, Jr., capped a seven-play, 74 yard drive with a 24-yard touchdown reception with 5:35 to play in the first quarter. Washburn then went up 14-7 on a 39-yard touchdown strike from Blake Peterson to James Brania-Hopp with 10:09 to play.

Northwest (2-0, 2-0 MIAA) tied the score with 7:11 to play in the half as the teams entered the break knotted at 14-14.

To open the third quarter, the Ichabods went on a 44-yard drive and went up 17-14 after Perry Schmiedeler connected on a 35-yard field goal with 11:54. The Bearcats came back with an 11-play, 77-yard drive to go up 21-17 with 7:08 to go in the third quarter.

Northwest pushed its lead to 24-17 with 2:38 to play in the third quarter on a

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE ICHABODS

(Sept. 5, 2019) TOPEKA, Kan. – The Washburn Ichabods racked up 28 points in the second half holding the visiting Lincoln Blue Tigers to six in the second half picking up a 49-27 win in Yager Stadium on Thursday night.

The Ichabods scored the first 21 points of the second stanza on a pair of touchdown passes from Mitch Schurig with the first going to Collin Wilson and the second to Austen Hubert pushing the Ichabods out to a 35-21 lead midway through the third quarter. In the fourth quarter, Percy Mitchell scored on a 6-yard run staking the Ichabods to a 42-21 margin taking advantage of one of five Blue Tiger turnovers on the evening with 12:08 to play in the game.

Lincoln's only second half points came with 9:08 to go on a Dre'Shon Alston 13-yard touchdown reception from Chancellor Johnson but the extra point attempt went off the upright as the Ichabods held on to the 42-27 lead.

Mitchell wrapped up the scoring on the night for the Ichabods with a 1-yard plunge capping a five-play drive with 3:22 to go staking Washburn to the 49-27 win.

To start the game the Ichabods jumped on the Blue Tigers first as Taylon Peters scored from 2-yards out ending a 12-play, 70-yard drive. After Lincoln punted, the Ichabods coughed up the ball for one of the school-record seven turnovers leading to a game-tying 7-7 score of 30 yards.

Washburn pushed out to a 14-7 lead on a 27-yard touchdown pass from Schurig to James Letcher, Jr. with 14:55 to go in the opening half. After a Blue Tiger punt and an Ichabod turnover, Lincoln knotted the score at 14-14 with 13:08 to play. Washburn's third turnover of the game led to the Blue Tigers taking a 21-14 lead with 7:16 to go. Washburn tied the score going into the break on a Peters' second 2-yard touchdown run of the game with under a minute to play.

Washburn will be back in action on Sept. 21 for Family Day when they will face Fort Hays State at 1 p.m. in Yager Stadium.



Entering his 18th season as the Ichabods' head coach, Craig Schurig has built one of the most respected programs in the MIAA with three NCAA playoff appearances as well as the 2005 MIAA title coming on the heel's of a 2007, 2009 and 2011 runner-up finish in the conference race.

He has completed an 116-80 record at Washburn. The 115 wins are on top of the all-time wins chart at Washburn. He won his 100th career game in a 45-13 win over Missouri Southern on Oct. 8, 2016 becoming only the fifth MIAA coach to reach the century mark in victories.

Through his first 17 seasons, in addition to three NCAA playoffs and a conference title, Schurig has led the Washburn football program to the 2004 Mineral Water Bowl championship, the 2010 Kanza Bowl championship and the 2017 C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl title; as well as the 2016 Mineral Water Bowl in Washburn's eighth postseason game under Schurig.

In 2011, the Ichabods reached their third NCAA playoffs in school history going 10-3 setting a school-record for the most wins in a season. Washburn also recorded its first playoff victory in school history with a 52-49 win over Abilene Christian.

As quarterbacks coach, he helped Dane Simoneau throw for more than 4,000 yards setting a school record and a national finalist award for the Harlon Hill Trophy as the best player in NCAA Division II, the first national finalist in Washburn history. Simoneau would go on to be a five-time consensus All-American at quarterback as well as the MIAA's Offensive Player of the Year, the first Ichabod to win the award.

The 2010 season saw the Ichabods go 8-4 with the Kanza Bowl appearance in front of a Topeka crowd topping a No. 24-ranked Midwestern State team.

During the 2009 campaign, Schurig led the Ichabods to their sixth straight winning season, something which had not been done in the program's history, finishing with an 8-3 overall record and a second place MIAA finish with a 6-3 mark.

In 2008, the season was the fifth-straight winning campaign for the Ichabods and the first five-year run of winning seasons since the 1903-07 seasons.

In 2007, the Ichabods made their second NCAA playoff appearance with an 8-4 overall record and a 7-2 MIAA mark placing second in the conference.

Following the 2006 season, the Ichabods recorded a 7-4 record securing their third straight winning season for the first time since the 1986 to 1988 campaigns.

Schurig earned the 2005 MIAA's Coach of the Year for his efforts leading the Ichabods that season in which Washburn won its first conference championship since 1983. He was also named the AFCA's Region 3 Coach of the Year. Washburn finished the 2005 season with a school-record nine wins and a 7-1 mark in conference play.

The 2004 season saw the Ichabods record their first winning season since 1999 and their first post-season win since 1986 with a 36-33 win over Northern State in the Mineral Water Bowl.

In his 17 seasons at Washburn, the Ichabods have had 23 different players earn 59 different All-American accolades, two MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players, an MIAA Offensive Player of the Year, four MIAA Freshman of the Year awards and 209 players receive all-MIAA honors. He has been equally on task with players in the classroom with 425 Ichabods named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll, including three Academic All-Americans.

While under Schurig, the Ichabod football program has also seen sweeping changes in facilities with the improvements to Yager Stadium including a new artificial turf and equipment upgrades in the weight room. In the summer of 2009, the Ichabods moved into a renovated football locker room and a state-of-the-art strength and conditioning center in a renovated Whiting Fieldhouse as part of a \$7 million project. Ground has also been broken on the \$20.3 million indoor athletic facility which was approved by the board of regents in the spring of 2018 and is set to open August, 2020

Schurig was named the Ichabod head coach on Dec. 28, 2001 after spending nine seasons on the Pittsburg State coaching staff, where he was a part of an NCAA national finalist squad in 1995, four MIAA championship teams and eight NCAA Division II playoff teams. He helped guide one of the top defenses in Division II, including the top-ranked defensive squad in 1999.

Prior to working with the defensive backs, he worked three seasons with the Gorillas' tight ends. Before arriving at Pittsburg State, Schurig spent the 1992 season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater, Colorado School of Mines before joining the Gorillas in 1993.

Schurig, a Willingboro, N.J., native, was a four-year letterman as a defensive back at Colorado Mines and was selected team captain as a senior. He earned second-team all-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference honors as a senior. He graduated in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering.

Schurig earned a master's degree in physical education at Pittsburg State in 1996. Craig and his wife, Louisa, have a daughter, Samantha, two sons, Mitchell, a junior quarterback at Washburn and Michael, a redshirt freshman on the Ichabod baseball team.
