NORTH DAKOTA STATE SERIES

Sunday's match marks the first-ever meeting between the two squads. Previously competing in the Western Wrestling Conference, North Dakota State joined five other schools as affiliate members of the Big 12 during the 2015-16 academic year.

SCOUTING THE BISON

North Dakota State won its third straight match Friday evening, topping Pitt in a 28-11 contest at the Fitzgerald Field House in Pittsburgh. The Bison won seven of 10 bouts, including four straight matches in the middle weights highlighted by No. 14 Clay Ream's last-second decision at 157 pounds. The Bison have not won a Big 12 match this season, though, falling to then-No. 13 Northern Iowa (Nov. 17), then-No. 3 Oklahoma State (Nov. 26) and Utah Valley (Dec. 15). NDSU's head coach Roger Kish led the Bison to a fourth-place finish at the 2017 Big 12 Wrestling Championship, collecting a 4-3 league mark in the team's second season of competition in the Big 12. Ream holds a team-best 8-1 record in dual matches thus far. Ream, a native of Wentzville, Missouri, is a three-time NCAA Qualifier and was named the runner-up at last year's Big 12 Championship.

LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia earned its second Big 12 Conference win in program history, upsetting No. 18 Oklahoma in a thrilling 24-12 contest on Thursday evening at the WVU Coliseum. The Mountaineers never trailed in the match, winning seven of 10 bouts to defeat the Sooners for the first time ever in Big 12 action. The last time West Virginia topped Oklahoma was in 1986 at a neutral site, which was when the two squads first met in the all-time series.

SWEET, SWEET VICTORY

Redshirt junior Zeke Moisey set the tone for West Virginia in the first bout of the evening, winning by fall over No. 17 Christian Moody in 1 minute, 11 seconds at 125 pounds. The Northampton, Pennsylvania, native avenged a loss to Moody at the Lindenwood Open on Nov. 18, as he collected his third straight dual-match win of the season.

A PAIR OF WRESTLERS REMAIN NATIONALLY RANKED

Redshirt senior Jacob A. Smith is ranked nationally in the top 10 by a trio of media outlets at 197 pounds. The Charleston, West Virginia, native is ranked No. 5 by InterMat and FloWrestling and appears at No. 10 according to The Open Mat. Moisey, a 2015 NCAA All-American, remains at No. 19 in InterMat's latest top-20 poll at 125 pounds and checks in at No. 20 via FloWrestling.

2017 MIDLANDS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Six WVU grapplers competed at the 55th annual Ken Kraft Midlands Championships in Hoffman Estates, Illinois, on Dec. 29-30. Moisey, seeded ninth at 125 pounds, collected a 5-2 overall record at the two-day event, dropping a 15-2 major decision to No. 5 seed Sebastian Rivera of Northwestern in the consolation finals for fourth place. Smith placed eighth in his respective pool of 197 pounds. Smith, seeded second overall, picked up a 5-1 decision in sudden victory over No. 6 seed Hunter Ritter of Wisconsin before dropping a 7-4 contest to No. 11 seed Patrick Brucki of Princeton in the consolation quarterfinals.

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TOUGH SLATE AHEAD

West Virginia has faced four teams ranked inside the USA Today/NWCA Coaches' Poll thus far, with No. 25 North Dakota State becoming the Mountaineers' fifth ranked opponent of the 2017-18 season. West Virginia has already topped two teams inside the top 25, with wins over then-No. 25 Pitt (Dec. 9) and then-No. 18 Oklahoma (Jan. 4) at home. Looking ahead, the Mountaineers will take on No. 3 Oklahoma State on Friday, Jan. 19, in StillWater, Oklahoma - WVU's first Big 12 road trip of the season.

MOUNTAINEER DEBUTS

Several newcomers made their Mountaineer debut on opening weekend (Nov. 3-5), as redshirt freshmen Hunter Jones (157), Rea (149) and Schmitt (133) as well as true freshmen Nick Kiussis (165), Brenden McRill (185) and Hunter DeLong (HWT) put on the WVU singlet for the first time in their careers. With only two seniors on the roster, West Virginia has welcomed 11 newcomers to Morgantown this season.

WVU WELCOMES BACK 2017 NCAA QUALIFIER

Smith returned to the mat for the first time this season on Dec. 9, earning the 5-2 decision over Pitt's Kellan Stout in a first-round tiebreaker at 197 pounds. Since then, he picked up his first Big 12 victory of the season with a 3-1 decision over Oklahoma's Andrew Dixon on Jan. 4. Smith spent the majority of the 2016-17 season in the top 10 before suffering a season-ending injury in the Big 12 Championship match. He still earned an automatic bid to the 2017 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championship as the Big 12 runner-up, but did not compete due to injury. Over the course of the season, he posted a 20-5 overall mark to go 14-2 in dual matches and 6-1 in Big 12 action.

MOISEY RETURNS TO THE MAT

Moisey, who earned All-America status as a freshman, took a redshirt last season and returned to the mat for the first time vs. Utah Valley on Nov. 3 - the Mountaineers' 2017-18 season opener. Since then, Moisey has competed at a trio of tournaments, registering an 11-5 mark in tournament play. He also has notched three straight dual-match wins, including two by fall vs. ranked opponents at 125 pounds over then-No. 25 Pitt and No. 18 Oklahoma at home. Moisey qualified for the 2016 NCAA Championships, but was forced to withdraw due to injury. The highlight of his collegiate career came during his freshman campaign, where he earned an automatic bid to the 2015 NCAA Championships. Unseeded Moisey knocked out four seeded foes and finished as the NCAA Runner-Up at 125. He became WVU's first NCAA All-American since 2007 and was the first unseeded wrestler to make the NCAA finals since 2003. Moisey led the team with a 32-14 mark on the year, defeating six ranked opponents over the course of the 2014-15 season.

Looking ahead, the Mountaineers' annual Cradles for Cancer for breast cancer awareness is set for WVU's contest against South Dakota State on Feb. 11, at 2 p.m. WVU Medicine will be sponsoring the match and collecting donations to the WVU Cancer Institute. Fans are encouraged to wear pink to the match and can get the WVU sports official "pink" t-shirt with a donation of \$10 or more to WVU Medicine. Mountaineer fans also can bring their valentine to the meet and get two tickets for the price of one. West Virginia then closes its regular-season slate against Clarion on Saturday, Feb. 18, at 2 p.m. It's Senior Day, and WVU will celebrate the careers of Jacob A. Smith and Parker VonEgidy following the match. Additionally, the Mountaineers will play host to their third Beauty and the

Beast event, as the WVU wrestling and gymnastics teams set to compete at the same time. It's also "Mountaineer Kids Club Day," as all kids club members will be invited to an exclusive event.

BIG 12 ADDS AFFILIATE MEMBERS

The Big 12 Conference added Fresno State and Northern Iowa in July of 2017 as affiliate members to give the league a 12-team field. The new additions will join Air Force, Iowa State, Northern Colorado, North Dakota State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, South Dakota State, Utah Valley, West Virginia and Wyoming.

BIG 12 WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP ANNOUNCED

The 2018 Big 12 Wrestling Championship will be held at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma, from March 3-4, for the second year in a row. Tickets are on sale now. Conference institutions hosted the wrestling championships on campus from 1997-2015. The 2016 event was held in Kansas City's Sprint Center.

HENSON ANNOUNCES A TRIO OF SIGNEES FOR 2018

West Virginia added three newcomers to the 2018 squad, as coach Sammie Henson officially announced his recruiting class on Dec. 4. Jackson Henson (Morgantown, West Virginia), Emille (DJ) Shannon (Belleville, Illinois) and Matthew Liberato (Florham Park, New Jersey) signed National Letters of Intent in early November as part of National Signing Day and will join the Mountaineers next season.

LOOKING BACK ON LAST SEASON

WVU finished the 2016-17 season with a 4-13 record and a 1-3 mark against Big 12 opponents. The Mountaineers earned their first Big 12 win in program history last season, as now-sophomore heavyweight Brandon Ngati pinned Iowa State's Joe Scanlan in the final bout of the day to claim a thrilling comeback win over the Cyclones, 22-20, on Feb. 12 inside the WVU Coliseum. Dylan Cottrell also became the first-ever WVU wrestler to win a Big 12 title, as he defeated Oklahoma State's Chandler Rogers in the 165-pound finals of the 2017 Big 12 Wrestling Championship at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on March 5.

WVU SCORES 600th ALL-TIME WIN

The Mountaineers posted a 22-20 win over Binghamton on Jan. 14, 2017, at the Pitt Duals, marking the program's 600th all-time win since 1921. Cory Stainbrook's pin at 133 led the way, along with a pair of tech. falls from Devin Brown (125) and Dylan Cottrell (165).

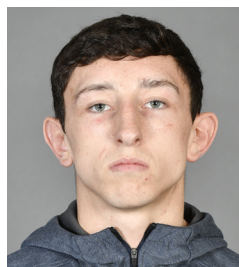

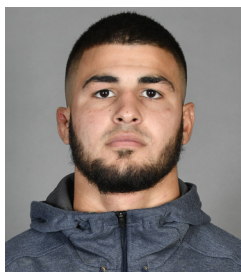
