- The Mountaineers rank fourth in the Big 12, averaging 2.52 blocks per set, and are 38th in the nation. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 209.5-164.5.
- Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 261 kills, averaging 3.18 per set to rank 10th in the league.
- The Palmdale, California, native has recorded double-digit kills in 14 matches, including 10 of the last 13.
- Looking ahead, the Mountaineers will trek to Manhattan, Kansas, to square off with Kansas State on Saturday, Nov. 3. First serve is set for 8 p.m. ET inside Ahearn Field House.

SCOUTING THE JAYHAWKS

Kansas is currently on a three-match losing streak, most recently falling to Baylor in three sets on Oct. 27, at the Ferrell Center, in Waco, Texas. The Jayhawks feature one of the best defenses in the conference, leading the Big 12 in blocks per set (2.93) and opponent hitting percentage (.175). Rachel Langs leads KU's presence at the net with 1.45 blocks per set, which ranks second in the Big 12. Zoe Hill also checks-in to the top five in blocks per set, averaging 1.29 to sit in fourth. Offensively, Jada Burse averages 3.34 kills per set and has reached doublefigure kills in 9 of the last 11 matches.

LAST MEETING VS. KU

West Virginia dropped a five-set match to Big 12 foe Kansas on Oct. 3, at the Horejsi Family Athletics Center, in Lawrence, Kansas. The Mountaineers fell to the Jayhawks in set scores of 22-25, 22-25, 25-23, 25-9 and 15-7. Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans paced WVU with 20 kills on the evening. Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo led the blocking efforts with seven. Freshman setter Lacey Zerwas also dished out 37 of the team's 45 assists, and sophomore defensive specialist Alexa Hasting had a team-high 18 digs in the match. The Mountaineers posted 50 kills, 41 digs and nine team blocks in the loss. The Jayhawks had 58 kills, 54 digs and 13 team blocks. Jada Burse led KU's offense with 17 kills, while Allie Nelson had a team-high 19 digs.

LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia snapped a three-match losing streak on Oct. 24, claiming a 3-1 triumph over Texas Tech, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown. Four Mountaineers finished the night hitting .200 or better, with the team hitting .184 on the evening. Evans paved the way for WVU with 16 kills, followed by junior right side hitter Natania Levak with 14 for a .394 hitting percentage. DeMeo also hit .348 in the match, racking up 12 kills. Zerwas assisted on 46 kills, three shy of a career high, while Hasting had a team-high 18 digs in the match. DeMeo also recorded four total blocks for the Mountaineers. while freshman outside hitter Macy

McElhaney, Zerwas and Evans posted three total blocks apiece. As a team, West Virginia had 55 kills and just 26 errors on 158 total swings, with 11 team blocks.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Mountaineers are currently 7-4 at the WVU Coliseum this season and is 316-233 at home all-time. West Virginia's four home losses came against Wright State (Aug. 25), Iowa State (Sept. 19), No. 4 Texas (Sept. 29) and No. 24 Baylor (Oct. 13).

FIVE-SET FINISH

The Mountaineers have played in five five-set matches, including three in a row in league play. West Virginia held a 2-0 match lead over a trio of Big 12 opponents, but couldn't seal the deal in the fifth set to walk away with a victory: at Kansas (Oct. 3), vs. Baylor (Oct. 13) and at TCU (Oct. 18). WVU holds a 2-3 record in five-set matches this season, picking up nonconference wins at Florida Gulf Coast (Sept. 8) and vs. Morehead State (Sept. 14).

LOOKING AHEAD

The Mountaineers will trek to Manhattan, Kansas, to square off with Kansas State (12-9, 2-8) on Saturday, Nov. 3. First serve is set for 8 p.m. ET inside Ahearn Field House. WVU swept K-State in its most recent meeting on Sept. 26, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown.

NOT UP IN HERE!

DeMeo has developed into one of the league's premier blockers. She currently sits atop the Big 12 Conference in blocks per set, totaling 104 blocks on the season to average 1.46 per set. The Troy, Ohio, native also ranks 10th among all NCAA Division I players in blocks per set. The Mountaineers rank fourth in the Big 12, averaging 2.52 blocks per set, and are 38th in the nation. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 209.5-164.5. West Virginia finished the 2017 season with 274.5 blocks, including 40 solo, to average 2.20 blocks per set, ranking fourth in the league.

DeMeo is on pace to etch her name in the WVU single-season record book. Her average of 1.46 blocks per set would rank No. 2 all-time by a Mountaineer sophomore and tie for fourth overall in a single season in program history. Additionally, she boasts 104 total blocks on the year, five shy of moving into the top-five all-time by a sophomore. Jordan ranks second on the team in blocks per set. Her average of 0.99 would tie for No. 4 all-time by a Mountaineer freshman. She also has 79 total blocks on the year, six shy of moving into the topfive all-time by a freshman.

WHAT A KILLING

Evans has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 261 kills, averaging 3.18 per set to rank 10th in the Big 12. The Palmdale, California, native has recorded double-digit kills in 14 matches, including 10 of the last 13. She posted a season-high 21 kills on 49 total attempts, hitting .265, in the 3-1 loss at Texas Tech on Sept. 22. She holds a career high of 24 kills, which was achieved last season at Army, on Sept. 15.

LIBERO TRACKING

After splitting time at libero with sophomore defensive specialist Lindsay Proctor in the preseason, Hasting's earned herself a spot in the starting lineup midway through the season. The Plain City, Ohio, native leads the team with 253 digs. averaging 3.05 per set. She has recorded double-digit digs in 12 matches, notching a career-high 28 digs in the five-set loss at TCU on Oct. 18.

LEADING THE PACK

Junior setter Erin Slinde and defensive specialist Gabrielle Cuckovich were named this year's co-captains. Slinde led WVU with 941 assists last season, averaging 9.14 per set, to rank seventh in the Big 12. She also ranked second on the team with 23 service aces, finishing the year with 0.22 per set. Cuckovich played in 91 sets as a sophomore, appearing in 12 Big 12 matches.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

Eight of nine freshmen made it into the rotation this season, with outside hitter Kristin Lux and Jordan starting all 22 matches for West Virginia. Lux ranks second on the team with 2.35 kills per set, while Jordan ranks second in blocks per set, with 0.99. Additionally, outside hitter Rhyenne Filisi, defensive specialists Keatan Broughton, Abby Gibbons and Marielena Somoza, McElhaney and Zerwas saw action on the court.

ZERWAS SETS UP FOR SUCESS

Zerwas leads the team with 602 assists, averaging 8.99 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12. The Phoenix, Arizona, native has earned a spot in the starting lineup in the Mountaineers' last 14 matches, dishing out a career-high 48 assists in West Virginia's 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Sept. 19. Her average of 8.99 would rank No. 4 all-time by a Mountaineer freshman. She also has 602 assists on the year, 81 shy of moving into the top-five all-time by a freshman.

CHALLENGING 2018 SLATE

WVU has played four teams ranked inside the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Poll in 2018, with seven of its 12 losses coming from teams which made the NCAA Tournament last season. Most recently, WVU dropped a five-set match to No. 24 Baylor in its first of two meetings, held in Morgantown. West Virginia, on Oct. 13.
