QUICK NOTES

- West Virginia suffered a 3-1 loss to Big 12 foe Iowa State on Saturday, at the Hilton Coliseum, in Ames, Iowa. The Cyclones took the match from the Mountaineers in set scores of 25-20, 23-25, 25-22 and 25-15.
- The Mountaineers and the Horned Frogs will meet for the 15th time overall on Wednesday and the 14th time in league play since WVU joined the Big 12 in 2012.
- The two squads met once as nonconference opponents back in 2009, with TCU claiming the 3-0 win at a neutral site.
- The Horned Frogs own a 10-4 lead in the all-time series. However, the two teams have split the home-and-away series the last two seasons.
- In its most recent meeting, TCU captured a five-set win on Oct. 18, 2018, in Fort Worth, Texas.
- The Mountaineers are currently 8-5 at the WVU Coliseum this season and is 320-244 at home all-time.
- The Mountaineers are one win away from collecting their 700th win in program history. West Virginia currently holds a 699-738 all-time record since its inaugural season in 1974.
- Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo ranks fourth in the Big 12 Conference in blocks per set, totaling 110 blocks on the season to average 1.34 per set.
- The Troy, Ohio, native also ranks 27th among all NCAA Division I players in blocks per set.
- The Mountaineers rank sixth in the Big 12, averaging 2.38 blocks per set. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 233.5-200.5.
- Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 314 kills, averaging 3.24 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12.
- The Palmdale, California, native has recorded double-digit kills in 18 matches, including 14 of the last 17.
- WVU will close its regular-season slate with a pair of Big 12 matches in Texas. West Virginia takes on Baylor on Wednesday, Nov. 21, at 8 p.m. ET, followed by a 2 p.m. ET league tilt at No. 5 Texas on Saturday, Nov. 24.

SCOUTING THE HORNEFROGS

TCU comes to Morgantown looking to bounce back from a 3-1 loss at Oklahoma last Friday, as the squad enters its final road trip of the 2018 season. Freshman Elan McCall is back in the lineup, as she put down 18 kills and picked up 17 digs against the Sooners. She currently ranks in the top 10 nationally in points per set (5.24 p/s) and kills per set (4.75 k/s). Defensively, the Horned Frogs have three players that are recording over 3.00 digs per set, with Lexi MacLean leading the way (3.38 d/s), followed by Berkli Baker (3.14 d/s) and McCall (3.10 d/s).

LAST MEETING VS. TCU

West Virginia fell to TCU in a five-set match on Oct. 18, inside the University Recreation Center, in Fort Worth, Texas. The Mountaineers fell to the Horned Frogs in set scores of 18-25, 25-27, 25-21, 25-23 and 15-7. Four Mountaineers tallied double-digit kills, as junior right side hitter Natania Levak paced WVU with a season-high 15 kills on the evening. Additionally, sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo led the team's blocking efforts with 11, four blocks shy of a career high. Freshman setter Lacey Zerwas also recorded her third double-double of the season, dishing out 47 assists and recording 11 digs in the match. Sophomore defensive specialist Alexa Hasting led the floor defense with a career-high 28 digs. The Mountaineers posted 60 kills, 85 digs and 18.5 team blocks in the loss.

LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia suffered a 3-1 loss to Big 12 foe Iowa State on Saturday, at the Hilton Coliseum, in Ames, Iowa. The Cyclones took the match from the Mountaineers in set scores of 25-20, 23-25, 25-22 and 25-15. Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans had a team-best 13 kills for WVU. Hasting had a team-high 17 kills, while Zerwas collected her fourth double-double of the season, recording 13 digs and 37 assists on the evening. Freshman middle blocker Kristina Jordan led the Mountaineers' blocking efforts with four. WVU finished the match hitting .107 with 48 kills and eight team blocks.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Mountaineers are currently 8-5 at the WVU Coliseum this season and is 320-244 at home all-time. West Virginia's five home losses came against Wright State (Aug. 25), Iowa State (Sept. 19), No. 4 Texas (Sept. 29), No. 24 Baylor (Oct. 13) and Kansas (Oct. 31).

LOOKING AHEAD

Looking ahead, WVU will close its regular-season slate with a pair of Big 12 matches in Texas. West Virginia takes on Baylor on Wednesday, Nov. 21, at 8 p.m. ET, followed by a 2 p.m. ET league tilt at No. 5 Texas on Saturday, Nov. 24. The Longhorn Network will televise Saturday's match vs. the Longhorns.

NOT UP IN HERE!

DeMeo has developed into one of the league's premier blockers. She currently ranks fourth in the Big 12 Conference in blocks per set, totaling 110 blocks on the season to average 1.34 per set. The Troy, Ohio, native also ranks 27th among all NCAA Division I players in blocks per set. The Mountaineers rank sixth in the Big 12, averaging 2.38 blocks per set. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 233.5-200.5. West Virginia finished the 2017 season with 274.5 blocks, including 40 solo, to average 2.20 blocks per set, ranking fourth in the league.

HONOR ROLL

WVU has picked up one Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honor this season, as DeMeo earned her first-ever career weekly award for the week of Sept. 10-16. It marked the fourth time since 2012 that a Mountaineer has received defensive honors. DeMeo finished the week with 1.92 blocks per set to rank third in the Big 12. She recorded four solo blocks and 19 block assists for a total of 23 blocks on the weekend, earning all-tournament team honors at the 2018 Mountaineer Classic (Sept. 14-15).

MILESTONE WATCH

DeMeo is on pace to etch her name in the WVU single-season record book. Her average of 1.34 blocks per set would rank No. 3 all-time by

Her average of 0.92 would rank No. 5 all-time by a Mountaineer freshman. She also has 86 total blocks on the year, one shy of moving into the top-four all-time by a freshman.

WHAT A KILLING

Evans has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 314 kills, averaging 3.24 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12. The Palmdale, California, native has recorded double-digit kills in 18 matches, including 14 of the last 17. She posted

a season-high 21 kills on 49 total attempts, hitting .265, in the 3-1 loss at Texas Tech on Sept. 22. She holds a career high of 24 kills, which was achieved last season at Army, on Sept. 15.

LIBERO TRACKING

After splitting time at libero with sophomore defensive specialist Lindsay Proctor in the preseason, Hasting's earned herself a spot in the starting lineup midway through the season. The Plain City, Ohio, native leads the team with 302 digs, averaging 3.08 per set. She has recorded double-digit digs in 15 matches, notching a career-high 28 digs in the five-set loss at TCU on Oct. 18.

LEADING THE PACK

Junior setter Erin Slinde and junior defensive specialist Gabrielle Cuckovich were named this year's co-captains. Slinde led WVU with 941 assists last season, averaging 9.14 per set, to rank seventh in the Big 12. She also ranked second on the team with 23 service aces, finishing the year with 0.22 per set. Cuckovich played in 91 sets as a sophomore, appearing in 12 Big 12 matches.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

Eight of nine freshmen made it into the rotation this season, with freshman outside hitter Kristin Lux and Jordan starting in 25 of 26 matches for West Virginia. Lux ranks second on the team with 2.39 kills per set, while Jordan ranks second in blocks per set, with 0.92. Additionally, outside hitters Rhyenne Filisi and Macy McElhaney, defensive specialists Abby Gibbons, Marielena Somoza and Keatan Broughton, as well as Zerwas, saw action on the court.

ZERWAS SETS UP FOR SUCCESS

Zerwas earned herself a spot in the Mountaineers' starting lineup on Sept. 8, dishing out a career-high 48 assists in West Virginia's 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Sept. 19. The Phoenix, Arizona, native leads the team with 751 assists, averaging 9.16 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12. Her average of 9.16 would rank No. 4 all-time by a Mountaineer freshman. She also is 87 assists shy of moving into the top-four all-time by a freshman. Additionally, Zerwas has recorded four double-doubles on the year, totaling 141 digs to rank third on the team.

CHALLENGING 2018 SLATE

WVU has played four teams ranked inside the AVCA Poll in 2018, with nine of its 15 losses coming from teams which made the NCAA Tournament last season. Most recently, WVU dropped a four-set match to Big 12 foe Kansas, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown, on Oct. 31.

MAKING HISTORY IN THE BIG 12

West Virginia upset No. 14 Kansas in the team's regular-season finale last season for its first-ever win over a top-25 team. Three straight Mountaineer kills gave WVU the 15-12 fifth-set win and the 3-2 victory in the contest. West Virginia finished the regular season winning three of its last four Big 12 matches, ending the 2017 campaign in fifth place for WVU's best finish since joining the league in 2012.
