### SOUTH DAKOTA STATE SERIES

Sunday's match will be another Big 12 battle for the Mountaineers, as the Jackrabbits were one of six teams added as affiliate wrestling members to the conference in the summer of 2015. South Dakota State joined five other schools, competing in its first Big 12 Championship in March of 2016. West Virginia and South Dakota State are scheduled to meet in dual action for the third time on Sunday. SDSU has won each of the first two meetings, posting an 18-15 victory at Frost Arena in the initial meeting on Feb. 12, 2016, before recording a 32-9 win in Morgantown last season.

### SCOUTING THE JACKRABBITS

The Jackrabbits are on an 12-match win streak that dates back to Dec. 3, 2017, notching a perfect 6-0 conference mark on the year. Since joining the league at the start of the 2015-16 season, SDSU has combined to post a 20-3 record in duals against Big 12 foes, including a 14-1 mark over the last two seasons, with the only loss coming at Oklahoma State on Jan. 22, 2017. Individually, six Jackrabbits, including top-ranked Seth Gross at 133 pounds, appeared in the first installment of the NCAA coaches' panel rankings, which were released on Jan. 18.

### FAMILIAR FACES

Once again, redshirt senior Jacob A. Smith and senior Nate Rotert of South Dakota State will highlight this season's dual in Morgantown. Smith enters the matchup ranked No. 18 in the nation at 197 pounds, while Rotert enters at No. 11 overall. Then-No. 5 Smith defeated then-No. 7 Rotert by an injury default last season to boast a perfect 2-0 record between the two. In 2016, Smith collected a hard-fought 5-4 decision in their first-ever meeting.

### LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia came back to Morgantown with a pair of Big 12 wins last weekend. On Feb. 2, the Mountaineers overcame a 18-12 deficit to defeat Air Force, 19-18, on the third tiebreaker criteria, picking up their first-ever conference road win at Clune Arena, in USAF Academy, Colorado. With the dual split at five matches apiece and each team owning a six-point victory, it came down to total match points. The Mountaineers outscored the Falcons, 28-27, to take the dual victory over their Big 12 opponent. West Virginia then completed its five-day road trip with a 24-16 win over Northern Colorado on Feb. 3, at the Bank of Colorado Arena, in Greeley, Colorado. Redshirt freshman Kyler Rea earned his first pin of the season at 149 pounds, winning by fall over UNC's Jimmy Fate in 1 minute, 32 seconds. Redshirt junior Zeke Moisey also earned his third tech. fall (15-0) of the season over Sean Cannon of Northern Colorado at 125 pounds. Junior Christian Monserrat notched his third major of the year with a 9-1 victory over UNC's Ben Polkowske at 141 pounds.

### HOME SWEET HOME

After a month on the road, the Mountaineers return to the WVU Coliseum for the first time since their Jan. 7. West Virginia has been victorious in its last three matchups at home, boasting a 3-1 record at the WVU Coliseum this season. Of note, all three victories have been against teams ranked inside the USA Today/NWCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll (No. 25 Pitt, No. 18 Oklahoma and No. 25 North Dakota State).

### TOUGH 2017-18 SLATE

The Mountaineers have faced six opponents ranked inside the USA Today/NWCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll this season, with three of their five losses coming against the country's top-13 teams (No. 13 Nebraska (Nov. 25), No. 10 Virginia Tech (Dec. 22) and No. 5 Oklahoma State (Jan. 19).

### THE PROCESS

With the win against Oklahoma on Jan. 4, fourth-year coach Sammie Henson captured West Virginia's second Big 12 victory in program history. Three days later, the Mountaineers doubled their conference win total from last season, topping North Dakota State inside the WVU Coliseum on Jan. 7. West Virginia then went on to collect two more league victories over Air Force (Feb. 2) and Northern Colorado (Feb. 3) on the road, with the Mountaineers winning four Big 12 matches in a season for the first time in program history. With four league victories thus far, Henson has earned his highest Big 12 win total as the head coach of the Mountaineers. Of note, WVU earned their first Big 12 win in program history last season, as now-sophomore heavyweight Brandon Ngati pinned Iowa State's Joe Scanlan in the final bout of the day to claim a thrilling comeback win over the Cyclones, 22-20, on Feb. 12 inside the WVU Coliseum.

### A PAIR OF WRESTLERS REMAIN NATIONALLY RANKED

A native of Northampton, Pennsylvania, Moisey checks in at No. 14 in both The Open Mat and InterMat's 125-pound rankings, moving up one spot in InterMat's Top-20 Poll. He also jumps up one spot in FloWrestling's Top-20 Poll, appearing at No. 15. Moisey sports a team-high 18-7 record on the year, winning six of his last seven duals. He also owns a 7-2 mark in the Big 12 thus far and paces the Mountaineers with 32 match points and 23 takedowns. Smith, a native of Charleston, West Virginia, checks in to InterMat's Top-20 Poll at No. 18 in his weight class of 197 pounds. Smith went 2-0 in Big 12 action last week, collecting a pair of decisions over Air Force and Northern Colorado, respectively. Smith holds a 9-5 overall mark on the year as well as a 5-3 record in dual matches this season.

### UPDATED COACHES RANKINGS; RPI ANNOUNCED

The second NCAA Division I Wrestling Coaches' Panel Rankings and the first edition of the NCAA Division I Wrestling Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) were released by the NCAA on Feb. 8. Smith (197), Moisey (125) and redshirt freshman Matthew Schmitt (133) of the West Virginia University wrestling team appear in the top 33 of the NCAA Coaches' Panel Rankings. Moisey and Schmitt also check-in to the top 33 of the RPI rankings, along with Rea (149) and true freshman Nick Kiussis (165). Wrestlers must have 17 matches against Division I opponents to be eligible for the RPI rankings. Forfeits do not count towards that total. Wrestlers in each weight class will be measured by winning percentage, rating percentage index (RPI) and coaches' rankings to earn spots in their qualifying tournaments

for the NCAA Championships. The coaches' rankings are compiled by a vote of coaches representing each qualifying tournament. For ranking purposes, coaches may only consider a wrestler that has been designated as a starter at a respective weight class. To be eligible for the rankings, wrestlers must have participated in at least five matches against Division I opponents in the weight class and have wrestled within the last 30 days. Moisey appears at No. 11 in the RPI and is ranked 16th overall in the coaches' panel rankings at 125 pounds. Schmitt comes in at No. 19 in the RPI and is ranked at No. 30 at 133 pounds in the coaches' panel, moving up two spots from his previous rank of No. 32 in the rankings released on Jan. 18. Smith remains in the NCAA coaches' panel rankings, checking in at No. 21 at 197 pounds. Rea checks in at No. 31 in the RPI rankings at 149 pounds, while Kiussis appears at No. 32 at 165 pounds. The final rankings will be used in determining qualifiers for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, which will be held in Cleveland, Ohio, at the Quicken Loans Arena, from March 15-17.

### MOUNTAINEER DEBUTS

Several newcomers made their Mountaineer debut on opening weekend (Nov. 3-5), as redshirt freshmen Hunter Jones (157), Rea (149) and Schmitt (133) as well as true freshmen Hunter DeLong (197), Brenden McRill (184) and Kiussis (165) put on the WVU singlet for the first time in their careers. With only two seniors on the roster, West Virginia has welcomed 11 newcomers to Morgantown this season.

### WVU WELCOMES BACK 2017 NCAA QUALIFIER

Smith returned to the mat for the first time this season on Dec. 9, earning a 5-2 decision over Pitt's Kellan Stout in a first-round tiebreaker at 197 pounds. Since then, he has earned a 9-5 overall mark, picking up a total of five Big 12 victories on the year. Smith also notched an eighth-place finish at the 2017 Midlands Championships, going 3-2 at the two-day event. He spent the majority of the 2016-17 season in the top 10 before suffering a season-ending injury in the Big 12 Championship match. He still earned an automatic bid to the 2017 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships as the Big 12 runner-up, but did not compete due to injury. Over the course of the season, he posted a 20-5 overall mark to go 14-2 in dual matches and 6-1 in Big 12 action.

### MOISEY RETURNS TO THE MAT

Moisey, who earned All-America status as a freshman, took a redshirt last season and returned to the mat for the first time vs. Utah Valley on Nov. 3 - the Mountaineers' 2017-18 season opener. Since then, Moisey has competed at a trio of tournaments, registering an 11-5 mark in tournament play. He also has notched a 7-2 record in dual matches, winning two of his last three matches by tech. falls. Moisey qualified for the 2016 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, but was forced to withdraw due to injury. The highlight of his collegiate career came during his freshman campaign, where he earned an automatic bid to the 2015 NCAA Championships. Unseeded Moisey knocked out four seeded foes and finished as the NCAA Runner-Up at 125. He became WVU's first NCAA All-American since 2007 and was the first unseeded wrestler to make the NCAA finals since 2003. Moisey led the team with a 32-14 mark on the year, defeating six ranked opponents over the course of the 2014-15 season.

### KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY

WVU doesn't have just one set of brothers, but two. Zeke Moisey (125) and freshman Cade Moisey (165) make up one set, while redshirt sophomores Keegan Moore (141) and Zachary Moore (157) make up another. Of note, the Moore brothers are twins.

Upon entrance, fans are encouraged to pick up their passport for the day and visit each of the team stations, including a selfie station with the WVU football team, featuring quarterback Will Grier, safety Dravon Askew-Henry and linebacker David Long Jr. Fans will get a stamp for their passports at each station. ### BIG 12 ADDS AFFILIATE MEMBERS

The Big 12 Conference added Fresno State and Northern Iowa in July of 2017 as affiliate members to give the league a 12-team field. The new additions joined Air Force, Iowa State, Northern Colorado, North Dakota State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, South Dakota State, Utah Valley, West Virginia and Wyoming.

### BIG 12 WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP ANNOUNCED

The 2018 Big 12 Wrestling Championship will be held at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma, from March 3-4, for the second year in a row. Tickets are on sale now. Conference institutions hosted the wrestling championships on campus from 1997-2015. The 2016 event was held in Kansas City's Sprint Center.

### HENSON ANNOUNCES A TRIO OF SIGNEES FOR 2018

West Virginia added three newcomers to the 2018 squad, as Henson officially announced his recruiting class on Dec. 4. Jackson Henson (Morgantown, West Virginia), Emille (DJ) Shannon (Belleville, Illinois) and Matthew Liberato (Florham Park, New Jersey) signed National Letters of Intent in early November as part of National Signing Day and will join the Mountaineers next season.

### LOOKING BACK ON LAST SEASON

WVU finished the 2016-17 season with a 4-13 record and a 1-3 mark against Big 12 opponents. The Mountaineers earned their first Big 12 win in program history last season, as Ngati pinned Iowa State's Joe Scanlan in the final bout of the day to claim a thrilling comeback win over the Cyclones, 22-20, on Feb. 12 inside the WVU Coliseum. Dylan Cottrell also became the first-ever WVU wrestler to win a Big 12 title, as he defeated Oklahoma State's Chandler Rogers in the 165-pound finals of the 2017 Big 12 Wrestling Championship at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on March 5.

### WVU SCORES 600th ALL-TIME WIN

The Mountaineers posted a 22-20 win over Binghamton on Jan. 14, 2017, at the Pitt Duals, marking the program's 600th all-time win since 1921. Cory Stainbrook's pin at 133 led the way, along with a pair of tech. falls from Devin Brown (125) and Dylan Cottrell (165).






