QUICK HITTERS

- The Mountaineers head to the Big 12 Wrestling Championship for the sixth time since joining the league in 2012.
- West Virginia posted fourth-place finishes in 2013, 2014 and 2015. The league then added Air Force, Utah Valley, Northern Colorado, North Dakota State, South Dakota State and Wyoming as affiliate members in 2016, with WVU claiming sixth at the 10-team tournament that season.
- Dylan Cottrell became the first-ever WVU wrestler to win a Big 12 title last season. Cottrell, seeded No. 2 in the 165-pound bout, defeated No. 1 seed Chandler Rogers of Oklahoma State in a hard-fought 5-4 decision, at the BOK Center, on March 5. With Cottrell's first-place finish, the Mountaineers completed the two-day event in seventh place.
- The Big 12 Conference then added two more affiliates in Fresno State and Northern Iowa in July of 2017, giving the league a 12-team field at this year's championship.
- The Mountaineers have a trio of grapplers pre-seeded inside the top five of their respective weight classes: 125-pound wrestler Zeke Moisey (No. 3), 197-pound wrestler Jake Smith (No. 4) and 133-pound wrestler Matthew Schmitt (No. 5).
- Moisey will compete in his first conference tournament since 2015, when he placed second in the 125-pound bout as a true freshman, at the Hilton Coliseum, in Ames, Iowa.

BIG 12 HISTORY

Last year, Oklahoma State won its fifth consecutive team title as well as its 15th Big 12 title overall. The conference championship is held at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the second straight year. The league set a Big 12 Conference attendance record last season when over 15,000 people attended the two-day event. Conference institutions hosted the wrestling championships on campus from 1997-2015. The 2016 event was held in Kansas City's Sprint Center.

BIG 12 PRE-SEEDS ANNOUNCED

Pre-seeds for the 2018 Big 12 Wrestling Championship were announced by the league office on Monday. All 12 schools placed a wrestler in each weight class. The seeds, as voted on by the conference coaches and approved at the pre-championship coaches meeting on Friday, will compete over two days for 45 automatic qualifying bids to the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, as well as the 2018 Big 12 Championship team title. The Mountaineers, who finished seventh at the 2017 Big 12 Championship, have a trio of wrestlers seeded inside the top five of their respective weight classes. Of note, Oklahoma State and Northern Iowa each have three top-seeded wrestlers, while Wyoming has two wrestlers in the top spot.

NCAA QUALIFIER ALLOCATIONS ANNOUNCED

The NCAA also announced qualifier allocations for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships on Feb 22. The Big 12 Conference was awarded 45 automatic qualifying spots, third most behind the Big Ten Conference (80) and the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (47). The 125-pound weight class will qualify the top seven finishers at the 2018 Big 12 Championship – the most of any weight class. A weight-by-weight breakdown is listed below:

Each Division I starter was evaluated for Division I wins at their respective weight class, RPI and coaches' panel rankings. For each Big 12 wrestler that reached the threshold in two of three categories, the league was awarded a qualifying spot in that weight class. NCAA tournament spots will be awarded at the Big 12 Championship based solely on place-finish. Wrestlers who do not earn a bid at their qualifying tournament may still be eligible for one of 47 at-large bids, which will be announced on March 6. All weight classes will consist of 33 wrestlers. The at-large selections will be made based on the following criteria: head-to-head competition, quality wins, coaches' panel rankings, results against common opponents, RPI, qualifying event placement and winning percentage.

A PAIR OF WRESTLERS REMAIN NATIONALLY RANKED

A native of Northampton, Pennsylvania, Moisey checks-in at No. 14 in both The Open Mat and InterMat's 125-pound rankings. He also comes in at No. 15 in FloWrestling's Top-20 Poll. The redshirt junior earned his team-leading 20th win of the year on Feb. 18, pinning Clarion's Gavin Park in 2:17. Moisey boasts a 6-2 record in league action and has won five of his last six duals, including two by tech. fall. He also paces the Mountaineers with 41 match points and 28 takedowns. Smith, a native of Charleston, West Virginia, appears in InterMat's Top-20 Poll at No. 18 in his weight class of 197 pounds. The redshirt senior holds an 11-6 overall mark on the year as well as a 7-4 record in dual matches this season.

UPDATED COACHES' PANEL RANKINGS AND RPI

The third NCAA Division I Wrestling Coaches' Panel Rankings and the second edition of the NCAA Division I Wrestling Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) were released by the NCAA on Feb. 22. Smith (197), Moisey (125) and Schmitt (133) appear in the top 33 of the NCAA Coaches' Panel Rankings. Moisey and Schmitt also check-in to the top 33 of the RPI rankings. Wrestlers must have 17 matches against Division I opponents to be eligible for the RPI rankings. Forfeits do not count towards that total. Wrestlers in each weight class will be measured by winning percentage, RPI and coaches' rankings to earn spots in their qualifying tournaments for the NCAA Championships. Moisey appears at No. 12 in the RPI and is ranked 15th overall in the coaches' panel rankings at 125 pounds. Schmitt comes in at No. 24 in the RPI and is ranked at No. 32 at 133 pounds in the coaches' panel. Smith remains in the NCAA coaches' panel rankings, checking in at No. 22 at 197 pounds. The final rankings will be used in determining qualifiers for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, which will be held in Cleveland, Ohio, at the Quicken Loans Arena, from March 15-17.

WVU WELCOMES BACK 2017 NCAA QUALIFIER

Smith returned to the mat for the first time this season on Dec. 9, earning a 5-2 decision over Pitt's Kellan Stout in a first-round tiebreaker at 197 pounds. Since then, he has earned a 11-6 overall mark, picking up a total of four Big 12 victories on the year. Smith also notched an eighth-place finish at the 2017 Midlands Championships, going 3-2 at the two-day event. He spent the majority of the 2016-17 season in the top 10 before suffering a season-ending injury in the Big 12 Championship match. He still earned an automatic bid to the 2017 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships as the Big 12 runner-up, but did not compete due to injury.

SMITH'S SENIOR TRIBUTE

Smith joined the Mountaineers in 2014 after starting his wrestling career at Cleveland State. A three-time NCAA Qualifier at 197 pounds, Smith has spent most of his career nationally ranked inside the top 20 of several wrestling publications. He placed second at Big 12's

in 2015 and 2017. This season, he battled back from a season-ending injury suffered in the 2017 championship match, finishing the regular-season with an 11-6 overall mark. Smith has earned multiple Big 12 Wrestler of the Week accolades and will finish five active seasons with more than 88 wins. The Charleston, West Virginia, native earned his bachelor's degree in biology and communication studies last spring and is currently in his first year of grad school.

MOISEY RETURNS TO THE MAT

Moisey, who earned All-America status as a freshman, took a redshirt last season and returned to the mat for the first time vs. Utah Valley on Nov. 3 - the Mountaineers' 2017-18 season opener. Since then, Moisey has competed at a trio of tournaments, registering an 11-5 mark in tournament play. He also has notched a 9-3 record in dual matches, winning five of his last six duals. Moisey qualified for the 2016 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships, but was forced to withdraw due to injury. The highlight of his collegiate career came during his freshman campaign, where he earned an automatic bid to the 2015 NCAA Championships. Unseeded Moisey knocked out four

seeded foes and finished as the NCAA Runner-Up at 125. He became WVU's first NCAA All-American since 2007 and was the first unseeded wrestler to make the NCAA finals since 2003. Moisey led the team with a 32-14 mark on the year, defeating six ranked opponents over the course of the 2014-15 season.

TOUGH 2017-18 SLATE

The Mountaineers finished their regular season with a 6-7 overall record and 4-4 mark in league play. West Virginia has faced six opponents ranked inside the USA Today/NWCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll over the course of the season, with four of their seven losses coming against the country's top-13 teams: No. 13 Nebraska (Nov. 25), No. 10 Virginia Tech (Dec. 22), No. 5 Oklahoma State (Jan. 19) and No. 12 South Dakota State (Feb. 11).

A TRIO OF MOUNTAINEER UPSETS

However, West Virginia has notched three upset wins of its own, upsetting No. 25 Pitt, No. 18 Oklahoma and No. 25 North Dakota State, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown. First up, the Mountaineers beat backyard rival Pitt three times in the last four seasons on Dec. 9. The squad then scored back-to-back wins over Big 12 foes in January. The Mountaineers defeated the Sooners for the first time in 32 years on Jan. 4. Three days later, West Virginia went head-to-head with NDSU for the first time in program history. With the win, the Mountaineers now hold a 1-0 advantage in the all-time series.

THE PROCESS

The Mountaineers have more than doubled their Big 12 win total from last season, completing their conference slate with a 4-4 overall mark. The 24-12 victory over No. 18 Oklahoma (Jan. 4) got things started for West Virginia, as fourth-year coach Sammie Henson captured WVU's second Big 12 win in program history. Three days later, the Mountaineers topped No. 25 North Dakota State inside the WVU Coliseum on Jan. 7. West Virginia then went on to collect two more league victories over Air Force (Feb. 2) and Northern Colorado (Feb. 3) on the road, with Henson earning his highest Big 12 win total as the head coach of the Mountaineers. Of note, WVU earned its first Big 12 win in program history last season over Iowa State on Feb. 12.

HOME SWEET HOME

In front of a program-record setting crowd of 4,517 Mountaineer fans, West Virginia capped its regular season with a 25-13 win over Clarion on Feb. 18. The Mountaineers finished their home slate with a 4-2 overall mark. Of note, three of the team's four victories were against top-25 opponents.

MOUNTAINEER DEBUTS

Several newcomers made their Mountaineer debut on opening weekend (Nov. 3-5), as redshirt freshmen Hunter Jones (157), Rea (149) and Schmitt (133) as well as true freshmen Hunter DeLong (197), McRill (184) and Kiussis

HENSON ANNOUNCES A TRIO OF SIGNEES FOR 2018

West Virginia added three newcomers to the 2018 squad, as Henson officially announced his recruiting class on Dec. 4. Jackson Henson (Morgantown, West Virginia), Emille (DJ) Shannon (Belleville, Illinois) and Matthew Liberato (Florham Park, New Jersey) signed National Letters of Intent in early November as part of National Signing Day and will join the Mountaineers next season.
