QUICK NOTES

- The Mountaineers return home for the first time since their season-opening tournament, wrapping up the bulk of their nonconference slate with matches against Morehead State, Penn and Wake Forest at the Mountaineer Classic, held inside the WVU Coliseum, from Sept. 14-15.
- West Virginia is 311-230 at home all-time. The Mountaineers posted a 2-1 record to open the season at the 2018 WVU Invitational, topping Georgia Southern and UConn to walk away with the tournament title on Aug. 25.
- WVU most recently earned a 2-1 record at the Florida Gulf Coast Tournament, held on FGCU's campus last weekend, topping Western Illinois Friday afternoon, as well as host Florida Gulf Coast Saturday evening. The Mountaineers lone loss of the weekend was to the Albany Great Danes on Sept. 8.
- Sophomore defensive specialist Lindsay Proctor and freshman

middle blocker Kristina Jordan earned all-tournament team honors for their efforts at the Florida Gulf Coast Tournament. Eight of nine freshmen made it into the rotation at the Mountaineers' first three tournaments, with outside hitter Kristin Lux and Jordan starting all nine matches for West Virginia. In 2018, the Mountaineers will face seven teams that made the NCAA Tournament last season, as well as three teams that played in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC). As a team, West Virginia is hitting .138, while outblocking its opponents, 83.0-62.5. Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans and Lux lead the way at the net with 76 kills each. Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo leads the team's blocking efforts with 38, averaging 1.46 per set. The Troy, Ohio, native is tied for second in the Big 12 Conference with Texas Tech's Katy Keenan in blocks per set, as well as 18th nationally.

SERIES HISTORY

The Mountaineers and the Eagles have met 11 times in program history, with West Virginia holding a 7-4 advantage in the all-time series. WVU has won the last four of five matches with MSU, picking up a 3-2 victory in its last meeting at a neutral site in 2016.

It's been 18 years since West Virginia and Penn last squared off. The two teams have played just three times since 1982, with the Mountaineers claiming their first-ever victory over the Quakers on Sept. 20, 1991, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

West Virginia will go head-to-head with Wake Forest for the fifth time in program history. The all-time series is knotted at two apiece, with the Demon Deacons picking up the latest victory over the Mountaineers on Sept. 10, 2010.


BIG 12 CONFERENCE

LAST TIMEOUT

The Mountaineers made their way back to Morgantown following a 2-1 weekend at the Florida Gulf Coast Tournament, held on FGCU's campus at Alico Arena, in Ft. Myers, Florida. Sophomore defensive specialist Lindsay Proctor and freshman middle blocker Kristina Jordan earned all-tournament team honors for their efforts at the two-day event. The Mountaineers started off with a 3-0 sweep over Western Illinois Friday afternoon. West Virginia returned to the court Saturday morning, dropping a three-set match to Albany. Despite the loss, West Virginia managed to bounce back in its final tilt of the weekend, topping host Florida Gulf Coast in a five-set thriller for the win later that evening. The Mountaineers played in their first five-set match of the year, taking the contest from Eagles in set scores of 29-27, 11-25, 26-24, 10-25 and 15-13.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

Morehead State sits at 8-2 on the season, with its only losses coming against Marshall and Wright State. Sophomore Olivia Lohmeier leads the Eagles with 125 kills in 34 sets (3.68 k/s). She has been named the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Offensive Player of the Week two weeks in a row.

SCOUTING THE QUAKERS

Penn enters the weekend with a 3-5 record on the year. Sophomore Raven Sulaimon paces the Quakers with 89 kills through 29 sets (3.07 k/s).

SCOUTING THE DEMON DEACONS

Wake Forest holds a 3-6 mark on the year, earning its first three wins of the season at the Wake Forest Invitational last weekend. Junior Caroline Rassenfoss leads the Demon Deacons with 74 kills in 32 sets, averaging 2.31 kills per set.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

Eight of nine freshmen made it into the rotation at the Mountaineers' first three tournaments, with outside hitter Kristin Lux and Jordan starting all nine matches for West Virginia. Lux and Evans each have 76 kills for

the team lead, while Jordan ranks second in blocks with 33. Additionally, outside hitters Macy McElhaney and Rhyenne Filisi, defensive specialists Keatan Broughton, Abby Gibbons and Marielena Somoza and setter Lacey Zerwas saw action on the court. Zerwas comes in second behind junior setter Erin Slinde, dishing out 112 of the team's 327 assists to average 7.00 per set.

LEADING THE PACK

Junior defensive specialist Gabrielle Cuckovich and Slinde were named this year's co-captains. Slinde led WVU with 941 assists last season, averaging 9.14 per set, to rank seventh in the Big 12. She also ranked second on the team with 23 service aces, finishing the year with 0.22 per set. Cuckovich played in 91 sets as a sophomore, appearing in 12 Big 12 matches.

PROCTOR HONORED BACK-TO-BACK

Proctor led the floor defense for the second straight week, earning back-to-back all-tournament team honors for her effort. The Grand Island, New York, native had a career-high match at Florida Gulf Coast last weekend, recording 21 digs in the win. She also earned all-tournament team honors at the 2018 BYU Nike Invitational (Aug. 30-Sept. 1) a week prior, notching 34 digs against three nationally-ranked opponents. Proctor has played in all 32 sets for the Mountaineers this season, leading the team in digs with 104 to average 3.25 per set. She currently ranks ninth in the Big 12 Conference and has recorded double-digit digs in seven of nine matches for WVU.

NOT UP IN HERE!

Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo leads the team in blocks with 38, averaging 1.46 per set to sit in a tie for second in the conference with Texas Tech's Katy Keenan. She also is tied for 18th nationally with Keenan in the blocks per set category. The Mountaineers rank fourth in the Big 12 behind Texas, Iowa State and Texas Tech, averaging 2.59 blocks per set. Of note, WVU also is 31st in the nation in blocks per set. West Virginia

CHALLENGES AWAITS

Coach Reed Sunahara, who is in his fourth season at the helm of the Mountaineers, is known for making a tough preseason schedule. The Mountaineers have already faced a trio of teams that qualified for the 2017 NCAA Tournament, including NCAA Semifinalist Stanford, who was ranked No. 1 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Top-25 Poll at the time. Last season, West Virginia traveled to Minneapolis, going head-to-head with No. 2 Minnesota at the 2017 Diet Coke Classic following a 3-0 setback to No. 6 Penn State at the WVU Invitational a week earlier. The Mountaineers also started their 2016 campaign at the Penn State

Classic, squaring off against the No. 9-ranked Nittany Lions and No. 19 North Carolina. This season alone, West Virginia will face seven teams that made the NCAA Tournament last season, as well as three teams that played in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC).

2017 SEASON

The Mountaineers saw their historic 2017 season end in the second-to-last match of the postseason, as the team dropped a three-set match to Ole Miss in a NIVC Semifinal matchup at the Gillom Athletics Performance Center, in Oxford, Mississippi, on Dec. 9. WVU's run to the semifinals was unforgettable, as the team earned three straight sweeps in front of its home crowd at the WVU Coliseum. West Virginia's 21-13 record was only the second time in program history the Mountaineers won 20 or more matches since their move to the Big East in 1995. With 21 wins in 2017, Sunahara earned his highest win total as head coach of the Mountaineers.

MAKING HISTORY IN THE BIG 12

West Virginia upset No. 14 Kansas in the team's regular-season finale last season for its first-ever win over a top-25 team. Down 9-8 in the fifth set, West Virginia took a timeout to regroup. The Mountaineers went on a 3-0 run out of the stoppage to take an 11-9 lead. Kansas continued to put up a fight, though, capitalizing on a Mountaineer attacking error to tie the set at 12-all. However, three straight kills gave WVU the 15-12 fifth-set win and the 3-2 victory in the contest. West Virginia finished the regular season winning three of its last four Big 12 matches, ending the 2017 campaign in fifth place for WVU's best finish since joining the league in 2012.
