QUICK NOTES

- West Virginia dropped two Big 12 matches last week, opening conference play with a four-set loss to Iowa State, at the WVU Coliseum, on Sept. 19, followed by a 3-1 setback at Texas Tech, on Sept. 22.
- West Virginia and Kansas State first met in 2012, when the Mountaineers joined the Big 12. K-State owns an 8-4 lead in series. However, the Mountaineers swept the Wildcats in the home-and-away series last season for the first time in program history.
- West Virginia picked up the five-set win in Morgantown on Oct. 21, 2017, followed by a 3-0 sweep in Manhattan on Nov. 22, 2017.
- West Virginia has played two teams ranked inside the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Top-25 Poll in 2018, with four of their seven losses coming from teams which made the NCAA Tournament last season.
- The Mountaineers are five wins away from collecting their 700th win in program history. West Virginia currently holds a 695-730 all-time record since its inaugural season in 1974.
- Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo ranks second in the Big 12, with 1.51 blocks per set, totaling 68 on the season. The Troy, Ohio, native also ranks ninth among all NCAA Division I players in blocks per set.
- The Mountaineers rank fourth in the Big 12, averaging 2.62 blocks per set, and are 31st in the nation. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 136.0-102.5.
- Junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans, who was most recently named the WVU Student-Athlete of the Week on Sept. 17, has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 156 kills, averaging 3.06 per set to rank ninth in the Big 12 Conference.
- Freshman setter Lacey Zerwas leads the team with 316 assists, averaging 8.78 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12. The Phoenix, Arizona, native has earned a spot in the starting lineup in the Mountaineers' last six matches, dishing out a career-high 48 assists in West Virginia's 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Sept. 19.

SERIES HISTORY

West Virginia and Kansas State first met in 2012, when the Mountaineers joined the Big 12. K-State owns an 8-4 lead in series. THE ROAD TO 700

The Mountaineers are five wins away from collecting their 700th win in program history. West Virginia currently holds a 695-730 all-time record since its inaugural season in 1974. Fourth-year coach Reed Sunahara owns a 46-61 record at WVU, bringing the program to new heights in his first three seasons. The 2017 campaign marked the first time in 26 years the Mountaineers made the postseason, with WVU reaching the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC) Semifinals.

BIG 12 CONFERENCE

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

K-State is coming off back-to-back losses for the first time this season, following a straight-set defeat at Oklahoma on Sept. 21. However, the Wildcats sit just outside the latest American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Top-25 Poll, receiving five points in Monday's poll. K-State leads the conference in kills, averaging 14.11 per set. Redshirt senior outside hitter Kylee Zumach paces the team offensively, averaging 4.14 kills per set to rank fourth in the league. Senior middle blocker Macy Flowers paves the way on the defensive side of the court, also leading the conference with 1.61 blocks per set. As a team, K-State ranks sixth in the league, averaging 2.42 blocks per set.

LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia dropped two Big 12 matches last week, opening conference play with a 3-1 loss to Iowa State, on Sept. 19, at the WVU Coliseum. WVU then traveled to Lubbock, Texas, as the Mountaineers suffered another four-set loss to Texas Tech, on Sept. 22. West Virginia finished the week hitting .187 with 110 kills and 17 blocks. Five Mountaineers tallied double-digit kills on the week, as junior outside hitter Katelyn Evans led the team with 36. Freshman setter Lacey Zerwas also dished out 89 assists to average 11.12 per set last week, while sophomore defensive specialist Alexa Hasting had a team-high 34 digs to average 4.25 per set.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Mountaineers are currently 5-2 at the WVU Coliseum this season and is 314-231 at home all-time. West Virginia's two losses came against Wright State on Aug. 25, and Iowa State on Sept. 19.

UP NEXT

West Virginia takes on perennial national contender No. 4 Texas on Saturday, Sept. 29, at 1 p.m. Saturday's match features a mini volleyball giveaway for the first 500 fans, courtesy of Coca-Cola. The match also will be a part of WVU volleyball's Alumni Weekend. The

Mountaineers will sign autographs following the match. Of note, the Mountaineers and the Longhorns first met in August of 2012, as Saturday marks the first match of the season between the two teams. Texas currently holds a 12-0 all-time advantage in the series. However, WVU took then-No. 6 Texas to five sets in its first of two matches last season.

NOT UP IN HERE!

Sophomore middle blocker Katie DeMeo has developed into one of the league's premier blockers. She ranks second in the Big 12, with 1.51 blocks per set, totaling 68 on the season. The Troy, Ohio, native also ranks ninth among all NCAA Division I players in blocks per set. The Mountaineers rank fourth in the Big 12, averaging 2.62 blocks per set, and are 31st in the nation. WVU is outblocking its opponents, 136.0-102.5. West Virginia finished the 2017 season with 274.5 blocks, including 40 solo, to average 2.20 blocks per set, ranking fourth in the league.

HONOR ROLL

WVU has picked up one Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honor this season, as DeMeo earned her first-ever career weekly award for the week of Sept. 10-16. It marked the fourth time since 2012 that a Mountaineer has received defense honors. DeMeo averaged 1.92 blocks per set to rank third in the Big 12. She recorded four solo blocks and 19 block assists for a total of 23 blocks on the weekend, earning all-tournament honors at the 2018 Mountaineer Classic (Sept. 14-15).

MILESTONE WATCH

DeMeo is on pace to etch her name in many WVU single-season records. Her average of 1.51 blocks per set would rank No. 1 all-time by a Mountaineer sophomore and third overall in a single season in program history. Additionally, she boasts 68 total blocks on the year, 41 shy of moving into the top-five all-time by a sophomore. Freshman middle blocker Kristina Jordan ranks second on the team in blocks per set. Her average of

WHAT A KILLING

Evans, who was most recently named the WVU Student-Athlete of the Week on Sept. 17, has played in all but one set for the Mountaineers this season. She leads the team with 156 kills, averaging 3.06 per set to rank ninth in the Big 12 Conference. The Palmdale, California, native has recorded double-digit kills in nine matches, including her last five. On Saturday, she posted a season-high 21 kills on 49 total attempts, hitting .265, in the

3-1 loss at Texas Tech. She holds a career high of 24 kills, which was achieved last season at Army, on Sept. 15.

LIBERO TRACKING

One of the biggest question marks heading into 2018 was who would take over for graduate Gianna Gotterba at the libero position. Sophomore defensive specialist Lindsay Proctor and Hasting have split time at libero throughout the preseason, as Proctor leads the team with 2.95 digs per set, followed by Hasting, with 2.63 per set. The classmates have combined for 252 of the team's 696 digs on the year.

LEADING THE PACK

Junior setter Erin Slinde and junior defensive specialist Gabrielle Cuckovich were named this year's co-captains. Slinde led WVU with 941 assists last season, averaging 9.14 per set, to rank seventh in the Big 12. She also ranked second on the team with 23 service aces, finishing the year with 0.22 per set. Cuckovich played in 91 sets as a sophomore, appearing in 12 Big 12 matches.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

Eight of nine freshmen made it into the rotation during nonconference play, with outside hitter Kristin Lux and Jordan starting all 14 matches for West Virginia. Lux ranks second on the team with 2.56 kills per set, while Jordan ranks second in blocks per set, with 1.08. Additionally, outside hitters Macy McElhaney and Rhyenne Filisi, defensive specialists Keatan Broughton, Abby Gibbons and Marielena Somoza and setter Lacey Zerwas saw action on the court.

ZERWAS SETS UP FOR SUCCESS

Zerwas leads the team with 316 assists, averaging 8.78 per set to rank eighth in the Big 12. The Phoenix, Arizona, native has earned a spot in the starting lineup in the Mountaineers' last six matches, dishing out a career-high 48 assists in West Virginia's 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Sept. 19.

CHALLENGES AWAITS

The Mountaineers have already faced four teams which qualified for the 2017 NCAA Tournament, including NCAA Semifinalist Stanford, who was ranked No. 1 in the AVCA Top-25 Poll at the time. Looking ahead, WVU has to face Big 12 foes Texas, Kansas and Baylor twice this season, all of which made the NCAA Tournament in 2017.

MAKING HISTORY IN THE BIG 12

West Virginia upset No. 14 Kansas in the team's regular-season finale last season for its first-ever win over a top-25 team. Down 9-8 in the fifth set, West Virginia took a timeout to regroup. The Mountaineers went on a 3-0 run out of the stoppage to take an 11-9 lead. Kansas continued to

put up a fight, though, capitalizing on a Mountaineer attacking error to tie the set at 12-all. However, three straight kills gave WVU the 15-12 fifth-set win and the 3-2 victory in the contest. West Virginia finished the regular season winning three of its last four Big 12 matches, ending the 2017 campaign in fifth place for WVU's best finish since joining the league in 2012.
