A NEW ERA

WVU Director of Athletics and Associate Vice President Shane Lyons named coach Tim Flynn the school's ninth wrestling coach in April 2018. Flynn came to West Virginia from Edinboro, where he spent the past 21 years building the Fighting Scots into a wrestling powerhouse. He compiled a 223-95-5 career record at Edinboro to become the school's all-time winningest coach and a member of its Hall of Fame. His accomplishments at Edinboro totaled 150 national qualifiers, 38 All-Americans, 64 Eastern Wrestling League (EWL) champions and 97 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) champions. He led the Fighting Scots to five top-10 finishes at the NCAA Wrestling Championships, 14 top-20 finishes and 18 top-25 finishes.

SERIES VS. NC STATE

West Virginia and NC State will meet for the sixth time on Sunday, with the Wolfpack holding a slim 3-2 lead in the all-time series. NC State picked up a 24-9 win at West Virginia on Jan. 31, 2016, as well as a 30-9 victory on Feb. 5, 2017, in Raleigh, North Carolina. Prior to the recent home-and-away series, the two squads have not met since 1953, which was the last time the Mountaineers defeated the Wolfpack.

SCOUTING THE WOLFPACK

NC State is ranked No. 9 in this week's College NWCA/USA Today Top-25 Poll. The Wolfpack will be without a pair of top-10 wrestlers this weekend due to injury: No. 8 Tariq Wilson (133) and No. 4 Nick Reenan (184). However, NC State has a trio of grapplers listed as a probable starter ranked inside Intermat's Top-20 Poll: No. 4 Justin Oliver (149), No. 4 Hayden Hidlay (157) and No. 19 Malik McDonald (197).

WE MEET AGAIN

A trio of Mountaineers look to avenge early season losses on Sunday, as redshirt senior Christian Monserrat (149), redshirt junior Zachary Moore (157) and freshman Josh Ramirez (174) are projected to go head-to-head with some familiar faces on the Wolfpack roster for the second time this season. Monserrat suffered an 18-3 technical fall to Oliver at the Journeymen/MyHouse Collegiate Classic on Nov. 11, while Moore dropped a 13-4 major decision

to Hidlay at the Hokie Open on Nov. 4. Ramirez also suffered a 6-2 setback to Bullard, who is ranked at No. 19 by The Open Mat, at the Journeymen/MyHouse Collegiate Classic on Nov. 11.

LAST TIMEOUT

West Virginia suffered a 26-17 setback to Oklahoma on Jan. 4, at McCasland Field House, in Norman, Oklahoma. The Mountaineers picked up two bonuspoint victories at 133 and 149 pounds, respectively, to take an 11-8 lead over the Sooners before suffering a pair of losses by fall in the heavyweights to hand Oklahoma the team win. Redshirt sophomore Matthew Schmitt earned his third technical fall victory of the season over Oklahoma's Anthony Madrigal at 133 pounds. Additionally, Monserrat earned his first pin of the season at 149 pounds, pinning Oklahoma's Davion Jeffries in 4 minutes, 8 seconds.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Mountaineers return to the WVU Coliseum for the first time since Dec. 19, as West Virginia welcomes Oklahoma State on Friday, Jan. 18, for an 8 p.m. dual. Iowa State also comes to Morgantown on Jan. 20 for a 1 p.m. matchup.

UPCOMING PROMOTIONS

Family Day is scheduled for the Oklahoma State match on Friday, Jan. 18. Families can purchase four tickets and receive a \$15 concession voucher for \$25. Mountaineer Maniac students also in attendance will receive free food and a giveaway item. Additionally, the Mountaineers will sign autographs following the match. The Mountaineers' annual Cradles for Cancer for breast cancer awareness is set for WVU's contest against Iowa State on Sunday, Jan. 20. WVU Medicine will sponsor the match and will collect donations for the WVU Cancer Institute. Fans are encouraged to wear pink and can get the WVU sports official "pink" t-shirt with a donation of \$10 or more to WVU Medicine. Autographs also will take place following the match.

Flynn's inaugural season is highlighted with 18 dual matches, including six in front of the Mountaineer faithful at the WVU Coliseum. West Virginia has faced six teams ranked inside the USA Today/ NWCA Coaches' Top-25 Poll thus far, with the Mountaineers upsetting No. 20 North Dakota State for their first win over a top-25 program. Of note, NC State marks WVU's seventh opponent ranked in the top 25 this season. WVU will wrestle nine Big 12 duals and will face seven opponents that finished in the top 25 at the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.

LEADING THE PACK

Redshirt Senior.....2

Redshirt freshman Noah Adams,
Schmitt and Monserrat were appointed
as this year's captains, with each
wrestler bringing a different leadership
trait to the team room this season.
Monserrat is one of two seniors on
the 2018-19 roster, donning the most
experience over Schmitt and Adams in
a Mountaineer singlet. However, Schmitt
is the only Mountaineer to return to the
mat this season as an NCAA Qualfiier.
Adams, a native of Coal City, West
Virginia, gained valuable experience
wrestling unattached in several
tournaments last season.

FRESH FACES

True freshman James Wujek is listed as a probable starter for the second time this season. The Prosper, Texas, native donned a Mountaineer singlet for the first time in his career on Jan. 4, falling to Anthony Mantanona of Oklahoma in 1:27 at 174 pounds. Wujek finished with a 137-39 record at Prosper High and was a three-time state qualifier, finishing as the runner-up his senior year.

FENSTERMACHER CHECKS BACK IN

Redshirt freshman KJ Fenstermacher started the season at 125 pounds before classmate Joey Thomas took over the starting role vs. Virginia Tech on Dec. 19. However, Fenstermacher will check back into the lineup at 133

pounds this week, as Schmitt battles a common cold back in Morgantown. The Northampton, Pennsylvania, native returns to the mat for the first time since Dec. 19, when he dropped a 9-2 decision to Kyle Norstrem of Virginia Tech at 133 pounds. He sports a 5-6 overall record on the year, as well as a 1-3 mark in dual action. Fenstermacher transferred to West Virginia from Pitt, redshirting as a true freshman last season. He capped his high school career with an overall record of 160-17 at 120 pounds, earning back to-back third-place finishes at the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) Class A Wrestling Championships his junior and senior year.

REA RETURNS

The 141-pound weight class has been a back-and-forth battle since redshirt senior Joe Wheeling suffered a season ending injury in early November. Freshman Caleb Rea most recently topped classmate Luke Martin in a wrestle-off, sliding into this week's starting slot. Rea is no stranger to the mat, as he stepped up in Schmitt's absence in a pair of nonconference duals at 133 pounds. Rea also wrestled unattached at the F&M Open on Jan. 5, placing fifth in the 141-pound bracket. The Weirton, West Virginia, native holds a 13-4 overall record on the year and a 1-1 mark in dual action. He was a fourtime Ohio Valley Athletic Conference (OVAC) placer, capturing an OVAC title his senior year at 132 pounds.

MONSERRAT MAKING MOVES

Monserrat moved up one weight class from last season, competing at 149 pounds for a 14-3 record on the year. He remains undefeated in dual action, leading the squad with 35 match points and 19 takedowns. A native of Methuen, Massachusetts, Monserrat competed at 141 pounds as a redshirt junior, recording an 18-16 overall mark, with five major decisions, two tech. falls and one pin.

KIUSSIS IN THE RANKINGS

Sophomore Nick Kiussis checks into the rankings for the first time in his career at 165 pounds, ranking at No. 19 by Intermat and No. 20 by The Open Mat. Kiussis is on a five-match win streak,

topping a pair of ranked opponents on the way (No. 18 Cam Coy of Virginia and No. 17 Andrew Fogarty of North Dakota State). Kiussis will go head-to-head with Thomas Bullard, who has been in-and-out of the rankings all season, on Sunday. Bullard is coming off a 4-2 win in sudden victory at Ohio State and sits at 11-4 on the season; 6-3 in duals. Kiussis started last season as a true freshman, going 14-14 and leading the team with five pins. This season, he is 14-4 and 7-3 in duals.

NGATI SETTLES IN

Junior Brandon Ngati returned to the lineup on Dec. 15 vs. Pitt, dropping a 6-4 decision to No. 13 Demetrius Thomas in the heavyweight bout. He then dropped a 4-0 decision to No. 7 Billy Miller of Virginia Tech four days later for an 0-2 record in dual action. Ngati bounced back at the South Beach Duals though, earning a 3-0 mark at the two-day event with wins over Virginia's Tyler Love, North Dakota State's Brandon Metz and Purdue's Jacob Aven. He then picked up his fourth straight dual victory with a 5-1 decision over Jake Boyd at Oklahoma. The Gaithersburg, Maryland, native earned

the starting role for WVU the past two seasons, though redshirt junior David Smith went 2-0 at wrestle-offs in late October to win the starting spot over Ngati at the beginning of the season.

JOURNEYMEN COLLEGIATE CLASSIC

Five Mountaineers took first place in their respective pools, as West Virginia collected 217 points for a seventh-place finish at the 2018 Journeymen MyHouse Collegiate Classic on Nov. 11, in Schenectady, New York. The tournament field featured competition from 17 universities, including six teams ranked inside the College NWCA/ USA Today Top-25 Poll. Thomas (125), Monserrat (149), Kiussis (165), redshirt freshman Noah Adams (197) and Smith (HWT) each earned a first-place finish in their respective pools.

HOKIE OPEN

West Virginia sent 16 wrestlers to compete in the 2018 Hokie Open, at Berglund Arena, in Roanoke, Virginia, on Nov. 4. Ten Mountaineers finished in the top five of their respective weight classes, with Schmitt (133) and Adams (197) winning division titles. Schmitt went 5-0 in the 133-pound open division to claim his first tournament win of his

career. Adams also recorded a perfect 4-0 mark to capture the 197-pound freshman/sophomore division title. Additionally, Moore (157) and Kiussis (165) each earned third-place finishes in the open division, while Smith placed fifth in the heavyweight open division. Five Mountaineers also joined Adams on the podium in the freshman/ sophomore division. Ramirez (174) and Fenstermacher (125) each collected third-place finishes, while sophomore Hunter DeLong placed fourth at 184 pounds. Additionally, redshirt freshman Sean Mullican and Thomas each claimed a fifth-place finish in the 285-pound and 125-pound pool, respectively.

SEASON-OPENING VICTORY

West Virginia topped Big 12 foe Northern Colorado, 22-14, in its 2018-19 season opener on Nov. 1, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown. WVU won six of 10 bouts against UNC, including a win by fall at 285 pounds. Down 14-9 with four bouts remaining, Schmitt collected a huge 13-5 major decision over Christopher Sandoval at 133 pounds, cutting WVU's deficit to one at 14-13. Wheeling then pushed the Mountaineers in front with a 7-1 decision over Owen Lamb at 141 pounds. Monserrat helped WVU seal the deal with an 8-2 decision over Mason Hulse at 149 pounds, increasing the Mountaineers lead to five at 19-14. Moore capped the night for the Mountaineers, as he used a trio of takedowns, a reversal and four near fall points for a 12-8 decision over Jordan Robison at 157 pounds.

BIG 12 ADDS AFFILIATE MEMBERS

The Big 12 Conference added Fresno State and Northern Iowa in July of 2017 as affiliate members to give the league a 12-team field. The new additions joined Air Force, Iowa State, Northern Colorado, North Dakota State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, South Dakota State, Utah Valley, West Virginia and Wyoming.






