### LAST TIMEOUT

- WVU (2-1) started the 2021 season with a pair of wins over Kent State and Ohio, before dropping a hard-fought match to No. 8 Virginia Tech on Jan. 10, at the WVU Coliseum, in Morgantown.
- The Mountaineers posted a 22-9 win over the Golden Flashes, followed by a 36-3 victory over the Bobcats. The last time West Virginia scored 30 or more points in a match was against Harvard at the 2017 Pitt Duals. Despite two wins under its belt, WVU suffered a 24-10 setback to the Hokies in the squad's final dual of the weekend.

## SERIES HISTORY

- West Virginia welcomes Bucknell and No. 19 Oklahoma (0-1) to Morgantown for a tri-meet on Sunday, Jan. 17, beginning with a dual against the Bison at 2 p.m. ET.
- Bucknell and Oklahoma will take the mat for the second match of the day, before the Mountaineers meet the Sooners for their first Big 12 contest of the season. A 12-minute intermission is scheduled to take place following each match.
- Sunday afternoon's matchup against BU marks just the second meeting between the squads. The two previously met at a neutral site in 2015, with WVU earning a 19-15 victory in Charlottesville, Virginia.
- The Mountaineers and the No. 19-ranked Sooners will go head-to-head for the 11th time since 1986. OU owns an 8-2 all-time series advantage, with WVU's last win coming in 2018. Last season, West Virginia dropped a 22-18 match at Oklahoma. Redshirt junior Noah Adams (197) and junior Caleb Rea (141) each picked up wins in their respective weight classes.
- Adams and Jake Woodley of Oklahoma will square off for the fourth time overall and the third time in dual action this weekend. Woodley holds a 2-1 record against Adams. However, it was Adams who came out on top last season, earning a 6-1 decision in dual action. The last time Woodley captured a win over Adams was at the 2019 Big 12 Wrestling Championship.
- Oklahoma is led by fifth-year coach Lou Rosselli, a 1993 graduate of Edinboro. Tim Flynn, who is in his third year at the helm of the Mountaineers, served as an assistant at Edinboro during Rosselli's final two years as a wrestler for the Fighting Scots. Rosselli also spent 11 years as an assistant at his alma mater, including a stint under Flynn who was the Edinboro head coach for over 20 seasons.

## MOUNTAINEER QUICK HITTERS

- West Virginia will face three teams ranked in the most recent National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Top-25 Poll this season, including Big 12 foe Iowa State who sits just inside the top 10. WVU most recently dropped a hard-fought, 24-10 battle to No. 8 Virginia Tech in its season-opening weekend on Jan. 10.
- The last time West Virginia topped a ranked opponent was Dec. 30, 2018, when the Mountaineers defeated No. 20 North Dakota State, a Big 12 affiliate, in a 19-17 contest at the South Beach Duals.
- WVU returns eight starters from its young squad a season ago. Flynn and company also welcomed a 10-man freshmen class to Morgantown this fall.
- The freshmen class, which ranked as high as No. 12 in the national recruiting rankings, combined for 13 high school state titles and includes four wrestlers listed among the top 100 national recruits by at least one wrestling outlet, including No. 31 Peyton Hall, No. 48 Brayden Roberts, No. 71 Caleb Dowling and No. 83 Anthony D'Alesio. Hall and Roberts donned a Mountaineer singlet for the first time last weekend, competing in dual action. Dowling also competed in a couple extra matches.
- Four grapplers listed in this weekend's probable lineup are from the state of West Virginia, including a pair of nationally-ranked wrestlers: Adams (197) and Hall (165).

## ADAMS CLIMB TO THE TOP

- Adams, who posted a 3-0 record to start the season, maintains his No. 1 ranking at 197 pounds by Intermat, FloWrestling and The Open Mat. The Coal City, West Virginia, native picked up an 11-5 victory over Kent State's Colin McCracken before he walked away with a win by forfeit against Ohio. He then capped the day with a 7-4 decision over Virginia Tech's Andy Smith. With a trio of season-opening wins, Adams extended his win streak to 35 – which dates back to Nov. 3, 2019.
- He was crowned a Big 12 champion a year ago, defeating South Dakota State's Tanner Sloan in a 5-1 decision to earn WVU's first individual conference title since 2017.
- Adams became the second Mountaineer in school history and the first since Greg Jones (2005) to boast an undefeated record, carrying 32 wins into the NCAA Championships.
- In an impressive sophomore campaign, Adams was the first wrestler in program history to be named the Big 12 Wrestler of the Year and the second to be picked as a finalist for the WIN Magazine/Culture House Dan Hodge Trophy.
- Adams also earned All-America First Team honors from the NWCA for the first time in his career and received the 2020 Hardman Award, an honor given to West Virginia's amateur athlete of the year, as selected by the West Virginia Sports Writers Association.

## NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Following a 3-0 record at the Mountaineer Quad on Jan. 10 to open the season, Hall appears at No. 24 according to FloWrestling and is ranked No. 30 via The Open Mat at 165 pounds. The Chester, West Virginia, native posted a decision and two major decisions in his collegiate debut, most notably claiming a 9-0 victory over No. 22 Colt Yinger of Ohio. Hall finished the weekend with 10 takedowns and a pair of reversals.
- Cardinale comes in at No. 15 according to The Open Mat and ranks No. 17 in both FloWrestling's and InterMat's latest poll. The Bristow, Virginia, native returns to the mat this weekend after earning a victory over Ohio last weekend.
- Despite not competing in the Mountaineers' season-opening weekend, Rea remains in the national rankings at 141 pounds, checking in at No. 22 in The Open Mat's latest top-33 poll.
- As a team, West Virginia ranks as high as No. 20 in the latest tournament top-25 poll by The Open Mat. Tournament rankings are associated with individual wrestler's rankings and predicts how teams could finish at the 2021 NCAA Tournament.

## THE ROAD TO NCAA's

- This year's slate will accommodate for a shortened season, with most dates featuring multiple contests. Wrestlers also will have an opportunity to compete in extra matches for NCAA qualification purposes.
- The 2021 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships are currently scheduled for March 18-20, in St. Louis, Missouri, with bracket sizes and qualification criteria to be determined based on season participation. The NCAA also ruled that all athletes competing this year will receive an extra year of eligibility.
