SERIES HISTORY

- WVU (4-2, 0-1) welcomes No. 17 Northern Colorado (3-0, 2-0) to Morgantown on Sunday, Jan. 31, at 12 p.m. ET, inside the WVU Coliseum.
- The Mountaineers and the Bears meet for the fifth time overall on Sunday and the fourth time in league action since UNC joined five other schools as affiliate members of the Big 12 during the 2015-16 academic year. The two squads met once as nonconference opponents in 2013, with WVU claiming a 35-4 victory in its first-ever meeting at the Hoosier Duals, in Bloomington, Indiana, on Dec. 8, 2013.
- West Virginia owns a 3-1 lead in the all-time series. However, the Mountaineers dropped a 31-10 contest at Northern Colorado last season (Nov. 16, 2019). WVU's last win over UNC took place on Nov. 1, 2018, coach Tim Flynn's first match at the helm of the Mountaineer wrestling program.
- A trio of grapplers projected to start in Sunday's lineup have previously competed against Northern Colorado in dual action: redshirt junior Noah Adams (197), junior Jackson Moomau (184) and redshirt sophomore Alex Hornfeck (157). Adams and Hornfeck each earned victories in their respective weight classes in Greeley, Colorado, last season.
- Adams and Jacob Seely of Northern Colorado will square off for the fourth time overall and the third time in dual action this weekend. Adams holds a 2-1 overall record against Seely, earning major decisions in both matches. The last time Seely captured a win over Adams was on Nov. 1, 2018, when the Coal City, West Virginia, native made his collegiate debut. Adams avenged his 12-9 loss with a dominating, 13-1 win at the 2019 Big 12 Championship to advance to the consolation semifinals.

LAST TIMEOUT

- In an added match, West Virginia overcame a 15-13 deficit to defeat Cleveland State, 18-15, on Jan. 23, at Woodling Gymnasium, in Cleveland, Ohio. With two bouts remaining, WVU desperately needed a pair of decisions to claim the team victory over CSU.
- Adams answered the call for the Mountaineers, as he grinded out an 8-2 decision over Ben Smith at 197 pounds for the one-point edge in team scoring. However, West Virginia was deducted a team point due to an unsportsmanlike conduct call on Adams for throwing his head gear.
- With the match knotted at 15-all, redshirt freshman Michael Wolfram turned it up in the heavyweight bout to claim a 6-3 win over John Kelby, as WVU walked away with the 18-15 team victory.
- Additionally, redshirt junior Killian Cardinale (125), sophomore Scott Joll (174), redshirt freshman Jeffrey Boyd (141) and freshman Peyton Hall (165) each tallied a win in Cleveland over the weekend, with Cardinale earning the Mountaineers' lone bonus victory of the match.

MOUNTAINEER QUICK HITTERS

- Sunday's match marks WVU's third ranked opponent in as many weeks, as the Mountaineers most recently dropped contests to No. 8 Virginia Tech (Jan. 10) and No. 19 Oklahoma (Jan. 17) at home. Of note, West Virginia received votes in this week's National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Top-25 Poll for the first time this season. As a team, WVU was last ranked on Jan. 14, 2016.
- The last time West Virginia topped a ranked opponent was Dec. 30, 2018, when the Mountaineers defeated No. 20 North Dakota State, a Big 12 affiliate, in a 19-17 contest at the South Beach Duals.
- WVU returns eight starters from its young squad a season ago. Flynn and company also welcomed a 10-man freshmen class to Morgantown this fall. The freshmen class, which ranked as high as No. 12 in the national recruiting rankings, combined for 13 high school state titles and includes four wrestlers listed among the top 100 national recruits by at least one wrestling outlet, including No. 31 Hall, No. 48 Brayden Roberts, No. 71 Caleb Dowling and No. 83 Anthony D'Alesio.
- Redshirt freshman Ryan Sullivan, a transfer from Pitt wrestling at 133 pounds, enters WVU's probable lineup for the first time this weekend. The Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, native competed in a pair of extra matches at 141 pounds earlier this season for a 1-1 record on the year.
- Sullivan is a two-time Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) Class 3A finalist, as well as a two-time Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League (WPIAL) finalist (2017-18). He placed second in both tournaments as a 106-pound sophomore, but moved up a weight class to 113 pounds his junior season to claim both titles.
- Four grapplers listed in this weekend's probable lineup are from the state of West Virginia, including a pair of nationally-ranked wrestlers: Adams (197) and Hall (165).

NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Adams continues to rank No. 1 at 197 pounds by FloWrestling, InterMat and The Open Mat. Adams grinded out an 8-2 decision over Cleveland State's Ben Smith last weekend to improve to 6-0 on the year and extend his win streak to 38, which dates back to Nov. 3, 2019. He also paces the Mountaineers with 23 team points and is tied for the team lead with 13 takedowns.
- At 165 pounds, Hall comes in at No. 24 via FloWrestling for the third consecutive week. He also checks in at No. 25 via The Open Mat. The Chester, West Virginia, native most recently picked up an 8-2 decision over Cleveland State's Riley Smucker. Hall boasts a 5-1 record on the year, including a pair of major-decision wins.
- Following his first bonus victory of the year, Cardinale, a native of Bristow, Virginia, moves up one spot to No. 24 in The Open Mat's latest top-33 poll at 125 pounds. Last week, he claimed a 9-1 major decision over Cleveland State's Jake Manley. He is now 3-3 on the year.

THE ROAD TO NCAA

- This year's slate will accommodate for a shortened season, with most dates featuring multiple contests. Wrestlers also will have an opportunity to compete in extra matches for NCAA qualification purposes.
- The 2021 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships are currently scheduled for March 18-20, in St. Louis, Missouri, with bracket sizes and qualification criteria to be determined based on season participation. The NCAA also ruled that all athletes competing this year will receive an extra year of eligibility.
