Career Coaching Highlights

- Under his guidance, Flynn has led the Mountaineers to a couple of four-win dual seasons and saw six wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.
- WVU placed 10th at the 2020 Big 12 Wrestling
 Championship before the season was canceled due to
 the COVID-19 pandemic. Noah Adams' performances
 highlighted the 2019-20 season, as he won the
 197-pound title at the conference tournament to cap
 an undefeated season at 32-0. Adams, a two-time
 NCAA Qualifier, was the nation's second-seeded
 wrestler heading into the NCAA Tournament.
- In his first season guiding the Mountaineers, WVU produced five podium finishers at the conference tournament and sent five wrestlers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2014.
- Flynn came to West Virginia from Edinboro, where
 he spent 21 years building the Fighting Scots into a
 wrestling powerhouse. He compiled a 223-95-5 career
 record to become the school's all-time winningest
 coach and a member of its Hall of Fame.
- Flynn engineered two of the best seasons in Edinboro wrestling history, with his 2014-15 squad placing third at nationals, the program's highest-ever finish.
 Additionally, his 2013-14 team recorded a fifth-place finish at the national tournament. The Fighting Scots ended the year with an 11-3 record, winning 10 of their last 11 duals, including a 17-16 win over No. 6 Pitt.

SERIES HISTORY

- West Virginia opens the month of February on the road, as the Mountaineers compete against a trio of Big 12 affiliate members on Saturday, Feb. 6. WVU heads to Laramie, Wyoming, for a 12 p.m. ET dual at Wyoming, followed by a pair of neutral-site matches against Fresno State and Air Force in Greeley, Colorado, later that evening. The Mountaineers match against the Bulldogs is scheduled to begin at 8 p.m. ET, followed by Air Force at approximately 9:30 p.m. ET.
- Over the last six years, the conference has added eight affiliate members in the sport of wrestling. In the summer of 2015, six schools of the Western Wrestling Conference – Air Force, North Dakota State, Northern Colorado, South Dakota State, Utah Valley and Wyoming – announced its addition to the Big 12's wrestling competition. Two years later, the Big 12 added Fresno State and Northern Iowa to give the conference a 12-team field.
- Saturday's match marks the Mountaineers and the Cowboys third straight meeting as league foes, with WVU claiming its first victory in the all-time series last season. West Virginia took down Wyoming in a 17-16 battle on Feb. 22, 2020, at University High, in Morgantown. WVU won fiveof-10 bouts, including a pair of major decisions, en route to its first conference win of the 2019-20 campaign. Most notably, then-freshman Scott Joll registered a 9-7 decision over No. 12 Hayden Hastings at 174 pounds, marking his first collegiate win over a ranked opponent.
- Additionally, Saturday marks the Mountaineers and the Bulldogs first-ever meeting, while West Virginia and Air Force set to meet for the second time in program history. The two squads last competed on Feb. 2, 2018, as WVU overcame an 18-12 deficit to defeat the Falcons, 19-18, on match point criteria for its first Big 12 road win in program history, at Clune Arena, in USAF Academy, Colorado.

LAST TIMEOUT

- West Virginia topped its first ranked opponent since the 2018-19 season, as the Mountaineers took down No. 17 Northern Colorado in a 25-11 contest on Jan. 31, inside the WVU Coliseum, in
- Trailing 8-0 to start the match, West Virginia won seven of the last eight bouts to secure the victory, starting with redshirt junior Noah Adams, ranked No. 1 nationally, at 197 pounds. Adams earned a 13-1 major decision over No. 16 Jacob Seely to put the Mountaineers on the board.
- Redshirt freshman Michael Wolfgram (HWT) and redshirt junior Killian Cardinale (125) each won by decision in their respective bouts, as West Virginia took a 10-8 lead with five bouts remaining.
- Redshirt freshman Ryan Sullivan made a statement in his Mountaineer debut at 133 pounds, pinning No. 20 Theorius Robison in 3:48 to put WVU on top for good.
- Additionally, redshirt sophomore Alex Hornfeck (157), redshirt freshman Jeffrey Boyd (141) and freshman Peyton Hall (165) each claimed a win in their respective weight classes.
- With the win, West Virginia topped its four-match win total from 2019 and 2020 coach Tim Flynn's first two seasons at the helm of the Mountaineer wrestling program.

MOUNTAINEER QUICK HITTERS

- For the first time this season, West Virginia checked in at No. 20 in Intermat's Dual Meet Rankings. 2019-20 Record 4-12 • WVU is one of eight Big 12 schools ranked inside this week's top 25. 2019-20 Big 12 Record 1-7
 - The Mountaineers have won three of their last four matches for a 5-2 overall record, their best start to a season since the 2015-16 campaign.
- 2021 Starters Returning/Lost 8/2 Additionally, West Virginia received votes in the National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Top-25 Poll for the second straight week. As a team, WVU was last ranked on Jan. 14, 2016.
 - The Mountaineers are 1-0 on the road this season, as the squad previously defeated Cleveland State in an 18-15 battle on Jan. 23.
 - WVU returns eight starters from its young squad a season ago. Flynn and company also welcomed a 10-man freshmen class to Morgantown this fall. The freshmen class, which ranked as high as No. 12 in the national recruiting rankings, combined for 13 high school state titles and includes four wrestlers listed among the top 100 national recruits by at least one wrestling outlet, including No. 31 Hall, No. 48 Brayden Roberts, No. 71 Caleb Dowling and No. 83 Anthony D'Alesio.
 - Four grapplers listed in this weekend's probable lineup are from the state of West Virginia, including a pair of nationally-ranked wrestlers: Adams (197) and Hall (165).

NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Boyd entered the national rankings for the first time in his collegiate career this week. He appears at No. 32 by The Open Mat at 141 pounds. The Erie, Pennsylvania, native captured a 7-1 decision over No. 24 Chris Sandoval on Jan. 31, marking his first win over a ranked foe. With the score knotted at one point apiece, the two grapplers entered sudden victory. However, it wasn't until the second overtime period that Boyd made Mountaineer Nation stand on their feet, as he scored a takedown and four nearfall points for the win. Boyd is now 5-2 on the year.
- Adams, who is 7-0 on the year and owns a 39-match win streak that dates back to Nov. 3, 2019, maintains his No. 1 rankings at 197 pounds by Intermat, FloWrestling and The Open Mat. The Coal City, West Virginia, native most recently picked up a 13-1 major decision over Seely. Adams boasts a pair of bonus victories this season and has outscored his opponents 59-15.
- Cardinale moves up two spots in The Open Mat's poll, coming in at No. 22 after a 7-2 decision over Jace Koelzer last weekend. The Bristow, Virginia, native sits at 4-3 on the year and is currently on a two-match win streak.
- At 165 pounds, Hall moves up one spot in FloWrestling's top-20 poll and two spots in The Open Mat's top-33 poll, checking in at No. 23 in both. The Chester, West Virginia, native most recently scored an 8-5 win over Jordan Robison to improve to 6-1 on the year.
