- The West Virginia University gymnastics team is set to open competition in the NCAA Norman Regional Championships, beginning with a first-round dual meet against Arizona, on Wednesday, March 30.
- Hosted by 2022 Big 12 Conference champion Oklahoma, the regional championships are scheduled for March 30 - April 2, inside the Lloyd Noble Center in Norman, Oklahoma
- Joining the Mountaineers in Norman are No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 8 Minnesota, No. 9 California, No. 16 Arizona State, Arkansas, Boise State, Utah State and Arizona.
- The Mountaineers and Wildcats are set to meet for the fifth time in program history, as well as the first time since 2010.
- The two squads have split the series, 2-2, with Arizona claiming a 194.750-192.975 victory over WVU in the most recent meeting in 2010.

MEET MINUTES

WEST VIRGINIA IN THE RANKINGS

- In this week's Road to Nationals rankings, WVU is ranked No. 19 on floor exercise with a 49.345 National Qualifying Score (NQS)
- The Mountaineers have been ranked inside the top 25 on floor every week during the regular season, after debuting in the rankings at No. 4 on Jan. 17. The rank marked the team's highest since at least 1998 in the Road to Nationals rankings.
- The last time the Mountaineers appeared inside the organization's top 10 was in the final rankings of the 2001 regular season, when the squad was ranked No. 8 nationally on floor.
- Overall, West Virginia sits at No. 31 nationally with a 196.315 NQS. The ranking helped qualify WVU for the 2022 NCAA Regional Championships
- Of note, West Virginia's NQS of 196.315 marks its highest since 2004, when the Mountaineers reached a NQS of 196.685 in the final week of the rankings.

INDIVIDUALS IN THE RANKINGS

- Senior Kendra Combs sits in a tie for No. 44 nationally on floor exercise with a 9.910 season NQS. Combs is tied for No. 7 in the individual regional rankings on floor.
- Junior Abbie Pierson follows in a tie for No. 10 (9.895 NQS) in the region, while sophomore Kiana Lewis checks in at No. 15 (9.870 NQS).
- Juniors Kianna Yancey and Emily Holmes-Hackerd are tied for No. 18 in the region with matching 9.865 National Qualifying Scores.
- Freshman Anna Leigh sits in a tie for No. 23 in the region with a 9.855 NQS.

NOTABLE MOMENTS

- West Virginia's 196.25-195.225 win over No. 22 North Carolina on Feb. 24, was its first win over a ranked opponent since March 17, 2019, when it bested No. 22 Ohio State and No. 24 Penn State.
- The Mountaineers went undefeated from Feb. 6-March 6, before falling to top-five foes No. 3 Michigan and No. 5 Auburn on March 12.
- On Feb. 19, WVU reached its first mark of 196.0+ of the season with a 196.575 to claim first place at Towson. The score marked its highest since March 18, 2018, and is the 12th-highest team score in program history.
- The squad then went on to top that total in the 2022 Big 12 Championship on March 19, securing a 196.650 for the 11th-best total and highest since 2018.

SENIOR LEADERS

- The Mountaineers are led by a trio of seniors this year: Esperanza Abarca, Kendra Combs and Rachel Hornung.
- Abarca is the most experienced gymnast on the roster, having competed in 45 meets in four seasons at WVU.
- Hornung leads the trio with 1,205.225 career points, while Combs is just behind her with 1,063.6 points in her four-year career.
- The duo eclipsed the 1,000-career point threshold this season, as Hornung reached the mark on Feb. 11, and Combs surpassed the milestone on March 6.

JOINING THE RANKS

- Five freshmen joined the Mountaineer squad this season, including Brooke Alban, Brynn Freehling, Heidi Hartje, Anna Leigh and Laura Soltis
- Alban and Leigh have made an immediate impact for WVU, each making their career debuts in the season opener on Jan. 14
- Alban has been a mainstay of the squad's vault and bars lineups, while Leigh has earned consistent time in the bars and floor lineups
- Freehling and Hartje also made their career debuts for the Mountaineers this season. Freehling earned a spot in the floor lineup on Jan. 28, and Hartje anchored the vault lineup on Feb. 11
- Sophomore Gillian Fletcher also earned her first career action on March 6, becoming a consistent member of the vault lineup



MEET MINUTES CONTINUED

LAST TIME OUT - THE 2022 BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP

- The Mountaineers reached a season-high 196.650 at the 2022 Big 12 Championship to finish in third place on March 19. It marked the squad's highest finish at the conference meet since 2017, when it also finished third.
- West Virginia's total was its highest team score at the Big 12 Championship in program history, besting its previous program-best of 196.375, recorded in 2014.
- Senior Rachel Hornung competed in the all-around, earning a spot on the 2022 All-Big 12 Championship Team with a third-place, 39.175 total
- The Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, native became the first Mountaineer to be named to the all-championship team since 2017
- She also was the first to earn the honors on the all-around since 2015

WVU AT NCAA REGIONALS

- WVU's NCAA Regionals bid marks the 42nd regional championships berth for the Mountaineers, their 37th in NCAA competition, and the team's seventh consecutive qualification.
- West Virginia has advanced to the NCAA National Championships three times (1995, 1999, 2000) since 1983.
- The Mountaineers' last NCAA National Championships berth came in 2000, when Hall of Fame coach Linda Burdette led WVU to a 12th-place finish with a 194.175 total
- Now-assistant coach Zaakira Muhammad was the last Mountaineer to qualify for the National Championships as an individual, earning a spot as an individual event specialist in the all-around
- Muhammad earned second team All-America honors after finishing 15th overall with a 39.0375 total

COMBS' SENIOR SZN

- Senior Kendra Combs made her career debut in the all-around lineup at Towson on Jan. 14. She set a new career-best in the all-around on Feb. 21, earning a 39.325 total.
- She earned recognition as the Big 12 Gymnast of the Week on March 1, becoming the first honoree since Feb. 6, 2017
- The Windsor, Conn., native was named to the All-Big 12 Gymnastics Team on the all-around, as she became West Virginia's first all-conference all-around honoree since 2014
- She also was the first to be named to the All-Big 12 team since 2017
- Combs leads the team with 19 podium finishes and 400.2 season points

Career Coaching Highlights

- In 2019, coached Kirah Koshinski to her third career NACGC/W Regular-Season All-America Vault honor and first first-team recognition. She was named to the second team three times (2016-18) and is the first Mountaineer in program history to earn at least one All-America award in three consecutive seasons.

- Coached Zaakira Muhammad to an individual all-around qualification to the 2017 NCAA National Championships, WVU's first qualifier since 2014.

- In 2017, helped Koshinski (regular season, vault) and Muhammad (NCAA Championships, floor) attain All-America second-team accolades, just the second pair in program history to earn honors in the same season.

- Coached Koshinski to the 2016 Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honor.

- Led the Mountaineers to a program best second-place finish at the 2015 Big 12 Gymnastics Championship.

- Coached Hope Sloanhoffer to an individual all-around qualification at the 2014 NCAA National Championships, WVU's first qualifier since 2009.

- Ushered in a new era for WVU gymnastics, leading WVU to a 13-9 record in 2013, its first season in the Big 12 Conference. WVU scored 196.0 or better in each home meet, a program first.

- Led the Mountaineers to the 2012 EAGL title in his first season as head coach.

- Mountaineers finished 2012 ranked No. 21, the team's first season-ending ranking since 2009, and with a 21-5 record, the team's first 20-win mark since 2008.

2022 REGULAR-SEASON MEET RECAPS

Meet 1: WVU at Towson with West Chester and William & Mary (Jan. 14)

WVU placed second in its season-opening quad meet at Towson with West Chester and William & Mary in Towson, Maryland, on Jan. 14 ... the Mountaineers opened the meet on the uneven bars and were forced to count a trio of falls ... the squad fought back from there to earn eight scores of 9.8 or higher and record a total score of 194.000 to top West Chester (192.600) and William & Mary (192.010), while the host Tigers claimed the top spot with 194.150 ... senior Rachel Hornung paced WVU on balance beam, notching a 9.85, just shy of her career high, to place third overall on the event ... junior Abbie Pierson and sophomore Kiana Lewis paced the Mountaineers on floor exercise, tallying matching 9.9s to tie for first place on the event ... Hornung (9.8), freshman Anna Leigh (9.875) and Combs (9.85) all recorded scores at 9.8 or better to help WVU sweep the top five spots in the final standings on floor ... in the squad's final rotation on vault, West Virginia hit six-of-six routines, as Pierson topped the podium with a 9.825 ... Hornung and Combs competed in the all-around, as Hornung claimed the top spot with a 39.100.

Meet 2: WVU vs. Denver (Jan. 21)

West Virginia opened up its home and conference slates with a 197.600-195.725 loss to No. 6 Denver at the WVU Coliseum in Morgantown, on Feb. 21 ... WVU's score of 195.725 tops its score from last week's season opener by 1.725 points, while the Mountaineers also bested their totals on uneven bars and floor exercise from last week ... despite finishing second to Denver on all four events, the Pioneers narrowly outsourced WVU on floor, 49.4-49.35, as West Virginia tallied five scores of 9.85 or better ... three different Mountaineers earned four podium appearances against UD, including three on floor and one on the all-around ... senior Kendra Combs led the way in second place on floor with a 9.9 total and third place on the all-around with a 39.150 ... junior Abbie Pierson and sophomore Kiana Lewis tied for third place on floor with a pair of 9.875 scores ... junior Kianna Yancey made her season debut on the all-around, while Combs and classmate Rachel Hornung also appeared in all four events ... Combs notched a total score of 39.150, taking third place ... Hornung followed with a 38.950, and Yancey tallied a 38.425.

Meet 3: WVU at Iowa State (Jan. 28)

West Virginia tallied a season-best road score, but fell, 196.225-195.425, to Iowa State in Ames, Iowa, on Jan. 28 ... Iowa State outsourced West Virginia on vault, balance beam and uneven bars, but WVU secured a narrow 49.25-49.225 victory on floor exercise ... West Virginia was led by junior Abbie Pierson, who logged stellar performances on each event in which she competed, including event wins on vault and balance beam ... Pierson's night was highlighted by a career-high 9.95 on vault to lead the Mountaineer lineup to a season-high 49.125 on the event ... Pierson led WVU with solo event wins on vault and beam, while senior Kendra Combs ascended the podium three times ... Combs finished tied for second on beam with a 9.85, before going on to match her career high on floor and finish tied for first place with a 9.9 ... the lone competitor in the all-around, Combs totaled a 39.025 across all four events.

Meet 4: WVU at Pitt with NC State and Alaska Anchorage (Feb. 6)

WVU recorded a season-best overall score to take first place in a quad meet at Pitt with NC State and Alaska Anchorage inside Fitzgerald Field House in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, on Feb. 6 ... the Mountaineers tallied a season-best 195.925 to secure first place, as the host Panthers finished in second place with a 195.8. NC State followed in third place with a 194.550, and Alaska Anchorage tallied a 191.25 total to finish in fourth place ... junior Abbie Pierson and sophomore Kiana Lewis paced the team with one first-place finish each ... Pierson topped the podium on floor exercise with a 9.9, and Lewis recorded a 9.825 on vault to finish in a four-way tie for first place ... three Mountaineers competed on the all-around at Pitt ... seniors Kendra Combs and Rachel Hornung each tallied career-high totals, while Pierson made her career debut on the all-around ... Combs secured a 39.225 to finish second overall, Hornung earned a 39.125 for third place and Pierson tallied a 38.575.

Meet 5: WVU vs. Texas Woman's and Pitt (Feb. 11)

WVU soared to a season-high total on the uneven bars to finish in first place in a tri meet against Pitt and Texas Woman's on Feb. 11 ... the Mountaineers tallied three consecutive scores of 9.875 to close the rotation, recording their first bars total of 49.0+ with a 49.150 on the event ... West Virginia finished first on every event except for balance beam, earning the team win on vault, bars and floor exercise on its way to a winning, 195.9 total ... Pitt finished second in the tri meet with a 194.575, while TWU finished third with a 194.5 ... junior Kianna Yancey paced West Virginia's podium finishers, as she tallied a pair of first-place finishes, while senior Rachel Hornung earned a win on the all-around ... five other Mountaineers – including senior Kendra Combs, junior Emily Holmes-Hackerd, sophomore Kiana Lewis and freshman Anna Leigh and Brooke Alban – also ascended the podium against Pitt and TWU ... Hornung and Combs were the lone Mountaineer competitors in the all-around, as Hornung topped the podium with a career-best 39.175 ... Combs followed in second place, after notching a 39.125 total.

Meet 6: WVU at Towson with Ursinus College (Feb. 19)

WVU coming off a season-best showing with a team score of 196.575 in a tri meet at Towson with Ursinus on Feb. 19, in Towson, Maryland ... West Virginia took home the vault and floor exercise event titles after scoring 49.0 or better on every rotation for the first time this season ... overall, the host Tigers took second place with a 196.525, while Ursinus place third with a 185.175 ... junior Kianna Yancey paced the team with a pair of podium finishes at Towson, including a tie for first on vault and third on floor exercise ... senior Kendra Combs and sophomore Chloe Asper also tallied first-place finishes, as Combs took the top spot on floor and Asper tied for first on beam ... Combs was the lone competitor in the all-around, as she notched a 39.200 total on all four events.

Meet 7: WVU vs. George Washington and William & Mary (Feb. 21)

West Virginia used a season-best score on floor exercise and a career-high night from senior Kendra Combs to finish in first place in a tri meet with George Washington and William & Mary inside the WVU Coliseum in Morgantown, on Feb. 21 ... all six gymnasts in WVU's floor lineup scored a 9.85 or better, including a trio who earned 9.9 or higher, to help the squad earn a 49.525 total, on its way to a first-place 196.100 final score ... the total marked WVU's second straight score of 196.0 or better, while it also is the No. 36 team score in program history ... Combs led the way for the Mountaineers, posting a huge, career-high 39.325 all-around score ... the Windsoor, Connecticut, native topped every podium but beam, as she earned career-best totals on vault, floor and the all-around ... Combs earned a 9.85 on vault, before going on to match the score on the uneven bars ... she rounded out the night with a near-perfect floor routine that earned a 9.95 ... five other Mountaineers also tallied podium finishes, including junior Abbie Pierson who earned three and freshman Anna Leigh with two ... senior Rachel Hornung, junior Kianna Yancey and sophomore Agatha Handono added one apiece.

Meet 8: WVU at North Carolina (Feb. 24)

WVU earned a 196.250-195.225 victory at No. 22 North Carolina on Feb. 24 ... the Mountaineers scored a season-high 49.225 on balance beam and a 49.325 on floor exercise to conclude the meet and outlast the Tarheels ... combined, WVU earned 10 podium finishes across all events, as well as a pair of wins ... West Virginia shined once again on floor exercise, as Combs led the way with her second 9.925 of the season, and Pierson and junior Emily Holmes-Hackerd followed with a pair of 9.9's ... the scores helped the trio sweep the podium at the end of the night ... Pierson also earned an event win on balance beam, securing a career-best 9.95 to pace the beam lineup and secure the meet victory ... Pierson's career-high 9.95 also was the first for the Mountaineers on the event since now-assistant coach Zaakira Muhammad scored a 9.95 on beam at Towson on March 18, 2018.

Meet 9: WVU vs. Ball State (March 6)

WVU used event wins on balance beam and floor exercise to tally a come-from-behind, 196.250-195.400 victory over Ball State inside the WVU Coliseum on March 6 ... in the Mountaineers' final home meet of the 2022 campaign, West Virginia put together another big performance on floor exercise to secure the Senior Day victory ... all five scoring gymnasts tallied a 9.85 or better to earn a 49.325 total on the event, helping West Virginia record its 11th straight win ... junior Kianna Yancey paced WVU against Ball State, notching a pair of podium finishes, including a share of first place on floor after notching a career-best 9.9 to anchor the lineup ... junior Abbie Pierson also recorded a pair of podium appearances, while six other Mountaineers added one podium finish apiece ... senior Rachel Hornung was the Mountaineers' lone competitor in the all-around, as she finished in second place with a career-high matching 39.175.

Meet 10: WVU at Michigan with Auburn (March 12)

WVU earned its second-highest team score of the season, as well as a season-high on the uneven bars, to finish in third place in a tri-meet at No. 3 Michigan with No. 5 Auburn inside the Crisler Center in Ann Arbor, Michigan ... the Mountaineers used a season-best 49.2 on the uneven bars to earn a 196.4 final score, good for the 19th-best team score in program history ... West Virginia also recorded a 49.3 on floor exercise to take second overall on the event ... in the final team standings, the host Wolverines placed first with a 197.95, while Auburn finished in second place with a 197.175 ... the Mountaineers opened the meet on balance beam, where junior Abbie Pierson led the way with a 9.875, as WVU notched a 48.975 total on the first rotation ... in the second rotation on floor, senior Kendra Combs paced the lineup with a 9.9 ... West Virginia then moved to vault, where senior Rachel Hornung and sophomore Kiana Lewis finished with a pair of 9.825s to lead the lineup to a 48.925 total ... the final rotation on the uneven bars saw a trio of Mountaineers either match or set their career highs, led by senior Esperanza Abarcá's season-best and career-high matching 9.9 ... junior Kianna Yancey matched her career high with a 9.875, and Pierson added a career-best 9.8 to help WVU notch a season-high 49.2 on bars.

THE ROAD TO AN NQS

The Road to Nationals Rankings were determined by team averages throughout the first half of the season. The Feb. 21 poll was the first of the year determined by National Qualifying Scores (NQS). NQS determines the top 16 teams that are seeded on a national basis for the NCAA Regional Championships. The NQS is obtained by taking a team's six best regular-season meet scores – three of which must be away – and dropping the top score before averaging the remaining five.

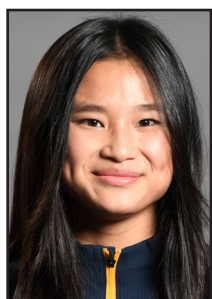

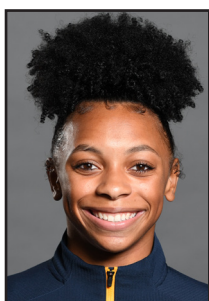

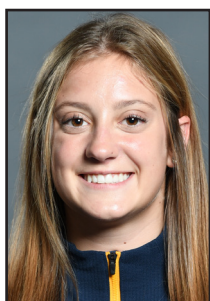
