QUICK HITS

- West Virginia begins postseason play at the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship against No. 3-seed Oklahoma on Wednesday night at Globe Life Field.
- WVU is 15-14 all-time at the Big 12 Championship. The Mountaineers have won multiple games at the event in six of the last eight tournaments, including five in a row.
- After going 14-10 inside the league, the Mountaineers earned the No. 6 seed in this week's championship.
- West Virginia's 14 Big 12 wins are its most in one season since joining the league in 2013.
- Overall, WVU is 13-18 against Oklahoma. Earlier this season, the Sooners took two of three games from May 13-15, in Norman.
- West Virginia and Oklahoma are set to meet in the postseason for the first time since 2016.
- The winner of Wednesday's game meets the winner of No. 2 Texas Tech vs. No. 7 Kansas State on Thursday. The two losers will be paired in an elimination game.
- Last time out, the Mountaineers capped the regular season with a three-game sweep over Kansas State from May 19-21, in Morgantown. West Virginia won, 15-4, 15-4, and 5-1.
- It marked WVU's second, Big 12 sweep of the season, the first time it has ever accomplished the feat in one season.
- The Mountaineers are the only team in the Big 12 who haven't endured a three-game losing streak this season.
- What's more, WVU is an impressive 15-5 in games following a loss in 2022.
- Coach Randy Mazey is 296-228 with the Mountaineers since taking over in 2013 and owns 483 career wins in 16 seasons as a head coach.
- WVU has won 30 or more games in five of Mazey's 10 seasons in Morgantown.
- Earlier this week, eight Mountaineers earned a spot on the All-Big 12 Teams, led by first-team honorees Trey Braithwaite (5th year, RHP) and Austin Davis (Sr., OF).
- Additionally, sophomore C McGwire Holbrook earned second-team honors, while redshirt junior RHP Noah Short, junior RHP Jacob Watters, sophomore LHP Ben Hampton and freshman INF JJ Wetherholt were Honorable Mention selections. Freshman RHP Chris Sleeper joined Wetherholt on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team.
- WVU is re-writing the record books in stolen bases. The club has stolen 154 bases so far this spring, the most in single-season program history.
- The Mountaineers enter the week ranked No. 2 nationally and No. 1 in the Big 12 in stolen bases. They also are No. 1 among "Power 5" programs in stolen bases since 2018.
- Individually, junior OF Victor Scott II's 38 stolen bases rank No. 6 in the nation. It's also the most in one season in WVU baseball history.
- West Virginia is 6-4 in its last 10 games, 9-6 in its last 15 games and 12-8 in its last 20 games.

Subscribers can watch ESPN+ on the ESPN App via most major mobile and connected-TV platforms, including iPhone, iPad, AppleTV, Android devices, Roku, Chromecast, FireTV, XBOX, PlayStation, Oculus Go and Samsung-connected TVs. It is also available via ESPN.com on the web.

In the spring of 2019, the Big 12 Conference and ESPN agreed to significantly expand their existing rights agreement, which runs through 2024-25. Under the expanded agreement, hundreds of additional Big 12 sports events annually are distributed on the Big 12 Now on ESPN+ digital platform.

FIRST CLASS

WVU has brought in some of its best talent in program history over the past five seasons, resulting in top-35 signing classes from 2018-22, according to Perfect Game. Year in and year out, the Mountaineers draw the attention of the nation's top players.

KEY TEAM NOTES

- Since debuting as a program in 1892, WVU has logged more than 2,200 wins, produced 27 Major League Baseball players, 24 All-Americans and one United States Olympian.
- The 2022 campaign marks the 130th year and 127th season of baseball at WVU. The Mountaineers are the second-oldest program in the Big 12.
- Prior to the start of the season, fifth-year senior RHP Trey Braithwaite, redshirt junior RHP Noah Short and Watters were named to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List. WVU was one of seven schools to have multiple players on the list, which honors the top relief pitcher in college baseball, as well as the only team in the country to have three players recognized.
- On April 27, Braithwaite was included on the Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List. He became the fourth WVU pitcher to be named to the list since 2018.
- Junior OF Victor Scott II was featured on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays on Feb. 25. He earned the No. 5 spot following a critical, over-the-wall catch in center field at Charlotte. He was on the program again at the No. 8 spot for stealing home on March 25, vs. Youngstown State. Infielder Tevin Tucker also was featured on the program (No. 5) on April 6.
- West Virginia finished 5-2 in February, good for its sixth winning record in the season's opening month in the last seven years. The club also went 9-7 in March, 11-7 in April and is 8-4 in May.
- The Mountaineers scored their first-ever series win at then-No. 10 TCU, from April 1-3, in Fort Worth. It marked the first series win over a top-10 opponent on the road since March 17-19, 2017, at then-No. 10 Baylor.
- WVU also enjoyed a three-game sweep over Baylor from April 8-10, at home. It marked the club's first series sweep over a Big 12 opponent since May 6-8, 2016, vs. Texas.
- The Mountaineers went on to sweep Kansas State at home to close the regular season (May 19-21), marking the first time they swept a pair of Big 12 foes in one season in program history.
- Sophomore OF Braden Barry and sophomore INF Nathan Blasick earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors on May 12, becoming the first WVU duo to be named to the team since 2003 (Lee Fritz & Zac Cline).

THE MAZEY EFFECT

Coach Randy Mazey is in his 10th season at the helm in Morgantown and owns a 296-228 mark with the Mountaineers.

- Mazey was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and ABCA East Regional Coach of the Year in 2019, after leading West Virginia to its second NCAA Tournament appearance in three years.
- He became the first coach in WVU history to be selected for the Big 12's yearly honor, while the ABCA accolade was his second in three seasons and the fourth ever for a WVU coach.
- Mazey's Mountaineer teams have won at least 30 games in five different campaigns and have/will finish .500 or better in nine of his 10 seasons at the helm.
- Mazey's 2019 club won 38 games, the most in his WVU tenure and second-most in school history, sitting only behind the 1994 squad (40 wins).
- April 9's game against Baylor marked Mazey's 500th game as the skipper of the Mountaineers.
- Now in his 16th season as a head coach, he is 483-388-2 in his career.

HOMEGROWN TALENT

Five West Virginia natives are featured on the 2022 roster, the second-most of any state (Pennsylvania, 8). Together, the group understands as well as anyone in the program about the honor and unique opportunity to represent the citizens of the Mountain State.

- The group includes freshman infielder/catcher Joel Gardner (Poca), freshman first baseman Grant Hussey (Washington), sophomore infielder Mikey Kluska (White Sulphur Springs), senior left-handed pitcher Beau Lowery (Martinsburg) and redshirt junior right-hander Noah Short (Scott Depot).

COUNTRY ROADS, TAKE ME HOME

Along with the squad's five in-state products, WVU is represented by 14 total states this season.

- Pennsylvania leads the list with eight representatives, ahead of West Virginia (five), Virginia (five), Georgia (four) and Alabama (three). WVU has two players from Florida, Kentucky, New York and Wisconsin, as well as one from Maryland, New Jersey, New Mexico, Texas and Ontario, Canada.

MOUNTAINEER BREAKDOWN

Take a look inside WVU's 38-man roster this spring:

- The roster is comprised of 16 freshmen, seven sophomores, one redshirt sophomore, three juniors, four redshirt juniors, three seniors, one redshirt senior and three fifth-year seniors.
- The group consists of four catchers, 11 infielders, eight outfielders, 19 RHPs and three LHPs.
- WVU also has a total of eight players with the ability to play multiple positions in the field, as noted on the squad's roster page.

VETERAN ADDITIONS

West Virginia stocked up with veteran talent over the offseason, adding four players with prior Division I experience to the roster in 2022.

- WVU has three fifth-year senior pitchers who have transferred in to finish their collegiate careers in Morgantown. RHP Trey Braithwaite arrived from Navy, while RHP Zach Bravo comes from Lamar and RHP Chase Smith from Pitt.
- In four seasons at Navy (2018-21), Braithwaite became Navy's all-time leader in saves (17). Smith also rewrote some records at his prior institution, appearing in 89 career games at Pitt from 2018-21, including a program-record 33 in 2019.
- Prior to his time in Division I ball, Bravo was selected in the 2019 MLB Draft, a 29th round pick by the Tampa Bay Rays.
- Additionally, a fourth Division I transfer joined the team in 2022 in redshirt junior C/INF Dayne Leonard, who played at Virginia Tech last spring.

SPEED KILLS

Over the last five seasons, few have been better on the basepaths than the Mountaineers. According to the numbers, WVU's aggressive baserunning has become a part of the program's DNA.

- From 2018-21, West Virginia swiped 309 bases, good for No. 1 in the Big 12 Conference in that time.
- Additionally, the squad ranked No. 14 nationally and No. 1 among "Power 5" teams in stolen bases from 2018-21.
- This season, the Mountaineers have been as aggressive as ever on the basepaths, ranking No. 2 nationally in the category.
- With 154 stolen bases this season, WVU is re-writing the record book for the most in a single season in program history. The previous best was 114 bags stolen in 1986.
- Individually, junior OF Victor Scott II has swiped 38 bags in 2022, good for No. 1 in single-season WVU history.

TOURNAMENT TIME

As the Big 12 Baseball Championship shifts to Globe Life Field for the first time in 2022, the Mountaineers hope their track record of conference tournament success continues in Arlington.

- WVU has won multiple games at the Big 12 Tournament in six of the last eight years the event has been played, including five in a row.
- West Virginia appeared in the semifinals in each season from 2016-19, with a pair of championship-game appearances in that span.
- Overall, the club is 15-14 all-time at the event. All 15 of WVU's victories in the Big 12 Tournament have come in OKC.
- Despite the success, WVU has never entered the tournament as a top-two seed. The squad was the No. 3 seed in 2013, marking its highest seeding in its Big 12 tenure. West Virginia has been a No. 6 seed or lower on five occasions.

WINNING IT LATE

Taking on an identity of a team that is never out of a game, West Virginia has won eight games in the ninth inning or later this season.

- Trailing, 4-1, at one point, WVU scored four unanswered at Charlotte on Feb. 25, including the go-ahead run in the top of the ninth.
- At the Cambria College Classic on March 4 in Minneapolis, WVU overcame a 4-2 deficit in the sixth to top Minnesota, 5-4, with a ninth-inning run.
- WVU also had two walk-off wins in one week on March 8 vs. Rider (5-4) and March 11 vs. Ohio State (7-6).
- On April 1, West Virginia opened Big 12 play with a wild, ninth-inning comeback at TCU. Trailing by a run and down to its last strike, WVU stole home to tie the game and added the go-ahead run when the ball got away from the catcher.
- A week later, WVU drew a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the ninth to walk-off Baylor, 7-6, on April 8, at home.
- WVU won its second extra-inning game on April 20, against Pitt at PNC Park. The Mountaineers scored the go-ahead run on a Panther throwing error.
- A two-run, ninth-inning rally fueled the Mountaineers to a 3-2 win over Charleston (WV) on May 4. Junior OF/LHP Kevin Dowdell led off the frame with a solo home run, before sophomore C McGwire Holbrook notched a walk-off single.

WAGENER FIELD AT MONONGALIA COUNTY BALLPARK

Wagener Field at Monongalia County Ballpark took on Rick and Jay Wagener's namesake on Aug. 30, 2021, following a major gift donation of \$1 million to the program. Rick Wagener was a standout pitcher at WVU from 1968-71.

- The donation will help with the maintenance and upkeep at Monongalia County Ballpark, as well as assist in the team's greatest needs.
- Rick Wagener, who is a 1971 graduate and first-ever freshman to play at the varsity level for the Mountaineers, serves as the managing partner and registered principal at Wagener-Lee, LLC, a financial and investment advisor located in Columbia, Maryland. His wife, Jay, also is a WVU grad.
- Wagener spent three seasons in the New York Mets organization from 1971-73, after being selected by the club in the second round of the 1971 January Secondary Draft.
- Prior to April 9's game against Baylor, the Mountaineers honored the Wageners with a field dedication ceremony.

HOME, SWEET HOME

The 2022 season marked West Virginia's eighth at beautiful Monongalia County Ballpark. With the help of Mountaineer Nation, the venue has become one of the greatest atmospheres in all of college baseball.

- WVU has tallied an impressive 110-61 mark at home since the ballpark opened in 2015. What's more, the club has never had a losing home record at the park and went 17-6 at the complex this spring.
- The squad's 100th win at the stadium came in a 17-8 triumph over Marshall on April 6, 2022.
- The Mountaineers had a streak 22 consecutive midweek, home wins from May 16, 2017, to April 27, 2022. Still, WVU has won 31 of its last 33 midweek, home games in Morgantown.
- A record crowd of 4,355 packed the stands to watch WVU's NCAA Regional opener vs. Fordham on May 31, 2019.
- Mon. County Ballpark was named BaseballParks.com's Ballpark of the Year in 2015.

- Led by fifth-year coach Skip Johnson, Oklahoma is 33-20 this season. OU also went 15-9 in Big 12 play, good for the No. 3 seed in this weekend's conference tournament.
- The Sooners capped the regular season by winning a series over Texas Tech, 2-1, in Lubbock last weekend.
- Earlier this season, OU took two of three games over the Mountaineers from May 13-15, in Norman.
- INF Peyton Graham and LHP Jake Bennett were named to the All-Big 12 First Team, while INF Blake Robertson, OF Tanner Tredaway and RHP Trevin Michael earned second-team honors.
- Additionally, Robertson was voted the league's Newcomer of the Year.
- Tredaway leads the squad with a .346 average, while Graham's 14 home runs and 53 RBI pace OU offensively.
- Oklahoma and West Virginia are set to meet in the postseason for the first time since 2016.
- OU is ranked as high as No. 18 by Perfect Game this week, while Baseball America and D1Baseball ranked the Sooners at No. 19 and No. 22, respectively.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Mountaineers capped the regular season with a three-game sweep over Kansas State last weekend in Morgantown.
- WVU tallied a pair of 15-4 victories to begin the series, before earning a 5-1 triumph in the regular-season finale.
- It marked the club's second sweep over a Big 12 foe this season, the first time it has ever accomplished the feat.
- Saturday's win was WVU's 14th in Big 12 play, a new single-season program record.
- Freshman INF JJ Wetherholt led the way at the plate for WVU by finishing 5-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, six runs scored, six RBI and a stolen base in the series. Sophomore C/DH McGwire Holbrook also registered six RBI in the three games.
- On the mound, all three WVU starters - junior RHP Jacob Watters, sophomore LHP Ben Hampton and freshman RHP Aidan Major earned victories.
- In all, West Virginia outscored K-State, 35-9, and outthit the Wildcats, 36-22, in the three-game set.

WATTERS' WORLD

Whether it be out of the bullpen or in a starting role, junior RHP Jacob Watters' stock has continued to rise around college baseball.

- In February, the Rocky Gap, Virginia, native was named a Preseason All-American by the NCBWA, earning a spot on the third team. He's the 10th player in program history to earn preseason All-America distinction.
- His first seven appearances of the year came out of the bullpen, where he compiled one save.
- On March 20, Watters was used in a starting role for the first time this season, logging 4.0 innings in a no decision at Campbell.
- On March 25, the right-hander pitched 5.0, no-hit innings against Youngstown State. He earned the win after posting five strikeouts.
- Watters enjoyed a big night on April 1, at TCU, tossing a then-career-best 6.0 innings and logging eight strikeouts to help the Mountaineers to a Big 12-opening win.
- He also fanned eight in a career-long 6.1 innings on April 16 vs. Oklahoma State.
- Watters struck out a career-high 15 batters with just one walk in 6.1 innings of work against Texas on May 7, earning National Player of the Week recognition by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. That's the most sent down by a Mountaineer pitcher since Nick Snyder (16) on April 30, 2019, vs. Marshall.

HAMPTON INN

Sophomore left-handed pitcher Ben Hampton has taken control as one of the most dependable pitchers in the Big 12 Conference.

- The De Pere, Wisconsin, native logged six straight quality starts from March 5 to April 9. His 7.2 innings of action on April 9 vs. Baylor was a career high. For th year, he has tossed 7.0+ innings three times with eight quality starts.
- In all, the lefty has fanned at least five batters in 13 of his 14 starts this spring. He also has limited his walks to one or fewer in nine of his starts.
- At 8-4 on the year, Hampton has fanned 85 hitters in 78.0 innings. He struck out a career-high 10 in his season debut vs. Kent State on Feb. 19.
- Last season, Hampton's 4-3 record and 4.83 ERA earned him Freshman All-America honors by Perfect Game/Rawlings. He fanned 47 on just 15 walks in 54.0 innings (14 app./10 starts).

SHORT-CHANGED

West Virginia was placed in the Preseason Big 12 Poll, which was voted on by the conference's nine head coaches. However, WVU finished above its preseason ranking for the sixth time in the last nine complete seasons inside the league. In fact, WVU set a program record for most Big 12 wins in one season, with 14, in 2022.

IN THE DRAFT

Since its first two selections in 1965, the West Virginia University baseball team has seen 102 players taken in the MLB Draft, including 32 in the Randy Mazey era (2013-present).

- WVU had at least two players drafted in eight of the last nine seasons, including four in 2021.
- The squad's 2021 draftees were: LHP Jackson Wolf (4th round, 129th pick, San Diego), RHP Ryan Bergert (6th round, 190th pick, San Diego), RHP Madison Jeffrey (15th round, 462nd pick, L.A. Dodgers) and LHP Adam Tulloch (17th round, 522nd pick, L.A. Dodgers).
- In all, the Mountaineers have had eight players taken in the first five rounds of MLB Drafts over the years. Two of them were first rounders - Alek Manoah (2019, 11th overall, Toronto) and Chris Enochs (1997, 11th overall, Oakland).

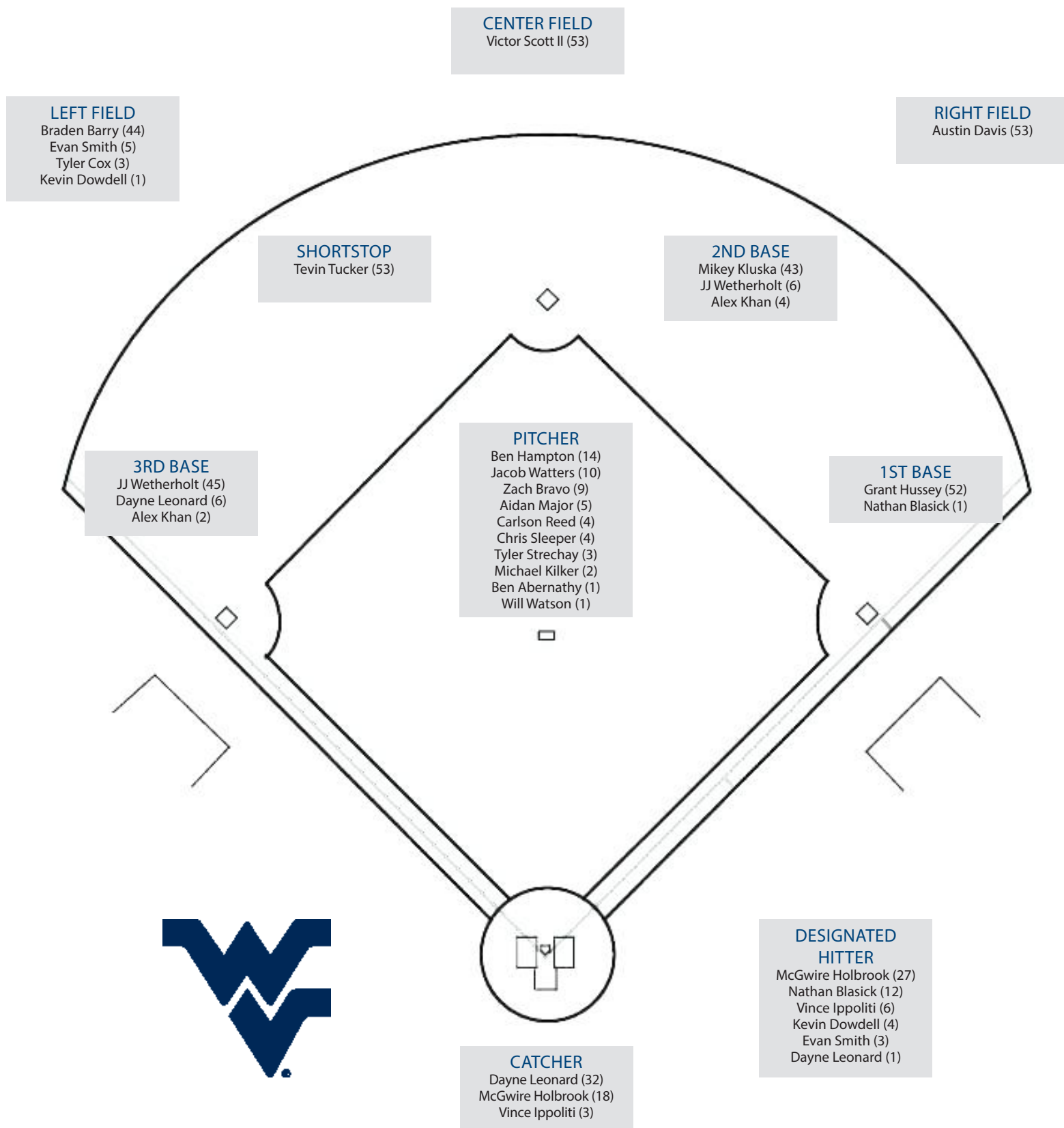
