DUICK HITS

- West Virginia is in its 128th season of baseball
- Randy Mazey is in his 11th season at the helm in Morgantown. The veteran skipper is 335-246 with the Mountaineers and owns 521 career wins as a head coach
- In the Big 12 Preseason Poll, the Mountaineers were picked sixth.
- Mazey has led West Virginia to a .500-or-better record in nine of his 10 seasons on campus.
- The Mountaineers' 55-game schedule features 12 opponents that reached the 2022 NCAA Tournament.
- Of those 12 opponents that reached the 2022 NCAA Tournament, four of them hosted regionals Georgia Southern, Maryland, Texas, and Oklahoma State.
- 2023 will be the ninth season the Mountaineers play at Wagener Field at Monongolia County Ballpark.
 The Field was named after Rick and Jay Wagener on Aug. 30, 2021, following a major gift donation to the program. Rick Wagener was a standout pitcher at WVU from 1968-71.
- WVU played 24 home games this spring. The squad has never had a losing record in the facility's eight-year history and put up their best record this season with a 18-6 record at home.
- The Mountaineers claimed their first Big 12 title in program history as they finished 15-9 in league play, tied atop the standings with Texas and Oklahoma State.
- Sophomore JJ Wetherholt was named Big 12 Player of the Year while Randy Mazey was named Coach of the Year.
- Wetherholt leads all Power 5 hitters with a .447 batting average, second-highest in the nation and was
 recently named a semifinalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy
- Juniors Ben Hampton and Carlson Reed joined Wetherholt on the All-Big 12 First Team while juniors Braden Barry and Landon Wallace as well as graduate Blaine Traxel earned second team honors.

KEY TERM NOTES

- Since debuting as a program in 1892, WVU has logged more than 2,200 wins, produced 27 Major League Baseball
 players, 24 All-Americans and one United States Olympian.
- The 2023 campaign marks the 131st year and 128th season of baseball at WVU. The Mountaineers are the secondoldest program in the Big 12.
- The Mountaineers were just one of five Power Five teams in 2022 to not lose more than two consecutive games. The
 other four were regional hosts Tennessee, Texas A&M, Maryland, and Auburn. The sweep at Texas last weekend was
 the first since getting swept by fifth-ranked TCU, April 30 May 1, 2021.
- Redshirt-senior Noah Short, junior Ben Hampton, and sophomore JJ Wetherholt each received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention status. Wetherholt and Chris Sleeper also earned spots on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team.
- Two key players the Mountaineers will have to replace are pitcher Trey Braithwaite and outfielder Austin Davis who
 each earned spots on the All-Big 12 First Team. Braithwaite was also named to the NCBWA All-America Third Team.
- Redshirt-senior Dayne Leonard led WVU in 2022 with a .331 average while Grant Hussey returns to the lineup after leading the Mountaineers with 11 home runs as a freshman.
- West Virginia welcomes 20 newcomers to the mix this season made up of 15 true freshmen and five transfers.

THE MAZEY EFFECT

Coach Randy Mazey is in his 11th season at the helm in Morgantown and owns a 335-246 mark with the Mountaineers.

- Mazey was named the Big 12 Coach of the Year and ABCA East Regional Coach of the Year in 2019, after leading West Virginia to its second NCAA Tournament appearance in three years.
- He became the first coach in WVU history to be selected for the Big 12's yearly honor, while the ABCA accolade
 was his second in three seasons and the fourth ever for a WVU coach.
- Mazey's Mountaineer teams have won at least 30 games in five different campaigns and have finished .500 or better in nine of his 10 seasons at the helm.
- Mazey's 2019 club won 38 games, the most in his WVU tenue and second-most in school history, sitting only behind the 1994 squad (40 wins).
- Last season's game against Baylor on April 9 marked Mazey's 500th game as the skipper of the Mountaineers.
- Now in his 17th season as a head coach, he is 521-406-2 in his career.
- He picked up his 500th win against Xavier. The first win of his career also came against Xavier in 1994 when he was the head coach at Charleston Southern.

HOMEGROWN TALENT

Four West Virginia natives are featured on the 2023 roster, tied for the second-most of any state (Pennsylvania, 9). Together, the group understands as well as anyone in the program about the honor and unique opportunity to represent the citizens of the Mountain State.

• The group includes redshirt-senior Noah Short (Scott Depot), senior Jake Carr (St. Alban's), sophomore Grant Hussey (Parkersburg), and freshman Michael McKinney (Sophia).

COUNTRY ROADS, TAKE ME HOME

Along with the squad's five in-state products, WVU is represented by 15 total states this season plus Canada.

 Pennsylvania leads the list with nine representatives, ahead of West Virginia (four), New York (four), and Virginia (four). WVU has two players from California, Kentucky, New Jersey, Wisconsin, Florida, Alabama, Arkansas, Connecticut, and Ontario, as well as one from Georgia, Ohio, and South Carolina.

MOUNTAINEER BREAKDOWN

Take a look inside WVU's 38-man roster this spring:

- The roster is comprised of 15 freshmen, two redshirt-freshman, 10 sophomores, four juniors, two seniors, four redshirt-seniors, and one fifth-year senior
- The group consists of four catchers, 10 infielders, seven outfielders, 15 RHPs and six LHPs.
- WVU also has a total of four players with the ability to play multiple positions in the field, as noted on the squad's roster page.

VETERAN ADDITIONS

West Virginia stocked up with veteran talent over the offseason, adding four players with prior Division I experience in addition to a standout junior college player.

- Pitchers Grant Siegel (Tulane) and Keegan Allen (Oklahoma) both transfer in as sophomores. Siegel went 7-1 with a 3.02 ERA and 53 strikeouts with the Green Wave as a freshman while Allen logged 7.0 innings on the mound as the Sooners finished National Runner-Up.
- Outfielder Landon Wallace comes to Morgantown after playing two years at Nevada where he hit .331 in 78 games for the Wolfpack.
- Infielder Caleb McNeely comes to WVU after hitting .376 with 49 home runs in three seasons at Walters State and was named the TCCAA Player of the Year in 2022
- Pitcher Blaine Traxel is the most-experienced transfer, having played four years at Cal State Northridge where he
 had a 3.43 ERA with 214 strikeouts in 270.1 innings pitched. He was also named All-Big West each of the past two
 seasons.





BRING IT ON

Once again this season, the Mountaineers will endure several stiff tests in its non-conference slate, mixed in with the always competitive Big 12 Conference.

- WVU has 12 opponents on its schedule that played in the 2022 NCAA Tournament. That includes Georgia Southern, Maryland, Arizona, VCU, Canisius, Hofstra, UNC Greensboro, Oklahoma State, Oklahoma, TCU, Texas and Texas Tech.
- Texas and Oklahoma each made made it to Omaha with the Sooners finishing as National Runner-Up.
- In all, West Virginia will play 29 of its 56 games against NCAA Tournament teams, including 18 away from home.
- So far, the Mountaineers are 20-7 against teams that made the tournament in 2022

SPEED KILLS

Over the last five seasons, few have been better on the basepaths than the Mountaineers. According to the numbers, WVU's aggressive baserunning has become a part of the program's DNA.

- From 2018-21, West Virginia swiped 309 bases, good for No. 1 in the Big 12 Conference in that time.
- Additionally, the squad ranked No. 14 nationally and No. 1 among "Power 5" teams in stolen bases from 2018-21.
- Last season, the Mountaineers were as aggressive as ever on the basepaths, ranking No. 2 nationally in the category.
- With 156 stolen bases last season, WVU is re-writing the record book for the most in a single season in program history. The previous best was 114 bags stolen in 1986.
- Individually, junior OF Victor Scott II swiped 38 bags in 2022, good for No. 1 in single-season WVU history.

Wagener Field at Monongalia County Ballpark took on Rick and Jay Wagener's namesake on Aug. 30, 2021, following a major gift donation of \$1 million to the program. Rick Wagener was a standout pitcher at WVU from 1968-71.

- The donation will help with the maintenance and upkeep at Monongalia County Ballpark, as well as assist in the team's greatest needs.
- Rick Wagener, who is a 1971 graduate and first-ever freshman to play at the varsity level for the Mountaineers, serves as the managing partner and registered principal at Wagener-Lee, LLC, a financial and investment advisor located in Columbia, Maryland. His wife, Jay, also is a WVU grad.
- · Wagener spent three seasons in the New York Mets organization from 1971-73, after being selected by the club in the second round of the 1971 January Secondary Draft.
- Prior to last season's April 9's game against Baylor, the Mountaineers honored the Wageners with a field dedication ceremony.

HOME, SWEET HOME

The 2023 season marks West Virginia's ninth at beautiful Monongalia County Ballpark. With the help of Mountaineer Nation, the venue has become one of the greatest atmospheres in all of college baseball.

- WVU has tallied an impressive 127-67 mark at home since the ballpark opened in 2015. What's more, the club has never had a losing home record at the park and went 17-6 at the complex in 2022.
- The squad's 100th win at the stadium came in a 17-8 triumph over Marshall on April 6, 2022.
- The Mountaineers had a streak of 22 consecutive midweek, home wins from May 16, 2017, to April 27, 2022. Still, WVU has won 35 of its last 38 midweek, home games in Morgantown.
- A then-record crowd of 4,355 packed the stands to watch WVU's NCAA Regional opener vs. Fordham on May 31,
- Mon. County Ballpark was named BaseballParks.com's Ballpark of the Year in 2015.

FIRST CLASS

WVU has brought in some of its best talent in program history over the past six seasons, resulting in top-35 signing classes from 2018-23, according to Perfect Game. Year in and year out, the Mountaineers draw the attention of the nation's top players.

BIG 12 RECOGNITION

Four Mountaineers have been honored by the Big 12 this season with six weekly awards. On Feb. 27 as sophomore JJ Wetherholt was named Player of the Week while fifth-year Blaine Traxel took home Pitcher of the Week. On April 10, Robby Porco was named Pitcher of the Week while on April 24, Tevin Tucker took home Player of the Week. Wetherholt and Traxel then both won again on May 2 with Traxel adding newcomer of the week as well. Wetherholt added his third on May 15.

- Wetherholt hit .529 (9-for17) with two home runs, three doubles, four RBI, six runs, and eight stolen bases while leading the Mountaineers to a 3-1 week against No. 13 Maryland and Arizona.
- Traxel threw a complete game with six strikeouts while allowing just one run against the Wildcats
- Porco struck out 12 batters in 6.0 innings against Kansas while allowing just one earned run. He is the first Mountaineer freshman to be named Pitcher of the Week since WVU joined the Big 12 in 2013.
- Tucker hit .571 (8-for-14) with a double, two RBI, and seven runs scored as the Mountaineers went 4-0 against Pitt and TCU
- Against Penn State and Baylor, Wetherholt hit .529 (9-for-17) with three home runs, a triple, nine RBI, and eight runs scored while putting up a 1.726 OPS.
- Traxel threw his fifth complete game of the season and first shutout against Baylor, striking out six, walking none, and allowing just six singles.

Wetherholt is the 16th WVU player to be named Big 12 Player of the Week while Traxel is the 18th Mountaineer to take home Big 12 Pitcher of the Week and 13th Newcomer of the Week

- In the season opener against Georgia Southern, Hampton struck out eight in 6.0 innings while allowing just one hit and one earned run
- He finished last season with a 4.66 ERA and 90 strikeouts against just 27 walks in 83.0 innings
- in all, the lefty fanned at least five batters in 14 of his 15 starts last spring. He also has limited his walks to one or fewer in nine of his starts.
- Hampton opened some eyes over the summer as he led the Cape Cod League with 49 strikeouts in 42.2 innings, pitching for the Chatham Anglers
- In 2021, Hampton's 4-3 record and 4.83 ERA earned him Freshman All-America honors by Perfect Game/Rawlings. He fanned 47 on just 15 walks in 54.0 innings (14 app./10 starts).

- WVU had at least two players drafted in nine of the last 10 seasons, including three in 2022.
- The squad's 2022 draftees were: RHP Jacob Watters (4th round, 124th pick, Oakland), OF Victor Scott II (5th round, 157th pick, St. Louis), and RHP Trey Braithwaite (16th round, 483rd pick, Cincinnati).
- In all, the Mountaineers have had 10 players taken in the first five rounds of MLB Drafts over the years. Two of them were first rounders - Alek Manoah (2019, 11th overall, Toronto) and Chris Enochs (1997, 11th overall, Oakland).

Sophomore JJ Wetherholt has been invited to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp and will look to become the first Mountaineer to ever make the 26-man roster.

The USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp will feature 56 of the premier nondraft eligible college players for a five-game Stars vs. Stripes intrasguad series in North Carolina from June 25-29. USA Baseball will name a final, 26-man Collegiate National Team roster after Training Camp that will represent the United States in friendship series against Chinese Taipei and Japan from June 30-July 12.

Junior Braden Barry and sopphmore JJ Wetherholt were each named College Sports Communicators Academic All-District. Both players are studying finance with Barry holding a 3.79 GPA and Wetherholt posting a 3.90 GPA. It is the second straight year Barry has earned the honor.


