## 2021-22 SEASON IN REVIEW

Head Coach: Luke Bennett (9th season)

GNAC Championships Finish: 1st

NCAA II West/South Central Regional Finish: T-13th

Competed in a full eight-tournament regular-season slate for the first time since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic... won the program's 10th Great Northwest Athletic Conference Championships title in the 14-year history of the tournament with a 22-stroke victory over 2nd-place Simon Fraser... WWU's fourth GNAC team title in the last six tournaments... earned the No. 1 seed out of the West Region in the South Central/West Super Regional, but placed tied for 13th in the 20-team field... made 23rd consecutive appearance at the NCAA Division II Championships, extending a streak that has featured the Vikings in the national postseason every year at the NCAA level... fell short of a 10th trip to the national championships not finishing in the top four in the Regional tournament... WWU led the conference with five players earning All-GNAC honors, with senior **Aidan Thain** being named GNAC Player of the Year, **Luke Bennet** earning GNAC Coach of the Year and freshman transfer **Seth King** picking up GNAC Newcomer of the Year... GNAC first-team selections were awarded to Thain, **Jordan Lee** and **Devin Andrews**... King and freshman **Conrad Brown** were second-team selections... Thain and Andrews were selected to the PING All-West Region Team for the second consecutive season, and Bennett was named West Region Coach of the year... tied program record with four players earning All-GNAC Academic honors – **Austin Darnell**, **Ryan Ho**, **Cody Oakes** and Thain... opened the season winning the SMU Saint Martin's Invitational at The Home Course in Dupont (September 24-25), led by a tournament-winning 7-under-par performance from Brown... also won the Hanny Stanislaus Invitational at Turlock Golf and Country Club in Turlock, California (March 28-29) with Thain picking up co-champion honors at 7-under-par... Thain led the team with a scoring average of 72.29 (+0.50 to par) and also led the team with two tournament wins, the second of which came with a record-breaking performance at the GNAC Championships... Lee finished as GNAC Championships runner-up... team combined for five GNAC Player of the Week awards, with Thain and Brown winning two and Lee winning one... four players recorded at least seven rounds at par or better, with Thain leading with 17, Brown recording 11 and Andrews and Lee each recording seven.

### THAIN'S RECORD-BREAKING SEASON

Senior **Aidan Thain** did it all in his final season as a Viking... the Bellevue native led the GNAC for the second consecutive season, recording a scoring average of 72.29 en route to a unanimous selection as the conference Player of the Year, becoming the ninth WWU selection and eighth Viking to earn the award... recorded a pair of wins during the season, both coming during the spring season, which included a dominating 16-stroke win at the GNAC Championships in a historic performance that set the all-time conference record with a three-round score of 199 (-14)... Thain's GNAC Championships second-round score of 64 tied for best spring round in GNAC history... the lefty turned in 16 rounds of par or better with six rounds in the 60s and recorded five top-10 finishes in nine tournaments... Thain finished his four-year WWU career with an average of 73.20, 4th-best in program history and 6th-best in GNAC history... left his mark on the WWU record book listed 15th all-time with 27 round of par or less, 11th with a career finish percentage of 72.5% and 4th all-time with 10 career eagles in just 59 rounds.

### GNAC CHAMPIONS

Led by a historic performance by senior **Aidan Thain**, WWU completed a dominating 22-stroke wire-to-wire victory at the 2022 Great Northwest Athletic Conference Championships to capture their 10th conference title in the 14 year history of the tournament, and their fourth in the last six tournaments... WWU recorded a 54-hole team score of 2-over-par 854 in the two-day tournament at the Coeur d'Alene Resort Golf Course, defeating second-place Simon Fraser University (+24, 876) by a 22-stroke margin... WWU's final-round score of 12-over-par 296 was the best in the field by a three-stroke margin while battling windy conditions... WWU won six consecutive titles from 2008-13, were back-to-back team champions in 2016-17, returned to the podium in 2019 and added the 10 title this season... a Viking has now won nine of 14 individual medalist honors with Thain joining the elite list with his dominating performance in 2022, setting the tournament record at 14-under-par 199 for a 15-stroke victory.

## 2022-23 SEASON IN REVIEW

Advanced to play in 24th consecutive NCAA II Championships West Regional, extending a streak that has featured the Vikings in the national postseason every year competing at the NCAA level ... tied for first at the GNAC Championships falling to Simon Fraser in a team tiebreaker ... also tied for first at the regional championships in Rohnert Park, California, with Sonoma State winning the tiebreaker when play was suspended due to darkness ... advanced to play in the NCAA II National Championships in Warren, Ohio, placing 15th overall ... senior **Jordan Lee** capped one of the greatest seasons in program history earning GNAC Men's Golf Player of the Year, First Team PING GCAA All-America and GNAC Male Athlete of the Year (all sports) honors ... Lee earned runner-up honors at both the NCAA West/South Central Super Regional and the NCAA Championship ... five players earned All-GNAC honors tying SFU for the most in the conference ... sophomore **Seth King** joined Lee as a First Team All-GNAC award winner ... senior co-captain **Cody Oakes**, junior **Drew Halili** and sophomore **Conrad Brown** were all Second Team All-GNAC honorees ... tied program record for the second consecutive season with four players earning GNAC All-Academic honors ... team turned in seven top-five team finishes out of 11 total tournament appearances, including winning the WWU Invitational (Sept. 26-27) and Hanny Stanislaus Invitational (March 27-28) ... Lee was a five-time GNAC Golfer of the Week award winner, finishing his career with a program record eight conference weekly awards.

### LEE'S HISTORIC SENIOR SEASON

Senior **Joran Lee** turned in not only one of the best golf seasons in program history, but one of the most impressive seasons by any athlete in the 22-year history of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference ... at the end of a year full of outstanding accomplishments on the course, Lee was named the 2022-23 GNAC Male Athlete of the Year ... Lee became fourth Viking to take home the award, joining John Allen (Basketball, 2012-13), Ryan Brown (Track & Field – Pole Vault, 2010-11) and Grant Dykstra (Basketball, 2005-06) ... it is the first time in conference history a golfer has received the award, and Lee's numbers back it up ... his senior season was one of surreal proportions at the Division II level playing in all 11 tournaments for the Vikings in 2022-23, recording a top 10 finish in nine of them ... during the spring season, Lee recorded a round of at or under par 19 times, including 16 consecutive to conclude his collegiate career ... he tied a program record three consecutive tournament wins, including both the NCAA West Regional Spring Preview and the GNAC Championships ... Lee would go on to earn runner-up individual honors at both the NCAA West/South Central Regional and the NCAA National Championship ... Lee shot at or below par in an incredible 26 times in 30 total rounds during the season ... his scoring average of 70.33 (-1.43 to par) set a single-season program and conference scoring record and was the top-ranked men's golfer in NCAA Division II via *Golfstat* ... Lee's nine top-10 rounds tied the GNAC single-season record while his 86.6% of rounds under par (26-30) smashed the conference record ... for his five-year collegiate career, Lee set records with 44 events and 124 rounds played, breaking records previously held by WWU's Chris Hatch (2013-17) ... his other accolades on the season include a unanimous selection as GNAC Golfer of the Year, five GNAC Golfer of the Week awards, an All-American selection from PING and WWU Male Athlete of the Year.

### NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

With a T-1st finish at the 2023 West/South Central Regional championships, the Vikings accomplished one of the toughest things in collegiate golf, earning one of the coveted five spots out of 20 teams to advance to the national championships ... the Vikings surged up the leaderboard over the last two rounds of the 20-team West/South Central Super Regional at Foxtail Golf Club, carding a final round team score of 4-under-par 284 to tie for the tournament victory with host Sonoma State as Super Regional co-champions ... marked the Vikings 10th team trip to nationals and first since 2016 ... the first-place finish at the regional tournament marks the second in program history since joining the NCAA in 1998-99, joining the 2004-05 team ... WWU's final round heroics were led by Jordan Lee's 5-under-par 67 and a bounce back even-par 72 by senior co-captain **Cody Oakes** ... sophomore **Seth King** capped a top-10 performance with a 1-under-par 71.
