Scouting the Bison

North Dakota State enters with an 0-4-0 record. The Bison have struggled offensively this fall, being outscored 12-1.

The Bison finished the 2021 spring slate at 7-8-1, finishing fifth in the Summit League.

Scouting the Gophers

Minnesota has a 2-0-1 record with an opening-season win over Baylor. The Gophers also have a game Thursday, as they play host to Mississippi State.

Sophia Boman and Delaney Stekr have accounted for Minnesota's scores this season, tallying one goal apiece. Megan Plaschko has made both starts in goal and recorded six saves and has let to allow a goal.

The Cowgirls last played a team from the Big Ten in 2018, toppling Iowa 1-0 in Laramie.

About the Cowgirls: The University of Wyoming soccer team takes to the road for the first time during the regular season. The unbeaten Cowgirls, sitting at 3-0-0, head east for a few games in the Northern Plains and Great Lakes Region.

The road trip begins with a game at North Dakota State on Thursday at 5 p.m. It finishes up with a road match at Minnesota on Sunday at 12 p.m. before a game at St. Thomas on Tuesday at 3 p.m.

"The most challenging part is the physicality and how taxing it is on your body to play that many matches, at a high level, in that short a time frame," head coach Colleen Corbin said. "We are going to be relying on our ability to really just hone in and focus in on what we need to accomplish as a program from each match and not let any other distractions get in the way of that."

The Cowgirls have already accomplished quite a bit during the early stages of this season. Wyoming has come from behind in a pair of games and tallied eight goals in all, as six different players have found the back of the net.

Junior forward Faith Joiner leads the way with two goals. Redshirt junior midfielder Jamie Tatum, sophomore forwards Alyssa Bedard and Nikayla Copenhaver, freshmen forward Maddi Chance and freshmen defender Eliza-Grace Smith have all registered one score this season.

"The fact that we are so dangerous from so many different people, I think speaks really well to the style that we are playing," Corbin said. "The game plan is not to get the ball to one or two people, the goal is to constantly create space to allow people to be themselves and to be dangerous and attack the space they're given."

Redshirt-junior goalkeeper Alex Daws makes all those goals stand up. She has only surrendered two goals, has seven saves and holds a GAA of 0.67.

Wyoming selected 10th in preseason MWC poll:

The Mountain West Conference released its preseason soccer poll Wednesday. The University of Wyoming was picked to finish 10th with 31 points.

New Mexico was pegged as the favorite, collecting 118 points and nine first-place votes. San Diego State was selected to finish runner-up with 111 points and three first-place votes, while Boise State rounds out the top three with 93 points.

The Lobos won the conference crown in the abbreviated 2021 spring season and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Aztecs claimed the runner-up spot.

The Cowgirls went 2-7 in the spring and welcome in a new coaching staff this fall led by first-year head coach Colleen Corbin. Wyoming begins its 2021 fall season Aug. 20 at home against Colorado School of Mines.

Balanced scoring attack: Numerous different Cowgirls have found the back of the net this fall. Six different players have accounted for seven goals this season. Junior forward Faith Joiner leads the way with a pair of goals, one in each of the season's first two matches.

Daws' dominant displays in net: Redshirt junior Alex Daws has commanded her position in net for the Cowgirls. She held Colorado School of Mines to one goal in her first-career start. She blanked Nebraska at Omaha for her first-career shutout and held South Dakota scoreless for the final 88 minutes of a 2-1 victory.

Bedard's offensive barrage: Sophomore forward Alyssa Bedard has shown to be Wyoming's most potent offensive weapon. She has fired multiple shots in each of the first three matches, scoring her first goal, in go-ahead fashion, against South Dakota.

Freshmen making their presence felt: Maddi Chance and Liv Stutzman have started all three games for the Cowgirls, while Taylor Brook has made three appearances and two starts.

Corbin brings a wealth of experience to the pitch: There isn't much first-year head coach Colleen Corbin hasn't seen on the soccer field. She was a two-time All-American in goal at Oregon State. She has made three different coaching stops as an assistant. Corbin also played professionally for a couple years for a couple different clubs in the northeast.

Home Cooking: Wyoming has enjoyed great success at the Madrid Sports Complex over the years. The Cowgirls have posted a winning record at home in seven of the last eight seasons and two of those seasons have featured unblemished records.

University of Wyoming Director of Athletics Tom Burman announced the hiring of Colleen Corbin as head coach of the Cowgirl Soccer Team on June, 21, 2021. She is the fifth head coach in the program's history. Corbin comes to Wyoming from James Madison University, where she spent three seasons as an associate head coach.

"We are excited to have Colleen Corbin lead the Cowgirl soccer program," Burman said. "She will bring a renewed energy to the team and brings great enthusiasm to our student-athletes."

Corbin brings a tremendous amount of experience in her days as an All-American at Oregon State, a professional player and as an assistant and associate head coach. She will make being a Cowgirl a great college experience for our student-athletes."

Corbin started her collegiate coaching career as an assistant coach at Cal State-Northridge before stops at Arizona State and James Madison. In the summer of 2016, Corbin was selected for the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) 30 Under 30 program, an initiative designed to give participants exposure to the Association's membership, and the opportunity to take advantage of educational offerings, such as diplomas and the NSCAA Convention. Corbin was chosen for the program from a pool of 350 applicants.

"I want to thank Athletic Director Tom Burman and Associate Athletic Director Peter Prigge for the opportunity to lead the Cowgirl Soccer Program and their professionalism during the hiring process," Corbin said. "For my fiancé and I to be in a place like Wyoming is special for us. Seeing the campus and facilities and meeting the people in Laramie verified that this is an incredible opportunity."

Corbin was a two-time All-American at Oregon State. A standout goalkeeper, Corbin also earned All-Pac 12 honors and All-West Region honors. She ended her career with the most shutouts and lowest goals-against-average in Oregon State history. Corbin was a two-time captain.

"I got into coaching to create the same experience I had as a student-athlete," Corbin said. "We want to build a culture that is competitive and feeds off hard work and high energy. Cowgirl Soccer will be committed to excellence on and off the field by producing well-rounded human beings. That starts by getting myself and the program involved in the Wyoming community. I'm so excited for this opportunity and ready to get started."

After her time at Oregon State, Corbin played two seasons of professional soccer in the WPSL for the Western New York Flash based in Buffalo, New York. Corbin helped lead the squad to the league championship. She also played a season for the Boston Breakers as part of the NWSL.

At James Madison, she helped lead JMU to the Regular season CAA Championship. Corbin helped the Dukes lead the league in regular-season shutouts in her first season, highlighted by Hannah McShea setting the program record for solo shutouts by a junior with seven. McShea was named Second Team All-CAA in her first season as the Dukes' starting goalkeeper.

At CSUN from 2014 to 2016, Corbin guided the Matador goalkeepers from two shutouts in 2013, the season before her arrival, to a combined 15 shutouts across the next two seasons, while dropping CSUN's goals-against average from 1.64 in 2013 to 1.12 from 2014-15.

She is a 2012 graduate of Oregon State and is a native of La Cañada, Calif. Corbin, formerly Colleen Boyd, married Nick Corbin in July of 2020.
