WYOMING UNDER BRANCH

- In his 13 seasons, UW head man Mark Branch has raised the expectations of Cowboy Wrestling to new heights. He's upped the profile of Wyoming Wrestling and brought the program notoriety and name recognition with levels of success rarely seen in the program's history.
- With 127 dual wins and a 76-percent win rate within the conference ranks, Branch has established the Cowboys as the team to beat year in and year out. Branch has compiled a 59-19 mark against conference record foes with four regular-season dual titles.
- Under Branch's watch, Wyoming has sent 58 wrestlers to the NCAA Championships with 12 returning as All-Americans.
- Branch's Cowboys have finished in the top five at the Big 12 Championships three of the last four years, which includes a fourth place finish in 2018. At the tournament, seniors Archie Colgan and Bryce Meredith were awarded the program's first two Big 12 individual titles.

THE BASICS

The Cowboys will begin the new year with a Big 12 road trip Sunday as they travel to Brookings, South Dakota to face two conference opponents in South Dakota State and Northern Iowa. The Cowboys will begin the day against Northern Iowa and then face SDSU immediately following their first dual.

This tri-dual will open up the second half of the season for the Pokes and will feature 10 dual meets leading up to the Big 12 Championships.

The last time the Cowboys and Jackrabbits met was in 2019 in a nail biting contest which SDSU won, 17-16. 2012 was the last time that Wyoming and Northern Iowa faced each other in a dual, the Cowboys took that meeting with a score of 27-12.

Sunday's action will look a little different for the Cowboys as well. Due to Covid-19 related concerns within the Cowboys Wrestling program, Wyoming will only be sending seven athletes to compete across five weight classes. These matches will count towards individual records but no team scores will be kept between Wyoming and their opponents.

ABOUT THE COWBOYS

The Cowboys posted a record of 3-3 in duals last season notching notable ranked wins over No. 19 Central Michigan and No. 20 Arizona State. Out of the six duals the Cowboys had, five of the teams were ranked at the time of the dual.

Due to the covid-19 pandemic a season ago the Cowboys did not compete in a traditional tournament until the Big 12 championships. This season the Cowboys will open their season with back to back tournaments starting with the Cowboy Open.

LAST TIME OUT

The Cowboys closed out the 2021 calendar year with a busy weekend as they dualled No. 3 Oklahoma State before traveling to Nevada to compete in the Reno Tournament of Champions.

COWBOY WRESTLING



No. 14 Tate Samuelson provided the highlight of the night as he faced off against No. 6 ranked Dakota Geer. The two grapplers would go to sudden victory overtime where Samuelson fired off a double leg to down Geer and upset the No. 6 wrestler sending the standing room only crowd into a uproar.

The Cowboys bounced back from a tough dual with an outstanding performance in Reno. Jaron Jensen (149), Jacob Wright (157), Hayden Hastings (174) and Stephen Buchanan (197) all finished first at their weight classes helping the Brown and Gold to a second place finish as a team.

Hastings in particular had a day to remember in Reno. He rattled off five straight wins by fall to roll into the finals. That streak of pins was highlighted by pinning Cael Valencia (ASU) who defeated Hastings earlier in the season. Hastings put together another strong performance in the finals shutting down Grandview's Casey Randles 7-2 to win the Reno TOC Title.

Buchanan also had a special day as he went 5-0 on his way to winning the 197 pound title and won every single match by bonus points. He recorded to pins, two tech. falls and one major decision en route to winning his second tournament of the season.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

The Cowboys seem primed to have another strong year as they return their entire starting lineup from a season ago including seven NCAA Qualifies and an All-American.

Continuing the trend from last season, the heart of the Wyoming Wrestling lineup will once again be in the upper weights. The Pokes have a returning NCAA Qualifier at every weight from 157-285 pounds. That group is highlighted by Stephen Buchanan who is an All-American after finishing 8th at last years NCAA Championships.

Complimenting the upper weights, Chase Zollmann and Jaron Jensen return to the lineup at 141 and 149 pounds respectively. Zollmann finished 5th at the Big 12 championships a year ago and was a NCAA qualifier a year ago while Jensen earned a career best sixth place finish at the Big 12 championships.

At 133 pounds Job Greenwood will be the Cowboy to watch after becoming the starter at the weight class a year ago.

RANKINGS REPORT

The Cowboys begin the new year with eight wrestlers ranked at their respective weights. The group is led by Stephen Buchanan who is ranked No. 4 at 197 pounds and only has one loss on the season along with four wins over ranked opponents.

Jacob Wright (157) and Brian Andrews (285) are the other two Pokes ranked inside the top ten as both of them check in at No. 10 in their respective weight classes. Cole Moody (165) and Hayden Hastings (174) share the same ranking as well with each of them being ranked 12th at their respective weights.

At 184 pounds Tate Samuelson rounds out the Cowboys ranked inside the top 15 as he ranked 14th. Job Greenwood (133) and Chase Zollmann (141) are also both ranked as one of the top 33 wrestlers at their respective weights receiving honorable mention rankings.

WYOMING AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Wyoming has crowned 36 All-Americans at the NCAA Championships since 1950. That total includes seven NCAA finalists.
- The last and only individual champion at UW was Dick Ballinger in 1960.
- Under head coach Mark Branch, 12 Cowboys have returned from the NCAA Championships as All-Americans.
- Branch's teams have recorded three top-20 finishes at the tournament, and five top-25 finishes.
- In Branch's previous 13 seasons, Wyoming has recorded multiple All-Americans in four years, one in four years, and none just three years.

RETURNING TALENT

The Cowboy lineup will once again be very strong in the upper weights this season as the starts from 157-285 have all returned. In total the Cowboys return seven NCAA Qualifiers from last season and bring back their entire starting lineup for the 2021-22 season. The Cowboys will also boast depth this season as showcased by an outstanding performance at the Mine Rookie Open. The Cowboys sent a contingent of first and second team wrestlers and came back with five champions and 13 total place winners.

FAMILIAR FACES

The Cowboys return 11 wrestlers who started in a dual last season, including seven national tournament qualifiers. The Pokes are solidified at multiple weights, including 141, 157, 174, 184, 197 and heavyweight.

PRE SEASON SUCCESS

In the build up to the new season the Cowboys reserves have been in action at open tournaments which has al-

lowed the Wyoming Wrestling program to showcase their youth and depth. At the Mines Rookie open the Cowboys sent a contingent of first and second year wrestlers and came home with five champions and fifteen total place winners. Following the performance a group of Cowboy grapplers went to the CMU Open where Wyoming once again had multiple place winners highlighted by 157 pounder Cooper Voorhees who finished first while true freshman Aidan Noonan finished third in the 133 pound bracket. At the UNK Open the Cowboys were able to notch six total champions and numerous place winners in a very competitive open tournament.

THE 7220 ADVANTAGE

Training and competing at 7,220 feet has its advantages. The Cowboys use their offseason to improve their conditioning, training in various outdoor locations. During the season, the Pokes train in the team wrestling room with high intensity. That has led to a lot of success on the home mats.

Since 1931-32, the Cowboys are 276-165-6 at home, a winning percentage of 60 percent.

At neutral sites, Wyoming is 97-66-1 (.591), and 225-205-8 (.513) at away locations.

BRANCH HITS CENTURY WIN MARK

In a 37-3 rout at Air Force in 2018, head coach Mark Branch picked up his 100th career coaching victory. With the win, he became the fourth coach in the history of Wyoming wrestling to win at least 100 duals with the program.

Laramie, Wyo. (Dec. 17, 2021) – The No.13 Wyoming Wrestling squad had their first dual of the season Friday night hosting No. 3 Oklahoma State in front of a standing room only crowd. OSU took the dual 30-3, but No. 14 ranked Tate Samuelson picked up a statement win over No. 6 Ranked Dakota Geer.

A season ago Samuelson defeated Geer twice but came into Friday night ranked eight spots behind the OSU Grappler. The two Cowboys traded escapes but neither could find a takedown in regulation sending the match to overtime. In the overtime period Samuelson made the decisive move firing off a double leg and downing No. 6 Geer for the win to send the packed UniWyo Sports Complex into an uproar.

"That was a gutsy match and I was really proud of Tate for having that kind of willpower and finishing that double leg to get the win." Head Wrestling Coach Mark Branch said "That takes a lot of will power to do that and finish a double leg in that position, it was a good win for Tate."

In the match of the night at 197 pounds, No. 5 Stephen Buchanan took the mat against No. 1 Ranked and reigning National Champion AJ Ferrari in a rematch of last year's Big 12 Championship match. It was a very tightly contested match that saw Buchanan trailing 2-1 in the third period before falling behind 4-2 after allowing a reversal and then scoring an escape. Ferrari survived a flurry of attacks from Buchanan and held on to take the battle of All-Americans.

Jacob Wright (157) and Jake Svihel (125) both came up just short in their matches as each of them faced a top 12 ranked opponent and both fell in nail-biting overtime matches.

It will now be a very quick turnaround for the Pokes as they travel to Nevada to compete in the Reno Tournament of Champions. Reno will be the last competition of the calendar year for Wyoming and will provide a chance to bounce back as they won the team title at Reno TOC in 2019.

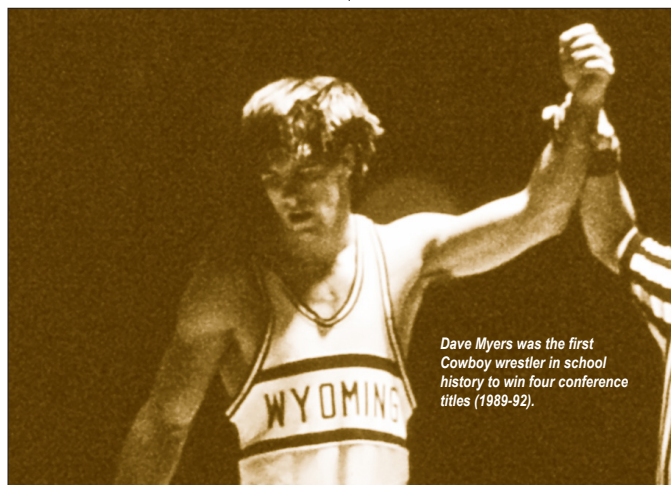

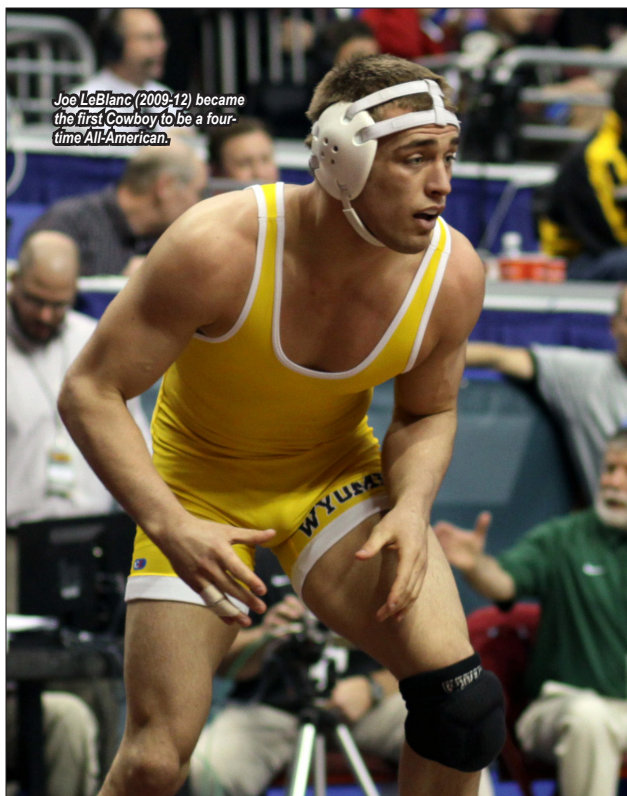

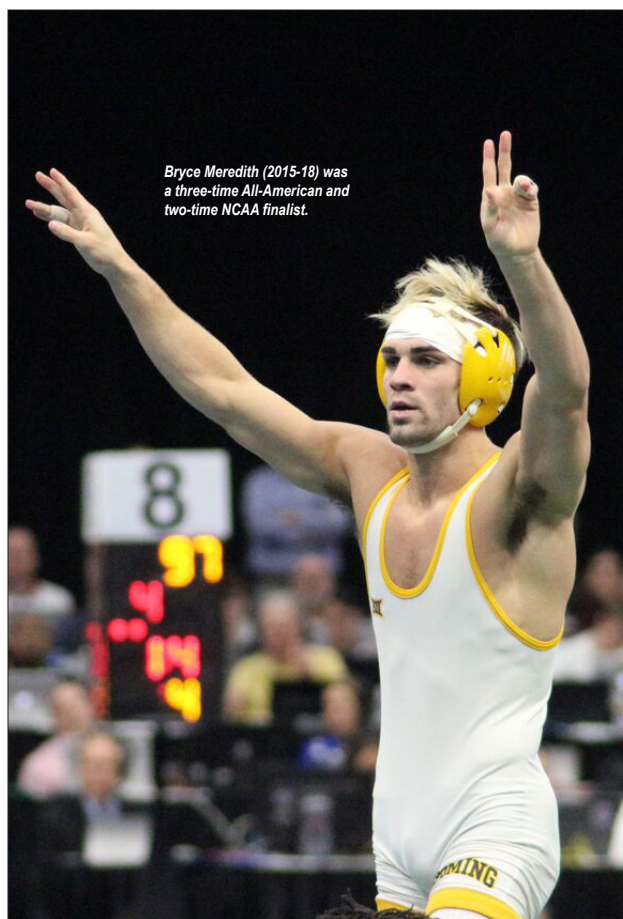
