WYOMING UNDER BRANCH

- In his 14 seasons, UW head man Mark Branch has raised the expectations of Cowboy Wrestling to new heights. He's upped the profile of Wyoming Wrestling and brought the program notoriety and name recognition with levels of success rarely seen in the program's history.
- With 127 dual wins and a 76-percent win rate within the conference ranks, Branch has established the Cowboys as the team to beat year in and year out. Branch has compiled a 59-19 mark against conference record foes with four regular-season dual titles.
- Under Branch's watch, Wyoming has sent 58 wrestlers to the NCAA Championships with 12 returning as All-Americans.
- Branch's Cowboys have set an impressive standard at the Big 12 Championships putting at least one grappler in the finals every year since Wyoming entered the conference in 2016-17.

THE BASICS

The Cowboy Wrestling squad will cap off the calendar year with a trip to Coralville, Iowa to compete in the first inaugural Soldier Salute Tournament.

The tournament field will be highlighted by national powerhouse No 2 ranked Iowa as well as conference foes No. 3 ranked Iowa State and No. 16 ranked Northern Iowa.

COVERAGE

Live stats will be available on TrackWrestling and live video for the dual will be available on FloWrestling.

SCOUTING THE FIELD

The Soldier Salute tournament will feature two top five teams as well as a selection of uncommon opponents for the Pokes to go up against.

No. 2 ranked Iowa will be the team to beat in Coralville. The Hawkeyes will be joined by fellow Big Ten power No. 8 ranked Wisconsin as well as Big 12 foes No. 3 Iowa State and No. 16 Northern Iowa.

Rounding out the field will be Citadel, VMI, Army, Navy, Columbia, Bellarmine, South Dakota State and No. 19 ranked Minnesota.

AT SOLDIER SALUTE TOURNAMENT PREVIEW

This weekend the Cowboys will compete in their final event of 2022 and will also wrestle in their last tournament until the Big 12 Championships.

The Pokes will be led by the seasoned duo of No. 11 Jacob Wright (157) and No. 14 Hayden Hastings (174) who are both coming off of first place finishes at the Reno Tournament of Champions. Wright is currently undefeated on the season with a record of 6-0 on the season.

Hastings will enter the tournament on the brink of history as he currently sits at 98 career wins needing two more wins to eclipse the century mark and move into the top 20 in all-time career wins. Hastings is currently 7-2 on the season looking to post the fourth 20 plus win season of his career.

For the second competition in a row the Cowboys will have a large contingent in action with a total of 18

grapplers set to make the trip to Coralville. 16 wrestlers will be competing attached with the additional two grapplers competing unattached.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

The Cowboys are primed to have an impressive lineup this year that will feature a mix of veterans and new faces highlighted three returning NCAA Qualifiers and six returning starters.

Continuing the trend from a season ago, the heart of the Cowboy lineup will once again be the at the upper weights led by two NCAA Qualifiers in Hayden Hastings (174) and Jacob Wright (157) as well as returning starter Cole Moody (165) who rounds out the experienced group of upper weights for the Pokes.

The lighter weights for Wyoming will feature a mix of young returners and new faces. One of those new faces will be Junior College standout Garret Ricks who transferred to Wyoming from Western Wyoming College where he was a two-time NJCCA all-American as well as the NJCCA 2022 National Champion.

Joining Ricks in the lighter weights will be standout incoming freshman Jore Volk. Volk enters his first year in the brown and gold after a tremendous summer competing at the domestic level. Volk got his summer off to a hot start by winning the U20 Freestyle World Team Trials at 57kg. He then followed that up by winning a U20 Freestyle World title going 4-0 at the U20 World Championships in Sofia, Bulgaria.

Complimenting the new faces on the Cowboy roster will be returning starters Darren Green (141) and Job Greenwood (133) who both be looking to build off their 2021-22 seasons. Green cemented his spot in the starting lineup last season making his first career trip to the Big 12 Championships picking up his first Big 12 tournament win. Greenwood also highlighted his season with a win over all-American Michael McGee (ASU) earning Big 12 Wrestler of the Week honors for his efforts.

week led by 157 pounder Jacob Wright who is currently ranked 11th. Wright is 6-0 on the season after an impressive performance in his return from injury winning the Reno Tournament of Champions.

At 174 pounds, Hayden Hastings enters the week ranked 14th after winning his weight class at the Reno Tournament Of Champions going 5-0 on his way to winning the title.

The final Cowboy to be ranked this week is Job Greenwood who is ranked as an Honorable Mention at 141 pounds making him one of the top 33 grapplers at his weight class.

CHASING THE CENTURY MARK

174 pounder Hayden Hastings will enter the season chasing a landmark as he looks to eclipse 100 career wins in his final season as a Pokes.

The Sheridan native currently sits at 98 career wins at the University of Wyoming. Hastings is coming off of one of the best seasons of his career highlighted by posting a career best finish at the NCAA tournament going 3-2 coming just one win shy of earning all-American honors.

In his four seasons at Wyoming, Hastings has posted three 20-plus win seasons including recording 25 wins during the 2021-22 campaign.

WYOMING AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Wyoming has crowned 37 All-Americans at the NCAA Championships since 1950. That total includes seven NCAA finalists.
- The last and only individual champion at UW was Dick Ballinger in 1960.
- Under head coach Mark Branch, 12 Cowboys have returned from the NCAA Championships as All-Americans.
- Branch's teams have recorded three top-20 finishes at the tournament, and five top-25 finishes.
- In Branch's previous 14 seasons, Wyoming has recorded multiple All-Americans in four years, one in five years, and none just three years.

FROM NEAR AND FAR

The 2022-23 Wyoming Cowboy wrestling roster features a diverse crew of 30 grapplers hailing from 17 different states.

Wyoming and California are the most well represented states on the Cowboy roster with five athletes hailing from each of those states. Oklahoma, Colorado, Ohio, Utah and Minnesota are the other states that are represented by two or more athletes on the Cowboy roster.

The Cowboys roster also featured representatives from both Hawaii and Alaska.

THE 7220 ADVANTAGE

Training and competing at 7,220 feet has its advantages. The Cowboys use their offseason to improve their conditioning, training in various outdoor locations. During the season, the Pokes train in the team wrestling room with high intensity. That has led to a lot of success on the home mats.

Since 1931-32, the Cowboys are 276-165-6 at home, a winning percentage of 60 percent.

At neutral sites, Wyoming is 97-66-1 (.591), and 225-205-8 (.513) at away locations.

BRANCH BECOMES SECOND WINNINGEST HEAD COACH

In a gritty 23-17 win over Utah Valley earlier this season, Mark Branch recorded the 128th win of his coaching career. This moved him into second all-time in program history moving ahead of Cowboy Wrestling great, Steven Suder.

Stillwater, Okla. (Nov. 18, 2022) – The Wyoming Cowboy wrestling competed in their first dual of the season on Friday night taking on Big 12 rival No. 7 Oklahoma State inside of Gallagher-Iba Arena. OSU took the dual 34-3, but Job Greenwood provided a big highlight for Wyoming with an upset win over No. 13 ranked Carter Young.

"Job showed heart and guts tonight when he was exhausted." Head Wrestling Coach Mark Branch said, "We know our wrestling shape is in its infancy and that's ok for November, but when you're tired you got to dig deep and that's what Job did."

After moving up a weight during the offseason, Greenwood continued to look like a threat at 141 pounds as he squared off with No. 13 Young. Greenwood struck first scoring the only takedown of the match early on and adding a second period reversal to go up 4-1. After building up his lead, Greenwood showed grit down the stretch denying No. 13 Young multiple times on the edge of the mat to seal a 4-3 victory. The ranked win is Greenwood's first at 141 pounds as he improves to 6-0 on the season.

"You're not going to hear me say this often after a lopsided loss, but I'm proud of these guys. Each guy went out and fought hard and didn't wrestle intimidated." Branch Said, "We had five guys wrestling in their first college dual and three guys up a weight class. The odds were certainly stacked against us but we showed heart. Give a coaching staff heart and hard work and you do a lot of work with that."

True Freshman Jore Volk (133) and Logan Ours (157) both looked promising in their dual debuts with each grappler coming up short in tightly contested matches against top 10 opponents.

Colorado Springs, Colo. (Dec. 10, 2022) – The Wyoming Cowboy wrestling squad was in action Saturday night competing in their second dual of the season on the road against Air Force inside Clune Arena. Three Cowboys picked up wins on the night, but the Cowboys dropped the dual 11-25.

"We saw a mixture of great things and not so great things tonight. Darren coming out and setting the tone in that first match with a big win was great." Head Wrestling Coach Mark Branch said, "We still got to grow in the room but it's a work in progress."

The first Cowboy to pick up a win on the night was Darren Green making his first dual start of the season at 141 pounds as he took on Nick Krug. Green got to his offense early scoring the first takedown of the match and never looking back. Green cruised to a 9-1 major decision win over Krug for his first dual win of the season.

At 157 pounds Bryce Dauphin took the mat against Garrett Bowers in his first career dual in the Brown and Gold. It was a gritty bout that saw Dauphin give up the first takedown of the match to trail 2-0. From there Dauphin fired back scoring four straight points and shutting down Bowers in the third period to seal the 4-2 victory and earn his first career dual win at Wyoming.

Competing in just his second competition of the season, No. 14 Hayden Hastings had a return to form in his 9-0 shutout win over Gage Musser. Hastings opened the scoring early with a takedown and then put Musser to his back to break the match open and cruise to the major decision victory.

Up next for the Cowboys is a trip top Reno, Nevada to compete in the Reno Tournament of Champions on Dec. 18.
