

2023-24 NOTES

- The Cowgirls were picked to finish third in the Preseason Mountain West Poll. UW received a total of 237 points and a pair of first-place votes.
- With its season-opening win over North Dakota, it marked the first time since 2021-22 that Wyoming has won its opener.
- **McKinley Dickerson, Allyson Fertig** and **Malene Pedersen** have all earned All-Mountain West accolades in the past. Dickerson was a 2021-22 All-Mountain West Team member while Fertig was an all-league selection last season. Pedersen, meanwhile, was the 2022-23 Mountain West Freshman of the Year.
- Wyoming's 23 victories overall and 13 Mountain West wins last season marks the first time since 2018-19 that the Cowgirls reached those bench marks.
- This season, **Allyson Fertig** became the first Cowgirl since Hillary Carlson (2008-11) to reach the 100-block milestone in program history. In the November 10 loss to Nebraska, Fertig became the sixth Cowgirls to reach 100 career blocks.
- UW must replace a pair of senior starters from 2022-23 in Tommi Olson and Quinn Weidemann, who combined for 214 career starts and 277 games played. Weidemann's 149 games played were the most in program history.
- One of the Cowgirls tasked with replacing Olson is **Emily Mellema**, who is averaging 9.5 points and 2.3 assists per game in the first four starts of her career thus far in 2023-24.

ARENA AUDITORIUM

POST GAME PROCEDURES

SPOKANE, Wash. (Nov. 18, 2023) – The Wyoming Cowgirl basketball team stumbled on the road Saturday, losing at Gonzaga 80-64. Despite shooting 53-percent from the floor and hitting a season-high eight 3-pointers, the big difference in the game came on the glass.

Gonzaga (4-1) out-rebounded the Cowgirls (2-2) 36-24 in the contest and enjoyed a 24-5 advantage in second-chance points. Despite Wyoming's hot shooting, the Bulldogs were able to hoist up 17 more shots on the day, neutralizing the UW offense to a degree.

Wyoming got Allyson Fertig going early, as she scored the first six points of the game for the Brown & Gold. After trailing 6-4 early, Gonzaga responded with a 14-0 run to go up by 12 and didn't look back from there. GU led 25-18 after the first and 43-33 at halftime.

The Cowgirls would get the deficit down to as little as eight points in the third quarter, but the Bulldogs were able to extend the lead back up to 16, 67-51 by the end of the frame. In the fourth, Gonzaga enjoyed a double-digit lead the final 10 minutes and led by as many as 19 at one point.

Fertig shot a perfect 5-for-5 from the floor and led the Cowgirls with 12 points in the loss. Tess Barnes and Emily Mellema also scored in double figures, posting 11 points each. The duo combined to shoot 9-of-11 overall and hit a trio of 3-pointers in the loss. Mellema also led the way with five assists and was one of five Cowgirls to record a steal in the loss.

Kati Ollilainen led the Wyoming reserves with 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting. Ollilainen hit a pair of 3-pointers and had two assists on

the day. Malene Pedersen added nine points and four assists. Marta Savic led the Cowgirls with a season-high nine rebounds off the bench.

Overall, Wyoming shot 26-for-49 and made 8-of-23 (34.8-percent) from beyond-the-arc. Gonzaga shot 48.5-percent (32-66) and hit 9-of-24 (37.5-percent) from deep. The Bulldogs made 7-of-9 at the free-throw line while the Cowgirls made just 4-of-7.

Gonzaga recorded 19 offensive rebounds in the contest and had 22 assists on 32 made field goals. UW committed a season-high 16 turnovers, leading to 27 Bulldog points. GU also enjoyed a 17-6 advantage in fast break points on the day.

2023-24 NOTES

In the loss to Nebraska November 10, **Allyson Fertig** became the sixth Cowgirl in program history to record her 100th career block. Fertig is currently sixth all-time in career blocks and was the first Cowgirl since Hillary Carlson (2008-11), to reach the milestone.

DEFENSIVE STALWART

In the November 14 win at Denver, **Allyson Fertig** was all over defensively for the Cowgirls. Fertig notched a season-high four blocks in the victory and also had a steal. As a team, UW held the Pioneers to just 41 points and under 30-percent shooting from the floor.

DEPTH OFF THE BENCH

Through three games in 2023-24, Wyoming is averaging 21.8 bench points per game. Last season, the Cowgirls averaged nearly 17.5 points per game from their reserves.

NEW ROLES

Both **Tess Barnes** and **Emily Mellema** are in new roles this season, as they've entered the starting lineup for the Cowgirls. Entering the season Barnes had made just two starts in her career and this season, is averaging nine points and nearly three assists per game. Meanwhile, Mellema, is making the first starts of her career this season and is averaging 9.5 points, 2.3 assists and 1.5 steals per game.

IMPACT OFF THE BENCH

In just her second career game, **Maren McKenna** provided a spark for the Cowgirls in their loss to Nebraska (Nov. 10). McKenna scored nine points off the bench and had an assist in the contest. McKenna made 2-of-3 and a 3-pointer against the Cornhuskers and also went 4-of-4 at the free-throw line.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

With her double-double of 18 points and 11 rebounds in the Cowgirls' season-opening win over North Dakota, **Allyson Fertig** recorded the 20th double-double of her career. She now sits just outside the top-10 in program history for career double-doubles.

COWGIRL DEBUTS

A trio of Cowgirls made their debuts in the Brown & Gold in the November 6 opener against North Dakota. **Maren McKenna**, **Kati Ollilainen** and **Madi Symons** all played against the Fighting Hawks. Ollilainen had a big impact off the bench in the contest, scoring 14 points and making a pair of 3-pointers. McKenna recorded a rebound in the contest while Symons made her only field goal attempt and also grabbed three rebounds.

STRONG DOWN THE STRETCH

Wyoming outscored North Dakota 20-7 in the fourth quarter of its November 6 win, turning a four-point lead heading into the quarter, into a 17-point final margin of victory. The Cowgirls went 6-of-13 from the floor in the final 10 minutes and went a perfect 8-for-8 from the free-throw line. UND, meanwhile, went just 3-of-16 shooting in the fourth and closed the game missing nine of its final 10 shots.

FIRST-CAREER START

Emily Mellema logged the first start of her career against North Dakota. The junior scored 10 points and led the Cowgirls with three steals in the win in the 65th game of her career with UW.

RETURN OF THE McK(INLEY)

McKinley Dickerson returned to the Cowgirls this season after spending the 2022-23 campaign on a Mission Trip. Dickerson scored eight points and went 4-for-4 from inside-the-arc against North Dakota. Dickerson also added a pair of rebounds and assists and had a block in her first game since March of 2022.

IN THE RECORD BOOK

McKinley Dickerson is 19th in program history with 102 career made 3-pointers. Dickerson's 279 career 3-point attempts are 22nd all-time while her career 3-point percentage of 36.6-percent ranks 12th in UW history. She also ranks 16th all-time with a 76.5-percent career free-throw percentage.

Dickerson's 33 points February 14, 2022 at San Jose State are tied for the seventh-most in a single game in program history. Her 13 made field goals in that contest are tied for sixth-best all-time.

Allyson Fertig's 20 career double-doubles are 11th in program history. Fertig's 105 career blocks are sixth all-time. Fertig is also tied for 18th in UW history with 584 career rebounds.

CURRENT ACTIVE LEADERS

McKinley Dickerson is the current active leader in points with 844, made 3-pointers with 102, made free throws with 150 and 84 games played. **Allyson Fertig** is second in points (812) and is the active leader in rebounds (584), field goals (330) and blocks (105). **Emily Mellema** has 103 career assists and 49 career steals.

SCOUTING CHADRON STATE

Chadron State is 1-1 on the season and actually plays a game Monday night against York (Neb.) before traveling to face the Cowgirls. The Eagles lost their lone road game of the season so far. Ashayla Powers is the only Eagle averaging in double figures this season, scoring a team-best 14 points per game on nearly 69-percent shooting. Powers also leads the team averaging seven rebounds a contest. Kyra Tanabe is second on the Eagles averaging 9.5 points per game and leads the way with 10 assists on the year. Kylie Krise is at eight points a contest and has a team-best four made 3-pointers.

As a team, Chadron State is averaging 76 points per game and is shooting an even 50-percent from the field. Chadron has made nearly 32-percent of its 3-pointers and is 20-for-29 at the free-throw line. Eagle opponents are averaging 77.5 points per game and are shooting 43.6-percent from the floor but are hitting over 40-percent from beyond-the-arc. The Eagles are out-rebounding their opponents by 8.5 boards per contest and have 14 more assists through two games, but has 14 more turnovers as well.

LAST TIME AGAINST CHADRON STATE

LARAMIE, Wyo. (Nov. 22, 2021) – The Wyoming Cowgirl basketball team got out to a fast start in the first half Monday night inside the Arena-Auditorium on their way to a 71-48 victory over Chadron State. UW scored 43 points in the first half.

The Cowgirls sparked offensively through the first 10 minutes of the contest, shooting 10-of-14 in the first quarter and carried a 23-16 lead into the second. In the second, the Cowgirl defense began to take shape, holding the Eagles to just six points and 3-of-13 shooting in the frame. Wyoming led 43-22 at halftime and shot 19-of-34 (56 percent) in the first half.

In the second half, the UW offense sputtered as it mustered just seven points in the frame, on 2-of-13 from the floor. The Cowgirl defense held Chadron in check, to just 11 points in the third and the Cowgirls led 50-33 heading into the final quarter.

In the fourth, Wyoming found its rhythm a bit again on the offensive end, thanks in large part to Allyson Fertig's eight points and six rebounds in the quarter. Overall, the Cowgirls hit 8-of-19 shots in the final 10 minutes, outscoring the Eagles 21-15 in the frame and lengthening its lead down the stretch.

"I thought that once again we played hard, but not always smart – but we played hard," said Head Coach Gerald Mattinson.

"I would have liked to have seen us execute a little bit better tonight. We've got to go back and look at some film and get better on the offensive end."

McKinley Bradshaw led all scorers with 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting in just 19 minutes of action. Fertig meanwhile, recorded career-highs in both points (14) and rebounds (10) as she notched her first-career double-double in the victory.

Ola Ustowska and Paula Salazar added nine and eight points, respectively off the bench, with Salazar grabbing six boards. Lexi Bull and Grace Ellis also added six boards each to lead the Cowgirl rebounding effort. Wyoming got a great effort from its bench on the night, scoring a season-high 38 points from its reserves. The Cowgirls also had big advantages in points in the paint (52-14), second-chance points (16-5) and points off turnovers (14-8).

"We needed the bench tonight," said Mattinson.

"I thought the bench stepped up and got some scoring done and that was a great effort from them." The Cowgirls out-rebounded the Eagles 50-23 in the contest and had a season-best 16 assists overall, 11 of which came in the first half. Quinn Weidemann led the Cowgirls in that category with a season-best five, while Tommi Olson added four.

UW shot just under 44 percent on the night but went just 2-of-16 from 3-point range. The Eagles, were held to 39.6 percent shooting from the floor and hit 5-of-18 from beyond-the-arc. The Cowgirls had a solid night at the free-throw line, hitting 11-of-14 at the stripe while CSC went just 2-of-6.

SERIES HISTORY AGAINST CHADRON STATE

The Cowgirls are 13-0 all-time against the Eagles and won the last matchup with Chadron State, 71-48 in November of 2021. All 13 of the previous meetings with the Eagles have come in Laramie. Wyoming's average margin of victory in the series is nearly 30 points per meeting. McKinley Dickerson led the Cowgirls with 16 points in the 2021 victory over CSC. Allyson Fertig had a double-double, 14 points and 10 rebounds, off the bench in the win.

HEATHER EZELL

University of Wyoming
Head Women's Basketball Coach

Heather Ezell will be in her second season as the head coach of the Cowgirls in 2023-24 after spending seven seasons on the UW staff, including three seasons as the associate head coach. In her inaugural campaign leading the Cowgirls, Ezell set a program record for wins by a first-year head coach with 23. Wyoming

finished second in the Mountain West and made an appearance in the MW Tournament Championship Game, as well as the Women's NIT. Ezell helped guide a trio of All-Mountain West student-athletes in Allyson Fertig, Malene Pedersen and Quinn Weidemann in 2023.

Fertig and Weidemann were both named to the All-Mountain West Team, becoming the first pair of Cowgirl teammates to be named to the all-league team since 2018-19. Weidemann was also named to the league's All-Defense Team while Pedersen was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year.

In her first seven seasons with the program as an assistant, the Cowgirls won 130 games, including a run of three-straight 20-plus win seasons from 2017-19 and a Mountain West Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2020-21. UW has played in the postseason five times (4 WNIT, 1 NCAA) with Ezell on staff, has had 18 All-Mountain West performers and 48 MW Scholar-Athletes.

She came to Wyoming after spending four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. She joined the staff in 2011 and was responsible for working with the guards along with organizing practices, game day preparation and running summer camps. In 2012-13, she helped mentor Kara Wright to an Ohio Valley Conference All-Newcomer selection, marking the first Redhawk to earn postseason honors since the 2008-09 season.

Ezell spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at Fairfield University, where the Stags posted a 17-13 overall record and a 10-8 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. She worked primarily with perimeter players while assisting in the day-to-day operations of the program, including practice and game planning, recruiting and coordinating the team's community service efforts.

Ezell had a highly decorated career both collegiately and professionally which began as a four-year letterwinner at Iowa State University (2005-09). She finished her career tied for the Cyclones' career record with 287 made three-point field goals and finished 10th in program history with 1,339 points. In her senior season, Ezell earned Second Team All-Big 12 honors. She ranked 27th nationally with 2.5 three-point field goals made per game and eighth in the Big 12 with 3.5 assists per contest. Ezell also earned a spot on the 2008 Big 12 All-Tournament Team and helped the Cyclones to three NCAA appearances including the Elite Eight in 2009.

Ezell moved onto the professional level in 2009-10, playing in Iceland for Haukar where she was named Best Player in the Iceland Express League. She led the league in points and steals while finishing second in assists and rebounds. She also earned Most Valuable Player recognition in the league's All-Star Game.

A native of Springfield, Mo., Ezell led her Kickapoo High School team to two state championships and a 113-7 record during her prep years. She was named Miss Show Me Basketball as Missouri's top player in 2005. Ezell graduated from Iowa State in 2009 with bachelor's degrees in management and marketing.
