

# STADIUM & GAMEDAY INFORMATION

**GAME SITE:** War Memorial Stadium – Field Turf

**SEATING CAPACITY:** 27,702

**NCAA DIVISION:** Division 1 – FBS

**CONFERENCE:** Mountain West Conference (MWC)

## **ATHLETIC TRAINING:**

Two host student trainers will be assigned to the visiting team to help as needed. Our team orthopedist and our team doctor (internal medicine) will be located on the Wyoming sideline. A portable X-Ray/Fluoroscopy unit is available on gameday. The ambulance unit is located in the end zone. They will respond at your request. If you need any special arrangements, please contact our Sports Medicine Office at 307-766-2305.

## **BENCH AREA:**

The visiting team sideline is on the west (Press Box) side of the field. Fifty bench passes will be in your credential packet. You will access the field from the southwest end zone (Diagram A). There will be security officers in bench area. Sports medicine staff will be provided medical passes.

## **CHEERLEADERS & BAND:**

Cheerleaders, band members (in uniform) and a costumed human mascot are permitted on the field. The field can be accessed through the SW corner gate (Diagram A). These individuals must stay clear of the outlined bench area. Vans will be parked in lot “FA” and busses will be parked on 19th street (Diagram B). Direct all questions pertaining to these groups to the Visiting Team Host, Nick Corbin (307-766-2015).

## **COACHES' BOOTH:**

Passes for assistant coaches to gain access to the Press Box/ Coaches' Booth will be in your credential packet. A maximum of six passes are available for the booth. The Press box is accessible via an elevator located at the southwest corner of the fieldhouse.

## **CREDENTIALS:**

All credentials (team bench, working staff, and official travel party) and parking passes will be delivered in one packet. This packet can either be picked up by your advance team or mailed to your school. Please contact Associate Athletic Director - Media Relations, Tim Harkins (307-766-2321) regarding credentials and parking passes.

## **DRESSING ROOMS:**

The visitors' dressing room is located on the east side of the Fieldhouse, room #113 (Diagram A). Equipment move-in can begin at 3:30pm on Friday and is coordinated through the Football Equipment Manager, JD Jordan. The University of Wyoming provides security Friday evening for the locker room complex. 60 permanent lockers are available with two hooks per locker, doors will remain locked. 14 temporary lockers are available with those doors remaining unlocked. 100 folding chairs are provided. Towels and ice are provided on game day. Visiting team field access is through the SW field gate. Exit the middle doors of the Fieldhouse and walk to the right. Stadium security will allow players, coaches, and credentialed staff enter the field.

## **GAME TIMING SHEET:**

Timing Sheets are provided the week of the game and will be based on the following:

- Field Open for teams pre-game – 2 hours prior to kick-off
- Mountain West Pregame Meeting - 105 minutes prior to kick-off
- Clock started – 95 minutes prior to kick-off
- Field cleared – 20 minutes prior to kick-off
- Wyoming enters the field – 4 minutes prior to kick-off

## **LIVE ANIMAL MASCOTS:**

If you are planning to bring a live animal mascot to Laramie, prior approval by UW Administration is required for the animal to enter War Memorial Stadium. Any mascots that arrive without prior approval will not be allowed into the stadium. Direct all questions regarding live mascots to Visiting Team Host, Nick Corbin (307-766-2015).

## **OFFICIALS:**

Officials for home games are assigned by Greg Burks, the Coordinator of Football Officials. Officials will report three hours prior to kick-off. The officials' dressing room is located in the fieldhouse.

## **PARKING:**

The Visiting AD has four parking passes available for their use. One vehicle will park beside the equipment truck on the south side of the Fieldhouse. The three additional passes will be located in the FA lot. These passes will be in your credential packet. The equipment truck is to park next to the stadium

on the south side of the Fieldhouse. Three team buses will enter Gate 1 of the stadium through the east lot off 22nd street. These three buses will park under the stadium on the west side near the dressing room. Additional buses will park in the connector area between “D” lot and “FA” lot or on 19th street if necessary (Diagram B).

## **POLICE ESCORTS:**

UW Police Department and the Visiting Team Host will arrange for each bus/ van/ vehicle in the official travel party entering the stadium or surrounding area to be inspected by canine teams before they leave the visiting team hotel. Following the canine inspections, UW PD will provide a police escort from your hotel in Laramie to the stadium on gameday.

If your team hotel is not in Laramie, UW PD will arrange for the local police to complete the canine inspections of all buses/ vans/ vehicles in the official travel party. A police escort will be arranged from the Grand Avenue exit off I-80, east of Laramie, to the stadium for any teams not staying in Laramie. After the game, an escort may be provided to I-80 or the Laramie Regional Airport.

## **PRACTICE:**

Wyoming normally practices from 3:00 to 5:00 pm on the Friday preceding the game. Contact Director of Event Management & Game Operations, Nick Corbin ((307) 766-2015) to make practice arrangements.

## **PRE-GAME WARM-UP:**

Wyoming will warm up at the north end, visitors at the south end (Diagram A).

## **PROGRAMS:**

Eighty programs will be placed in the visiting team dressing room prior to the game.

## **SIDELINE COMMUNICATION:**

The following are available for Sideline to Press Box communications: Copper: Eight Runs of RJ14-4 Wire Dry Pair. (4 Wires in each, wired for pin with no phase reversal). These are numbered 1-8 with matching connections in Visiting Team Press Box. Fiber: 8 Strands of Single-Mode Fiber and Duplex LC Termination Neutrik optical/CON DUO Chassis Connector for use with Coach Comm Brand X System. 2.4 Frequency Sideline Units will NOT work in War Memorial Stadium. War Memorial Stadium utilizes a 2.4 GHz Distributed Antennae System for wireless internet to enhance fan experience. This system will create issues with 2.4 GHz Frequency Headset Systems. University of Wyoming does NOT have a backup or loaner headset system for visiting teams available. Press Box Communications: 2.4 Frequency Press Box Units will work in War Memorial Stadium Press Box. Should you have any questions, please call JD Jordan.

## **TEAM HOST:**

The Visiting Team Host will be Director of Event Management/Game Operations, Nick Corbin (307-766-2015). Please contact him Monday prior to the game.

## **TEAM VIDEO:**

Contact the Director of Recruiting Operations/Video Coordinator, Jake Chapman (307-766-3155) at least two weeks in advance to make arrangements.

## **TICKET INFORMATION:**

All complimentary tickets are issued per MWC regulations and/or contract arrangements. Any arrangements for complimentary and consignment tickets should be made with Assistant AD - Ticketing & Sales, Matt Chapman (307-766-4919). Visiting teams need to provide their own representative to staff the visiting team player pass pick up location inside the Arena Auditorium.

## **UNIFORMS:**

Wyoming will wear a combination of brown, gold, or white jerseys with brown, gold, or white pants.

## **VISITING AD BOX:**

The Visiting AD Box is located in the Press Box. Visiting AD Box passes will be in your credential packet, please address all questions to Tim Harkins. There will be catered food as well as sodas/ waters provided inside the Visiting AD Box.

## **VISITING TEAM RADIO:**

The booth is located in the press box beside the Visiting Team AD Box (south of press area). Passes will be in your credential packet.

## TEAM AREA CREDENTIALS

The Team Area shall be limited to squad members in full uniform and a maximum of 60 other individuals directly involved in the game. "Full uniform" is defined as being equipped in accordance with NCAA football rules and regulations, and ready to play. The 60 individuals not in full uniform shall wear special Team Area credentials numbered 1 through 60. No other credential is valid for the team area.

The NCAA has agreed to permit players in jerseys to be in the team area and not be counted against the 60 limit. The following names and responsibilities represent the individuals who will be in the Team Area in compliance with the NCAA rule as stated above.

# COACHES' COMMUNICATION DEVICES FORM

## COACHES' COMMUNICATION DEVICES

**NCAA RULE 1-4-12: COACHES' PHONES, HEADSETS AND COMMUNICATION DEVICES ARE NOT SUBJECT TO PLAYING RULES PENALTIES BEFORE OR DURING THE GAME. EACH TEAM MAY USE A MAXIMUM OF 23 HEADSETS WITH GUIDELINES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Fifteen (15) of the headsets may be used by countable coaches and graduate assistants for coaching purposes.
2. Three (3) "listen only" headsets may be used in the Coaches' Booth by individuals who are full-time undergraduate students or are within 10 years of exhaustion of eligibility or, if earlier, college graduation. Only countable coaches, graduate assistants and the three (3) individuals using the "listen only" devices may be in the Coaches' Booth. (Exception: One (1) communications technician)
3. Four (4) of the headsets may only be used by Squad Members or up to four (4) other designated full-time undergraduate students.
4. The one (1) remaining headset may be used on the field for non-coaching activity.
5. Headsets that are used for medical, game operations, security, etc. staffs are exempt from these limitations, provided the communication is separate from coaching communication devices.
6. One (1) communication technician in the team area and one (1) communication technician in the Coaches' Booth may be on the coaching headsets to monitor and handle any technical issues with the headset outside of the allowable 23 devices.

ALL UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING STUDENT-ATHLETES ARE PROVIDED WITH UP TO FOUR (4) COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS (IF APPLICABLE) PER HOME SPORTING EVENT IN THEIR RESPECTIVE SPORT. THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION RELATES TO ALL UW POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR GUESTS UTILIZING THE NCAA PLAYER PASS LIST.

- All individuals expecting to receive a complimentary ticket must be approved by the Compliance Office and placed on the player pass list prior to any University sponsored sporting event.
- All individuals must present a valid form of identification to the University staff member working the player pass. (Children without an ID will not be expected to present one upon entrance).
- The University staff member will review the individual guests ID, ensure their name is on the player pass list, and then provide the guest with a ticket stub for entry into the venue.
- Player guests will either receive a designated seat in a venue/arena or they will received a general admission ticket for a designated section or seating area.
- Other important notes:
- Any individual who receives a ticket via the NCAA player pass list may not exchange their ticket or sell their ticket to any other individual.
- Additional tickets may be purchased by any additional guests not on the player pass list.
- If an individual is not listed on the player pass list, he/she will be denied admission into the game and will be required to purchase a ticket for the event.
- If an individual does not show up to claim his/her complimentary admission, that ticket may not be provided to a different individual in lieu of someone not utilizing his/her ticket. (Ex. If a designated family member is on the pass list to receive a ticket and does not show up, that ticket may not be transferred to another family member who does not have a ticket).

## AREA ATTRACTIONS

---

The beautiful Snowy Range Mountains are located just 27 miles west of Laramie on Highway 130.

Resting in the shadows of the Snowy Range Mountains, the Vee Bar Guest Ranch is located 21 miles west of Laramie. The 100 year-old landmark has served as a cattle ranch, a stagecoach stop, a buffalo ranch, a summer guest ranch and a winter Bed & Breakfast. With careful restoration and creative décor, its western heritage has been preserved. The cabins and lodge offer antique furnishing from its rich and colorful past. The Vee Bar's menu of home-cooked food is part of the great stay at the ranch. Dining is buffet style in the informal western tradition. The ranch also offers numerous activities such as horseback riding, hayrides, hiking, trap shooting, fishing and river tubing.

The Old West Territorial Prison is located five minutes from downtown Laramie. The prison is a State Historic Site & Western Heritage attraction. The site is home to a restored 1870's prison. Group tours should be arranged in advance.


The Laramie Plains Museum is located in the heart of Laramie at 603 Iverson Street. The museum is housed in a restored 1892 Victorian mansion build by Edward Iverson, one of Laramie's original settlers. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, it is furnished with period pieces, including hand-carved furniture made at the territorial prison. The museum's exhibits include outstanding collections donated by Laramie area pioneers.

The American Heritage Center collects, preserves and catalogs manuscripts, photographs, maps, audio-visual materials, rare books and artifacts related to Wyoming and the West, economic geology, the petroleum and mining industries, transportation, American culture, conservation, and water resources. It is home to the papers of many prominent individuals including statesmen, authors, journalists, artists, pioneers, and entertainers. The AHC also houses the University of Wyoming Archives and the 50,000 book collection of the University of Wyoming. Students and scholars from around the world use the collections of the AHC and the AHC sponsors a wide range of scholarly and popular programs including lectures, concerts, symposia, and exhibits.

The University of Wyoming Art Museum is located in the dramatic Centennial Complex on the university campus. The museum exhibitions offer something for everyone and are displayed in an exciting gallery environment. Special programs, lectures, openings, workshops, classes, and tours are held on a regular basis. The University of Wyoming Art Museum offers a year-round source of education and entertainment for the entire family.

UW Geological Museum is located on the campus of the University of Wyoming in the S.H. Knight Geology Building. A wide variety of exhibits are on display of the physical and historical geology of Wyoming. Rocks and minerals as well as vertebrate, invertebrate, and plant fossils are displayed. Group tours should be arranged in advance.
