MATCH NOTES

THE BASICS

The Cowgirls open the 2026 campaign with their first of two home tournaments this fall. UW faces Texas Tech Friday at 6:30 p.m., before hosting St. Thomas at 1:30 Sunday afternoon. Both matches will be played in the Arena-Auditorium.

TEAM NOTES

- Wyoming's 2.72 blocks per set in 2025 ranked third-best in the conference and 16th in the nation.
- The Cowgirls' 318 total team blocks were also third in the MW and 16th-best in the country last season.
- Last season was UW's first trip to the Mountain West Volleyball Championships. The league moved to the new format in 2021.
- UW was picked to finish fourth in the Preseason Mountain West Poll.
- Offensively, Wyoming's .219 team hitting percentage ranks third in the league. The Cowgirls were sixth in the conference in assists (11.97) and kills (12.95) per set.
- On defense, the Cowgirls led the conference averaging 15.34 digs per set while their 2.72 blocks per set as a team ranked third-best.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Paige Lauterwasser was named to the Preseason All-Mountain West Team earlier in August. Lauterwasser is a two-time All-Mountain West honoree.
- Lauterwasser was also named to the CSC Academic All-District Team last fall, the second time she has received that honor.
- Evelyn Udezue's seven service aces in the September 12, 2025 win over Rhode Island, ties the program record for most aces in a three-set match.
- Lauterwasser was named the league's defensive player of the week November 3 of last season.
- Sara Quigley was named the MW Freshman of the Week October 6, 2025.
- Quigley was eighth in the league averaging 6.04 assists per set as Wyoming ran a 6-2 offense a season ago.

ABOUT THE ROSTER

The Cowgirls return 2024 and 2025 All-Mountain West performer Paige Lauterwasser to the 2026 squad. She is one of three returning starters for Wyoming, who need to replace three other starters, as well as its starting libero from 2025. Setters Sara Quigley and Maddy Stucky both return in 2026, as well as starting rightside Emma Winter, who is entering her senior campaign along with Lauterwasser. Also back are returners Rya Finglerlin, Abi Milby, Reagan Sharp, Addy Thorington, Evelyn Udezue and Anna Williams. UW welcomes in seven newcomers to this season squad in three transfers and four incoming freshmen. Transfers Peyton Carruth (Casper College), Anna Melgren (Houston Christian) and Senna Roberts-Navarro (Seton Hall) all bring collegiate experience to the 2026 Cowgirls. Kristina Bozovic (Montenegro), Rylee Heinz (Rocklin, Calif.), Ruby Jensen (Prescott, Ariz.) and Emerson Macias (Murrieta, Calif.) are the four incoming freshmen for UW.

LAST TIME OUT

LAS VEGAS, Nev. (Nov. 26, 2025) – The Wyoming Cowgirls' season came to an end Wednesday night

at the Mountain West Volleyball Championships. The third-seeded Cowgirls were swept in the contest by the No. 6 seed San Diego State. Set scores went 25-21, 25-20 and 25-19.

The Aztecs controlled things from start-to-finish Wednesday, scoring the first three points of the match and didn't look back. Wyoming didn't have a lead in either the first or third sets. The Cowgirls hit .216 in the loss while San Diego State hit .294.

Wyoming did record more blocks than the Aztecs, 8-2 and had one more service ace (5-4). However, the league's number one digs team was out dug by SDSU in the match, 50-39 and had 15 fewer kills. San Diego State also had one fewer serving error.

Sarah Holcomb led the Cowgirls on both sides of the net in her final match in the Brown & Gold. Holcomb was the only Cowgirl with double-digit kills as she tallied 11 and hit an efficient .455 in the loss. Holcomb also recorded a match-high five total blocks. The senior finishes her career fourth in program history in career hitting percentage and is sixth with 538 career blocks.

Addy Cook and Jordan Sandy had six and five kills, respectively on the night. The duo also recorded three blocks each. Paige Lauterwasser and Emma Winter chipped in with four kills each while Lauterwasser had 11 digs.

Skylar Erickson led the way with 13 digs in the loss and finishes with 1,048 for her career, placing her in seventh on the all-time career digs list. Lily LaFlesch led the Cowgirls with three service aces. Erickson and Sandy had the other two.

At setter, Sara Quigley paced Wyoming with 13 against the Aztecs while Maddy Stucky had 10. Both also added four digs while Quigley also had a kill. Erickson added five assists of her own.

UW finishes 2025 at 17-13 overall.

KNOW THE FOES

Texas Tech went 10-20 a year ago and won a pair of Big 12 matches. This season, the Red Raiders welcome in four transfer student-athletes, including Maggie Boyd, who was the 2026 AVCA National Beach Player of the Year at UCLA, where she was also a four-time First Team All-America. Senior Reagan Engler was third on the squad last season with 235 kills (2.42 per set) and returns to lead the TTU attack. The Red Raiders deployed a 6-2 offense last season with Katelyn Cochran tallying 444 assists in 2025. Last season, Texas Tech went 2-10 in true road matches.

St. Thomas was a national power at the Division III level and is now in its sixth season playing at the Division I level. The Tommies went 21-10 last season and 11-5 in the Summit League, winning the Summit League Tournament and lost in five sets in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament to Iowa State. Anya Schmidt was second on the team in 2025 as a freshman with 342 kills. Morgan Kealy returns to the Tommies for her senior campaign after averaging 10.08 assists per set last season.
