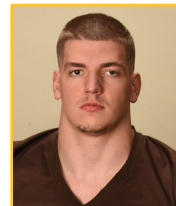

WYOMING ATHLETICS ON MW+

Wyoming athletics in conjunction with the Mountain West Conference announced the launch of MW+, a new direct-to-consumer digital subscription platform, powered by leading streaming technology and services company, Kiswe.

The platform marks a significant step forward in the Conference's digital evolution, delivering expanded access to live and on-demand content, while creating new opportunities for fan engagement and revenue generation for member institutions.

Season Openers: As the Wyoming Cowboys enter their 130th season of college football in 2026, the Pokes record in season openers stands at: 81-65-2 (.636) in 129 previous season-opening games. The Cowboys are 60-18-1 (.772) in season-opening games at home, and are 21-28-1 (.430) in road games to begin the season.

Border War: The Cowboys and the Rams will meet for the 118th time on Saturday. The Cowboys are 52-60-5 all-time against the Rams. The Pokes are 32-26 in the Bronze Boot Portion of the series. The Pokes were 14-13 in the Mountain West portion of the series.

Maxwell Award Adds Tote Harris to Watch List: The Maxwell Football Club announced its watch list for the 90th Maxwell Award on Monday presented annually to the outstanding player in college football. Cowboy running back Samuel "Tote" Harris was named to the list for the first time in his career. The Maxwell Award has been presented to the College Player of the Year since 1937 and is named in honor of Robert "Tiny" Maxwell who was a former standout at Swarthmore College and a renowned sportswriter and football official. Harris was a preseason All-MW selection by both Phil Steele and Athlon Sports. Harris was Wyoming's leading rusher last season, appearing in 11 games with seven starts. He finished the season with 558 yards on 100 carries for 5.6 yards per rush.

Bogar Added to Watch List: The Polynesian Football Hall of Fame announced today the Watch List for the 2026 Polynesian College Player of the Year Award and Wyoming defensive end Esaia Bogar was named to the list. Presented annually, the award honors the most outstanding college football player of Polynesian ancestry who exemplifies exceptional ability and integrity both on and off the field. This year's list features 69 players from 36 different NCAA Division I programs.

Bogar appeared in 10 games with one start for the Cowboys. He finished the season with 13 total tackles. He finished the season with seven solo stops and six assisted tackles. He also added 1.5 tackles for loss along with a sack.

Harris Added to Doak Walker Award Watch List: The PwC SMU Athletic Forum released today the preseason candidates for the 2026 Doak Walker Award. The Forum annually presents the award to the nation's most outstanding college running back. Wyoming sophomore running back Samuel "Tote" Harris was named to the list. He was also named to the Maxwell Award Watch List earlier this month. The list features 2025 Doak Walker Award finalist Ahmad Hardy (Missouri). Hardy rushed for 1,649 yards and 16 touchdowns, ranking second nationally in total rushing yards in 2025. The list also includes 2025 Doak Walker Award finalist Kewan Lacy (Ole Miss), who rushed for 1,567 yards and 24 touchdowns while helping the Rebels to a Sugar Bowl victory, and 2025 semifinalists Cam Cook (West Virginia), Cameron Dickey (Texas Tech) and Lucky Sutton (San Diego State).

Hughes Added to Wuerffel Trophy Watch List: The Wuerffel Foundation today announced a record 113 nominees to the 2026 Allstate Wuerffel Trophy Watch List, recognizing college football players from across the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) who exemplify community service, academic excellence and athletic achievement. Wyoming quarterback Tyler Hughes was named to the list. Widely regarded as college football's premier award for community service, the Allstate Wuerffel Trophy celebrates student-athletes who use their platforms to serve others and create positive change. Named after 1996 Heisman Trophy winner and University of Florida quarterback Danny Wuerffel, who turned his football success into a lifelong mission of service, the award reflects his legacy of leadership and humanitarianism. This year marks the 21st anniversary of the trophy's founding. Wyoming student-athletes recorded 2,600-plus hours of community service this past season. Hughes contributed by working with the Boys and Girls Club hosting a camp in Casper with fellow quarterback Mason Drube. The Wyoming football program partnered with "Get in the Game" to encourage people to sign up and register as potential donors in the National Marrow Donor Program (NMDP) in April in the Wyoming Union. In the span of a few hours, 113 people volunteered for cheek swabs to have their DNA added to the NMDP registry. Hughes was also involved in other outreach events since his arrival in Laramie.

Tote Note: Running back Samuel "Tote" Harris is one of the top returning running backs in the MW Conference. He rushed for 558 yards last season to lead the Cowboys. He also grabbed 16 catches for 184 yards. He had a career-high 126 yards rushing against Colorado and added 102 yards against Fresno State on only 12 carries. He was named First Team Preseason All-MW by Phil Steele and was second team by Athlon Sports.

Along The Line: The Cowboys return a pair of talented players along the offensive line in tackles Rex Johnsen and Braylon Jenkins. Johnsen started all 12 games for the Cowboys and has appeared in 32 in his career. Jenkins played in 12 contests and started the last six of the season. Johnsen was named Second Team All-MW by Athlon Sports and Third Team by Phil Steele. Transfer Chandler Donaway was a fourth team selection by Phil Steele as he will added to the line mix with Nebraska transfer Jason Maciejczak.

The Signal Callers: Wyoming will have three quarterbacks that have playing experience. Tyler Hughes is a transfer from William & Mary and earned Third Team All-CAA honors last season. He was the first quarterback in school history to pass for over 2,000 yards and rush for over 600. In 2025, Hughes threw for 2,330 yards completing 66 percent of his passes with 20 touchdowns and only three interceptions. He also rushed for 670 yards with 11 touchdowns. Wyoming native Mason Drube played the last game of last season as a true freshman passing for nearly 200 yards and Landon Sims helped lead the Pokes to a Border War win last season.

Impact on two Levels: Wide receiver/punt returner Deion DeBlanc makes plays both offensively and on special teams. He was a second team all-MW selection by Phil Steele last season and earned preseason second team honors by Phil Steele and Athlon Sports. He recorded a punt return for a score against San Jose State, which was a 73-yard return for a career long. He also added a 24-yard return against Northern Iowa. He had 17 catches for 90 yards last season.

New Man Running the Offense: Head Coach Jay Sawvel added new offensive coordinator Christian Taylor to the staff during the offseason. He comes to Laramie after coaching in the NFL with the Buffalo Bills. He has 16 years of collegiate coaching experience and has spent two seasons in the NFL. Taylor helped lead his programs to multiple NCAA Playoff appearances, including a trip to the FCS semifinals, he mentored 11 All-Americans, four Walter Payton Award Finalists and 24 all-conference standouts highlighted by at least one first-team all-league selection every year.

The Wideouts Bring Experience: The Pokes return production in the wide receiver room this season. Deion DeBlanc leads all returners with 17 receptions as season ago. Jackson Holman added 13 last season and Eric Richardson added 10. Other returners with experience include Charlie Coenen and Bricen Brantley. That group accounted for 50 receptions on the season. Wyoming added Division II transfer Justin Popovich, who added 686 yards last season with 55 receptions and was a All-PSAC selection.

The Tight End Room: The Cowboys return talent in the tight end room. Jake Wilson returns after missing last season with an injury. He was second team preseason All-MW by Phil Steele and fourth team by Athlon Sports. Kyle Frendt played a role as a true freshman last season and brings experience along with veteran Issac Schoenfeld, a native of Wyoming.

Another Talent in the Backfield: Transfer Markell Holman will make an impact in the backfield this season. He was the Ohio Valley Conference rushing champion last season at Western Illinois with 1,063 yards and had five 100 yard rushing games.

Sandvik Back: Kicker Erik Sandvik returns, as Wyoming has only had three kickers in the last 10 seasons with Cooper Rothe and John Hoyland being the other two. He was 6-of-11 last season and 6-of-9 within 50 yards.

Playmakers in the Secondary: The Cowboys return two of the top playmakers in the Mountain West Conference in nickel Desman Hearn along with safety Jones Thomas. The duo tied for the team lead with each adding a pair of interceptions last season. They also combined for nine pass breakups with nine, as Thomas had four and Hearn adding five, which tied or the team lead a season ago.

Mr. Jones: Safety Jones Thomas comes into the season as Wyoming's returning leading tackler with 57. He had 38 solo stops and 19 helpers. He had two interceptions and four pass breakups. He had a career-high 12 tackles for the Pokes at Fresno State. He also tied a career-high with seven solo stops, as he also had seven against Air Force. He added eight tackles against Utah and against UNIV. He was a preseason All-MW selection by both Phil Steele and Athlon Sports.

Hearns Back for Brown and Gold: Nickel Desman Hearns started 11 games for the Pokes last season. He finished the season with 35 total tackles with 29 solo stops. He also added two tackles for loss. He tied for the team lead with two interceptions and forced two fumbles. He also tied for the team lead with five pass breakups. He added an interception in both the Northern Iowa and Colorado State games. He was a first team preseason All-MW selection by Athlon Sports.

The Next Linebacker for the Brown and Gold: Linebacker Ethan Stuhlsatz will step into the role at middle linebacker last season replacing All-MW member Brayden Johnson. UW has had a first team all-conference linebacker in five of the last seven seasons. He was named First Team All-MW by both Phil Steele and Athlon Sports. Stuhlsatz appeared in all 12 games and made one start. He finished the season with 41 tackles to go along with 1.5 tackles for loss and one pass breakup. He had 20 solo stops and 21 assisted tackles. He recorded a season-high 10 tackle for the Pokes at San Diego State.

Interior Defenders: The Pokes return talent in the middle of the defense. Jayden Williams was a preseason All-MW selection by Phil Steele and Athlon Sports getting second team honors. Williams played in 11 games with three starts during the 2025 season. He recorded 24 tackles for the season with a career-high three tackles for loss. He had 13 solo stops and 11 assisted tackles. Wyoming returns Dante Drake and Caleb Robinson, who missed last season with injuries. Both played big roles for the Pokes in 2024.

Off The Edge: Wyoming added some talent in the transfer portal at defensive end and welcome back Esaia Bogar, as he added 13 tackles a season ago. Jack Dunkley was a Fourth Team Preseason All-MW selection and comes to UW from Duquesne. He was an All-NEC selection for the Dukes. He has appeared in 28 games in his career with 66 tackles, 24 tackles for loss and 14.5 sacks. Others added were All-Ivy league selection Thaddeus Gianaris from Dartmouth along with Donnie Wingate an honorable mention All-MVC selection.

New Look at Corner: Wyoming brings experience at corner in Ian Bell, who missed most of last season along with a true freshman from last season in Tyson Shamsid-Deen, as he had seven tackles last season. Those two will be joined by Weber State transfer Logan Mackey, David Leonard, BJ Inmon along with some newcomers in Kendall Griffin and Junus McGraw.

Edmiston Returns as one of Nation's Top Punters: Wyoming returns one of the nation's top punters in Bart Edmiston. He was named to the Ray Guy Award Preseason Watch List. Edmiston was one of the top punters in the Mountain West last season. He was fourth in the conference and No. 12 in the nation at 46.1 yards per punt. He punted the ball 65 time for nearly 3,000 yards. He had a long of 68 yards and recorded 26 punts of 50 or more yards. He had 22 punts inside the 20-yard line. His long punt came against San Jose State and he recorded five punts inside the 20-yard line against Colorado State. He was preseason All-MW selection by Phil Steele and Athlon Sports.

Contests on Friday: Wyoming will have three contests shifted to Fridays with two of those contests being inside War Memorial Stadium. Wyoming will host Friday home games against Air Force on October 23 and host New Mexico on November 20. UW will play a road game at San Jose State on Friday, October 9.

Pokes to play Three Home Games on The CW: The Pokes will open their home portion of the schedule against Northern Colorado on September 12 with a 2 p.m. start on the conference's new stream service MW+ with more information being released in the coming weeks. The Pokes will host Hawai'i on September 26 for a 1 p.m. start on The CW, which marks three-straight home contests on the network. UW will host MW newcomer Northern Illinois at 1:30 p.m. on October 17 then a Friday contest with Air Force on October 23 at 7 p.m. :Wyoming will host New Mexico on Friday, November 20 at 7 p.m. in a contest on FS1 and closes the regular season hosting UCONN on November 28 on the Fox Family of Networks with a time to be determined.

WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM

The 2025 college football season will be the 76th season of War Memorial Stadium. But mark the 75th Birthday of the stadium

The Cowboys won their 250th game in War Memorial Stadium on Nov. 6, 2021, with a 31-17 win over Colorado State.

Wyoming has won **65 percent** of its games in War Memorial Stadium.

"The War" first opened on Sept. 16, 1950, with UW recording a 61-13 win over Montana State. War Memorial's original capacity was 20,000 in 1950. It was expanded to 25,500 in 1970, and the seating was increased to a capacity of 33,500 in 1977.

Following reconstruction of the upper deck on the West side of War Memorial Stadium in the summer of 2004, the new capacity of War Memorial Stadium was 30,514. With the construction of the Wildcatter Stadium Club & Suites in 2009-10 and Restore The War updates, the current capacity is just over 25,000

Wyoming completed a perfect 7-0 home in 2023. It was the first time in War Memorial Stadium history that the Cowboys won seven home games in a single season. It is the 15th undefeated regular-season home record in War Memorial history and the third in the Bohl era. The 2019 and 2016 Cowboy teams posted perfect 6-0 home records in the regular season.

Wyoming fans set a new War Memorial Stadium single-season attendance record this season. With a crowd of 18,233, the 2023 season attendance total finished at 162,144, breaking the previous record of 149, 625 set in a seven-game home season in 1990.

ABOUT COLORADO STATE

Colorado State is looking for a fresh start as the program enters its first season in the Pac-12. The Rams, who suffered losing seasons in seven of their final eight seasons as members of the Mountain West, rebooted last November by hiring head coach Jim Mora Jr. away from UConn. Two transfer quarterbacks, Hauss Hejny (Oklahoma State) and K'saan Farrar (UConn), were the primary contenders for the starting job through fall camp. Mora told the media he planned for them to find out the winner of the battle during CSU's first offensive series in the opener vs. Wyoming. The Rams' offense line is led by tackle Quinton Harris, a TCU transfer, with UConn transfers Toriyan Johnson and Diego Rodriguez also blocking for former UConn teammates Mel Brown and Oliver Lundberg-Coleman. Tight end Juice Vereen, yet another former UConn standout, has the talent to be an all-Pac-12 player. Mora was able to retain wide receiver Tommy Maher. Tyson Summers, who was CSU's interim head coach for five games last season, including the 28-0 loss to the Cowboys in Laramie, returns as defensive coordinator. Defensive end Stephon Wright and linebacker Oumar Diomande are the UConn transfers on the defensive side of the ball expected to have a big impact.

ABOUT COLORADO STATE HEAD COACH JIM MORA

Mora, 64, was an NFL head coach with the Atlanta Falcons (2004-06) and Seattle Seahawks (2009) before becoming an FBS head coach at UCLA (2012-17). His father, Jim Mora Sr., was also an NFL head coach with the New Orleans Saints (1986-96) and Indianapolis Colts (1998-2001). During his six seasons leading the Bruins, Mora posted a 46-30 overall record. UCLA finished No. 16 in the final Associated Press poll at 10-3 overall in 2013 and No. 10 at 10-3 in 2014 with bowl wins each season. Following his departure from UCLA after back-to-back losing seasons in 2016-17, Mora worked as an analyst for the NFL Network. He took over the struggling UConn program in 2022 and led the Huskies to a 27-23 overall record, including back-to-back nine-win seasons in 2024-25, before leaving for CSU. Mora played defensive back and linebacker at Washington before starting his coaching career as a San Diego Chargers assistant in 1985.

UW OVERTIME HISTORY

Wyoming has played 20 overtime games in its history. The most recent overtime game the Cowboys played was against Texas Tech on Sept. 2. The Cowboys downed the Red Raiders 35-33 in double overtime. Wyoming has played six overtime games at home in War Memorial Stadium. Three of Wyoming's 19 overtime games have been played on neutral sites. The other 11 overtime games have been played on the road.

JAY SAWVEL

(MOUNT UNION '93)

HEAD COACH, UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING

Jay Sawvel was introduced by University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman as the new head coach of the Wyoming Cowboys on Dec. 6, 2023. He officially replaced Craig Bohl following Wyoming's bowl victory against Toledo in the Barstool Sports Arizona Bowl.

"Jay has done a masterful job in his time at Wyoming building strong relationships with players and staff," Burman said. "His defense embodies Wyoming's culture in that we play physical, disciplined and with passion."

Sawvel is the 33rd coach in Wyoming history and has served as the team's defensive coordinator and safeties coach since February of 2020. Over his career, he has been part of 21 teams who advanced to postseason play, including 14 bowl appearances and seven NCAA Playoff appearances.

"His vision on the future of Cowboy Football energized me and I feel he will help us reach a Mountain West Championship in the near future," Burman said.

Sawvel has learned from some of the top minds in college football history. Some of the names include Craig Bohl, Lou Holtz, Roy Kidd and Jerry Kill. Of the seven head coaches that Sawvel has worked for, the group owns over 1,200 wins.

In 2025, The Cowboys defense was once again one of the top units in the nation ranking No. 30 in the nation allowing only 20.5 points per game. The Cowboys also featured one the nation's top red-zone defenses ranking second in the nation. Wyoming allowed only 175.5 passing yards per game, which ranked No. 13 in the nation. The Cowboys also blocked four kicks on the season, a number that ranked fifth in the nation.

Wyoming recorded two shutouts during the season doing so against Akron in the season opener and Colorado State. It marked the first time since 1966 that the Cowboys recorded two shutouts in a season.

Sawvel mentored seven Cowboys to All-Mountain West honors in 2025. Wyoming had two Second Team selections in offensive guard Caden Barnett and linebacker Brayden Johnson. Tight end John Michael Gyllenborg earned an invite to the NFL Combine and also played in the Senior Bowl.

The Pokes were solid once again in the classroom with seven players being named CSC Academic All-District. Six Cowboys were also named to the Hampshire Honor Society by the National Football Foundation. Sawvel had 36 players earn Academic All-MW honors.

In 2024, Sawvel and Cowboys led the nation in third-down defense holding opponents to 25.9 percent on third down. Wyoming struggled with injuries during the season, but closed out strong defeating Washington State on the road in the final minute, as the Cougars had ranked in the national polls during the season. The Pokes also nearly knocked off Boise State, A College Football Playoff participant holding the Broncos well below their season averages offensively. In total, the Cowboys played a pair of teams in the first ever College Football Playoff also facing Arizona State.

He earned his first career win in a home victory against Air Force on Sept. 28, 2024. He is the first Cowboy coach since Paul Roach to earn their first win against Air Force. Sawvel took over for Craig Bohl, as Bohl also earned his first Mountain West win against the Air Force Academy in 2014.

Nine Cowboys earned All-Mountain West honors in Sawvel's first season as head coach with four players on defense, three on offense and two

special teamers garnering honors for the Cowboys. Wyoming also excelled in the classroom with 25 players earning Academic All-Mountain West honors.

"I'm excited and honored to be the next head football coach at the University of Wyoming," Sawvel said. "I have loved working and learning under head coach Craig Bohl for the last four years. The infrastructure Coach Bohl has put into this program makes me very excited to be the next leader of this program."

In 2023, the Pokes would win nine games, as it was Wyoming's first nine-win season since 1996 when UW posted a 10-2 season. The Cowboy defense ranked No. 26 in the nation in turnovers gained, which ranked third in the MW. The Cowboys rank seventh in the nation with 11 fumble recoveries. The Wyoming defense ranks No. 24 in the nation in fewest yards allowed per pass attempts. Sawvel's 2023 defense ranks No. 2 in the Mountain West Conference in scoring defense (allowing only 22.3 points per game) and ranks No. 3 in the MW in total defense (allowing opponents only 357.8 yards per game).

Linebacker Easton Gibbs, a first-team All-MW selection finished the 2023 regular season averaging 8.8 tackles per game to rank No. 4 in the Mountain West and No. 29 in the nation. Gibbs recorded over 360 tackles as a Cowboy to rank in the top-10 in school history. He signed as a priority free agent with Seattle Seahawks in April. Defensive tackle Jordan Bertagnole, was a second-team All-MW selection ranking No. 3 among all Mountain West defensive linemen in tackles this season, averaging 4.3 tackles per game. Safety Wyatt Ekeler ranked third on the Cowboy team in tackles this season with 77 and ranked No. 9 among MW defensive backs in tackles, averaging 5.9 per game. Ekeler was twice named MW Defensive Player of the Week in 2023 and was an honorable mention All-MW selection.



Sawvel's 2022 defense ranked No. 2 in the Mountain West and No. 21 in the nation in sacks, averaging 2.85 per game. His defense also ranked No. 2 in the MW and No. 33 in the FBS in defensive touchdowns scored, with two. Sawvel's defense featured three All-MW honorees as selected by coaches and media. Those three were: Easton Gibbs (LB), who earned First Team All-MW; and defensive end DeVonne Harris and cornerback Cam Stone, who both earned Honorable Mention honors. Phil Steele's All-MW team included: Gibbs and Stone on his First Team; defensive tackle Jordan Bertagnole on his Second Team; and Harris on Steele's Fourth Team. Freshman defensive end Braden Siders was also named an Honorable Mention Freshman All-American by College Football News.

The Wyoming Cowboys entered the 2022 college football season as the fourth youngest team in the country. But given that, the Cowboys went on to record a 7-6 record, finish second in the Mountain West Conference Mountain Division and earn a spot in the Barstool Sports Arizona Bowl. Along the way the '22 Pokes defeated rivals Air Force, Colorado State, Hawai'i, Utah State and American Athletic Conference member Tulsa. Wyoming's 7-6 record gave them their fifth winning season in the past seven seasons.

The Cowboy defense in 2021 was one of the top pass defenses in the nation. Wyoming allowed opponents only 189.8 passing yards per game to rank No. 1 in the Mountain West and No. 12 in the nation. The Cowboy defense was also No. 13 in the nation in defensive touchdowns scored, with three. Wyoming held opponents to 23.7 points per game in the 2021 season to rank No. 5 in the MW and No. 43 in the country out of 130 FBS programs. The Cowboys posted a 7-6 record and won their third consecutive bowl game, with a convincing 52-38 win over Kent State in the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl. Linebacker Chad Muma was one of six national finalists for the Butkus Award in 2021. Muma earned Second Team All-America honors from the Walter Camp Football Foundation and Pro Football Focus and was a Third Team selection by Associated Press. He was selected as the Sixth Pick in the Third Round (70th overall) by the Jacksonville Jaguars in the 2022 NFL Draft. Sawvel also had six of his defenders earn All-Mountain West Conference honors in 2021. Muma was a First Team selection (MW Coaches/Media and Pro Football Focus), cornerback C.J. Coldon (Second Team MW Coaches/Media), nose tackle Cole Godbout (Second Team Pro Football Focus and Honorable Mention MW Coaches/Media), cornerback Azizi Hearn (Second Team Pro Football Focus), defensive end Garrett Crall (Honorable Mention MW Coaches/Media), linebacker Easton Gibbs (Honorable Mention Pro Football Focus).



Over his career, he has been part of 21 teams who advanced to postseason play,

In his first season guiding the Wyoming defense as defensive coordinator in 2020, the Cowboys were among the best in the country, ranking No. 16 in the nation in total defense, allowing opponents only 328.0 yards per game. UW's defense also ranked No. 21 in rushing defense (125.3 yards per game), No. 24 in scoring defense (21.0 points per game) and No. 29 in pass defense (202.7 yards per game). Three of his Cowboy defenders earned All-Conference recognition in 2020. Junior linebacker Chad Muma earned First Team All-Mountain West honors from MW head coaches and media. Senior free safety Esaias Gandy earned Honorable Mention honors from the conference head coaches and media, and sophomore cornerback C.J. Coldon earned Fourth Team All-MW from Phil Steele. Before coming to Wyoming, Sawvel served as the defensive coordinator at Wake Forest University in 2017 and '18. He was named the defensive coordinator at Wake Forest in January 2017 and helped the Deacons to the 2017 Belk Bowl. During his first season at the helm of the Wake Forest defense, the Deacons set school records for tackles for loss in a single season and finished the season ranked No. 7 nationally in tackles for loss.

As the cornerbacks coach in 2017, Sawvel coached Essang Bassey, who set a sophomore school record with 19 passes defended and earned Honorable Mention All-ACC honors. Prior to coaching at Wake Forest, Sawvel served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Minnesota where he constructed a Top 25 ranked defense and helped the Gophers to their best record in 13 seasons in 2016. Minnesota posted a 9-4 record in 2016 and defeated Washington State, 17-12, in the Holiday Bowl. In the Holiday Bowl victory, Minnesota held Washington State's explosive passing offense to just 264 yards, 86 yards below its average, and held the Cougars to their lowest point total of the season.

Sawvel spent six seasons as an assistant at Minnesota. He was the defensive backs and special teams coach from 2011 to 2015. After Jerry Kill's retirement as the head coach at Minnesota, Tracy Claeys was elevated to head coach and Sawvel became the Gophers' defensive coordinator.

Under Sawvel's direction, the 2016 Golden Gopher defense was ranked in the Top 25 in a number of defensive categories including: rushing defense (14th), turnover margin (18th), scoring defense (21st), total defense (21st) and sacks (22nd). In addition, Minnesota ranked 27th nationally in team pass efficiency defense. Sawvel has helped develop several players who went on to play in the NFL. In 2015, two of his players at Minnesota, Eric Murray and Brian Boddy-Calhoun, earned opportunities in the NFL. Murray was a fourth round pick of the Kansas City Chiefs while Boddy-Calhoun signed with the Jacksonville Jaguars as a free agent. In 2014, both Murray and Boddy-Calhoun were named to the All-Big Ten Team following a season in which the Gophers were 18th in the nation in pass defense.

Brock Vereen, a 2014 First Team All-Big Ten selection and another one of Sawvel's pupils, was drafted in the fourth round of the NFL Draft by the Chicago Bears.

For three seasons from 2014 through 2016, Sawvel had at least one of his secondary players selected in the NFL Draft. Sawvel was part of teams that advanced to four conference championships as a collegiate coach.

Prior to his time at Minnesota, he served as the defensive backs coach on Kill's coaching staff at Northern Illinois for three seasons from 2008-10. As secondary coach at Northern Illinois, he mentored Jimmie Ward, a first round pick of the San Francisco 49ers.

Sawvel was a member of the Southern Illinois staff under Kill for seven seasons from 2001-07, working with the secondary and special teams. His first full-time coaching position came at Ferris State for two seasons from 1999-2000, where he coached the defensive backs and special teams.

Sawvel was a three-year letterwinner and an All-Conference linebacker in 1993 at Division III power Mount Union. He earned a bachelor's degree in 1993 in sports management with minors in business administration, information systems and physical education. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Eastern Kentucky in 1994 and moved to Notre Dame as a graduate assistant coach for the 1996-98 seasons. Sawvel owns master's degrees from both Eastern Kentucky and Notre Dame, where he completed his master's in administration. Sawvel has two daughters, Mackenzie and Miranda.
