The No. 24/25 Yale Bulldogs (8-1, 5-1 Ivy) are on a five-game win streak and after its win over then-No. 18/19 Princeton last Saturday, the Elis have an opportunity at a second Ivy League Championship in three years when Yale takes on Harvard (4-5, 2-4 Ivy) this Saturday on ESPNU at the Yale Bowl.

**The Series:** College football's second oldest rivalry renews in New Haven with Yale leading the all-time series, 67-60-8. The Bulldogs have won two of the previous three meetings, including 2017's game at the Yale Bowl in which the Bulldogs improved to 9-1 overall and 5-1 in conference play to win the Ivy League Championship.

**Ivy & National Accolades:** Senior quarterback Kurt Rawlings was selected as the Ivy League Offensive Player of the week for the fifth time this season as well as the New England Football Writers' Gold Helmet Award winner. It is the fifth-straight week and seventh time in the past eight weeks that Yale has been recognized with an Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week award. Yale now boasts eight Ivy weekly honors in 2019. Rawlings takes home the fifth-straight offensive award for Yale after JP Shohfi earned the honor last Monday. Rawlings set a Yale single-game record at Princeton as he threw six touchdown passes to help the Bulldogs down the Tigers, 51-14, tying the largest margin of victory over Princeton in 142 all-time meetings. Rawlings was also honored by by STATS FCS as a National Player of the Week Honorable Mention selection. Additionally, senior kicker Sam Tuckerman was honored as the Ivy Special Teams Player of the Week. Tuckerman drilled a 43-yard field goal and finished with nine points on the day as he put home six extra points.

**Bulldog Breakdown:** The Bulldogs boast the highest scoring offense among the Ivies (37.4 pts, ranked 10th FCS), have won five-straight games and have scored 45-plus points in each of those games. They are coming off a blowout at then-No. 18/19 Princeton Stadium, which tied the largest margin of victory against the Tigers in program history, set in 1931.

Team 147 includes the most prolific passing trio in the history of the program in quarterback Kurt Rawlings and wide receivers JP Shohfi and Reed Klubnik. Those three senior names are etched throughout the school's record books with way too many accomplishments to list here. Between them, there are 13 league-leading stats categories this fall, something that could not have been accomplished without an amazing offensive line that includes senior offensive lineman, Sterling Strother, Dieter Eiselen, Steven Cepalia and Lucas Tribble.

Yale's defense is led by senior linebacker Ryan Burke who has 41 tackles in eight games. Sophomore safety Kyle Ellis, who had an interception last Saturday is tied for the league-lead in picks with three. Senior defensive lineman Spencer Matthaei is tied for the national lead with three blocked kicks and has been a force inside all season.

## SCOUTING HARVARD

The Crimson, coming off a loss to Penn at Boston, have now lost four straight heading into The Game, but those losses have come by a combined 18 points, including a Hail Mary loss vs. Dartmouth, and a six-point loss at Princeton.

The Harvard defense is its strength as defensive lineman Truman Jones ranks 11th in the FCS and tops the Ivies in sacks with .93 per game. He also leads the league with 1.6 tackles for lost yards per game.

Meanwhile, Harvard ranks 12th in the nation in scoring defense (19.8 points), No. 1 in sacks (4.33) and is sixth against the run (85.6).

On the other side, quarterback Jake Smith ranks among the top four in the Ivies for all passing categories with numerous weapons to target.

Yale special teams must also be aware that the Crimson top the FCS this fall in blocked kicks with nine.

## 9 IVY LEAGUE HONORS IN 8 WEEKS

Kurt Rawlings and Sam Tuckerman's weekly Ivy League honors this week have the Elis up to nine awards in just eight weeks!

11/9 - The Bulldogs received two honorees for the first time in 2019 as senior captain and wide receiver **JP Shohfi** was selected as the Offensive Player of the Week while first-year defensive back **Brandon Benn** was tabbed Rookie of the Week. Shohfi pulled in 10 completions for 166 yards and a Yale single-game record four touchdowns in a 59-35 win at Brown. Benn has stepped into a starting role for the Bulldogs and led Yale with 10 tackles from the safety position. The Atlanta, Ga., native also had a game-high nine solo tackles and forced one of four fumbles for the Yale defense.

11/4 - For the third-straight week and fourth time in the past five weeks, **Kurt Rawlings** is the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week. Rawlings led the Bulldogs to a rout of Columbia, 45-10, as Yale improved to 6-1 overall for the third time in the past six seasons. Rawlings accounted for four touchdowns in the game, marking the third-straight time he accomplished the feat and fourth time this season. He set a new career high with 390 passing yards and completed at least 20 passes for the third-consecutive game. He threw for two TD's and ran two in.

10/28 - For the second-straight week and the third time in the past four weeks, Rawlings has been selected as the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week. He paced the Bulldogs in offensive shootout against Penn as he orchestrated a 46-41 victory. The Bel Air, Md., native threw for a career-high 388 yards and went 455 yards of total offense. He also found the endzone four times, rushing for two and throwing for two more.

10/21 - Yale Football erased a 27-14 deficit in the final 90 seconds at Richmond as Rawlings was honored afternoon as the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week. Rawlings threw for all four Yale touchdowns and the Bulldogs came up with the key onside kick to set up his game-tying score with just nine seconds left to take their first lead of the game.

10/7 - After a 48-24 win over Fordham, the Ivy League has selected Rawlings as its Offensive Player of the Week. He was responsible for four touchdowns, throwing for two and rushing for two more. He finished the day with 301 passing yards, completing 16-of-21 passes and scoring tosses of 69 and 48 yards. His two scrambling touchdowns came deep in the redzone.

9/30 - Yale's defense limited Cornell to 16 points while intercepting four passes and allowing just 14 completions in the Elis' league-opening win at Yale Bowl. Junior **Rodney Thomas II** had two of those picks along with 52 returns yards and a touchdown which earned him Ivy League Defensive Player of the Week.

## COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Two Yale football seniors were selected to the 2019 College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-District Team. Senior defensive lineman Josh Keeler and senior center Sterling Strother were tabbed to the NCAA Division I District 1 team, made up of players from Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island and Vermont.

The Academic All-District team recognizes the nation’s top student-athletes for their combined performances on the field and in the classroom. Academic All-District honorees now advance to the CoSIDA Academic All-America ballot. First- and second- team (if applicable) Academic All-America honorees will be announced in early December.

Keeler, an Orlando, Fla., native, boasts a 3.5 GPA in Political Science. He has started the past 11 games at defensive tackle for Yale and played in the previous 27. Keeler anchors a defensive line rotation as the starting nose guard, eating up space to go along with 25 career tackles and two sacks. He helped the Bulldogs with an Ivy League Championship in 2017.

Strother, a Moraga, Calif., native, boasts a 3.68 GPA in Psychology. Strother is a Semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy; the ‘academic Heisman.’ A two-time All-Ivy League performer; has played left tackle, left guard and now center, he has started the past 30 games the Bulldogs. Also part of Yale’s Ivy title team, Strother has been scouted by the NFL.

## IVY LEAGUE FAVORITE

The Ivy League announced its 2019 football preseason poll as selected by the media and Yale was selected atop the standings with 119 points and nine first-place votes. The Bulldogs ranked seven points ahead of second-place Dartmouth and boast five more first-place votes than any other team. It is the second-straight season in which Yale has been picked first in the preseason poll.

Head coach Tony Reno enters his eighth season with the Elis and aims to bring Yale its second Ivy League Championship in three years after claiming the 2017 title.

“To be recognized by the media among a league filled with strong teams which have talented players is always an honor,” said Reno. “Team No. 147 is excited to get the 2019 season started. We continue to strive to become the best version of ourselves each and every day.”

## PHIL STEELE ALL-AMERICAN

Senior guard Dieter Eiselen was tabbed as an All-American by Phil Steele Dieter, a senior offensive lineman from Stellenbosch, South Africa, started all 10 games for Yale last season. He has made 24 starts in his career and has twice garnered All-Ivy League accolades, including a second team honor last year. Phil Steele selected Dieter as a Preseason Second-Team All-American.

## STEELE’ING RECOGNITION

Senior wide receiver Reed Klubnik was selected as the Preseason Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year. Klubnik, who was already tabbed to the Walter Payton Watch List earlier this offseason, garnered the top offensive Ivy League honor from Steele. The senior wideout from Austin, Texas broke the Yale record with 1,143 receiving yards last season, ranking ninth in FCS overall.

Steele also selected 11 Yale players to his All-Ivy teams. Klubnik, Eiselen, wide receiver JP Shohfi, offensive lineman Sterling Strother, defensive lineman Spencer Matthaei and linebacker Ryan Burke were selected to the First Team. Quarterback Kurt Rawlings, running back Alan Lamar and defensive lineman Charles Callender were second team selections. Running back Zane Dudek and tight end JJ Howland were tabbed to the Third Team.

## IN THE POLLS

For the first time in 2019, the Bulldogs are into both top-25 polls, but they have been receiving votes all season long. Three preseason top-25 polls recognized the Elis as they received votes in the STATS FCS Preseason Poll also were ranked in both HERO Sports' and College Sports Madness' top-25 rankings at 17 and 20, respectively. The Bulldogs have been receiving votes in the STATS' national poll all season, marking the 14th- consecutive week that they have appeared in at least one of the two national top-25 polls. They are also in the AFCA for the 12th week this year.

## KLUBNIK & RAWLINGS ON WALTER PAYTON WATCH LIST

Senior quarterback Kurt Rawlings was one of 16 additions to the 2019 STATS FCS Walter Payton Award, the Heisman Trophy of the FCS. Rawlings joins classmate and wide receiver Reed Klubnik, a preseason pick, as 41 total honorees tabbed for consideration.

Rawlings has won three-straight Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week awards and four in the past five weeks. He has re-written the Yale record book as he now ranks first all-time in touchdown passes, passing yards, total yards, efficiency and completion percentage. Additionally, he boasts five top-25 rankings in the country this season including efficiency (11th, 154.), passing yards (20th, 269.1), yards per completion (13th, 14.38), points (21st, 16.3) and total offense (12th, 298.3). The Bel Air, Md., native has completed 131 passes for 1,884 yards, 12 touchdowns and a 63.29 completion percentage. Rawlings has also added 293 yards rushing on 70 carries for seven touchdowns.

Klubnik is also climbing up the Yale record books as he ranks third all-time with 17 touchdown receptions and 2,289 receiving yards, and fourth with 153 catches. The Austin, Texas, native is 13th in the country with 94.9 yards per game and ranks 42nd with 5.1 catches per game. Klubnik has 36 catches on the year for 664 yards, an 18.44 yards per catch average and four touchdowns.

Yale, Alcorn State, Jacksonville State, Monmouth, San Diego and South Dakota State are the only six programs in the nation with two players on the watch list.

## SROTHER A CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

Senior offensive lineman Sterling Strother was selected as a semifinalist for the 2019 Williams V. Campbell Trophy, presented by Mazda, as selected by the National Football Foundation (NFF). The award recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership.

Strother is one of just 39 nominees from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Not only is Strother well-accomplished on the field as an All-Ivy League performer, Ivy League Champion and potential 2019 NFL Draft pick, but his example both on the field as a leader and service in the community truly sets him apart. Strother is heavily involved with Team Impact, often serving a baby sister and an active supporter at the Special Olympics with Yale's team member, Dante Chiappetta. He is also a member of the Mandi Schwartz Marrow Drive committee for the past three years and volunteers in Yale's "Big Sib" program in which upper-classmen help first-years get acclimated to school, both socially and academically. Additionally, the Moraga, Calif., native, works in a psychology lab called the Clinical Affective Neuroscience and Development Lab (CAN-DLab) and does research on PTSD in children, adolescents and young adults. He will publish the research in this lab at the end of the year for his BS requirement. Strother is a psychology major who boasts over a 3.65 GPA. He has previously been recognized by Google Cloud as a College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-District selection.

## IVY AT ESPN

The Yale Bulldogs made the trip up to Bristol in mid-August to ESPN Headquarters for the 2019 Ivy League Football Media Day. In addition to numerous media hits, press conferences and interviews for the Elis, Yale was also recognized by ESPN College Football as one of the top-10 programs in the 150 years of collegiate football, raking No. 7 overall.

Head coach Tony Reno, senior quarterback Kurt Rawlings and senior defensive lineman Devin Moore were all on campus at ESPN yesterday along with several Yale administrators as the Bulldogs took top billing on the day as the Ivy League Preseason Media Poll favorites.

Reno and the Bulldogs got a full tour of the ESPN grounds including ESPN Radio, SportsCenter Coast to Coast studios and even the famous ESPN Cafeteria. Yale stopped for media hits with Worldwide Leader representatives as well as members of the NCAA office, Ivy League Digital team and local and national journalists.

While the day was capped with Reno, Rawlings and Moore live in studio on ESPN+ with host Jack Ford '72, the event started with a bang for the Bulldogs as ESPN Stats & Information put Yale in the top-10 of its 50 best college football programs over the past 150 years.

The goal of the rankings was to honor the accomplishments of teams across 150 seasons and all divisions, while rewarding successful programs at the highest level in the sport's most competitive era.

7. Yale – ranking: 66.7 | 18 national titles

“Yeah, Yale. Park your recency bias at the curb for just a moment and consider that for the first 50 years of college football, the sport's dominant power resided in New Haven. No wonder Yale is in the top 10: Walter Camp, the Father of American Football, played here (and yes, he made up the rules as he went along). Once the Ivies took a look at scholarship football after World War II and said no thanks, Yale ranked as first among equals in that league through the 1970's.”

The Ivy League was well represented with Yale leading the way and Princeton (11), Harvard (13), Penn (26) and Dartmouth (37) all in the top-40 of the rankings.

## THE CAPTAIN

Chosen by his peers, senior wideout JP Shohfi was selected as the 147th captain of the Yale Bulldogs. The psychology major in Saybrook College has been a regular in the route-running rotation for three seasons and a starter the last two while compiling 99 catches in 28 collegiate games. Shohfi has 10 career touchdown grabs, 1,489 yards and numerous highlight plays.



# TONY RENO

*Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach*

Anthony (Tony) Reno, who became the Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach of Yale Football on Jan. 12, 2012, transformed the Elis into a champion in his sixth campaign. His Team 145 defied all 2017 prognostications with a 9-1 (6-1 Ivy) record and the school's first outright league title in 37 years.

Reno's squad, which included 20 all-league selections, finished with a No. 24 national ranking after earning the Blue's first Ivy championship in 11 seasons. The fruits of his labor – with help from some of the best recruiting classes in FCS Football – were realized in grand fashion with a 24-3 win over Harvard before 52,000 fans at Yale Bowl. The young head coach earned Division I Coach of the Year from both the New England Football Writers and the Gridiron Club of Boston.

The 34th head coach of the Bulldogs, who came back to the program after serving as an assistant at Yale and Harvard, had come close before. The 2014 campaign brought much national attention back to New Haven's gridiron with the Bowl's 100th anniversary and a remarkable Yale season, including an 8-2 record and a shot at the Ivy title in the season finale with ESPN's GameDay set up outside the stadium.

The 2014 Elis led the FCS in total offense while TB Tyler Varga '15 led the nation in scoring and WR Grant Wallace was tops in yards per game receiving. The season included an OT win over Army and an award for the nation's team of the week by the College Football Writer's Association of America. Reno was also honored as a finalist for the 2014 Eddie Robinson Award.

His 2013 Yale team made national news by beating a ranked Cal Poly team on the road in October. His Bulldogs also produced numerous league and national honors.

Reno, the Harvard special teams coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2009 to 2011, helped engineer an undefeated 2011 Ivy League Championship team, which earned a No. 14 Football Championship Subdivision National Ranking. Three of his Crimson special teams units were ranked statistically among the nation's top 20 in 2011.

The 42-year-old Oxford, Mass., native and a 1997 Worcester State College graduate, helped develop 10 All-Ivy players and an All-American over his last two seasons in Boston. His defensive backs enabled the Crimson to lead the league in scoring defense while earning impressive national rankings in numerous categories.

Reno, who spent six years in New Haven and rose to assistant head coach under Jack Siedlecki, helped the Bulldogs win a 2006 Ivy title. He was Yale's wide receivers coach in 2003 and the defensive secondary leader from 2004 to 2008. His 2003 receivers played an integral role in the Blue's No. 2 national ranking in total offense. When he took over the Eli defensive backs, they helped the defense rise to new heights. The 2007 and 2008 Bulldogs were No. 1 in FCS scoring defense, while 14 of his players earned all-league honors during his Yale tenure.

A 2002 AFLAC/Coach Magazine National Assistant of the Year Award winner, Reno served as Worcester State's defensive coordinator from 1998 to 2002. The Lancers, who made two post-season appearances and went 27-5 with Reno as defensive coordinator, were 2001 ECAC Northeast Champions and made it to the title game the following year.

Reno, whose first job was defensive assistant coach at King's (Pa.) College for the 1997 season, earned a degree in history before completing a master of science in health education from WSC in 2000. As a player at WSC, Reno was a three-year starter at free safety, and his team was league champion his last two seasons. His 1996 team led the nation in scoring, rushing and pass efficiency defense.

Reno is the first Yale football head coach from Massachusetts since Ted Coy '10 in 1910. He and his wife, Toni, have three children: Dante, Angelina and Vince.
