

Yale Men's Team Awards

John Edward Heaton High Point

Award (1924) – John Edward Heaton, a former resident of New Haven. Awarded to that swimmer or diver who has scored the highest possible number of points for the team in dual meet competition for the past season.

From 1961-1968 it was given in four categories described as follows:

- (1) To the freshman who was a non-swimmer upon entrance to the university and who has shown the most improvement in swimming.
- (2) To the freshman who took advanced swimming and made the most progress during the year.
- (3) To the member of the freshman squad who demonstrated the most all-around improvement in his swimming and in sportsmanship.
- (4) To the member of the freshman squad for his effort and sportsmanship in diving.

From 1969 it was given in two categories.

- (1) To the member of the freshman squad who demonstrated the most all-around improvement in his swimming and sportsmanship.
- (2) To the member of the freshman squad who demonstrated the most all-around improvement in diving and sportsmanship.
