The Bulldogs begin a three-game road trip this Saturday at Goodman Stadium in Bethlehem, Pa., as the Elis face the Lehigh Mountain Hawks for the first time in four years. Yale got back on track with a 23-17 Ivy League win last week vs. Cornell while Lehigh is in search of its first victory of the season.

### The Series

Saturday's matchup is the 26th all-time meeting between the Bulldogs and Mountain Hawks. Yale leads the series 18-7. The Elis were victorious in the last meeting in 2017, 56-28, also on the road. The Bulldogs have won three of the past four meetings and six of the past eight dating back to 2006. The Elis have also won three of the past four games at Goodman Stadium.

### Bulldog Breakdown

Yale earned its first victory since winning the Ivy League Championship title on the final game of the 2019 season with an Ivy win against Cornell last Saturday at the Yale Bowl. The Bulldogs even their 2021 record and now look to move above .500 with a win at Lehigh.

Senior safety Rodney Thomas II earned the game ball against the Big Red, as well as honorable mention honors by STATS Perform for their FCS National Defensive Player of the Week. Thomas picked off two passes vs. Cornell (one he returned for a touchdown which was called back on a penalty) and recovered an onside kick attempt and ran it back 48 yards for a touchdown with just 70 seconds left. It is the second straight meeting against Cornell that Thomas picked off two passes. He now has six INT's in his career.

Thomas and the Yale defense has allowed 17 points in each game this season and brought the intensity against Cornell with three interceptions, two sacks (both by sophomore tackle Clay Patterson), six tackles for loss and six pass break ups.

On the year, senior captain John Dean leads the way with 16 tackles and is one of six Bulldogs with at least 10 tackles. The Elis have racked up five sacks and 12 pass break-ups in just two games.

On offense, junior quarterback Griffin O'Connor leads the way with four touchdown passes, 551 yards through the air and a 142.51 QB rating. O'Connor completed passes to 10 different receivers last Saturday vs. Cornell.

The Yale quarterback has benefited from strong line play up front which has also opened holes for senior running back Zane Dudek. Dudek moved up to seventh all-time on the Yale rushing list with 2,488 career yards; surpassing John Pagliaro '78 (2,476).

With four rushing attempts on Saturday at Lehigh, Dudek would reach the 400 rush plateau. His current 6.3 yard per rush average would then rank first all-time at Yale (minimum 400 rush attempts) as he would move past all-time great, Dick Jauron '73 (5.7 yards per carry).

## **Yank Townsend Trophy on the Line**

In recognition of competition between Lehigh (founded 1865) and Yale (founded 1701), the lifetime achievements of their graduates, and the generations of families that have attended both universities, the Yank Townsend Trophy is presented to the winner of the Lehigh - Yale football game.

Charles Frederick Townsend was the only student from Connecticut to enter the Lehigh Class of 1895, earning the nickname "Yank." He graduated with a bachelor of science degree in architecture and engineering, operated his own firm, Norton & Townsend from 1911-1960, and designed a number of bank buildings and colonial residences. Yank Townsend (1873-1963) was a devotee of Lehigh and Yale athletics, and today a trophy bearing his name is presented to the winner for the eighth time.

Yale initially won the trophy in 2006 and successfully retained it twice, before Lehigh captured the trophy for the first time in 2011 and reclaimed it in 2016. The Bulldogs won the most recent meeting in 2017.

## **Scouting Lehigh**

The Mountain Hawks are in search of their first win of the season after a grueling start. Lehigh has already taken on then-No. 15/16 Villanova, played at then-No. 22/25 Richmond, faced Ivy League preseason No. 1 Princeton and took to the road to face a tough Colgate team which has also played Boston College, Stony Brook and William & Mary.

Lehigh is currently on an 11-game losing streak dating back to the 2019 season; its longest since the 1934-44 seasons. A twelfth loss would tie the programs longest losing streak from the 1925-26 seasons.

Cross Wilkinson is Lehigh's leading passer with 227 yards on 29 completions but has through four interceptions. Seven different Mountain Hawks have rushed this year but non have crossed 73 yards through four games. Lehigh is still in search of its first touchdown in 2021.

On defense, TyGee Leach leads the team with 24 tackles. Lehigh has nine sacks but has allowed 30 points in each game.

Saturday's matchup will also be Tackle Cancer Day at Goodman Stadium, presented in partnership with the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.

## **Season Outlook**

After winning two of the past three Ivy League Championship, head coach Tony Reno looks to remain the class of the conference with a strong start to the 2021 season. While the Bulldogs have not played a game in 22 months, they do return a great deal of experience. All but one of Yale's set-to-graduate Class of 2021 has returned for this season as the Yale roster now boasts 126 student-athletes.

Four All-Ivy League performers return from the 2019 squad in seniors Zane Dudek (RB), Melvin Rouse (WR), Cam Warfield (OL) and Rodney Thomas (LB/DB) in addition to 2021 captain, John Dean (LB).

Additionally, Yale boasts two of the past three Ivy League Rookies of the Year as Dudek (2017) is joined by quarterback Griffin O'Connor (2018). O'Connor takes on the starting role a season after Kurt Rawlings, the 2019 Bushnell Cup winner, re-wrote the Yale record book with every career passing record.

The offense will need to replace all-time producers JP Shohfi and Reed Klubnik at wide receiver but with Rouse moving back to offense after playing cornerback in 2019 and senior All-Ivy tight end JJ Howland returning from injury, the Bulldogs have two talented performers to join rising sophomore Mason Tipton and senior Darrion Carrington out wide.

The Yale defense returns six of its top seven tacklers from 2019 and once again looks to use a plethora of options along the line and second and third levels. The Bulldogs held Holy Cross to just 10 points in their last meeting but the Crusaders have averaged nearly 30 points over their first two games.

Yale was picked second in the 2021 Ivy League preseason media poll, just behind Princeton. The Bulldogs were also recognized with 12 Phil Steele Preseason All-Ivy League selections: First Team (Dudek, Nick Gargiulo, Rouse), Second Team (Tipton, Thomas, Joey Felton,) and Third Team (O'Connor, Howland, Warfield, Tate Goodyear, Micah Awodiran, Nick Tibbetts).

## The Captain

Yale football continued its tradition of student-athletes selecting its lone senior captain the day after the Bulldogs won a share of the Ivy League Championship. When the votes were tallied it was rising senior linebacker John Dean who was chosen to lead the Elis.

A 6-foot-1, 224-pound defensive starter this past season, Dean takes the baton from JP Shohfi, who led a 27-man senior class to the top of the mountain in 2019. Dean, a Wrentham, Mass., native, started every game for the Bulldogs in its 9-1, Ivy League Championship season.

“Being selected by your peers is the ultimate honor,” said head coach Tony Reno. “John has an incredible work ethic and a driven group of classmates that will help him lead Team 148.”

Dean was third on the team with 18 assisted tackles and ranked seventh with 32 total tackles in 2019. He was no stranger to playing behind the line with 5.5 tackles for loss while also posting a sack and interception in his third season. He has already played in 28 career games for Yale with 88 tackles, four sacks and two picks.

## Top-Two in the Ivy League

Team 148 was selected second overall in the 2021 Ivy League Football Preseason Media Poll as announced by the conference office on Monday morning. Yale earned 104 points, just nine back of Princeton to go along with six first place votes.

### 2021 Ivy League Football Preseason Poll

The poll was voted on by a panel of 16 media members from across the league.

The reigning Ivy League champions went 9-1 overall in 2019 with a 6-1 Ivy record.

Rising junior quarterback and 2018 Ivy League Rookie of the Year, Griffin O'Connor, takes the reins of the offense from reigning Bushnell Cup winner, Kurt Rawlings. O'Connor will benefit from lead rusher, Zane Dudek, who was second in the league with eight rushing touchdowns in 2019.

The Yale defense also keeps continuity as the Elis return six of its top-seven tacklers from 2019, including captain and linebacker, John Dean.

# TONY RENO

*Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach*

Anthony (Tony) Reno, who became the Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach of Yale Football on Jan. 12, 2012, transformed the Elis into a champion in his sixth campaign. His Team 145 defied all 2017 prognostications with a 9-1 (6-1 Ivy) record and the school's first outright league title in 37 years. He followed it up in 2019 with his second championship in three seasons with an identical record and an Ivy League title-clinching victory in one of the greatest playings of The Game ever with a 50-43 double overtime victory.

Team 147 boasted the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year in all-time Bulldog gunslinger, Kurt Rawlings. The senior was also joined by three All-American classmates in captain and wide receiver JP Shohfi, offensive line and Chicago Bears signee Dieter Eiselen and defensive tackle Spencer Matthaei.

Reno's squad in 2017, which included 20 all-league selections, finished with a No. 24 national ranking after earning the Blue's first Ivy championship in 11 seasons. The fruits of his labor – with help from some of the best recruiting classes in FCS Football – were realized in grand fashion with a 24-3 win over Harvard before 52,000 fans at Yale Bowl. The young head coach earned Division I Coach of the Year from both the New England Football Writers and the Gridiron Club of Boston.

The 34th head coach of the Bulldogs, who came back to the program after serving as an assistant at Yale and Harvard, had come close before. The 2014 campaign brought much national attention back to New Haven's gridiron with the Bowl's 100th anniversary and a remarkable Yale season, including an 8-2 record and a shot at the Ivy title in the season finale with ESPN's GameDay set up outside the stadium.

The 2014 Elis led the FCS in total offense while TB Tyler Varga '15 led the nation in scoring and WR Grant Wallace was tops in yards per game receiving. The season included an OT win over Army and an award for the nation's team of the week by the College Football Writer's Association of America. Reno was also honored as a finalist for the 2014 Eddie Robinson Award.

His 2013 Yale team made national news by beating a ranked Cal Poly team on the road in October. His Bulldogs also produced numerous league and national honors.

Reno, the Harvard special teams coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2009 to 2011, helped engineer an undefeated 2011 Ivy League Championship team, which earned a No. 14 Football Championship Subdivision National Ranking. Three of his Crimson special teams units were ranked statistically among the nation's top 20 in 2011.

The Oxford, Mass., native and a 1997 Worcester State College graduate, helped develop 10 All-Ivy players and an All-American over his last two seasons in Boston. His defensive backs enabled the Crimson to lead the league in scoring defense while earning impressive national rankings in numerous categories.

Reno, who spent six years in New Haven and rose to assistant head coach under Jack Siedlecki, helped the Bulldogs win a 2006 Ivy title. He was Yale's wide receivers coach in 2003 and the defensive secondary leader from 2004 to 2008. His 2003 receivers played an integral role in the Blue's No. 2 national ranking in total offense. When he took over the Eli defensive backs, they helped the defense rise to new heights. The 2007 and 2008 Bulldogs were No. 1 in FCS scoring defense, while 14 of his players earned all-league honors during his Yale tenure.

A 2002 AFLAC/Coach Magazine National Assistant of the Year Award winner, Reno served as Worcester State's defensive coordinator from 1998 to 2002. The Lancers, who made two post-season appearances and went 27-5 with Reno as defensive coordinator, were 2001 ECAC Northeast Champions and made it to the title game the following year.

Reno, whose first job was defensive assistant coach at King's (Pa.) College for the 1997 season, earned a degree in history before completing a master of science in health education from WSC in 2000. As a player at WSC, Reno was a three-year starter at free safety, and his team was league champion his last two seasons. His 1996 team led the nation in scoring, rushing and pass efficiency defense.

Reno is the first Yale football head coach from Massachusetts since Ted Coy '10 in 1910. He and his wife, Toni, have three children: Dante, Angelina and Vince.
